Four Down Territory:

1 Missouri S&T seeks its second straight win to open the 2021 spring season Saturday night when it hosts Southwest Baptist in a Great Lakes Valley Conference matchup at Allgood-Bailey Stadium. The Miners were victorious in their first contest when they rallied from a two-touchdown deficit at the half, outscoring William Jewell 35-0 over the final 30 minutes in a 49-28 win.

Southwest Baptist held a 13-7 lead over Truman State midway through the first quarter of its first contest last week, but gave up 31 consecutive points in a game it would eventually lose to the Bulldogs 38-20.

The Miners have won the last three meetings from the Bearcats and have gone 4-2 in their conference matchups against SBU since the Bearcats' first season of GLVC football in 2014.

2 The Miners rolled up 532 yards of total offense in the win at William Jewell -- the most of any GLVC team on the opening weekend of play -- which was the most by a Miner team in a season opener since 2004 when they had 586 against Upper Iowa. S&T also had 302 yards rushing in the game, its first 300-yard game since the 2017 season finale against Quincy (343) and most in an opener since 2000, when it ran for 311 yards against Kentucky Wesleyan.

Aaron Moya, this week's GLVC Player of the Week and Payton McAlister became the first Miner duo to clear the 100-yard mark in a game since Deshawn Jones had 191 yards and D'Luis West had 123 in the aforementioned Quincy contest. Moya had a career-high 143 yards and McAlister finished with 131 last week; Moya's 143 was the most in an opener since Ken Okwuonu had 169 against Quincy in 2001.

3 Justin Onwugbufo's 93-yard fumble runback last week was the longest fumble return in Miner history and second-longest ever in the GLVC, topped only by Cuda Dimmett's 99-yard runback for Kentucky Wesleyan in 2012. Onwugbufo also helped extend a streak as the Miners have now had a return for a touchdown in 16 consecutive seasons.

4 S&T quarterback Brennan Simms is closing in on some top 10 lists in the passing department heading into the SBU game. He needs two touchdown passes and 15 completions to reach 10th place, while also sitting only 260 yards away from Ron Lewis' 10th place mark of 3,332 yards. Simms is also just 333 yards away from 10th place in total offense for a career.

Meanwhile, Aaron Moya and Payton McAlister are both in position to reach the 1,000-yard mark for career rushing. Moya is just 10 yards away from that plateau, while McAlister enters Saturday's contest only 99 yards from that mark.

S&T Head Coach Todd Drury:

Todd Drury was named as the head football coach at Missouri S&T on January 11, 2019 following a three-year stint at the program's defensive coordinator. In his first season at the helm, Drury led the Miners to a 7-4 record -- including a win over Division I FCS opponent Texas Southern -- and became just the second Miner coach in the last century to post a winning record in his inaugural season as S&T's head coach.



Drury has been on the S&T coaching staff for five seasons, starting out as the defensive line coach in 2015 before moving into the coordinator role a year later.

Drury took the helm of the program after guiding the Miner defense to the top of the GLVC during the two previous seasons, as S&T allowed a league-low 292.2 yards per game in 2018 after giving up 294.3 in 2017 to head the league on that side of the ball.

The Miner defense recorded a GLVC-high 43 quarterback sacks during the 2018 season after posting 37 in 2017 and 35 in the 2016 season under Drury's tutelage. S&T was especially stingy against the run during those last two years, allowing just 102.8 yards per game last season after giving up only 91.3 yards per game to opponents on the ground the previous year.

S&T's defense had two All-America selections in 2018 in linebacker Bo Brooks and cornerback Roderick Chapman, both of whom were ranked among the statistical leaders in NCAA Division II. Brooks and Chapman were among nine members of the Miners' defense to earn All-GLVC honors, which included six first-team selections.

Eight members of the defense earned All-GLVC honors in 2017, including first-team pick Tershawn Wharton who set a new S&T single-season record with 21 tackles behind the line of scrimmage. Wharton just completed his rookie season with the National Football League's Kansas City Chiefs in 2020.

In 2016, the Miner defense also recorded its first shutout in over five years when S&T posted a 26-0 win over William Jewell and also had a hand in the scoring with an interception return for a touchdown in that contest. The Miners also posted a shutout in 2019 over Southwest Baptist that also saw the defense score a touchdown; S&T had four defensive touchdowns during the 2019 campaign.

