Noting the Golden Eagles

- Southern Miss plays in its 106th football season in 2022, having first fielded a team in 1912. The Golden Eagles are 607-449-27, which is 41st best among FBS teams by winning percentage (.573).
- The second year of the Will Hall era got underway last Saturday. He became the top man of the program on Dec. 2, 2020 (formally introduced on Dec. 7). Hall is the school's 22nd full-time head coach.
- The Golden Eagles will begin play in their fourth different conference in their football history this season, holding a spot in the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Association from 1931-41, the Gulf States Conference from 1948-1951 and Conference USA from 1996-2021. Southern Miss starts its first year as a member of the Sun Belt Conference.
- The program has collected 23 winning seasons over the last 29 and appeared in 18 bowl games during that time.
- Overall, Southern Miss has enjoyed 73 winning seasons and five years of .500 football over its history. Since 2000, the Golden Eagles have 17 of 22 winning seasons.

Sun Belt Conference Inaugural Season

- After spending the last 26 seasons in Conference USA, the Golden Eagles announced its intention of joining the Sun Belt Conference last fall and became full members July 1.
- The Golden Eagles are a part of the new 14-team Sun Belt Conference that will be separated in the East (App State, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, James Madison, Marshall and Old Dominion) and West (Arkansas State, Louisiana, South Alabama, Southern Miss, Texas State, Troy and ULM) division. JMU, ODU and Marshall joins the Golden Eagles as first-year members.
- Southern Miss won five Conference USA titles during its tenure, including one since divisional play started in 2005. They captured their only league title contest and the school's fifth overall C-USA league crown when they beat Houston, 49-28, in 2011.
- The school's other C-USA titles came in the inaugural season of 1996 as well as the 1997, 1999 and 2003 campaigns. The Golden Eagles also won two East Division crowns in C-USA (2006, 2011), and captured their first West title in 2015 after moving to that division during the 2014 campaign. Southern Miss won its third division title in 2015, but lost in the C-USA championship game at WKU, 45-28. Southern Miss was 1-2 in C-USA title games.
- Along with the five C-USA titles, the Golden Eagles also won three league titles - 1948, 1950, 1951 - when they were members of the Gulf States Conference.
- Against the current membership of the Sun Belt Conference, the Golden Eagles are 74-28-1 versus league foes, having never met Coastal Carolina, Georgia State and JMU.

The Northwestern State Series

- The two programs battle for the 23rd time in football as each school has won 11 meetings.
- The Golden Eagles have won the last two meetings with the Demons, collecting a 40-6 decision in the last encounter between the two on Sept. 11, 1999. (the entire series breakdown and the 1999 game can be found on page 3 of the notes)
- Southern Miss has won eight of the last nine games in the series which dates back to 1930, when the Demons captured a 32-12 decision in Natchitoches, La.
- The last five games in the series, dating back to 1951, have been played in Hattiesburg.
- This will be only the fourth meeting between the schools since the 1984 season.
- Southern Miss scored a school-record 76 points in the Nov. 3, 1951 meeting.
- Current graduate assistant Carter Hankins played baseball at one point at NSU.

Against the Southland Conference

The Golden Eagles enjoy a 36-17 record (.679) against the current membership of the Southland Conference. The Golden Eagles are 19-3 over Southeastern Louisiana, tied with Northwestern State at 11-11 and have winning records over Lamar (3-1) and McNeese State (2-0). Southern Miss also is 1-2 against Texas A&M-Commerce and have not played Houston Baptist, Incarnate Word or Nicholls in football.

Will Hall

Head Football Coach | Second Season - 3-11 (.214) / Overall - Eighth Season 59-31 (.656)

At his introductory press conference in December of 2020 as the 22nd head coach of Southern Miss football, Will Hall spoke about how ‘attitude is everything’ in his initial comments to those in attendance at Reed Green Coliseum.

That attitude has provided a relentlessly positive approach in how he has communicated and prepared his players, elevated the growth of every facet of this football program, while also energizing a fan base since first taking the stage as the Golden Eagles top football coach.

In his opening season for the Golden Eagles, adversity struck hard for the program as the Golden Eagles saw most of their quarterback corps go down due to injury during the early portion of the season. Despite that fact, the Golden Eagles remained upbeat each week and transitioned its offense that many fans dubbed the “Superback” featuring a running back overseeing the offense from a shotgun position toward the latter part of the campaign.

