- SCSU is playing Winona State for the 62nd time in the series that started in 1919. The 62 games against WSU is the second-most in the St. Cloud State record book behind the 79 contests against Minnesota State (formerly Mankato State). The Huskies currently own a 43-14-4 series lead over the Warriors. SCSU and Winona State did not play in 2014. The last time these two teams met the Huskies charted a close

# **FOOTBALL NOTES CONTINUE:**

- Bret Piekarski, Sr., OL, Jordan Sefon, Sr., DB, Ledell White, Sr., RB, Grant Thayer, Sr., TE, Karl Eichinger, Sr., OL, Matt Hentges, Jr., WR, Rafael Saez, Sr., OL and Adam Josephson, Jr., LB were all named preseason Division II All-Americans for 2015 by USA College Football.
- SCSU received votes in this year's AFCA Division II Coaches' poll. In the 2015 preseason NSIC poll, the Huskies were ranked 5th overall and they gained a #3 ranking from the league coaches in the always rugged NSIC North Division.
- SCSU opened its season on Sept. 3 with a 28-10 win over Concordia-St. Paul. SCSU is now 14-12 in season openers since the 1990 season.
- SCSU lost in its second game, a road game to Augustana, by a 41-27 score on Sept. 12. Matt Hentges recorded nine catches for 128 yards and a touchdown in the game. Nate Meyer threw his first three touchdown passes of the season and went 30-for-38 for 336 yards in the loss
- The Huskies fell in a close 21-20 contest at home to Southwest Minnesota State on Sept. 19 to drop to 1-2 on the campaign. The team rallied from 14 points down in the fourth quarter, but came up one point short of sending the game to overtime after a missed extra point on the final touchdown.
- Jameson Parsons had nine catches for 180 yards against SMSU.
  Both his catch and his yardage totals are career highs breaking his
  marks of six catches for 96 yards against Augustana the previous
  weekend (9/12). His 180 yards receiving in a game is the eighthhighest single game total in school history and the most for a SCSU
  receiver since Eli Shoemaker's 195 yards against Bemidji State on
  Oct. 27, 2012. Parsons has accumulated 15 catches for 276 yards
  the last two weeks.
- The home loss for SCSU to SMSU was the program's first in 10 games in St. Cloud. The all-time series between the schools is now SCSU 16 and SMSU 2. It was the program's first loss to the Mustangs since the 1981 season in a series that started in 1970.
- Jaden Huff scored a pair of touchdowns for the Huskies and ran for 46 yards. Huff has now scored a team-high five touchdowns and 30 points on the season. He is tied for the conference lead with his five touchdowns this season.

### **MORE SCSU FOOTBALL NOTES:**

- Nate Meyer went 13-for-20 for 244 yards and one rushing score against the Mustangs. Meyer has thrown for 580 yards over the last two weeks.
- Brady Westart had a steady performance for SCSU with his 13 tackles, a sack and 2.5 stops for loss in the contest against SMSU.
- Craig Szymanski tallied nine tackles, a sack and 1.5 stops for loss. He has put together 16 tackles including four stops for loss the last two games.
- Senior running back Ledell White recorded 54 yards rushing in the loss to SMSU. He has rushed for a team-high 209 yards on the season and 1,875 yards in his career to move up a place to 11th on the all-time list. SCSU's all-time rushing leader is Matt Birkel with 4,920 yards on the ground from 2001-05. White also ranks tied for 15th in touchdowns scored (19).
- Nate Meyer's 244 yards passing against Southwest Minnesota State gave him 2,772 in his career. That total ranks 13th in the SCSU record book. The all-time leader for St. Cloud State is Phillip Klaphake's (2010-13) 11,261 yards. Meyer is also ranked seventh in pass completion percentage (57.9), 12th in passing touchdowns (19) and 14th in pass completions (198).
- Senior defensive back Jordan Stefon's 19 career pass breakups rank him tied for ninth place at SCSU along with Ted Bents (1986-89) and Marvin Matthews (2009-13). The school's all-time leader is Eric Mickleson (2000-03) with 45.
- Four of Grant Thayer's eight receptions on the season have come on third down and all but one of his eight catches have resulted in St. Cloud State first downs.
- Nate Meyer is completing nearly 69 percent of his passes (68.5%) this year (54for-79). He came into the year with a career completion percentage of 54 percent (144-for-263). Meyer is the top ranked quarterback in the NSIC with his 155 pass efficiency
- Jameson Parsons has five 20+ yard receptions this season and is the only player on the offensive unit to record more than two runs or receptions of 20+ yards this season
