Noting the Golden Eagles

- Southern Miss plays in its 108th football season in 2024, having first fielded a team in 1912. The program did not play during World War I (1917-18) or World War II (1943-45).
- The Golden Eagles currently play in their fourth different conference in their football history, after holding a spot in the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Association from 1931-41, the Gulf States Conference from 1948-1951 and Conference USA from 1996-2021, before starting play in the Sun Belt Conference for the 2022 season.
- Since 1994, the program has collected 24 winning seasons and played in 19 bowl games.
- Overall, Southern Miss has enjoyed 74 winning seasons and five years of .500 football over its history. Since 2000, the Golden Eagles have had 18 of 24 winning seasons.
- The 2022 LendingTree Bowl was the 27th bowl appearance for the Golden Eagles as they hold an 12-15 record overall in postseason games.

Change in Leadership

- On Sunday evening, Oct. 20, Director of Athletics Jeremy McClain announced that the University was moving in a new direction with its football program, parting ways with head coach Will Hall.
- “We are grateful to Will and his family for their dedication to Southern Miss over the past four years,” McClain said. “Will poured his heart and soul into this program and into shaping these young men. Unfortunately, the results on the field didn’t align with our shared goals and expectations.”
- McClain further outlined the path ahead for Southern Miss football. “Our immediate focus is twofold: first, supporting our student-athletes throughout the remainder of the season, and second, conducting a comprehensive national search to identify the next leader for Southern Miss football. This is a proud program with an outstanding history and a premier job in college football. We will find the next leader to usher us into a new era of championship success.”
- Southern Miss will immediately commence its search for the next leader of the football program. Assistant Head Coach/General Manager Reed Stringer will serve as the Golden Eagles’ interim head coach for the remainder of the 2024 season.

Against Marshall

- Southern Miss leads the series with Marshall 8-6 with the Golden Eagles winning the last three games, after dropping five in a row.
- Southern Miss also won the first three meetings in the series and five of the first six.
- This is the first meeting between two schools in football in six seasons since both were members of Conference USA. The last tilt was a 26-24 decision for the Golden Eagles in Hattiesburg in 2018.
- Six games have been decided by seven points or less as the Golden Eagles are 4-2 in those contests. The initial meeting between the two foes came down to a Darren McCaleb 34-yard field goal in overtime which proved to be the game winner.
- Southern Miss head athletic trainer Todd McCall worked for Marshall for two seasons.
- There are no players from the state of West Virginia on the Golden Eagle roster.
- Former Golden Eagle offensive lineman Bryce Ramsey (Gulfport) is one of two Thundering Herd players from Mississippi. The other is Jacarius Clayton (Tupelo).

#MississippiMade

Of the 110 players listed on the Southern Miss 2024 football roster, 70 Golden Eagles come from Mississippi (63.6%), representing 47 different Magnolia State communities. The city of Hattiesburg leads the way with nine Golden Eagles, followed by three each from Madison, Starkville and Tylertown.

The Golden Eagles at Home

Since the start of the 1976 season, following the renovation of M.M. Roberts Stadium, the Golden Eagles have posted a 163-86 (.656) record at The Rock. The program has finished at .500 or better in home games for a season 39 times during that span.

Reed Stringer

Interim Head Football Coach | First Season - 0-1 (.000) / Overall - Same

Reed Stringer returned for his fourth season as assistant head coach/general manager and seventh year overall with the Golden Eagle football program, and now takes over as interim head coach for the Golden Eagle program for the remainder of the season as of Oct. 20.

In his previous role with the Golden Eagles as assistant head coach/general manager, he oversaw the daily management of the football program and all its administration pertaining to academics, player personnel and general duties in an effort to keep things running smoothly for both players and staff.

Before coming to Southern Miss, Stringer spent the previous seven seasons as assistant head coach, recruiting coordinator and tight ends coach at Louisiana-Lafayette.

At UL, Stringer developed and mentored one of the most consistent and high achieving units on the Ragin' Cajun squad with five different tight ends earning all-conference honors in seven years.

