Noting the Golden Eagles

- Southern Miss plays in its 106th football season in 2022, having first fielded a team in 1912. The Golden Eagles are 612-451-27, which is 40th best among FBS teams by winning percentage (.574).
- The Golden Eagles began play in their fourth different conference in their football history in 2022, after holding a spot in the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Association from 1931-41, the Gulf States Conference from 1948-1951 and Conference USA from 1996-2021. Southern Miss starts its first year as a member of the Sun Belt Conference. Its first-ever game came at Troy on Oct. 8.
- The program has collected 23 winning seasons over the last 29 and appeared in 18 bowl games during that time.
- Overall, Southern Miss has enjoyed 73 winning seasons and five years of .500 football over its history. Since 2000, the Golden Eagles have 17 of 22 winning seasons.
- Against the current membership of the Sun Belt Conference, the Golden Eagles are 77-30-1 versus league foes, having never met Coastal Carolina and JMU.

The Coastal Carolina Series

- This will be the 75th different opponent of the current FBS alignment that Southern Miss will meet in football for the first time this weekend.
- They are the first team from the state of South Carolina that the Golden Eagles have played since dropping a 41-13 decision at South Carolina to open the 2010 season.
- There is one Golden Eagle on the current roster from South Carolina - offensive lineman James Middleton from North Charleston. He has appeared in one game this season.
- CCU head coach Jamey Chadwell was the head coach for a season in 2012 at Delta State and met Will Hall when he was the head coach at West Alabama. UWA won that day 37-7 in the Statesmen's homecoming contest.
- The Chanticleers have one player from the state of Mississippi - cornerback D'Jordan Strong (Batesville).

Winning Close Games

- Of the five wins for Southern Miss this season, three have come by six points or less. The last time Southern Miss won at least three games in a season by seven or fewer points was during the 2017 campaign when they defeated UTSA (31-29), Louisiana Tech (34-27) in double overtime, and Marshall (28-27).
- Over the last month, Southern Miss captured a 20-19 home triumph over Arkansas State, a 20-14 decision at Texas State in close contests before defeating Louisiana 39-24 at home on a Thursday night. The last time the Golden Eagles won consecutive games by seven or fewer points was in 2004 when they upended USF (27-20) and Houston (39-35) in overtime in back-to-back outcomes.
- With the win at Texas State, the Golden Eagles went over the .500 mark for the first time since the end of the 2019 campaign when they posted a 7-6 record.

Notes from Georgia State Game

- Trey Lowe came off the bench in the second half to throw for 84 yards on 6-of-14 passes with a touchdown pass to Cole Cavallo in the third quarter. It was Cavallo's first career TD catch.
- The Golden Eagles allowed a season-high seven sacks.
- USM held GSU on fourth down on the opening series, moving its season total to 2-for-17 on opposing fourth downs and now rank No. 1 in the country in that category.
- The defense gave up over 300 yards rushing for the first time since North Texas rushed for 321 yards last season. The Panthers finished with 388 total yards.
- Daylen Gill led the team in tackles with a career-high 12 tackles (five solo, seven assists), besting his previous best of 11 from last the previous week's game against Louisiana. Jalen Williams also notched a season-best nine stops in the contest.
- Mason Hunt booted 10 punts, tying his career-high set last season against Troy. His 10 punts totaled 459 yards with a season-long 59. Two were downed inside the 20-yard line.

Will Hall

Head Football Coach | Second Season - 8-13 (.381) / Overall - Eighth Season 64-33 (.660)

At his introductory press conference in December of 2020 as the 22nd head coach of Southern Miss football, Will Hall spoke about how ‘attitude is everything’ in his initial comments to those in attendance at Reed Green Coliseum.

That attitude has provided a relentlessly positive approach in how he has communicated and prepared his players, elevated the growth of every facet of this football program, while also energizing a fan base since first taking the stage as the Golden Eagles top football coach.

In his opening season for the Golden Eagles, adversity struck hard for the program as the Golden Eagles saw most of their quarterback corps go down due to injury during the early portion of the season. Despite that fact, the Golden Eagles remained upbeat each week and transitioned its offense that many fans dubbed the “Superback” featuring a running back overseeing the offense from a shotgun position toward the latter part of the campaign.

That transition allowed the Golden Eagles to win two of their final three games of the campaign, while also almost knocking off the league champion, UTSA.