That transition allowed the Golden Eagles to win two of their final three games of the campaign, while also almost knocking off the league champion, UTSA.

Hall also oversaw a Nasty Bunch defense that provided many highlights, including holding its opponents to the second fewest first downs in the country (197), while collecting the fourth most fumble recoveries (13). The defense gave up just 358.5 yards per game, which ranked No. 3 in Conference USA and No. 42 in the country. Southern Miss bettered their national ranking in total defense by 18 spots from the previous year.

With its core nucleus of players returning for 2022, to go along with a plethora of talent incoming for this season, Southern Miss looks poised to make a splash its initial Sun Belt Conference season as well as return to a bowl game for the first time since the 2019 campaign.

Hall, a native of Amory, Miss., came to Southern Miss after serving the previous two years as offensive coordinator at Tulane.

Hall made an immediate impact on the Tulane offense and helped the Green Wave rewrite their offensive record books. He helped Tulane post one of the most successful offensive seasons in program history in 2019. The Green Wave finished the season ranked 11th in the nation in rushing offense (243.2), 22nd in total offense (449.3) and 30th in scoring offense (33.1). Hall helped the Green Wave rush for over 200 yards in nine games in 2019 and over 300 times four times.

The Tulane offense set the program record in rushing yards at 3,162 yards in 2019. The offense ranked second in program history in rushing yards per game (243.2), rushing touchdowns (33) and rushing first downs (166).

Tulane's offense also eclipsed 500 yards five times, including a season-high 634 total yards against UConn. The Green Wave also set a season-high in passing yards against the Huskies with 323.

In 2020, the Green Wave enjoyed more success offensively as they finished No. 17 nationally in rushing offense (217.1), No. 19 in first downs (258) and No. 22 in scoring offense (34.7), while adding two more 500-yard total offensive games to his resume.

Hall joined the Green Wave coaching staff after he spent the 2018 campaign as the Associate Head Coach/Tight Ends Coach at the University of Memphis where he helped guide the Tigers to the American Athletic Conference Championship game for the second straight season and helped the Tigers to their fifth straight bowl appearance.

During his lone season at Memphis, Hall helped guide the Tigers to a school record with 42 rushing touchdowns during the regular season. In addition, Memphis finished the regular season with 3,311 rushing yards, setting a new school record.

Memphis' offense ranked in the nation's top 10 in rushing (No. 5, 275.9), scoring offense (No. 6, 43.8) and total offense (No. 6, 530.3) under Hall's assistance. In addition, Hall helped four Memphis offensive players earn All-AAC honors.

Hall joined the Memphis staff in January 2018 after spending the 2017 season as the offensive coordinator for the Louisiana-Lafayette Ragin' Cajuns, where six offensive players received all-conference honors. The Cajuns ranked among the best in the nation in red zone offense and turnovers lost with just 16.

In his one season as offensive coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette, the Ragin' Cajuns compiled the Sun Belt Conference's third-best rushing offense with 2,204 yards and 27 rushing touchdowns. The Louisiana-Lafayette offense tied for the second-fewest turnovers in the Sun Belt during the 2017 season. The Cajuns were also efficient in the red zone, leading the Sun Belt by scoring

on 92.9-percent of their red zone chances.

In his three-year head coaching stint at West Georgia (UWG), Hall led the Wolves to a 31-9 record, the first Gulf South Conference (GSC) title since 2000 and a pair of NCAA Division II semifinal appearances. His first two seasons at UWG produced a pair of 12-win seasons before he finished 7-4 in 2016.

Success was immediate for Hall as the Wolves set multiple school records, won their first GSC title in 14 years and reached the NCAA Division II playoffs.

Under his direction, a program that had not made an impact in the conference, much less nationally, in over a decade transformed into the talk of the nation in NCAA Division II. Under Hall's direction, the Wolves were nationally ranked for 17 weeks consecutively and earned the program's first No. 1 national ranking on Oct. 26, 2015.