Beginning in 2011, Stringer assisted Ladarius Green in finishing off his career as a three-time All-Sun Belt Conference performer and working his way into a fourth-round draft pick for the NFL's San Diego Chargers. In 2013, senior Jacob Maxwell earned All-Sun Belt Conference honors and along with Ian Thompson, the duo both received opportunities to play in the National Football League. Followed in 2014, Larry Pettis' career came to an end on a high note as he also garnered all-conference recognition as well. In 2017, Stringer helped develop converted offensive lineman Raynard Ford into an all-conference player, joining true freshman Chase Rogers on the prestigious unit.

Known for being a great evaluator and a relentless recruiter, Stringer's recruiting efforts led the way in Louisiana posting four consecutive nine-win seasons for the first time in school history. The Ragin' Cajun recruiting classes consistently finished at the top of the Sun Belt conference and among the group of 5 institutions.

Stringer, the 2012 Sun Belt Conference Recruiter of the Year by Scout.com, was also recognized in 2009 as one of the SEC's "Top 10 Recruiters" by Rivals.com for his contributions to Mississippi State's nationally-ranked class which produced 12 players who signed NFL contracts and included Cincinnati Red's centerfielder Billy Hamilton, Thorpe Award winner Jonathan Banks, and the Philadelphia Eagles defensive lineman Fletcher Cox. Before spending the 2010 season on Dabo Swinney's staff at Clemson, Stringer spent seven seasons at Mississippi State in a variety of roles. At 25, he became the youngest full-time coach in the SEC when he was promoted to tight ends coach on Sylvester Croom's staff in 2005 and added special teams duties to his resume in 2007. He was also the Director of Recruiting for Dan Mullen's 2009 staff.

He earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Delta State in 2001 and completed a master's in business administration from DSU in 2003.

A four-year letterman on the Statesmen's offensive line, he helped DSU claim the 2000 NCAA Division II national championship. Stringer concluded his career with a string of 35 consecutive starting assignments at offensive left tackle. In addition to the 2000 national title, he was also instrumental in helping Delta State win the 1998 and 2000 Gulf South Conference championships.

Stringer is married to the former Emily Howell and they have three sons, Smith, Banks, and John Reed.

Last Time versus Marshall

Southern Miss 26, Marshall 24

Nov. 3, 2018

HATTIESBURG, Miss. – The Southern Miss defense lived up to its “Nasty Bunch” moniker as the Golden Eagles held off Marshall 26-24 before an announced 20,375.

Southern Miss came up with four turnovers and limited the Thundering Herd to 249 yards total offense.

Southern Miss converted three of the takeaways into 17 points, including a scoop-and-score fumble return by Darian Yancey as the Golden Eagles scored two touchdowns in a 15-second span near the end of the half.

Southern Miss stifled the Herd's ground game, with Marshall netting just 31 yards rushing, the fewest rushing yards the Golden Eagles had allowed this season.

The Herd clamped down on a Golden Eagle offense that saw freshman quarterback Tate Whatley make his first career start in place of starter Jack Abraham, who had been banged up last week at Charlotte.

Whatley completed 16-of-25 passes for a touchdown with no interceptions and led the Golden Eagles in rushing for a second consecutive game. Southern Miss only managed 222 yards total offense, including 134 yards passing, and Whatley's 40 yards rushing came on 25 attempts.

And yet, Southern Miss managed just enough offense and bowed up with enough defense to pick up its third consecutive home win.

The Golden Eagles opened the game with a 12-play, 39 yard drive that ate 7 minutes, 35 seconds, off the clock to take a 3-0 lead on Parker Shaunfield's 45-yard field goal.

After a 29-yard punt set up Marshall at the Golden Eagles' 29-yard line, Southern Miss was able to limit the Herd to a 24-yard field goal by Justin Rohrwasser.

The Herd took its only lead of the game when a botched punt snap wound up as a fumble at Southern Miss' 8-yard line. Marshall Brenden Knox picked up the loose ball and covered the distance for a 10-3 lead.

Momentum mounted for Marshall when Whatley fumbled during a delayed draw, with Marshall taking over at the Southern Miss 36-yard line.

But two plays later, starting quarterback Alex Thomson was intercepted at the 5-yard line by Southern Miss cornerback Ty Williams, who returned his second pick of the year 49 yards to the Marshall 46.

A 29-yard gain on reverse by receiver DeMichael Harris brought the ball to the Marshall 17, and four plays later, Whatley found Quez Watkins on a fade route in the back corner of the end zone to tie the game just 48 seconds before halftime.

