2013-14 Notes

- ◆◆Saturday's game marks the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) opener for both the Huskies and Bulldogs. The Huskies are the defending NSIC North Division Champions and were picked to finish first in the division again in 2013-14 and second overall in the league. Minnesota Duluth is picked to finish third in the North.
- ◆◆It's Men's Basketball Alumni Day at Halenbeck Hall. St. Cloud State Athletics and Men's Basketball will recognize the alumni in attendance during half-time of the game.
- ◆◆The Huskies received eight votes in the Nov. 26 NABC/Division II Coaches Poll.
- ◆◆St. Cloud State has posted a 4-0 record in non-conference play this season including last Saturday's 87-84 win at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside.
- ◆◆Sophomore guard Jordan Poydras (De Pere, Wis.) scored a career high 32 points in the win over the Rangers. He made three free throws in the final :45 seconds to hold off the Rangers. Senior guard Damarius Cruz (Plymouth) added 16 points and six rebounds and senior forward Matt Craggs (Kimberly, Wis.) added nine rebounds.
- ◆◆The win over UW-Parkside was the 325th in head coach Kevin Schlagel's career with the Huskies.
- ◆◆Minnesota Duluth went 2-2 in non-conference play. The Bulldogs last game was at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside, an 83-70 loss. Junior guard Reece Zoelle (De Pere, Wis.) led the Bulldogs with 26 points. Senior guard Jordan Reetz added 17 points.
- ◆◆The Bulldogs are coached by Matt Bowen, in his second year at Minnesota Duluth. Last season his team posted an 8-19 overall record and went 6-16 in the NSIC.
- ◆◆St. Cloud State front liners Matt Craggs and junior center James Fort (South Haven) are shooting over 60 percent from the field in the first four games of the year. Craggs is .615, having made 16 of 26 field goal attempts. Fort is shooting at a 64% clip, making 16 of 25 attempts.
- ◆◆Jordan Poydras has scored in double figures in each of the Huskies last three games. He has dished out at least three assists in all four games played this season.
- ◆◆St. Cloud State's Kevin Schlagel is in his 17th and final season as the Husky head coach as he announced that he will retire at the end of the year. Schlagel has averaged 20 wins per season over his 16 years and is the winningest men's basketball coach at SCSU with a 321-149 overall record. Schlagel's squads have earned eight NCAA tournament bids and most recently won back-to-back NSIC Sanford Health postseason tournament championships in 2009 and 2010 to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

2012-13 Season in Review

- **NSIC NORTH CHAMPIONS!** The Huskies secured the 2013 NSIC North Division title with a 15-7 league record.
- St. Cloud State men's basketball posted a 20-8 overall record. The Huskies started the season with seven straight wins.
- The Huskies were ranked #9 in the final NCAA Division II Central Region ranking posted on March 6, 2013. The Huskies were ranked #4 in the first region ranking of the season and dropped to seventh in the Feb. 28 ranking.
- St. Cloud State was ranked #19 in the 2012-13 Basketball Times NCAA Division II Preseasonpoll and received votes in the NABC/Division II Top 25 Coaches Pre-Season poll. The Huskies went as high as #22 in the NABC/Division II poll during the regular season.
- The Huskies collected their ninth 20-win season under head coach Kevin Schlagel. 2012-13 marked the second straight 20-win season for the Huskies and the fourth in the last five seasons.
- Husky basketball was crowned the NCAA Statistical Champion for fewest turnovers (10.1) per game in the Division II ranks.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

After a 40-year association with the St. Cloud State University men's basketball program, head coach Kevin Schlagel announced on Sept. 16 that he will retire following the end of the 2013-14 season.

Schlagel, a Rush City, Minn., native, landed on the St. Cloud State campus in 1972 and played four seasons for Noel Olson. He became the program's top assistant coach in 1980 and spent 18 seasons with three different coaches before being named the head coach for the 1997-98 season.



"I am fortunate to work in a job that I have absolutely loved," said Schlagel. "I consider it a privilege to have had the opportunity to be a college coach and work with the outstanding young people that have gone through our program."

Schlagel made the announcement prior to the 2013-14 season for several reasons, among them making the transition as easy as possible for the current players and to allow the university time to conduct a national search. "I don't want to mislead any recruits as we move forward in this process," said Schlagel. He also wants to be mindful of his current coaching staff. "By announcing my retirement now, it gives my staff, and Matt Reimer in particular, the opportunity to pursue a head coaching position at St. Cloud State or another program."

"On behalf of St. Cloud State University I first want to thank Coach Schlagel for his enduring commitment," said Director of Athletics Heather Weems. "In my short year with Kevin I have found him to be a passionate advocate for his students and his program, and I value his knowledge as a coach and many years of dedication to Husky Basketball. Kevin has been an iconic figure in St. Cloud State athletics for almost 40 years. He has consistently demonstrated his ability to develop students into high-level basketball players while graduating students of integrity and purpose. Our graduates have gone on to be leaders in their professional lives and communities, and see their SCSU experience as foundational in their success. I respect his decision to retire after such a wonderful career, and know that his legacy is etched in the hearts and experiences of players, fans, and community members. A national search will commence later in the season, and internal candidates will be considered. In the meantime, our focus will be on preparing our student-athletes for the 2013-14 season and shaping our recruiting classes of the future."

The winningest men's basketball coach in school history, Schlagel's teams have averaged 20 wins a season during his tenure and he has compiled a 321-149 won/loss record entering his 17th season as head coach of the Huskies.

Schlagel's teams have entertained fans with an up-tempo and aggressive style of play that has earned the Huskies five conference titles, the most recent being the 2013 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) North Division championship.

The Huskies have advanced to eight NCAA Division II tournaments under Schlagel and reached the Elite Eight in 2010, advancing to the semifinal game of the Final Four in Springfield, Mass. That season the Huskies set a school record for wins with 29.

As an assistant coach, Schlagel was part of SCSU's triple crown in the North Central Conference (NCC) when the Huskies won three consecutive conference titles from 1985 to 1988.