Hall's first UWG squad in 2014 caught more than a few people by surprise. The Wolves finished the regular season strong with a 9-2 record and earned the program's first NCAA playoffs bid since 2000. Road wins at Tuskegee, Delta State, and Valdosta State were the first postseason victories in the school's Division II history and gave UWG the NCAA Super Region 2 title.

Though UWG caught no one by surprise in 2015, it didn't matter. Hall's juggernaut roared through the first nine games of the regular season, all wins, and none were closer than a 17-point margin. A three-touchdown, Week 8 win over nationally ranked North Alabama pushed the Wolves into the top spot in the nation in Division II for the first time in school history.

Hall was twice named GSC Coach of the Year and was the Super Region 2 Coach of the Year.

In his first season at West Georgia, more than 30 team and individual records fell. In addition to setting records, the Wolves hauled in individual accolades.

Sixteen players earned All-Gulf South Conference recognition and seven received All-American distinction, which included the program's first Academic All-American in Alex Macaulay.

From 2011-13 as the head coach at West Alabama, his teams won two league titles and twice earned spots in the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

Hall's players also have had success at the next level, and among that group of honored athletes is 2015 Super Bowl hero and current Tennessee Titan Malcolm Butler, who was a two-time All-GSC performer for Hall at West Alabama. In the spring of 2016, offensive tackle Dominique Robertson became the first UWG player in school history to receive an invitation to the NFL Draft Combine.

Prior to his six seasons at West Alabama, Hall enjoyed successful stints on the coaching staff at Arkansas-Monticello, Southwest Baptist, Henderson State, and Presbyterian. Hall's achievements in the coaching profession are a carryover from his illustrious career on the playing field at North Alabama.

Hall played for his father, Bobby Hall, at Amory High School leading the Panthers to the 1998 Mississippi High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) Class 3A state title. From 1999-2000, he attended Northwest Mississippi Community College, where he was a two-time National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) All-American.

In 2000, Hall set a NJCAA record for total offense in a season (4,075 yards) and added an NJCAA single-game record with nine touchdown passes.

Hall then moved to North Alabama, where he was a quarterback for the Lions from 2002-03. He won the Harlan Hill Trophy in 2003, emblematic of being America's top player in NCAA Division II. In 2003, Hall, who threw for 3,531 yards and 30 touchdowns, led the Lions to a 13-1 record and an NCAA Division II semifinals appearance.

In 2004, Hall signed a contract to play for the Tupelo FireAnts of the National Indoor Football League. Playing once again for his father, who was the head coach for the team, Hall passed for 2,046 yards and 44 touchdowns while rushing for 13 scores in the 14-game season.

A 2003 graduate of North Alabama, Hall, and wife Rebecca, have two sons – Tripp and Pete.

Last Time versus Northwestern State

Southern Miss 40, Northwestern State 6 Sept. 11, 1999

HATTIESBURG, Miss. (AP) – Jeff Kelly threw two touchdowns and ran for another one as Southern Mississippi beat I-AA Northwestern State 40-6.

Southern Miss (2-0), which beat Tulane 48-14 on Labor Day, had over 200 return yards off blocked field goals, extra points, and fumbles in the game. Northwestern State (0-2), ranked 15th in Division I-AA, could not put together any offense against the Golden Eagles.

The Demons' special teams had two field-goal attempts blocked. Ty Trahan blocked one in the second quarter and Roy Magee returned it 48 yards for a touchdown to give the Golden Eagles a 21-0 lead.

Kelly, making his second college start, kept the ball on a bootleg to open the scoring with a 6-yard touchdown run just two minutes into the first quarter.

Kelly, who was 13-for-21 passing, added a 6-yard TD pass to Dannye Fowler to put Golden Eagles ahead 14-0. Adalius Thomas ran 64 yards on a fumble recovery to give Southern Miss a 31-0 lead at the half.

The Golden Eagles won the game despite playing without starting wide receiver Sherrod Gideon and safety Leo Barnes. Both players were suspended by coach Jeff Bower earlier in the week for violating team rules.

Derrick Nix rushed for 100 yards for the Golden Eagles.

Kelly hit Todd Pinkston with a 25-yard TD pass in the third quarter to extend the lead to 38-0.

Northwestern State scored its only touchdown with 29 seconds remaining on Tony Taylor's 2-yard run. Magee returned the blocked extra-point attempt for two points to end the scoring.