Hall also oversaw a Nasty Bunch defense that provided many highlights, including holding its opponents to the second fewest first downs in the country (197), while collecting the fourth most fumble recoveries (13). The defense gave up just 358.5 yards per game, which ranked No. 3 in Conference USA and No. 42 in the country. Southern Miss bettered their national ranking in total defense by 18 spots from the previous year.

With its core nucleus of players returning for 2022, to go along with a plethora of talent incoming for this season, Southern Miss looks poised to make a splash its initial Sun Belt Conference season as well as return to a bowl game for the first time since the 2019 campaign.

Hall, a native of Amory, Miss., came to Southern Miss after serving the previous two years as offensive coordinator at Tulane.

Hall made an immediate impact on the Tulane offense and helped the Green Wave rewrite their offensive record books. He helped Tulane post one of the most successful offensive seasons in program history in 2019. The Green Wave finished the season ranked 11th in the nation in rushing offense (243.2), 22nd in total offense (449.3) and 30th in scoring offense (33.1). Hall helped the Green Wave rush for over 200 yards in nine games in 2019 and over 300 times four times.

The Tulane offense set the program record in rushing yards at 3,162 yards in 2019. The offense ranked second in program history in rushing yards per game (243.2), rushing touchdowns (33) and rushing first downs (166).

Tulane's offense also eclipsed 500 yards against five times, including a season-high 634 total yards against UConn. The Green Wave also set a season-high in passing yards against the Huskies with 323.

In 2020, the Green Wave enjoyed more success offensively as they finished No. 17 nationally in rushing offense (217.1), No. 19 in first downs (258) and No. 22 in scoring offense (34.7), while adding two more 500-yard total offensive games to his resume.

Hall joined the Green Wave coaching staff after he spent the 2018 campaign as the Associate Head Coach/Tight Ends Coach at the University of Memphis where he helped guide the Tigers to the American Athletic Conference Championship game for the second straight season and helped the Tigers to their fifth straight bowl appearance.

During his lone season at Memphis, Hall helped guide the Tigers to a school record with 42 rushing touchdowns during the regular season. In addition, Memphis finished the regular season with 3,311 rushing yards, setting a new school record.

Memphis' offense ranked in the nation's top 10 in rushing (No. 5, 275.9), scoring offense (No. 6, 43.8) and total offense (No. 6, 530.3) under Hall's assistance. In addition, Hall helped four Memphis offensive players earn All-AAC honors.

Hall joined the Memphis staff in January 2018 after spending the 2017 season as the offensive coordinator for the Louisiana-Lafayette Ragin' Cajuns, where six offensive players received all-conference honors. The Cajuns ranked among the best in the nation in red zone offense and turnovers lost with just 16.

In his one season as offensive coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette, the Ragin' Cajuns compiled the Sun Belt Conference's third-best rushing offense with 2,204 yards and 27 rushing touchdowns. The Louisiana-Lafayette offense tied for the second-fewest turnovers in the Sun Belt during the 2017 season. The Cajuns were also efficient in the red zone, leading the Sun Belt by scoring

on 92.9-percent of their red zone chances.

In his three-year head coaching stint at West Georgia (UWG), Hall led the Wolves to a 31-9 record, the first Gulf South Conference (GSC) title since 2000 and a pair of NCAA Division II semifinal appearances. His first two seasons at UWG produced a pair of 12-win seasons before he finished 7-4 in 2016.

Success was immediate for Hall as the Wolves set multiple school records, won their first GSC title in 14 years and reached the NCAA Division II playoffs.

Under his direction, a program that had not made an impact in the conference, much less nationally, in over a decade transformed into the talk of the nation in NCAA Division II. Under Hall's direction, the Wolves were nationally ranked for 17 weeks consecutively and earned the program's first No. 1 national ranking on Oct. 26, 2015.

Hall's first UWG squad in 2014 caught more than a few people by surprise. The Wolves finished the regular season strong with a 9-2 record and earned the program's first NCAA playoffs bid since 2000. Road wins at Tuskegee, Delta State, and Valdosta State were the first postseason victories in the school's Division II history and gave UWG the NCAA Super Region 2 title.

Though UWG caught no one by surprise in 2015, it didn't matter. Hall's juggernaut roared through the first nine games of the regular season, all wins, and none were closer than a 17-point margin. A three-touchdown, Week 8 win over nationally ranked North Alabama pushed the Wolves into the top spot in the nation in Division II for the first time in school history.