Marshall subbed in Isaiah Green at quarterback in place of Thomson, but on first down, defensive end Jacques Turner caught Green from behind as he tried to shift to his right to avoid pressure.

Notes from the JMU Game

- This was the first meeting between the two schools in football and the last program the Golden Eagles have ever played in the Sun Belt Conference. The Dukes are the 78th different opponent Southern Miss has faced against current FBS opponents.
- With a first-half catch of 20 yards, Larry Simmons is the only player to catch a pass in all eight games.
- Kenyon Clay recorded a 15-yard rushing touchdown in the third quarter, giving him a team-high six rushing touchdowns. He has now scored a rushing touchdown in four-straight games.
- Elijah Sabbatini recorded his first career interception late in the first quarter. It was the first turnover for the Golden Eagles in four games.
- The Southern Miss defense limited JMU to 2-of-12 on third down and 0-of-2 on fourth down.
- Jay Jones registered a season-high 10 tackles, leading the team for the first time this season.
- Connor Gibbs converted three first-half field goals to account for all the Golden Eagle points in the opening half. He made from 44, 54 and 46 yards. The 54-yard field goal tied for the third-longest in school history (Danny Hrapmann vs. UAB, 2010 and Chris Seroka vs. Tulane, 1987). It also was the first 50-plus yard field goal for Southern Miss since Andrew Stein kicked a 52-yard attempt versus Alcorn State (9/2/23). Stein is also the last FG kicker to hit three in a game – coming at Arkansas State last season.
- The first quarter punt of Bryce Lofton covered 57 yards, tying his career high. Lofton finished with seven points for a 45.4-yard average. It was his fifth time this season averaging over 45 yards a punt.

Playing for MJ

The Golden Eagles have dedicated this season to fallen teammate MJ Daniels (Lucedale, Miss.), whose life was taken from him earlier the summer. Daniels played for the Golden Eagles in 2023 after transferring from Ole Miss. Daniels registered 28 tackles for Southern Miss last season and tied a team-high with three interceptions along with four pass breakups and two forced fumbles. The Golden Eagles will wear a No. 11 patch on their helmets as well as enter the field with his jersey during the season.



Overtime Anyone?

Southern Miss has been involved in 14 overtime games since the rule went into effect prior to the 1996 season and the Golden Eagles are 6-8 overall, after defeating Louisiana on the road late in the 2023 season. Golden Eagles Enjoying Third Season in Sun Belt Conference

- After spending 26 seasons in Conference USA, the Golden Eagles play in their third Sun Belt Conference season.
- The Golden Eagles are part of a 14-team Sun Belt that are separated in the East (App State, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, James Madison, Marshall and Old Dominion) and West (Arkansas State, Louisiana, South Alabama, Southern Miss, Texas State, Troy and ULM) division. JMU, ODU and Marshall joined the Golden Eagles as first-year members during the 2022 season.
- Southern Miss played at Troy for its first Sun Belt contest on Oct. 8, 2022, dropping a 27-10 decision.
- Southern Miss won five Conference USA titles during its tenure, including one since divisional play started in 2005. They captured their only league title contest and the school's fifth overall C-USA league crown when they beat Houston, 49-28, in 2011.
- The school's other C-USA titles came in the inaugural season of 1996 as well as the 1997, 1999 and 2003 campaigns. The Golden Eagles also won two East Division crowns in C-USA (2006, 2011), and captured their first West title in 2015 after moving to that division during the 2014 campaign. Southern Miss won its third division title in 2015, but lost in the C-USA championship game at WKU, 45-28. Southern Miss were 1-2 in C-USA title games.
- Along with the five C-USA titles, the Golden Eagles also won three additional league titles - 1948, 1950, 1951 - when they were members of the Gulf States Conference.

Drew Lawson Was Named to Jason Witten Watch List

The watch list for the eighth annual Jason Witten Collegiate Man of the Year was announced with Southern Miss junior center Drew Lawson (Madison, Ala.) chosen among a group that includes 52 of the nation's top leaders in college football.

The former Golden Eagle walk-on has risen through the ranks and established himself as a starter for the 2024 Golden Eagles, getting the nod in all four games. Lawson's nomination was based on his ability to demonstrate a record of leadership by exhibiting exceptional courage, integrity and sportsmanship both on and off the field.

