SAVANNAH STATE TIGERS

The Savannah State Tigers will take on the Georgia Southern Eagles in both teams' season openers on Saturday, August 31 at 6 p.m. in Statesboro, Ga. The day will officially mark a new era in SSU football.

Under the direction of head coach Earnest Wilson, who will make his official collegiate head coaching debut, SSU will look to turn around a program that has finished with 1-10 records the last three seasons. The last time the Tigers won a season opener was in 2009 when SSU defeated Livingstone 34-12.

After an exhausting and grueling fall camp and preseason workouts, the Tigers are poised and anxious to get the season underway.

SSU's offenses will be led by senior wide receiver Simon Heyward who was named to the 2013 All-MEAC Preseason First Team. Coach Wilson announced early this week that SSU's starting quarterback will be redshirt freshman Leon Prunty. Last season's starter, Antonio Bostick, will have to sit out at least the first two games for academic reasons.

The defense is anchored by John Wilson who led the Tigers with four interceptions and seven breakups last season.

Media Information

Credential Requests: All media outlets that wish to cover Savannah State Football games at T. A. Wright Stadium must submit their request for credentials in writing, either via e-mail or via fax, at least one week prior to the home contest, unless requesting a season pass. Single game press credentials can be picked up in the Savannah State Athletic Media Relations Office during the week of a home contest. Credentials must be worn and visible at all times, as there will be staff verifying credentials. All credentials are non-transferable. Your credential will get you access to the stadium, press box, sidelines, and post-game interview area in front of the locker rooms in the north end of T.A. Wright Stadium.

Phone Lines: Any phone lines needed for a particular game must be requested at least 72 hours prior to the game. All-long distance costs associated with the phone line are the responsibility of the media member/outlet utilizing them.

Internet Access: For those with laptop computers that have wireless capabilities, Savannah State University's campus is equipped with wireless internet access. Please know that the University server does track all internet usage, including in the press box, for inappropriate use.

Interview Protocol: After a 10-minute cooling off period, requested players and head coach Earnest Wilson will be available for members of the media. The Tiger locker room is **CLOSED** both at home and on the road. At home, the interview area is located in front of the locker rooms in the north end of T. A. Wright Stadium. Requested players and Coach Wilson will be brought to an area designated by the home team, or just outside the Tigers locker room facility. Player requests should be directed to Opiio Mashariki.

Tigers on Radio: All Tiger football games can be heard on WHCJ 90.3 FM in the Savannah area. Toby Hyde is in his first season of handling the play-by-play duties while Curtis Foster will be handling the color commentary.

Georgia Southern

Georgia Southern is 9-0 in the series against SSU. The Eagles beat the Tigers, 48-3, when the teams last met Sept. 4, 2010, at Paulson Stadium. It was Jeff Monken's head coaching debut at GSU.

GSU has advanced to the Football Championship Subdivision semifinals in each of the past three seasons

GSU features four preseason All-America selections in quarterback Jerick McKinnon, a 5-foot-9, 210-pound senior; B-back Dominique Swope, a 5-foot-11, 201-pound junior; right tackle Dorian Byrd, a 6-foot-1, 269-pound senior; and left tackle Garrett Frye, a 6-foot-5, 275-pound junior. McKinnon ran for 1,817 yards and 20 touchdowns on 269 carries last season.

SSU Playing Division I

Savannah State University made the decision to move from Division II to Division I in 1998, while opting to leave the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference and become independent of conference affiliation. SSU played their first season as a Division I institution in 2002.

Earnest Wilson III



Earnest J. Wilson III was hired as Savannah State's 24th head football coach on June 7, 2013. Entering his 23rd year of coaching, Wilson brings a plethora of coaching experience to the Tigers.

In his first season at the helm of the Tigers, Wilson will also handle the play calling duties as the team's offensive coordinator. A position he held at several previous

institutions.

Wilson comes to SSU from fellow Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) member Hampton University, where he has served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach since 2012. Under Wilson, Hampton averaged 317.2 yards of total offense and 21.7 points per game.

Before joining Hampton, Wilson worked at Jackson State University (JSU) as offensive coordinator, quarterback coach and wide receiver coach for two years (2010-12). While at JSU, Wilson's offense led the South Western Athletic Conference (SWAC) in scoring offense, total offense, pass offense, pass efficiency, first downs and fourth down conversions. Under his tutelage, JSU had the 9th highest scoring offense in the nation.