Hall was twice named GSC Coach of the Year and was the Super Region 2 Coach of the Year.

In his first season at West Georgia, more than 30 team and individual records fell. In addition to setting records, the Wolves hauled in individual accolades.

Sixteen players earned All-Gulf South Conference recognition and seven received All-American distinction, which included the program's first Academic All-American in Alex Macaulay.

From 2011-13 as the head coach at West Alabama, his teams won two league titles and twice earned spots in the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

Hall's players also have had success at the next level, and among that group of honored athletes is 2015 Super Bowl hero and current Tennessee Titan Malcolm Butler, who was a two-time All-GSC performer for Hall at West Alabama. In the spring of 2016, offensive tackle Dominique Robertson became the first UWG player in school history to receive an invitation to the NFL Draft Combine.

Prior to his six seasons at West Alabama, Hall enjoyed successful stints on the coaching staff at Arkansas-Monticello, Southwest Baptist, Henderson State, and Presbyterian. Hall's achievements in the coaching profession are a carryover from his illustrious career on the playing field at North Alabama.

Hall played for his father, Bobby Hall, at Amory High School leading the Panthers to the 1998 Mississippi High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) Class 3A state title. From 1999-2000, he attended Northwest Mississippi Community College, where he was a two-time National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) All-American.

In 2000, Hall set a NJCAA record for total offense in a season (4,075 yards) and added an NJCAA single-game record with nine touchdown passes.

Hall then moved to North Alabama, where he was a quarterback for the Lions from 2002-03. He won the Harlan Hill Trophy in 2003, emblematic of being America's top player in NCAA Division II. In 2003, Hall, who threw for 3,531 yards and 30 touchdowns, led the Lions to a 13-1 record and an NCAA Division II semifinals appearance.

In 2004, Hall signed a contract to play for the Tupelo FireAnts of the National Indoor Football League. Playing once again for his father, who was the head coach for the team, Hall passed for 2,046 yards and 44 touchdowns while rushing for 13 scores in the 14-game season.

A 2003 graduate of North Alabama, Hall, and wife Rebecca, have two sons – Tripp and Pete.

Last Week's Game

Georgia State 42, Southern Miss 14 Nov. 5, 2022

HATTIESBURG (AP) - Marcus Carroll ran for 163 yards and three touchdowns to lead Georgia State to a 42-14 win over Southern Miss.

Georgia State (4-5, 3-2 Sun Belt) has won four of its last five games, while Southern Miss (5-4, 3-2 Sun Belt) ended a three-game win streak.

Carroll scored on an 18-yard run and twice more from short yardage. Darren Grainger threw for 133 yards and two touchdown passes and added 143 yards on the ground on 13 carries. Jamari Thrash made two touchdown catches and had 60 yards receiving.

Frank Gore, Jr. posted a 43-yard touchdown run that pulled Southern Miss to 28-14 late in the third quarter and finished with 87 yards rushing. Trey Lowe, who came off the bench to quarterback the Golden Eagles, threw for 84 yards and a score.

The Golden Eagles other score came on a seven-yard pass to Cole Cavallo, which was his first career touchdown reception.

Golden Eagles Kick Off Inaugural Sun Belt Conference Season

- After spending the last 26 seasons in Conference USA, the Golden Eagles announced their intention of joining the Sun Belt Conference last fall and became full members July 1.
- The Golden Eagles are part of the new 14-team Sun Belt Conference that are separated in the East (App State, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, James Madison, Marshall and Old Dominion) and West (Arkansas State, Louisiana, South Alabama, Southern Miss, Texas State, Troy and ULM) division. JMU, ODU and Marshall joins the Golden Eagles as first-year members.
- Southern Miss won five Conference USA titles during its tenure, including one since divisional play started in 2005. They captured their only league title contest and the school's fifth overall C-USA league crown when they beat Houston, 49-28, in 2011.
- The school's other C-USA titles came in the inaugural season of 1996 as well as the 1997, 1999 and 2003 campaigns. The Golden Eagles also won two East Division crowns in C-USA (2006, 2011), and captured their first West title in 2015 after moving to that division during the 2014 campaign. Southern Miss won its third division title in 2015, but lost in the C-USA championship game at WKU, 45-28. Southern Miss was 1-2 in C-USA title games.
- Along with the five C-USA titles, the Golden Eagles also won three league titles - 1948, 1950, 1951 - when they were members of the Gulf States Conference.