New Starters in 2024

Southern Miss has had 22 first-time starters this season in a Golden Eagle uniform, including offensive lineman Luke Rogers, who started for the first time against JMU.

Of the 22 first-time Golden Eagle starters, five including - Will James, Tre' Pinkney, Greg Nunnery, Drew Lawson and Dontae Lucas - have started in all eight games.

Ten-Plus Play Scoring Drives

In the four touchdown drives for Southern Miss against Arkansas State, all went 10 or more plays. It was the first time Southern Miss had four touchdown drives of 10 or more plays in the same game since versus UTSA in 2016. In fact, the Golden Eagles had five 10-plus play drives in that contest with one field goal as well. In 2017, Southern Miss enjoyed five 10-plus scoring drives versus Rice and that included three touchdowns and two field goals.

Quarterback Ethan Crawford scored the Golden Eagles' last touchdown of the game from three yards, which capped a 15-play drive. That was the longest touchdown drive in terms of plays since a 16-yard touchdown drive against South Alabama in 2021.

The Offensive Line

Southern Miss featured only one offensive lineman that had made a start for the Golden Eagles and another that had started games at the FBS level prior to the start of the season. Southern Miss saw four first-time Southern Miss starters on the line versus Kentucky in the season opener and then again over the next four games from JC transfer Greg Nunnery (RT), Dontae Lucas (transfer from South Alabama at RG), Drew Lawson at center and Will Saxton (LG). Left tackle Gabe Cavazos, Jr., notched his 15th career start for Southern Miss against JMU, while Lucas had 35 previous career starts over five seasons with Florida State (14 in three seasons) and South Alabama (21 over the last two seasons). The line had two changes over the last three games with graduate transfer Zack Conti (Eastern Michigan) starting for Saxton at left guard. Conti was hurt versus Arkansas State and did not play against JMU, making the way for Luke Rogers to earn his first start.

Golden Eagles Have Played Three QBs

Redshirt junior Tate Rodemaker, a transfer from Florida State, sophomore Ethan Crawford and true freshman John White have all seen action under center in the first eight games. Rodemaker transferred from Florida State after four seasons, where he threw for 901 yards on 68-of-118 with five interceptions and seven touchdown passes. In 2023, he threw for 519 yards on 32-of-56 throws with five touchdowns and no picks.

Rodemaker started the first five games for the Golden Eagles and has thrown four touchdown passes on 59-of-92 throws for 580 yards and four interceptions. He has not played in two of the last three games.

Crawford made his third start at JMU and has now appeared in 12 games for Southern Miss (seven last season). He threw for 240 yards on 17-of-36 attempts with three touchdowns and no picks in 2023 and started the final two games of the year at Mississippi State and at home versus Troy.

The Tuscaloosa, Ala., native converted his first five throws of the year over the first three games for 186 yards, including three throws over 42 yards. For the year, he is 42-of-97 for 772 yards and three interceptions. He also has three rushing scores. He returned against ULM after missing two games with an injury. Crawford has led the team in rushing over the last two games, averaging 54.3 yards on the ground during that span.

White has played in two games and has gone 12-for-23 for 211 yards and a pair of interceptions. He did not play in the last four games.

Crawford is one of eight Golden Eagles to start a game at quarterback since the start of the 2021 season.

Clark and Clay Leading the Running Attack

The Golden Eagles have looked to two returning backs, including Rodrigues "Dreke" Clark and Kenyon Clay, to lead the running game in 2024. Clark, a transfer from Memphis, ran for 429 yards and a pair of touchdowns in 10 games a season ago, while Clay added 179 yards over 11 games with a rushing score.

Clark leads the way in rushing for the Golden Eagles this fall with 341 yards on 81 carries and a rushing score, while Clay has added 281 yards on 45 rushes and six touchdowns on the ground as well. Clay enjoyed his first two-TD rushing contest against Louisiana (10/5).

Ti Mims Returns to Lead Receivers

Ti Mims is in his third season with the Golden Eagles as he led the team in catches with 39 a year ago. Mims enjoyed his best day at receiver at App State in 2023 with 10 catches for 141 yards. Both his catches and yardage were season bests for the team. Mims finished with 445 receiving yards with a pair of touchdown catches.

He also totaled 167 punt return yards and one touchdown. He ranked No. 2 in punt return touchdowns nationally and No. 13 in punt returns at 11.1 yards per return.

