### First and 10:

- Missouri S&T will look to win for the fourth straight week and reach the eight-win mark for the first time since the 2012 season when it plays its final regular season road contest Saturday against McKendree. The Miners defeated Lincoln 45-7 Saturday to improve to 7-2 overall and 4-1 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference, while McKendree is also coming off a win -- taking a 47-31 decision over William Jewell -- and brings records of 5-4 and 3-2 in the GLVC into Saturday's contest.
- The Miners are ranked 10th this week in the NCAA Division II Super Region 3 rankings (listed on page 2) and received votes in the AFCA national poll for the second straight week. Prior to last week, S&T had not been listed in the AFCA poll since the 2013 pre-season rankings. The Miners are in the Super Region rankings for the first time since the 2012 campaign.
- How good has the Miners' return game been this season? Following Saturday's game with Quincy, the Miners have now had eight kickoff or punt returns for at least 30 yards. Roderick Chapman has four of those returns -- with two scores included -- while Josh Brown and Braxton Graham have two apiece. S&T is averaging 26.9 yards per kickoff runback this season (seventh in NCAA Division II) and 14.8 yards per punt return (19th in D-II) with three kick returns for touchdowns.
- Thanks to four returns for scores this season, S&T has extended a streak to 14 straight years with at least one return (kickoff, punt, interception or fumble) for a score. Roderick Chapman has a punt and kickoff runback for a touchdown and is the first Miner with a return of a kickoff, punt and interception for a touchdown in his career.
- S&T is one of just 10 teams in NCAA Division II with a kickoff, punt and interception return for a touchdown this season.
- Quarterback Tyler Swart and wide receiver Braxton Graham are closing in on milestone plateaus heading into Saturday's game. Swart is 23 yards away from reaching 8,000 for his career and needs two touchdowns to get to 70, while Graham is two yards from 3,000 receiving yards and 24 all-purpose yards from 5,000 -- plateaus exceeded only by Ashton Gronewold in S&T history.
- Placekicker Ben Styron etched his name into the Miner record book in the month of October, becoming the all-time scoring leader among placekickers in S&T history with 218 points and also broke the S&T career record for field goals made as he now has 36.
- S&T linebacker Landon Compton is the leading active tackler in the GLVC, as he has recorded 334 stops in his three-plus seasons in a Miner uniform. Compton ranks fourth on the GLVC's all-time tackle list and fifth in school history, while heading S&T's all-time list for tackles for a loss with 48.
- The Miners have earned 12 GLVC "Player of the Week" awards during the 2018 season, with quarterback Tyler Swart and cornerback Roderick Chapman each being named three times each. S&T has had a weekly award winner in eight of the nine weeks of the 2018 season.
- MATCHUP TO WATCH: McKendree in the red zone:** Missouri S&T ranks 17th in NCAA-II on defense in the red zone (68 percent), but will be tested by a McKendree offense that has scored on 92 percent of its trips inside the opponent's 20-yard line, the fourth-best mark in Division II.

## S&T Head Coach Tyler Fenwick:

Tyler Fenwick is in his sixth season at the helm of Missouri S&T's football program. Fenwick, the 19th head coach in the history of the S&T program, was the first to lead the Miners to a winning season in his first year as head coach since 1914.

Fenwick came to S&T after a successful six-season stint as offensive coordinator at Missouri Western; the Griffons played in the post-season in each of those six years, including an appearance in the NCAA Division II quarterfinals in 2012. MWSU was 53-18 during the six years Fenwick served on its staff. He is a native of Los Angeles, Calif. and also coached at Occidental College in California for four years and MSU Moorhead in Minnesota for a year before joining the staff at Missouri Western. He played collegiately as a wide receiver at Los Angeles Valley College and at the University of New Mexico.

## Scoring streaks:

Missouri S&T broke two scoring streak records during the course of the 2017 season. The Miners have scored in each of their last 83 games since Sept. 17, 2011, the longest such streak in school history. However, the Miners' streak of 12 straight games with at least 17 points came to an end earlier this season at Drake.

In addition, the Miners have also scored in each of their last 54 road games which is the longest run on the all-time list for consecutive road games with points. The Miners last went scoreless in a road game on Sept. 26, 2009 at Wisconsin-LaCrosse.

## On top of the GLVC:

In the 2017 season, Missouri S&T led the GLVC in both total offense and total defense, as it averaged a school-record 459.7 yards per game of the offensive side and gave up just 294.3 on defense. It was only the second time in the six-year history of GLVC football that a team led the conference in both categories in a season, the other being Indianapolis in 2014.

The 294.3 yards allowed by the S&T defense last season also marked the fifth time in GLVC history that a team gave up fewer than 300 yards per game in a season. The Miners also hit that milestone in 2012, while UIndy gave up less than 300 in 2012, 2013 and 2014.

## Standing out on offense:

Last fall, Missouri S&T was one of only two teams in NCAA Division II to have a player that ranked among the top 20 in the nation in rushing yards and another player among the top 20 in passing yards. Deshaun Jones, with his 1,579 rushing yards, finished fourth in Division II in rushing and Tyler Swart, who threw for 3,165 yards, was 12th in the nation. Six of the 11 players who finished ahead of Swart in passing played in at least 12 games; as Swart was among the top 10 prior to the NCAA Division II playoffs.

The other team with players in the top 20 in those categories was Bowie State.

## Playing behind the line:

Last season, Missouri S&T recorded the eighth-most sacks on average in NCAA Division II, taking down the quarterback on a GLVC-high 37 occasions or 3.4 times per contest.