Of the 114 players listed on the Southern Miss 2022 football roster, 76 players come from Mississippi (66.7%), representing 52 different Magnolia State communities. The cities of Hattiesburg, Madison and Oxford lead the way with four players apiece, while Flora, Purvis each have three Golden Eagles from their respective towns. Bassfield, Bay St. Louis, Fayette, Greenwood, Gulfport, Louisville, Magee, Starkville, Taylorsville and West Point each have two Southern Miss players represent their city.

Pro Traditions

Southern Miss, which has a reputation in training and producing professional talent over the years, has a long list of former players that have reached the NFL including the likes of Ray Guy, Brett Favre, Sammy Winder, Michael Boley and Jamie Collins. Southern Miss has had at least one player drafted in 15 of the last 22 NFL drafts. Since 1942, 129 players have been drafted by the NFL, AFL or AAFC, which including a school-best four on nine different occasions.

The Golden Eagles at Home

- Since the start of the 1976 season, following the renovation of M.M. Roberts Stadium, the Golden Eagles have posted a 160-78 (.675) record at The Rock. The program has finished at .500 or better in home games for a season 39 times during that span.

Crazy Night at The Rock

- Maybe it was because the game was played so close to Halloween, but there were some weird happenings at the Thursday night, Oct. 27, game against Louisiana.
 - After Southern Miss' first touchdown, UL blocked the extra point and scored on a defensive extra point - the first allowed by the Golden Eagles since 2009 against East Carolina. It snapped a 19-straight extra-point made streak for PK Briggs Bourgeois.
 - The Golden Eagles later blocked an extra point and Malik Shorts also registered an pick on an another extra point and almost was able to score a defensive extra point for USM.
 - There was a safety charged to UL with an intentional grounding in the end zone.
 - USM threw a pick on the first play of the game and then held UL on a 4th down play.

November Games

The Golden Eagles hold a 212-151-11 record (.582) in games played in the month of November in its long, storied history. The Golden Eagles posted undefeated and untied records this calendar month 17 times, when they played two or more games during the month.

A Golden Eagles Win over Coastal Carolina would...

- improve the Golden Eagles to 4-1 over opponents from the state of South Carolina (2-0 versus The Citadel, 1-0 versus the Parris Island Marines and 0-1 versus South Carolina)
- capture their sixth win over the last eight games
- allow them to be bowl eligible for the first time since 2019 and for the 22nd time in the last 27 years
- enable them to win their third of the last five games against foes they are meeting for the first time

The Offensive Line

The Golden Eagle offensive front line returned six players that started a year ago and all six of those have made at least one start in 2022 after Coker Wright got his first nod of the year at Texas State at right guard. Freshman Kyron Barnes is one newcomer on the offensive line that has also started up front - getting the call in five games for Paul Gainer, Jr. Gerquan Scott, who is the only returning Southern Miss player to start every game on the line last year, ran his consecutive start streak to 25 for the Golden Eagles against Texas State. Gainer has played the most on the offensive line at 33 contests, with 14 starts, while John Bolding had a string of 13th straight starts snapped at Texas State. Briason Mays missed the Texas State game with an injury, snapping a string of 10 starts in a row coming at center. Mays and Bolding each returned to the starting lineup in each of the last two contests.

Wilcke Gets the Call at Quarterback

Zach Wilcke became the ninth true freshman since 1987 to get the starting call at quarterback at No. 15 Miami early in the season. Wilcke is the sixth Golden Eagle true freshman to open a game at QB since the start of the 2012 campaign. He is the first freshman quarterback for the program to start in his initial Southern Miss playing experience since Keon Howard did it at Old Dominion, on Nov. 12, 2016.

Wilcke went 16-for-27 for 207 yards in his debut with a 32-yard touchdown pass to Jason Brownlee. He added a team-high 15 yards rushing. His passing yards were the most by a Golden Eagle freshman in his debut since Howard threw 230 and a TD on 12-of-24 throws.

Wilcke made the start due to an injury with Ty Keyes, which he sustained in the opening half of the Liberty contest. The Golden Eagles used their SuperBack offense for the remainder of that contest.