Taylor led Northwestern State in rushing with 71 yards on 28 carries.

The Golden Eagles at Home

Since the start of the 1976 season, following the renovation of M.M. Roberts Stadium, the Golden Eagles have posted a 157-77 (.670) record at The Rock. The program has finished at .500 or better in home games for a season 39 times during that span.

Notes from Miami Game

- This was the first meeting between the two schools in football.
- Southern Miss played its first ranked team of the season and first game against a ranked foe since playing at UTSA, Nov. 13, 2021, falling 27-17 in that contest. The Golden Eagles dropped its 10th-straight contest against an Associated Press Top 25 team.
- It was the program's first game played in South Florida since dropping a 34-17 decision to then league foe Florida Atlantic 34-17 on Nov. 30, 2019.
- Golden Eagle sophomore running back Frank Gore, Jr., made his first trip back in his hometown for a game. Miami is the alma mater of his dad, Frank Gore, Sr., who lettered for UM in 2001, 03-04.
- True freshman Zach Wilcke made his first collegiate appearance and first career start, finishing with 207 yards passing on 16-of-27 throwing with a passing touchdown.
- Wilcke hit Jason Brownlee for this first throwing touchdown of his career early in the second quarter. The 32-yard TD reception was the 14th scoring grab of Brownlee's career.
- Brownlee finished with five catches for 102 yards. It was Brownlee's sixth 100-yard receiving game.
- Malik Shorts posted his second interception of the season and the fourth of the year for the team with a second-quarter pick. It was Shorts' sixth career interception.
- Josh Ratcliff and Quentin Bivens posted their first respective sacks of the season on the same drive, while Swayze Bozeman added his sack as well in the contest. Averie Habas notched the fourth sack for the Golden Eagle defense to give them six over the first two games.

Conference USA Play History

In 26 seasons of Conference USA play, Southern Miss registered an all-time mark of 116-79 (.595) in C-USA contests, including a 61-37 mark at home, while compiling a 55-42 ledger on the road. Southern Miss enjoyed 18 seasons of winning marks as well as two years of finishing at .500.

Pro Traditions

Southern Miss, which has a reputation in training and producing professional talent over the years, has a long list of former players that have reached the NFL including the likes of Ray Guy, Brett Favre, Sammy Winder, Michael Boley and Jamie Collins. Southern Miss has had at least one player drafted in 15 of the last 22 NFL drafts. Since 1942, 129 players have been drafted by the NFL, AFL or AAFC, which including a school-best four on nine different occasions.

#Mississippi Made

Of the 115 players listed on the Southern Miss 2022 football roster, 77 players come from Mississippi (66.9%), representing 52 different Magnolia State communities. The cities of Hattiesburg, Madison and Oxford lead the way with four players apiece, while Flora, Purvis each have three Golden Eagles from their respective towns. Bassfield, Bay St. Louis, Fayette, Greenwood, Gulfport, Houston, Louisville, Magee, Starkville, Taylorsville and West Point each have two Southern Miss players represent their city.

September Games

The Golden Eagles hold a 136-117 record (.538) in games played in the month of September in its long, storied history. The Golden Eagles posted undefeated and untied records this calendar month 12 times, when they played two or more games during the month.

Graduates on the 2022 Roster

Twenty one players on the 2022 football roster have obtained their undergraduate degrees, tying for 11th most in the FBS. Nebraska leads the way with 26, followed by Liberty and Rice with 23. Baylor, Eastern Michigan, Fresno State, North Texas, Pitt, Texas State and UTSA are each at 22, with Southern Miss, Akron, Hawai'i, James Madison, Kent State, Oregon and South Carolina tied for 11th most graduates on the current roster at 21 apiece.

The Offensive Line

The Golden Eagle offensive front line returned six players that made at least one start a year ago and five of those players started in each of the first two games of the season. The Golden Eagles have gone with the same starting lineup in each of the two games in 2022. The longest streak of using the same lineup last year was three games and they did that twice during the year. Gerquan Scott, who is the only returning Southern Miss player to start every game on the line last year, ran his consecutive start streak to 18 last week for the Golden Eagles. Paul Gainer, who has played the most on the offensive line at 26 contests, got his 12th overall start, including nine in a row at right tackle, while John Bolding started for the eighth straight time, getting the call at right guard.

