### ALL-TIME WITH DOMINICAN

The Owls lead the all-time series with the Chargers, 6-1.

### THE LAST MEETING DOMINICAN

The dynamic duo of Africa Williams '18 and Kiana Steinauer helped push the Owls past Dominican, 65-43 for their fourth straight win back on Nov. 26, 2017.

### THE LAST TIME OUT

- Southern defeated Concordia, 96-48 at Moore Field House.
- Steinauer collected her 10th double-double of the season, where she grabbed 31 of the Owls' 55 rebounds (56.3%). She also hit on 12-of-15 from the field including 4-of-6 from three-point range after entering the game with three three-pointers in her previous 11 games this year.
- Erin Ryder broke a career-high in points with 14, while Amanda Pfohl capped a career-high with 20 points.
- For the fourth-straight game, the Owls had three-or-more players score in double-digits: Steinauer (33), Pfohl (20), Ryder (14), Walker (10) and Smith (10).
- This is the first time this season that the Owls have accumulated over 90 points in a single game.

### KEEP'EM COMIN' STEINAUER

Kiana Steinauer's jaw-dropping performance of 33 points and 31 rebounds against Concordia resulted in:

- the first 30-point, 30-rebound performance in NE10 and SCSU women's basketball history and broke her own SCSU single-game record of 23 rebounds.
- the second 30-30 game in NCAA Division II women's basketball history, the second 30-rebound game in NE10 history and second 30-rebound game in NCAA Division II women's basketball since 1996 and the 13th all-time in NCAA Division II history.

Because of her stellar 33-point, 31-rebound performance against Concordia, Steinauer was tabbed as the NE10 and the U.S Basketball Writers Association National DII Player of the Week for the week of Dec. 17.

### THE OWLS IN THE NE10

- The Owls currently have two players in the conference in the top 20 in scoring, highlighted by Kiana Steinauer (17.6, 5th) and Amanda Pfohl (13.2, 16th).
- Pfohl's 37 three-pointers lead the conference.
- Steinauer's 16.0 rebounds per game puts her first in the NE10, while her 2.3 steals rank fourth.
- Imani Wheeler ranks fifth in the NE10 with 4.7 assists per game and eighth with 2.1 steals per game.

### THE OWLS IN THE NCAA

- As of Dec. 29, Kiana Steinauer leads NCAA DII in four categories. She ranks first in rebounds per game with 16.0; total rebounds with 192; total defensive rebounds with 133 and double-doubles with 10.
- Amanda Pfohl ranks sixth in NCAA DII in three-point field goal attempts with 100 and sixth in 3-pointers made with 37.