He has thrown for 1,163 yards thus far in 2022 and has the capability to throw the most passing yards in the last three seasons this weekend. Jake Lange threw for 843 yards last year to lead the squad and Jack Abraham's 1,224 passing yards led the team in 2020.

Lange Comes In Late to Rally Eagles in ASU Win

Jake Lange, who entered the game late in the third quarter at Arkansas State, led the Golden Eagles to two scoring drives as they rallied to win the contest. His first scoring drive, Lange led the Golden Eagles 95 yards on nine plays, which marked the longest drive of the season and longest since against Jackson State in the opening game of 2018. On the game-winning drive, he scrambled for six yards on his only rush on a third-down play that put the team close to a first down before hitting Cole Cavallo on a four-yard completion inside the Red Wolves 5 on 4th-and-3 on the next play, in which the Golden Eagles got a first down. They scored the game-winning touchdown on the next play.

Big Play Brownlee

In 2022, Jason Brownlee has 38 catches for 564 yards with six TD catches and is the top current receiver for the Golden Eagles with 118 career catches for 1,817 yards with 19 touchdown grabs.

He tallied his sixth 100-yard receiving game at Miami with five catches for 102 yards and then his seventh when he notched 105 yards on a career-best 12 catches versus Troy. That catch total ties for the second-most catches in a game by a Golden Eagle. He added his 8th 100-yard receiving game with three catches for 102 yards and a pair of scores from 76 and 12 yards out versus UL.

His eight 100-yard receiving games rank fourth on the school career charts behind Sherrod Gideon (11), and Mike Thomas and Quez Watkins (10). His 19 touchdown receptions also is tied for fourth on the career Golden Eagle charts with Mike Thomas. Brownlee has at least one catch in each of the last 19 games and has caught a pass in all but two games he has played in his career.

Gore Leads the Running Backs

Frank Gore, Jr. led the Golden Eagles offense in a couple of roles last season. He was the team's top running back with 801 yards on the ground with three rushing scores and was also called to take snaps from center late in the year and converted 10-of-16 passes for 189 yards with four touchdown passes, two coming at LA Tech and two versus FIU. He also led the team in all-purpose yards with 990, as he also had 155 receiving yards.

He started his third season with a career-best 178 yards on a career-best 32 carries as he also threw for 48 yards on 1-of-4 passing against Liberty. It was his sixth 100-yard rushing game of his career and the Golden Eagles are 4-2 when he achieves that feat. Currently, Gore, Jr., paces the Eagles with 742 rushing yards this season, averaging 4.9 yards per carry with a team-high five rushing scores, including a 43-yard touchdown run against Georgia State. He threw his first touchdown pass of the year versus UL, and fifth of his career, on a 52-yard strike to Tiaquelin Mims in the first quarter.

Gore, Jr., led the team in rushing in 2020 with 708 yards on 121 carries for a 5.9 rush average. Gore was a second-team All-Conference USA selection in 2020 and was a member of the league's All-Freshman team. Gore is a member of the preseason watch list for the Doak Walker Award, given to the nation's top running back.

His six 100-yard rushing games tie him for 13th on Golden Eagle charts for that category with Tony Smith (1989-91) and Kendrick Hardy (2010-13).

Youngest Defensive Coordinator in the FBS

Southern Miss assistant coach Austin Armstrong has the distinction of being the youngest defensive coordinator in the Football Bowl Subdivision for the second-straight season. At 29, Armstrong came to Southern Miss prior to last season from Louisiana-Lafayette where he was the inside linebackers coach. The next youngest defensive coordinator is Nate Dreiling at New Mexico State, who opened the season at 31 years old.

Nasty Bunch Continuing with Solid Performance

Southern Miss finished 2021 at No. 42 nationally in total defense, allowing 358.5 yards per contest. The group finished No. 73 in the country in rushing defense (156.5 ypg), holding opponents to under 100 yards on the ground three times, and 24th in passing yards allowed at 202.0 per game.

The Golden Eagles surrendered 27.9 points per contest, ranking No. 80 in the country. But of the 335 points allowed by the team, the Golden Eagles gave up 63 points directly off turnovers, 34 points on short fields after turnovers, 14 points on two kick returns for scores, and one safety when the quarterback was sacked in the end zone, cutting the number to the defense allowing to 18.5 points per contest.