Defensive end Tershawn Wharton led the GLVC and ranked third nationally with 13.5 sacks and also had a school record 21 tackles for a loss that put him seventh among all players in NCAA Division II. Of his 21 stops behind the line of scrimmage, 16 of them were of the solo variety.

## Return to glory:

Missouri S&T has continued its longest run of consecutive seasons with at least one return for a touchdown, as Roderick Chapman's punt return for a score at Drake has given S&T at least one return for a score in 14 consecutive years. Last year, Chapman scored on both a kickoff return and interception runback, while Leshawn Lampkins also scored following a picked off pass in the season finale.

During this 14-year run, the Miners have had 47 returns that have resulted in touchdowns -- including 12 kickoff runbacks, 12 punts, 17 interception runbacks and six fumbles brought back for scores, as well as a defensive extra point during that span. S&T has had four runbacks for scores this season.

## Milestone Watches:

### Quarterback Tyler Swart:

Missouri S&T quarterback Tyler Swart enters this week's game ranked among the career leaders in several passing categories at S&T and in GLVC history. Coming into this week's play, Swart -- who has recorded the third-highest passing yardage total in a season last fall -- is the record holder for career passing yards, total offense, completions and touchdown passes at S&T after throwing a career-high five scoring passes at SBU and is also closing in on two GLVC passing records that he could reach later this fall. In the opener against Eastern New Mexico, he became the first player in GLVC history with a four-touchdown game in four different seasons.

### Wide Receiver Braxton Graham:

Missouri S&T wide receiver Braxton Graham is also among the school and GLVC all-time leaders in all-purpose yards and into the top 10 on the receiving lists. At the end of last season, Graham had moved up to second place on the career all-purpose yardage list -- trailing only Ashton Gronewold -- and is also second in receiving yards as he became the fifth Miner in history to reach 2,000 receiving yards in 2017. He also sits among the top five for career receptions and yardage in both school and GLVC history.

## Running Back Deshawn Jones:

Deshawn Jones, the 2017 rushing champion in the GLVC, is the first Miner back in history with 10 straight 100-yard rushing games, including an S&T and GLVC record 275 in the win over Saint Francis. His 1,579 yards last season -- the second-most in a full season in GLVC history -- had him ranked fourth in NCAA Division II at the conclusion of the 2017 campaign. He became the fourth Miner player to reach the 1,000-yard mark for a season last year and moved over the 2,000-yard mark for his career in the season opener.

### Placekicker Ben Styron:

As a freshman, S&T placekicker Ben Styron became the first Miner since Jim Zacny in 1985 to make at least four field goals of at least 40 yards in a season. He is one of just two Miners in history with at least five made field goals over 40 yards or more and has tied the school record of eight set by Zacny. Styron, who set a new S&T single-season mark for points scored by a placekicker last fall, set the career field goal mark at S&T on October 20 and is currently the school's all-time scoring leader among placekickers.

### Quick Hits on McKendree:

- The Bearcats topped William Jewell in a high-scoring affair Saturday 47-31, as quarterback Reece Metcalf returned to the lineup to complete 17-of-24 passes for a school record 391 yards and four touchdowns. While Metcalf had a big day through the air, Preston Thompson added 105 yards and two touchdowns on the ground for the 5-4 Bearcats (3-2 in the GLVC).
- Metcalf, who missed just over a game and a half prior to the William Jewell contest, leads the GLVC in passing with 2,159 yards and 25 touchdowns while completing 66.5 percent of his throws. His leading targets have been Jalyn Williams and Josh Revay with 38 catches each; Williams has 599 yards and eight touchdowns, while Revay has six scores and 434 yards.
- The Bearcats lead the GLVC in both scoring (35.9 points per game) and total offense (455.9 yards per contest), as they also possess the GLVC's second-leading rusher in Thompson with 905 yards on the year. Thompson is not doing it alone in the backfield, as Jace Franklin has rushed for 566 yards for a team averaging 205.9 rushing yards per game.
- While the McKendree offense ranks first in the GLVC, the Bearcat defense enters the week at the bottom of the list as it has given up an average of 463.8 yards per contest and 34.2 points per game. Linebacker Ricco Gipson leads the unit with 82 tackles on the year, the fourth-best mark in the conference, while safety Blake Benoist has recorded 58 stops on the year.

### Series history with McKendree:

The Miners lead the all-time series with McKendree 11-4, but the Bearcats have won the last two matchups. A year ago, McKendree outscored the Miners 25-0 in the third quarter -- after S&T held a 9-7 halftime lead -- including two Austin Weltha interception returns for touchdowns in a span of 1:22 to build a lead that the Miners could not overcome in the final period of play.

In the last meeting in Lebanon, McKendree routed the Miners 40-7 and has won two of the three GLVC meetings between the teams at Leemon Field. The Miners won 31-0 in the first matchup in Lebanon in 2012, before McKendree recorded a 27-24 victory two seasons later.

S&T's last win over McKendree came in Rolla on Oct. 24, 2015 by the score of 34-27. The teams have split their six GLVC matchups.

### A victory over McKendree would:

- Give the Miners a 8-2 record, assuring S&T of its first season with at least eight wins since going 10-1 in 2012.
- Give the Miners their first victory over McKendree since 2015 and first over the Bearcats in Lebanon since 2012.
- Give the Miners their 11th win in their last 14 GLVC contests.
- Give the Miners their 11th win in their last 13 road games.
- Make the Miners 8-1 against NCAA Division II competition in 2018.