Wilcke Gets the Call at Quarterback

Zach Wilcke became the ninth true freshman since 1987 to get the starting call at quarterback last weekend at No. 15 Miami. Wilcke is the sixth Golden Eagle true freshman to start since the start of the 2012 campaign. He is the first freshman quarterback for the program to start in his initial Southern Miss playing experience since Keon Howard, who started at Old Dominion, on Nov. 12, 2016.

Wilcke went 16-for-27 for 207 yards in his debut with a 32-yard touchdown pass to Jason Brownlee. He added a team-high 15 yards rushing. His passing yards were the most by a Golden Eagle freshman in his debut since Howard threw 230 on 12-of-24 attempts at ODU with a TD throw.

Wilcke made the start due to an injury with Ty Keyes, which he sustained in the opening half of the Liberty contest. The Golden Eagles used their SuperBack offense for the remainder of that contest.

SuperBack Returns

After using the SuperBack offense in the final three games of the 2021 season, it returned for Southern Miss in the second half against Liberty in the 2022 season. The trio of Frank Gore, Jr., Dajon Richard and Antavious Willis rotated taking snaps down the stretch.

The Golden Eagles produced 229 offensive yards in the second half and overtime as it was the fifth straight game the team collected 100 or more yards on the ground offensively, finishing the game with 252 yards on the ground.

Gore collected touchdown runs of 46 and 5 yard runs in the second half, with the five-yard scoring run giving the Golden Eagles the lead with 1:54 to play.

Southern Miss did not use the SuperBack in the Miami game.

Big Play Brownlee

Southern Miss senior Jason Brownlee led the team last season with 46 catches for 643 yards and eight touchdowns, despite having to mesh with all the different signal callers. He posted a solid performance against Rice with eight catches for a career-best 127 yards and against Middle Tennessee registered a career-high nine catches for 120 yards and his fifth career 100-yard receiving game.

After the Middle Tennessee contest, Brownlee recorded a touchdown catch for the second-straight game against North Texas with four catches for a team-high 53 yards. He caught Frank Gore, Jr.'s first career pass of 32 yards at UTSA and followed that with his first two-touchdown catch game - both coming from Gore, Jr. - at Louisiana Tech as he caught five passes for 67 yards. Brownlee finished the season with two more TD catches from Gore, Jr., in the finale - both from 34 yards out - as he finished with five catches for 98 yards against FIU to conclude the 2021 campaign.

Brownlee has started the 2022 season with six catches for 137 yards and is the top current receiver for the Golden Eagles who has 86 career catches for 1,390 yards with 14 touchdown grabs.

He tallied his sixth 100-yard receiving game last week at Miami with five catches for 102 yards.

Gore Leads the Running Backs

Frank Gore, Jr. led the Golden Eagles offense in a couple of roles last season. He was the team's top running back with 801 yards on the ground with three rushing scores and was also called to take snaps from the center late in the year and converted 10-of-16 passes for 189 yards with four touchdown passes, two coming at LA Tech and two versus FIU. He also led the team in all-purpose yards with 990, as he also had 155 receiving yards.

He started his third season with a career-best 178 yards on a career-best 32 carries as he also threw for 48 yards on 1-of-4 passing against Liberty. It was his sixth 100-yard rushing game of his career and the Golden Eagles are 4-2 when he achieves that feat.

Gore, Jr., led the team in rushing in 2020 with 708 yards on 121 carries for a 5.9 rush average. Gore was a second-team All-Conference USA selection in 2020 and was a member of the league's All-Freshman team. Gore is a member of the preseason watch list for the Doak Walker Award, given to the nation's top running back.

His six 100-yard rushing games tie him for 13th on Golden Eagle charts for that category with Tony Smith (1989-91) and Kendrick Hardy (2010-13).

Youngest Defensive Coordinator in the FBS

Southern Miss defensive coordinator Austin Armstrong has the distinction of being the youngest defensive coordinator in the Football Bowl Subdivision for the second-straight season. At 29, Armstrong came to Southern Miss last season from Louisiana-Lafayette where he was the inside linebackers coach. The next youngest defensive coordinator is Nate Dreiling at New Mexico State, who opens the season at 31 years old.