Mims registered his first 100-yard receiving game of 2024 and second of his career with six catches for 128 yards against USF. Mims leads the team in catches with 22 and is second in receiving yards at 245.

Simmons Enjoys First 100-Yard Receiving Game

Larry Simmons, a redshirt sophomore transfer from Ole Miss and Moss Point, Miss., native enjoyed his first 100-yard receiving game as a Golden Eagle against SLU with 100 yards on five catches. Simmons leads the team in yards receiving this season with 307 on 18 catches and is the only Golden Eagle to register a reception in all eight games this season.

Golden Eagles Solid in Passing Defense

Southern Miss has limited its opponent to 190.3 yards per game passing, which is ranked No. 32 in the FBS. The Golden Eagles have only allowed over 200 yards passing twice in a game this season, with the most surrendering being 236 at Jacksonville State.

The Golden Eagles have registered four interceptions for the season, including one returned for a touchdown by Dylan Lawrence at home against Southeastern Louisiana, which covered 63 yards. Elijah Sabbatini collected on at JMU.

The D-Line Includes Solid Depth

Southern Miss' defensive line features seven players that all have started in their Golden Eagle careers, including Jalil Clemons, who tallied 31 tackles a year ago with team highs of 11 tackles for loss for 45 yards and 5 1/2 sacks for 29 yards. Jalen Williams tallied 30 tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss and a half sack, while Kristin Booth added 29 stops in 2023 with three tackles for losses and two sacks. Demeco Roland notched 23 tackles last fall with 3.5 TFLs and a half sack.

The linemen have combined for 85 starts for the Golden Eagles, including 27 from Williams, 25 from Booth, 13 from Clemons, 11 from Brodarius Lewis, four from Roland, three from Ryan Johnson and two from Jameer Lewis.

Williams leads all defensive linemen in tackles with 23, followed by Jameer Lewis and Clemons with 19 each, along with Brodarius Lewis at 17.

Top Tackler is Back on Defense

Graduate student Dylan Lawrence returns after leading the team in tackles a season ago. Lawrence, who transferred from Mississippi State prior to the 2023 season, posted 78 total tackles with a tackle for loss and one breakup. He enjoyed a season-high 11 stops versus Arkansas State last season.

Lawrence led the team in tackles in the first two games this season - six at UK and seven versus SLU. After not registering an interception last season, he has two this year, including one versus UK and one versus SLU which was returned 63 yards for a touchdown.

He currently ranks third on the squad in tackles this season behind Tre' Pinkney (53) and Chris Jones (38) with 36. Pinkney has led the Golden Eagles in tackles in three of the last six games.

Roland Sending Back Kicks

Graduate student Demeco Roland (Broken Arrow, Okla.) has swatted away two kicks for the Golden Eagles this season. He first knocked away an extra point attempt at Jax State and then blocked a 41-yard field goal at ULM, which was returned 69 yards for a touchdown by Braxton Myers.

His blocked field goal was the first for the Golden Eagles since Natrone Brooks did it at Tulane on Sept. 24, 2022.

He is the first Golden Eagle player to have two blocks in a season since Dylan Bradley did it in 2016. Bradley blocked a field goal against both Savannah State and Marshall that season.

Lofton Off to Strong Start in Punting Duties

Bryce Lofton, who has held the punting duties for the last two seasons and is on the Ray Guy Award Watch List this fall, has enjoyed a solid start to the 2024 campaign. Over eight games, he has averaged 44.4 yards per punt over 38 tries with a long of 57 yards. He has experienced just two touchbacks with 11 fair catches, 10 inside the opponent's 20 and 10 of 50 yards or more.

His punting average at JMU was 45.4, which was his fifth time to average over 45.0 yards per game this season and sixth of his career.

If the season ended today, he would hold the fifth highest seasonal punting average at the school.

Seventh-Year Player Deep Snapping for the Golden Eagles

Brennen Milliron, who handles the Golden Eagle deep snapping duties, is in his seventh year of college football. After being a part of Troy's program for five seasons, Milliron came to Southern Miss prior to the 2023 campaign. He is one of 34 seventh-year players in FBS football this season. His brother, Carter, is a deep snapper at league foe Louisiana and is in his sophomore season.