Drury came to S&T from Evangel University, where he spent two seasons as the defensive line coach and strength coordinator for the Crusaders. He was also a graduate assistant at Evangel for three years while working on his Master's degree in secondary education. He went on to serve as the linebackers coach and special teams coordinator at Midland University in Nebraska during the 2012 season before returning to his alma mater a year later.

A native of Peoria, Ill., Drury played tight end at Evangel from 2005-08 and served as a team captain during the 2008 season. He was a four-year letterwinner for the Crusaders and was part of Evangel's 2005 squad that won the Heart of America Conference championship and advanced to the NAIA quarterfinals. He received his bachelor's degree in social science from Evangel in 2009.

Drury and his wife, Kelly, have two children and live in Rolla.

Scoring streaks:

Missouri S&T is in the midst of two record scoring streaks heading into Saturday's game. The Miners have scored in each of their last 98 games since Sept. 17, 2011, the longest such streak in school history. Since the streak started, S&T teams have scored 2,946 points in 98 games, or an average of 30.1 points per game. Last week's game at William Jewell marked the 31st game in which the Miners have scored at least 40 points during the span of the streak.

In addition, the Miners have also scored in each of their last 62 road games, the longest run on the all-time list for consecutive road games with points. The Miners last went scoreless in a road game on Sept. 26, 2009 at Wisconsin-LaCrosse.

Return to glory:

Missouri S&T has had at least one return for a touchdown in 16 consecutive seasons, after Justin Onwugbufo's fumble return for a score in the win at William Jewell extended the streak. The Miners had four returns for scores in the 2019 campaign -- interception returns for scores from Dontay White, Stefan Camplin and Ryan Kirkendall and a fumble return by Tershawn Wharton.

Last week's return marked the fifth time during the streak where the first return score came in the season opener. The previous times were in 2005 (Rodrick McDonald, interception), 2011 (Zach Melber, fumble), 2012 (Carlton Westbrook, punt) and 2016 (Nate Brown, interception).

During this 16-year run, the Miners have had 52 returns that have resulted in touchdowns -- including 12 kickoff runbacks, 12 punts, 20 interception returns and eight fumbles brought back for scores, as well as a defensive extra point during that span.

About the Opponent:

Quick Hits on Southwest Baptist:

- The Bearcats opened their spring schedule with a 38-20 home loss to Truman State on April 1, as the Bulldogs scored 31 unanswered points after SBU had taken a 13-7 lead midway through the first quarter. The Bearcats finished the 2019 season with a record of 3-8 and went 1-6 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference. SBU was outscored 176-27 over its final three contests of the 2019 campaign, a stretch that included a 62-0 loss at Missouri S&T.
- Quarterback Cooper Callis, a transfer from Fullerton College, completed 29-of-38 passes for 376 yards and three touchdowns in the opener; the 376 yards were the most by any GLVC passer in week one. Curtis Culliard caught two of Callis' three scoring passes and had nine receptions for 101 yards in the game.
- The Bearcats struggled to get their ground game going against Truman as they accumulated only 43 net yards rushing. Abel Carter had 20 yards to lead the way and Bryce Cabrera had 13, as SBU averaged just over two yards per carry on its 21 attempts on the ground.
- On the defensive side, safety Bryton Lewi had 10 tackles to lead the Bearcats and also forced a fumble in the game, while Aaron Harris and Brenden Smith each made an interception. Truman State finished with 474 yards of total offense in the contest of which 253 came on the ground.

Series history with Southwest Baptist:

The Bearcats hold a 17-10 lead in the all-time series with one tie, but the Miners have won the last three meetings and four of the six GLVC games between the teams since 2014. The Miners rolled to a 62-0 win over the Bearcats at Allgood-Bailey Stadium in the most recent matchup, scoring 31 points in each half as they accumulated 585 yards of total offense.

In the six GLVC meetings, the Miners have averaged 40.5 points against SBU and 25.2 points in the first half of those games. Missouri S&T has won just six of the 14 meetings held at Allgood-Bailey Stadium, with the Bearcats' last win coming on Oct. 31, 2015 when they rallied from a 19-point deficit in the second half for a 46-42 victory.
