## Four Down Territory:

**1** Missouri S&T will look to open a conference season with a win for the fifth straight time in a matchup of two of the top offensive teams statistically in the Great Lakes Valley Conference as it takes on Quincy in Quincy, Ill. The Miners, who lead the GLVC with an average of 496.8 yards and 46 points per game, are 2-2 heading into the contest after a 38-31 loss last Saturday at Hillsdale.

Quincy, 2-2 on the season after a 63-23 loss last week at Ashland, is second behind S&T in total offense at 472 yards and in points per game at 36.8 entering the game. Saturday's game is also the Hawks' GLVC opener.

**2** **Notes from Hillsdale:** Breon Michel cleared the 100-yard mark in receiving for the third time this year with 124 yards and fourth time in his last six outings; he currently leads the GLVC in receptions and receiving yards and is tied for the league lead with eight touchdowns. ... The run of games with a 100-yard rusher ended at seven as Aaron Moya was held to 60 yards last week. ... Following the game, the Miners stood at fifth in NCAA Division II in total offense and fourth in scoring offense. ... With his 86-yard kickoff return last week, Gideon Niboh became the first Miner with two kick returns of 80 or more yards since Rodrick Chapman in 2018. Niboh returned a kickoff 93 yards for a touchdown against Wayne State. ... S&T failed to get a first down on any of its eight third down plays; the last time it failed to convert on third down came in 2017 against Northwood (0-10). ... S&T was held to 321 yards of total offense last week, its lowest total in a game since gaining only 196 in a 2019 loss to Indianapolis. ... The Miners' run of consecutive quarters with points ended at 14 when they were blanked in the final period by the Chargers.

**3** The Miners have scored at least 30 points in nine of their last 10 games and have put at least 30 points in the scoreboard in 13 of the 18 games that Todd Drury has served as head coach at S&T. The Miners have gone 9-4 in those games in which they have scored at least 30 and have won 22 straight times in which they have posted at least 40 points.

S&T has also scored in a school record 104 consecutive games, a streak that dates back to Sept. 17, 2011. The Miners have scored 3,205 points (30.8 per game) over the course of that run and has reached double figures in all but six games during that time. S&T is also in the midst of its longest string of road games with points, scoring in its last 64 games away from home.

**4** On an individual basis, the Miners have several players that rank among the national leaders. Breon Michel leads all of NCAA Division II with his eight touchdown catches and his 535 receiving yards rank second in the nation. Michel is also fifth in overall scoring in Division II. Gideon Niboh is fourth in kickoff returns with his average of 34.1 yards per runback, Cameron Clemons ranks third in passes defended and Luke Hertzler is eighth in passing efficiency entering play this weekend.

**S&T Head Coach Todd Drury:**

Todd Drury was named as the head football coach at Missouri S&T on January 11, 2019 following a three-year stint at the program's defensive coordinator. In his first season at the helm, Drury led the Miners to a 7-4 record -- including a win over Division I FCS opponent Texas Southern -- and became just the second Miner coach in the last century to post a winning record in his inaugural season as S&T's head coach. The Miners won two of their three games played in the spring of 2021 after the season was moved to the second semester.

Drury has been on the S&T coaching staff for six seasons, starting out as the defensive line coach in 2015 before moving into the coordinator role a year later.



Drury took the helm of the program after guiding the Miner defense to the top of the GLVC during the two previous seasons, as S&T allowed a league-low 292.2 yards per game in 2018 after giving up 294.3 in 2017 to head the league on that side of the ball.

The Miner defense recorded a GLVC-high 43 quarterback sacks during the 2018 season after posting 37 in 2017 and 35 in the 2016 season under Drury's tutelage. S&T was especially stingy against the run during those last two years, allowing just 102.8 yards per game last season after giving up only 91.3 yards per game to opponents on the ground the previous year.

S&T's defense had two All-America selections in 2018 in linebacker Bo Brooks and cornerback Roderick Chapman, both of whom were ranked among the statistical leaders in NCAA Division II. Brooks and Chapman were among nine members of the Miners' defense to earn All-GLVC honors, which included six first-team selections.

Eight members of the defense earned All-GLVC honors in 2017, including first-team pick Tershawn Wharton who set a new S&T single-season record with 21 tackles behind the line of scrimmage. Wharton is beginning his second season with the National Football League's Kansas City Chiefs in 2021.