Nasty Bunch Opens Season with Solid Performance

Southern Miss finished 2021 at No. 42 nationally in total defense, allowing 358.5 yards per contest. The group finished No. 73 in the country in rushing defense (156.5 ypg), holding opponents to under 100 yards on the ground three times, and 24th in passing yards allowed at 202.0 per game.

The Golden Eagles surrendered 27.9 points per contest, ranking No. 80 in the country. But of the 335 points allowed by the team, the Golden Eagles gave up 63 points directly off turnovers, 34 points on short fields after turnovers, 14 points on two kick returns for scores, and one safety when the quarterback was sacked in the end zone, cutting the number to the defense allowing to 18.5 points per contest.

In 2022, the Golden Eagles have allowed an average of 446.0 yards per game, but limited the Flames to just 194 yards over the first three quarters and held Miami to 10 points in the opening half. They also have produced four turnovers this season, including three versus Liberty.

Shorts Leading Team in Tackles in 2022

Defensive back Malik Shorts paced the Golden Eagles in 2021, as he was the school's nominee for the Conerly Trophy - the top collegiate player in the state of Mississippi.

In seven games last season, he either led or tied for the team high in tackles. Shorts ranked first in tackles with 89 including two tackles for loss, two interceptions and seven pass breakups.

Shorts ranked second in tackles in 2020 at 81, including 14 tackles versus Louisiana Tech as well as a team-high 11 stops at WKU. He had three 10 or more tackles contests three times in 2020. He tallied his lone interception of the season against UTSA.

This season, Shorts opened with a game-high 12 tackles and an interception against Liberty and followed that with a game-high 13 stops with another interception at Miami.

Latham Finished No. 3 in Country in Fumble Recoveries

Santrell Latham recovered three fumbles last season - the last one he returned it 72 yards at Louisiana Tech - and finished ranked No. 3 in the country in that category. He also forced four fumbles which ranked No. 8 in the country. He started this season with another forced fumble on a sack against Liberty to give him six forces in his career. Latham added six solo tackles in the contest with two of those tackles for loss. He followed that with three assisted tackles last week at Miami.

Latham ended fifth on the team in tackles with 52, including five for loss, a season ago.

Ratcliff Returns as Top Tackler on D-Line

Sophomore Josh Ratcliff returned as the top defensive lineman in terms of tackles returning in 2022. Ratcliff tallied 34 tackles (13 solos) with 4.5 tackles for loss and a half sack to go along with one fumble recovery. After not registering a tackle in the opener, Ratcliff posted a career-high tying five stops against Miami, including his first sack of the year.

In the 2022 opener, defensive line teammates Kristin Booth and Jalen Williams paced the defensive line with four tackles each, while Armdondous Cooley added three stops. Against Miami, Williams collected seven stops while Quentin Bivens tallied his first sack of the year.

Briggs Bourgeois Back Booting Kicks

Redshirt senior Briggs Bourgeois opened 2022 by making all three extra-point attempts to go along with 2-of-3 field goals made, including a career-long 53 yard attempt in the second overtime. He added an extra point and two touchbacks in his contest at Miami.

In his career, Bourgeois has converted 24-of-35 field goals, while making 63-of-67 career extra-point attempts.

This is the third consecutive year and fifth overall that Bourgeois has handled most of the kicking duties, after missing 2019 with a leg injury.

Hunt Punts Down the Field

Redshirt senior Mason Hunt, who punted in the first game in 2020 and averaged 32.2 yards per punt over four tries against South Alabama in his only action of the year, had the duties all during the 2021 campaign. He is a Ray Guy Award Watchlist honoree prior to this season.

Hunt opened 2021 by blasting eight punts for an average of 47.9 yards. It was, at the time, the longest average by a Golden Eagle punter in a game since Zac Everett enjoyed a 48.7 punting average over three punts against ULM on Sept. 8, 2018.

Hunt enjoyed his best punting day of the season, averaging 51.7 yards per punt over six punts against UTEP. Of his punts, three were over 50 yards including a career-long 63 and 60-yard punts. He pinned the Miners back inside the 20-yardline four times including the 1, 4 and 6 yardlines. He also added a punt to the Miner 9 that was returned for six yards to the 15, but a facemask penalty forced the ball up to the 30.