The 2024 Schedule

- The 2024 Southern Miss football schedule shows the Golden Eagles playing seven teams that enjoyed winning records last season and 10 schools that played in bowl games.
- The Golden Eagles opened the 2024 campaign with Kentucky for the third time since 2016.
- Southern Miss met Southeastern Louisiana for the first time since 2011 and only third time since 1969 and have now won the last 13 games in the series.
- USF and the Golden Eagles played for the first time since 2004 when they were both members of Conference USA.
- Southern Miss played Jacksonville State for the first time since the 1946 season.
- The winning streak over Louisiana ended at 11 games after dropping a 23-13 decision at home.
- The Golden Eagles made just their third ever trip to Monroe.

Game Recaps

Game 1: at Kentucky 31, Southern Miss 0 (Aug. 31, 2024)

LEXINGTON, Ky. (AP)— Brock Vandagriff emerged from a two-hour-plus lightning delay to throw three touchdown passes in his Kentucky debut to lead a 31-0 opening-game shutout of Southern Miss on Saturday night in a game that was called for good with 9:56 remaining in the third quarter after a second delay.

Lightning in the area delayed the scheduled 7:45 p.m. start to 10:05 p.m., and the Georgia transfer took charge to throw for 169 yards and two 12-yard scores to Barion Brown in the first half and a five-yard score to Jordan Dingle in the third before the second lightning delay early Sunday morning.

A release stated that the termination was "by mutual agreement of the participating institutions as permitted by NCAA rules" and considered final and complete.

Tate Rodemaker threw for 126 yards for the Golden Eagles along with two interceptions, with one ending their best scoring chance when Kentucky's JQ Hardaway picked off a tipped pass in the end zone with 13:37 left in the first half.

Vandagriff's opening drive ended when his tipped pass was intercepted by Dylan Lawrence. But he led the Wildcats 59 yards in 10 plays on the next, capped by his TD pass to Brown with 11:57 left in the first quarter.

After an Alex Raynor 41-yard field goal, Demie Sumo-Karngbaye scored on a 1-yard run with 3:07 left in the first half. A failed fake punt gave Kentucky possession at the Southern Miss 29 with 1:52 left in the first half to set up Vandagriff's second scoring pass to Brown.

Game 2: at Southern Miss 35, Southeastern Louisiana 10 (Sept. 7, 2024)

HATTIESBURG, Miss. – A pair of long fourth-quarter touchdowns, one on offense and one from the defense, helped Southern Miss pull away from Southeastern Louisiana at Carlisle-Faulkner Field at M.M. Roberts Stadium to secure a 35-10 victory.

The Golden Eagles snapped a three-game losing streak dating back to last season, while the Lions dropped their second game to open the campaign.

Up 21-10 in the final quarter, Southern Miss' Dylan Lawrence picked off an Eli Sawyer pass and returned it 63 yards for a touchdown with 13:19 remaining and Kenyon Clay added a 70-yard scoring run with 1:44 left to help the Golden Eagles pull away in the contest.

Southern Miss quarterback Tate Rodemaker threw for a pair of touchdowns on 18-of-32 throws, while Larry Simmons caught five passes for 107 yards.

After leading 14-10 at the half, the Golden Eagles gave themselves some cushion in the third quarter as Dreke Clark extended the lead on a one-yard rush. The score came one play after a 59-yard pass from backup quarterback Ethan Crawford to Justyn Reid to the one.

It was the visiting Lions, though, that took the early lead in the contest.

After getting stopped on their first possession in Golden Eagle territory and a 31-yard punt to the Southern Miss nine, Ti Mims fumbled on the home team's first play. SLU recovered the ball and four plays later kicked at 25-yard field goal by Riley Callaghan to give the visitors a 3-0 advantage.

Southern Miss then took advantage of a muffed punt later in the opening quarter as Rodemaker completed a four-play, 13-yard drive with a nine-yard scoring throw to Kyirin Heath to give the Golden Eagles a 7-3 advantage.

Southern Miss extended the lead in the second quarter on Rodemaker's second touchdown pass. The Golden Eagles moved the ball 88 yards on 11 plays and concluded on a five-yard throw to Davis Dalton on his first career scoring reception.

The Lions cut the margin right before the half as Antonio Martin, Jr., recorded a 10-yard scoring run that culminated a 69-yard, 10-play drive with 14 seconds before half to cut the Golden Eagle lead to 14-10 at intermission.