In 2016, the Miner defense also recorded its first shutout in over five years when S&T posted a 26-0 win over William Jewell and also had a hand in the scoring with an interception return for a touchdown in that contest. The Miners also posted a shutout in 2019 over Southwest Baptist that also saw the defense score a touchdown; S&T had four defensive touchdowns during the 2019 campaign.

Drury came to S&T from Evangel University, where he spent two seasons as the defensive line coach and strength coordinator for the Crusaders. He was also a graduate assistant at Evangel for three years while working on his Master's degree in secondary education. He went on to serve as the linebackers coach and special teams coordinator at Midland University in Nebraska during the 2012 season before returning to his alma mater a year later.

A native of Peoria, Ill., Drury played tight end at Evangel from 2005-08 and served as a team captain during the 2008 season. He was a four-year letterwinner for the Crusaders and was part of Evangel's 2005 squad that won the Heart of America Conference championship and advanced to the NAIA quarterfinals. He received his bachelor's degree in social science from Evangel in 2009.

Drury and his wife, Kelly, have two children and live in Rolla.

**Return to glory:**

Missouri S&T extended a streak earlier this season as the Miners have now made at least one return for a touchdown in 17 consecutive seasons. The streak continues through 2021 after Gideon Niboh ran back a kickoff 93 yards for a score in the Wayne State contest.

During this 17-year run, the Miners have had 53 returns that have resulted in touchdowns -- including 13 kickoff runbacks, 12 punts, 20 interception returns and eight fumbles brought back for scores, as well as a defensive extra point during that span. The kickoff return by Niboh was the first for a Miner since Roderick Chapman returned the opening kickoff for a score against Tuskegee on Sept. 22, 2018.

About the Opponent:

Quick Hits on Quincy:

- The Hawks also bring a 2-2 record into Saturday’s conference opener after their 63-23 loss last week at Ashland, as they gave up 718 yards of offense to the Eagles. Quincy ranks second in the GLVC in total offense with an average of 472 yards per game, 309 of which has come through the air. Quarterback Tionne Harris has thrown for 281.3 yards per game as he has completed 46 of his 92 pass attempts; he is averaging 18.3 yards per completion.
- Quincy has two receivers that rank among the conference leaders led by Eugene Witherspoon, who is second in the GLVC with 460 yards on his 17 catches and has eight touchdowns. The other is AJ Hardin, who has 12 receptions for 284 yards and has the league’s longest reception this season of 83 yards in a win two weeks ago over Walsh.
- Tremayne Lee leads the Hawks in the rushing department with 298 yards and his backup, Taylor Temple, has recorded 182 thus far. Quincy is averaging 163 per game on the ground, but much of that stemmed from a 307-yard rushing output in its victory over Iowa Wesleyan on Sept. 11. The Hawks have finished three of their four contests with more passing yards.
- Quincy’s top tackler is strong safety Melvin Brock, who has been in on 26 stops on the season. Linebacker Trevon Rhodes has 21 tackles, while linebackers Dale Dambek and Peyton Chappel have 16 stops as does defensive tackle Collin Olla-Chatman. The Hawks have recorded 13 sacks, but have allowed 499.5 yards and 38.8 points per game in the first four weeks.

Series history with Quincy:

The Miners hold a 10-3 lead in the all-time series over the Hawks and are 7-1 against Quincy in GLVC matchups. Most of the eight conference games have been tight affairs, as the Miners won the last meeting on Oct. 5, 2019 by a count of 21-13 in Rolla and the last matchup in Quincy 20-13 on Oct. 20, 2018.

Quincy’s only GLVC win over the Miners came in 2014, when it came away with a 20-13 win. S&T has won five straight over the Hawks since that game, four of which that were decided by eight points or less.

A victory over Quincy would:

- Give the Miners a win in their GLVC opener for the fifth straight year.
- Give the Miners their seventh win in a GLVC opener in 10 tries.
- Give the Miners their sixth straight win over the Hawks.
- Move S&T’s all-time record to 5-2 in matchups played in Quincy.
- Give S&T a 14-5 record in its last 19 GLVC contests.
- Improve S&T’s record in GLVC road games to 21-12 since the league began sponsoring a football championship in 2012.

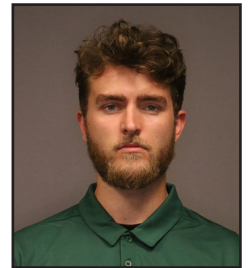

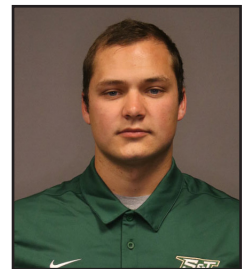