In 2022, the Golden Eagles have allowed an average of 378.8 yards per game (No. 70 currently). They limited Liberty to just 194 yards over the first three quarters, while holding Miami to 10 points in the opening half, giving up only 198 yards to Tulane in the second half, holding Arkansas State to 50 yards rushing, forcing negative six yards rushing at Texas State before holding Louisiana to 69 yards rushing. They also have produced 15 turnovers (No. 38 FBS), including a season-high four versus Louisiana, three versus Liberty and two against Troy, and at least one in eight of nine of games.

Qewon Leads the Team in Sacks

Senior Dominic Qewon leads the team and is second in the Sun Belt in sacks with 7.5, averaging 0.83 per contest. Qewon also ranks No. 12 in the country in that category, while he leads the team in TFLs with 8.5. The Golden Eagles as a team have at least one sack in every games this season and have at least two in all nine games for 31 on the year (No. 7 in FBS at sacks per game at 3.4).

Shorts Leading Team in Tackles in 2022

Defensive back Malik Shorts paced the Golden Eagles in 2021, as he was the school's nominee for the Conerly Trophy - the top collegiate player in the state of Mississippi.

In seven games last season, he either led or tied for the team high in tackles. Shorts ranked first in tackles with 89 including two tackles for loss, two interceptions and seven pass breakups.

This season, Shorts opened with a game-high 12 tackles and an interception against Liberty and followed that with a game-high 13 stops with another interception at Miami. He got two tackles in limited action against Northwestern State, before getting eight stops versus Tulane, six at Troy, five versus Arkansas State and six at Texas State. Versus UL, he registered a team-high tying 11 stops with an interceptions and another pick on a Louisiana extra point and notched seven versus Georgia State. He has a team-best 71 stops in 2022 and ranks No. 8 in the Sun Belt in tackles per game.

Latham Finished No. 3 in Country in Fumble Recoveries

Santrell Latham recovered three fumbles last season - the last one he returned 72 yards at Louisiana Tech - and finished ranked No. 3 in the country in that category. He also forced four fumbles which ranked No. 8 in the country. He started this season with another forced fumble on a sack against Liberty to give him six forces in his career. Latham collected six solo tackles in the contest with two of those tackles for loss. He followed that with three assisted tackles at Miami.

Latham ended fifth on the team in tackles with 52, including five for loss, a season ago.

This year, after getting a team-high tackles at Tulane (9) and Troy (10) and a team-tying best eight versus Arkansas State, Latham is second on the team in stops with 60.

The D-Line Keeps Things Stuffed Up Front

Sophomore Josh Ratcliff returned as the top defensive lineman in terms of tackles returning in 2022. Ratcliff tallied 34 tackles (13 solos) with 4.5 tackles for loss and a half sack to go along with one fumble recovery. After not registering a tackle in the opener, Ratcliff posted a career-high tying five stops against Miami, including his first sack of the year.

In the 2022 opener, defensive line teammates Kristin Booth and Jalen Williams paced the defensive line with four tackles each, while Armondous Cooley added three stops. Against Miami, Williams collected seven stops while Quentin Bivens tallied his first sack of the year. Ratcliff led all defensive lineman in tackles against Northwestern State with four stops, including a half sack and 1.5 TFLs.

Versus Tulane, Williams posted seven tackles and Bivens added six stops to pace the defensive line. In the Troy contest, Williams led the defensive line again with five tackles with one for loss. Jordyn Mahaffey led the D-line for the first time in tackles against Arkansas State with four. Bivens paced the team with two tackles at Texas State.

Bivens and Ratcliff led the defensive line with four tackles against Louisiana, while Williams registered a career-high nine stops versus Georgia State.

Briggs Bourgeois Back Booting Kicks

Redshirt senior Briggs Bourgeois opened 2022 by making all three extra-point attempts to go along with 2-of-3 field goals made, including a career-long 53 yard attempt in the second overtime. He added an extra point and two touchbacks in his contest at Miami. His best game of the year came versus Northwestern State in which he converted 34- and 26-yard field goals as well as making seven-of-seven extra point attempts. He also notched 10 kickoffs for a 64.3 yard average, including eight touchbacks. He added two more field goals - 36 and 26 yards - at Tulane with three extra points, and after making a 34-yard at Troy, along with a pair of makes at Texas State (33, 40) and one versus Louisiana (25), he now has converted his last nine field goal attempts. In his career, Bourgeois has made 32-of-43 field goals, and 84-of-89 career extra-point attempts.