Hunt finished the season by averaging 43.6 yards over 71 punts with 40 fair catches, 18 inside the opponents 20 and 15 or more for 50 yards. His per punt average was the furthest by a Golden Eagle since Tyler Sarrazin averaged 44.7 yards per punt in 2016.

Hunt started this year with 11 punts for a 43.1 average, including three inside the opponent's 20 yardline and a long of 57 versus Miami.

Harrell Preseason All-Sun Belt at Kick Returner

Senior Camron Harrell was the only Golden Eagle to post a preseason All-Sun Belt Conference nod by the league's coaches at first-team kick returner.

Last season, Harrell returned 26 kicks for 662 yards and a 25.5 yard per return average. He contributed with a 95-yard touchdown return at Rice. It was his second kickoff return for a score during his Golden Eagle career as he also a 100-yard return in the 2020 season finale versus Florida Atlantic. He opened this year with two kickoff returns for 38 yards against Liberty.

His two career kickoff returns for touchdowns is tied for a school record, as Harrell holds it with seven other players.

Game Recaps

Game 1: Liberty 29, at Southern Miss 27 in 4 OTs (Sept. 3, 2022)

HATTIESBURG, Miss. – Reserve quarterback Kaidon Salter hit Jerome Jackson in the back of the end zone in the fourth overtime to lead Liberty to a 29-27 victory over Southern Miss here Saturday night in both team's season opener.

Golden Eagle running back Frank Gore, Jr., tallied a career-high 178 yards on a career-best 32 carries and a pair of rushing scores to lead the Golden Eagles.

Gore put the Golden Eagles up 24-17 with 1:54 to play in regulation on a five-yard run, but the visiting Flames needed just 1:18 to go 81 yards on four plays, culminated with a 23-yard pass from Salter to Demario Douglas to tie the game.

After both team's missed field goals in the first overtime session, they each collected a field goal to tie the score at 27-27. Golden Eagle kick Briggs Bourgeois sent the game to the third overtime with a career-long 53 field goal.

After each team missed their one-play try from the three-yard line on the third overtime, Liberty converted theirs to start the fourth. After an interference penalty forced gave the Golden Eagles one more try, Gore's run came up short to end the contest.

Eric Scott, Jr., also added a 22-yard interception return for a touchdown for the Golden Eagles, marking the fourth time that has happened over the last five games.

Game 2: at No. 15 Miami 30, Southern Miss 7 (Sept. 10, 2022)

MIAMI GARDENS, Fla. -- (AP) A pair of third-quarter touchdowns — barely two minutes apart — changed the game, Henry Parrish rushed for 97 yards and a score, and No. 15 Miami pulled away in the second half to beat Southern Miss 30-7 on Saturday at Hard Rock Stadium.

The Hurricanes (2-0) trailed for most of the second quarter, then shook off the slow start by scoring the game's final 27 points.

Thaddeus Franklin Jr. rushed in from seven yards out for a 17-7 third-quarter lead, Tyler Van Dyke connected with Key'Shawn Smith for a 35-yard flea-flicker touchdown on Miami's next offensive snap, and the outcome wasn't in doubt again.

Parrish had a 1-yard touchdown run late in the first half for the Hurricanes, who have started with two wins for only the seventh time in the past 18 seasons.

Jason Brownlee caught a 32-yard touchdown pass from Zach Wilcke for Southern Miss (0-2). That capped a six-play, 75-yard drive for the Golden Eagles – but they managed only 122 yards on their next seven drives, five of which ended in punts, one with an interception in the end zone and the other with a fumble.

Frank Gore Jr., the son of Miami Hall of Famer Frank Gore, was held largely in check by the Hurricanes' defense in his return to his hometown. Gore Jr. had seven carries for 10 yards, and two catches for 18 more yards. That's after he rushed for 178 yards last week in Southern Miss' opening-game loss to Liberty.

Wilcox completed 16 of 27 passes for 207 yards for the Golden Eagles. Brownlee had five of those catches for 102 yards. Malik Shorts recorded is second interception in as many weeks when he picked off Van Dyke in the second quarter.