The Golden Eagles out gained the visitors 359-274.

Game 3: USF 49, at Southern Miss 24 (Sept. 14, 2024)

HATTIESBURG, Miss. – USF rolled up 369 rushing yards and collected five rushing touchdowns to defeat Southern Miss 49-24 at Carlisle-Faulkner Field at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

Kelly Joiner rushed for 117 yards and Nay'Quan Wright added 105, while the Bulls ended the night with 487 total offensive yards. Joiner scored on a 50-yard run in the fourth quarter, while Wright added a 33-scoring rush late in third.

USF quarterback Bryum Brown threw for 193 yards and a pair of touchdowns, while adding 72 yards on the ground.

The visitors broke open a 28-21 halftime advantage by scoring the first three touchdowns of the second half as TaRon Keith scored the first one on a three-yard run with 8:12 in the third, before the two additional scores by Wright and Joiner.

Southern Miss completed the scoring with a 31-yard field goal by Connor Gibbs with 7:05 left in the contest.

Southern Miss got 85 yards on the ground from Dreke Clark to lead the rushing attack, while Ethan Crawford threw for 183 yards off the bench, in relief of Tate Rodemaker, who was 10-of-15 for 120 yards and a pair of touchdown throws. John White also saw his first collegiate action and threw for 94 yards on 3-of-5 throws.

The Golden Eagles jumped out to an early 14-0 advantage by scoring on their first two possessions.

On the second play of the contest, Crawford hit the other Southern Miss quarterback, Rodemaker, on a throwback pass for 42 yards that put the ball in Bull territory. After a roughing the passer play on a third-down play to keep the drive alive, Southern Miss capped the first drive with a 19-yard pass from Rodemaker to Kyirin Heath.

After turning the Bulls over on downs on the next possession, Southern Miss used a seven-play, 65-yard drive which was capped on a 37-yard pass to Kenyon Clay from Rodemaker to make the score 14-0.

The Bulls then scored on their next drive, capping an 11-play, 64-yard drive with a four-yard pass from Brown to Payten Singletary.

USF forced a fumble on the next Southern Miss possession and turned that into seven more points as Kelly Joiner collected a 43-yard scoring run 32 seconds before the end of the opening quarter to tie the game at 14-14.

In the second quarter, Brown hit Joshua Hardeman for a 3-yard score to give the Bulls the 21-14 advantage with 10:52 to play before extending the lead to 14 when Brown called his own number for a one-yard sneak up the middle.

Southern Miss closed the gap 2:31 before the half as Crawford collected an 8-yard scoring rush.

Game 4: at Jacksonville State 44, Southern Miss 7 (Sept. 21, 2024)

JACKSONVILLE, Ala. (AP) — Tyler Huff threw for 236 yards and a touchdown and Tre Stewart ran for two touchdowns and Jacksonville State beat Southern Miss 44-7.

MONROE, La. (AP)—Aidan Armenta had a touchdown pass and a touchdown run in the fourth quarter to help ULM pull away for a 38-21 victory over Southern Miss on Saturday.

HARRISONBURG, Va. (AP) — Alonza Barnett III threw two touchdowns and James Madison beat Southern Miss 32-15 on Saturday, Oct. 26, to move the Dukes to 2-2 in Sun Belt Conference play.

George Pettaway's 4-yard scoring run with 5:49 remaining before halftime ended a 3-all tie and the Dukes led the rest of the game.

On the Golden Eagles' ensuing drive, Terrence Spence intercepted Ethan Crawford and ran it back 30 yards to the Southern Miss 10. Barnett then threw a 10-yard scoring pass to Taylor Thompson for a 17-3 lead. Southern Miss got field goals of 54 and 46 yards from Connor Gibbs to draw within eight.

To start the third quarter, Cam Ross returned the opening kickoff 94 yards for a 23-9 lead after the point-after attempt failed.

The feisty Golden Eagles got back in it when Kenyon Clay ran it in from the 15, but the point-after attempt was blocked and the Dukes returned it for two points and led 25-15. Barnett found Ross for a 7-yard touchdown early in the fourth for the game's final score.

Crawford threw for 178 yards and Clay ran for 69 yards for Southern Miss.

It was the first-ever meeting between the two teams.