This is the third consecutive year and fifth overall that Bourgeois has handled most of the kicking duties, after missing 2019 with a leg injury.

Hunt Punts Down the Field

Ray Guy Award Watch list candidate Mason Hunt has had the punting chores over the last 2 years.

Hunt finished the 2020 season by averaging 43.6 yards over 71 punts with 40 fair catches, 18 inside the opponents 20 and 15 or more for 50 yards. His per punt average was the furthest by a Golden Eagle since Tyler Sarrazin averaged 44.7 yards per punt in 2016.

This year, Hunt has collected 53 punts for a 43.4 average, including 22 inside the opponent's 20 yardline and a long of 59 last week versus Georgia State and 15 of 50 or more yards. He also has 21 fair catches, while opponents have returned eight punts for

an average of 5.8 yards.

Honoring the Greatest Punter of All Time

The Golden Eagles will wear the logo RG44 on their helmets for the remainder of the year to honor punting great Ray Guy, who passed away last week. The Pro Football Hall of Famer and former Golden Eagle was 72. He lettered for the school from 1970-72. That logo is displayed on the front page of these notes.

After each team missed their one-play try from the three-yard line on the third overtime, Liberty converted theirs to start the fourth. After an interference penalty forced gave the Golden Eagles one more try, Gore's run came up short to end the contest.

Eric Scott, Jr., also added a 22-yard interception return for a touchdown for the Golden Eagles, marking the fourth time that has happened over the last five games.

Game 2: at No. 15 Miami 30, Southern Miss 7 (Sept. 10, 2022)

MIAMI GARDENS, Fla. -- (AP) A pair of third-quarter touchdowns — barely two minutes apart — changed the game, Henry Parrish rushed for 97 yards and a score, and No. 15 Miami pulled away in the second half to beat Southern Miss 30-7 on Saturday at Hard Rock Stadium.

The Hurricanes (2-0) trailed for most of the second quarter, then shook off the slow start by scoring the game's final 27 points.

Thaddius Franklin Jr. rushed in from seven yards out for a 17-7 third-quarter lead, Tyler Van Dyke connected with Key'Shawn Smith for a 35-yard flea-flicker touchdown on Miami's next offensive snap, and the outcome wasn't in doubt again.

Parrish had a 1-yard touchdown run late in the first half for only the seventh time in the past 18 seasons.

Jason Brownlee caught a 32-yard touchdown pass from Zach Wilcke for Southern Miss (0-2). That capped a six-play, 75-yard drive for the Golden Eagles — but they managed only 122 yards on their next seven drives, five of which ended in punts, one with an interception in the end zone and the other with a fumble.

Frank Gore Jr., the son of Miami Hall of Famer Frank Gore, was held largely in check by the Hurricanes' defense in his return to his hometown. Gore Jr. had seven carries for 10 yards, and two catches for 18 more yards. That's after he rushed for 178 yards last week in Southern Miss' opening-game loss to Liberty.

Wilcke completed 16 of 27 passes for 207 yards for the Golden Eagles. Brownlee had five of those catches for 102 yards. Malik Shorts recorded is second interception in as many weeks when he picked off Van Dyke in the second quarter.

Game 3: at Southern Miss 64, Northwestern State 10 (Sept. 17, 2022)

HATTIESBURG, Miss. – Southern Miss scored its most points since 2017 and garnered 587 offensive yards to post a 64-10 non-conference football victory over Northwestern State at The Rock.

The Golden Eagles (1-2) snapped a two-game losing streak as four quarterbacks combined to throw for 400 yards, including a career-high 192 yards and a career-best three touchdowns from Ty Keyes off the bench.

The point total was the most for the program since defeating Charlotte, 66-21, here, Nov. 18, 2017.

Southern Miss scored the first 50 point of the contest, include taking a 41-0 halftime advantage, as Jakarius Caston collected two touchdown catches of 40 and 7 yards in the first half. Caston finished with games highs of six catches and 94 yards.

The Golden Eagles started the scoring on field goals of 34 and 26 yards on their first two drives by Briggs Bourgeois and Caston added the 40-yard TD score on the third drive, giving Southern Miss a 13-0 advantage after a quarter.