Prior to JSU, Wilson served as the running backs coach and recruiting coordinator at New Mexico State (2005-09). Wilson coached the number two passer in the nation while at New Mexico State and a team that lead the nation in total offense and was 3rd in the nation in passing (2010 and 2011) for NCAA Division I. He successfully recruited two players that continued on to play in the NFL.

Before Mexico State, Wilson was the offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Benedict College (2003-04) for two seasons. He led the team to its first winning season with a first team All-Academic quarterback.

Wilson's coaching background includes a stint as the head coach and director of football operations for the Carolina Rhinos (2001-02) and Jacksonville Tomcats (1999-2001) of Arena League Football 2 (AFL2). In his first season as head coach in 2000, the Rhinos posted a 10-8 record. The next year, Wilson led the Rhinos to a 13-5 record and advanced to the semifinals of the playoffs. Wilson took over at Jacksonville in

2002, leading the Tomcats to an 8-8 record (second place).

Wilson also served as the head coach of the Dayton Skyhawks of the Indoor Football League (1999). He led the team to the semifinals of the playoffs.

From 1998-1999 he served as the offensive coordinator and offensive line coach at Oberlin College. He coached numerous All-League and All-American performers. While at Oberlin he also served as an assistant men's and women's track and field coach.

Prior to Oberlin, Wilson was the offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator, quarterbacks coach for Elizabeth City State University in North Carolina. He also served as a lecturer for the Department of Health and Physical Education while at Elizabeth City.

From 1994-1996 he was the special teams coordinator, receivers and tight ends coach at Alabama A&M. Under his tutelage the special teams was ranked first in the nation in KOR and second in punt return. Wilson coached a first team All-Conference (SWAC) wide receiver.

Wilson worked as an offensive graduate assistant under legendary football coach Joe Paterno at Penn State in the 1993-1994 season. That season, the Nittany Lions finished 10-2 and won the 1993 Citrus Bowl.

Prior to his graduate work, Wilson was the receivers and tight ends coach at The University of Maine. Wilson helped the team set passing and special teams records and compile the best team record in four years, while at Maine.

Wilson also worked as receivers and tight ends coach at Allegheny College (1990-92). While at Allegheny, he was part of the coaching staff that won the 1990 NCAA Division III National Championship.

Wilson played football while receiving both his undergraduate and graduate degrees from Texas Tech University. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Recreation in 1989 and a Master of Education in Sports Administration in 1990.

Wilson is married to Maria, and the couple has three children, Earnest, IV, Jonathan, and Mya.

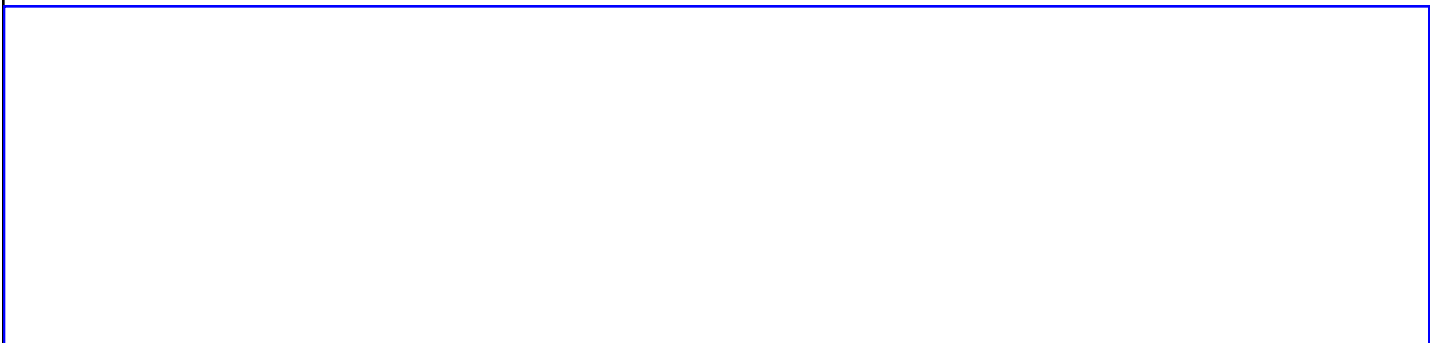