Southern Miss pulled away in the second quarter after Swayze Bozeman returned a fumble 12 yards off a sack and forced fumble by Dominic Quewon and Gore, who rushed for a game-high 82 yards, tallied a 26-yard scoring run with 9:20 left in the second quarter, before Caston added his second TD some six minutes later.

Jalen May finished the scoring for the home team's first-half scoring with 1:24 left before the break on an 89-yard strike across the middle from Keyes, which turned into the fourth longest TD throw in school history.

The defense limited the Demons to just 234 yards, including 16 on the ground.

Game 4: Southern Miss 27, at Tulane 24 (Sept. 24, 2022)

NEW ORLEANS (AP) — Zach Wilcke threw a pair of touchdown passes, Eric Scott, Jr. returned an interception for a score and Southern Miss collected its second win of the season, beating previously unbeaten Tulane on Saturday night, 27-24.

Wilcke's 37-yard touchdown pass to Jakarius Caston tied it at 17 late in the third quarter. Scott's pick-6 stretched the Southern Miss lead to 27-17 with 7:07 remaining. Wilcke was 17-of-25 passing for 194 yards. Caston had a career-high eight receptions for 91 yards.

Michael Pratt's 25-yard touchdown pass to Jha'Quan Jackson for Tulane capped the scoring with 19 seconds left.

Tyjae Spears ran for 114 yards and two touchdowns for Tulane (3-1). Spears also made five catches for 74 yards. Spears' 8-yard TD run and his 34-yard scoring run gave Tulane a 14-0 lead early in the second quarter.

Southern Miss (2-2) ended a two-game skid in the series, a 30-13 loss in the 2020 Armed Forces Bowl and a 66-24 defeat at home during the 2020 regular season.

It was the 33rd meeting in the series dating to 1979, but the first in New Orleans since 2010, a 46-10 Southern Miss win at the Louisiana Superdome. It was also the first time the teams met in Yulman Stadium.

Dominic Quewon registered his team-high third sack of the year in the second quarter. The Golden Eagles registered four sacks for the third straight game and now have 14 on the year.

Jay Jones collected his first blocked punt of his career in the second quarter as it was the program's first blocked punt since Jordan Mitchell did it against UTEP on Sept. 28, 2019.

Game 6: at Southern Miss 20, Arkansas State 19 (Oct. 15, 2022)

HATTIESBURG, Miss. (AP) -- Frank Gore, Jr. and Janari Dean had fourth-quarter touchdown runs and Southern Miss rallied to beat Arkansas State 20-19.

Arkansas State used James Blackman's 9-yard touchdown pass to Jeff Foreman and a safety to take a 19-7 lead after three quarters.

Southern Miss (3-3, 1-1 Sun Belt) pulled within five points on Gore's 30-yard scoring run to finish off a nine-play, 95-yard drive with 9:20 remaining in the game.

The 95-yard drive was the longest of the season and longest since a 98-yard drive against Jackson State during the 2018 season.

The Golden Eagles' defense forced a three-and-out and Natrone Brooks' 30-yard punt return set Southern Miss up at the Red Wolves' 45-yard line. Jake Lange directed a 12-play drive with Dean giving the Golden Eagles the lead on a 3-yard run with 2:12 left to play.

Arkansas State (2-5, 1-3 Sun Belt) turned the ball over on downs after two false-start penalties and a sack by the Golden Eagles' Jalil Clemons left the Red Wolves in a fourth-and-27 hole.

Zach Wilcke completed 11 of 20 passes for 132 yards with two interceptions for Southern Miss. His 23-yard scoring strike to Jason Brownlee late in the second quarter left Southern Miss trailing 10-7 at halftime. Gore totaled 96 yards on 19 carries. Lange completed 6 of 12 passes for 45 yards after coming off the bench late in the third quarter.

Blackman completed 25 of 34 passes for 236 yards and two touchdowns for Arkansas State. The Red Wolves managed just 50 yards on the ground on 31 rushes.

The game marked the first Sun Belt Conference victory in the program's history.

Janari Dean extended the Golden Eagles lead in the second quarter with a two-yard run to make the score 10-0, before the Bobcats then completed a 75-yard, eight play drive on their next series with their first touchdown of the night - a 4-yard Javen Banks throw from Hatcher.

The score went into halftime 13-7 for the visitors when Bourgeois nailed a 40-yard attempt as the clock expired in the second quarter.
