BLIZZARD'S BULLETS

- ▶ **THE MATCHUP:** St. Cloud State plays host to No. 4/5 Wisconsin this weekend for the Huskies' WCHA home opening series. SCSU and Wisconsin drop the puck at 6:00 p.m. CT Friday with a 3:00 p.m. CT start on Saturday at the Herb Brooks National Hockey Center.
- ▶ **THE SERIES:** The Huskies are 6-83-3 against Wisconsin with their last win coming in Madison on February 20, 2015. Goals by Alyssa Erickson and Payge Pena provided the offense in a 2-1 win over then-No. 4 Wisconsin as Julie Friend stopped 52 of 53 shots faced in goal. Last season, St. Cloud State took a point from the Badgers with a shootout loss on January 28. The Huskies haven't beaten Wisconsin at the HBNHC since November 21, 2009.
- ▶ **SCOUTING THE ENEMY:** The Badgers are 5-1-0 overall and 2-0-0 in conference play this season, entering the series having won five straight after a 4-1 opening night loss at Penn State. Since their loss, the Badgers are outscoring their opponents 49-2 and have not allowed a team to score more than one goal in any of the five contests. Casey O'Brien (4-8-12), Lacey Eden (5-6-11), Sophie Shirley (5-6-11) and Caroline Harvey (1-9-10) each have already reached double-digit points this season while eight Badgers have skated to a plus-10 or better. Jane Gervais (3-0-0, 0.67 GAA, .963 SV%) and Cami Kronish (2-1-0, 1.01 GAA, .914 SV%) have split Wisconsin's six games in goal.
- ▶ **HUSKIES PRIMER:** The Huskies were swept last weekend by No. 1 Ohio State, struggling to generate consistent chances on the offensive end. SCSU was outshot 84-29 in the series and took eight penalties, allowing the Buckeyes to go 3-for-8 on the power play for a 62.5% kill. Jenniina Nylund and Emma Gentry share the Huskies' goal lead this season with three each while Taylor Lind leads in both assists and points with a 2-4-6 line. Klára Hymlová has a point in each of St. Cloud State's first four games. On the defensive end, Taytum Geier has 11 blocks while Regan Bulger has 10, both landing in the top-seven of the conference leaders. Sanni Ahola has started three games in goal for SCSU with a 1-2-0 record while JoJo Chobak owns a 0.75 goals against and a .967 save percentage across 79:31 in the crease.
- ▶ **POWER UP:** St. Cloud State leads the nation with a 50.0% power play, having gone 5-for-10. Emma Gentry's three goals on the power play is tied for the WCHA lead and stands as the second-most across the NCAA.
- ▶ **RISING ROOKIE:** Huskies freshman defender Regan Bulger has enjoyed a stellar start to her collegiate career, skating on the second pairing with Grace Wolfe and posting 10 blocks through four games. Bulger ranks seventh across the WCHA in blocked shots and has nine over her last three games.
- ▶ **WELCOME TO THE CLUB:** SCSU captain Taylor Lind became the program's 28th member of the 50 Point Club last weekend with an assist on Friday in Columbus.
- ▶ **JOJO'S HOUSE, PART II:** Junior goaltender JoJo Chobak has made three career starts at the Herb Brooks National Hockey Center with two of her outings being shutouts. Chobak shut out the Huskies last season and blanked RPI in her first start with SCSU this fall.

STREAKS AND SUCH: 2022 Olympians Jenniina Nylund and Klára Hymálová each are on four-game point streaks to open the season with at least one in each of their first four games. Taylor Lind and Emma Gentry both have a point in three of four games this season.

GEIER THE GREAT: Assistant captain Taytum Geier is fifth in the WCHA this season with five blocks while delivering a 1-1-2 line, sharing the Huskies' defender point lead with sophomores Dayle Ross and Grace Wolfe.

BADGER CONNECTIONS: An iconic member of Wisconsin Women's Hockey history, Huskies associate head coach Jinelle Siergiey played for the Badgers from 2004-08. She gained All-WCHA honors in 2006, 2007 and 2008 and was selected to the WCHA All-Rookie team in 2005. At Wisconsin, Siergiey was part of two national title teams in 2006 and 2007 and left the campus as UW's all-time leader in goals, game-winning goals and power play goals. Across her four-year career the legendary forward produced 89 goals and 67 assists for 156 collegiate points, posting three 20-goal seasons and eclipsing 40 points twice with 50 in her junior season.

2022-23 OUTLOOK: St. Cloud State enters the new campaign under the direction of Brian Idalski, manning the bench in his first season as the Huskies' head coach. SCSU returns their entire top-six including 93% of the team's points from a season ago. The formidable top line of Taylor Lind, Jenniina Nylund and Emma Gentry will be looked to as key scoring threats alongside talented wings Olivia Cvar and Klára Hymálová. Centers Addi Scribner and Courtney Hall each reached the double-digit point threshold last season, providing playmaking to the second and third lines. Sanni Ahola and transfer JoJo Chobak project to serve as one of the top netminding pairs in the conference while Taytum Geier and McKenna Wesloh provide senior leadership to a young defensive corps.

OH CAPTAINS, OUR CAPTAINS: St. Cloud State announced their 2022-23 captains on September 23. Senior forward Taylor Lind will serve as the Huskies' captain while fifth-year forward Jenniina Nylund, graduate defender Taytum Geier and senior forward Klára Hymálová will don the "A" as assistant captains. "These four truly stood out in their ability to steer our program forward," said head coach Brian Idalski, "Our captains lead with their composure, determination, effort and competitiveness. Their shared experience across the hockey map is incredibly valuable, as is their willingness to help their teammates grow on and off the ice. We are excited to watch this group lead in 2022-23."

25 YEARS OF HUSKIES WOMEN'S HOCKEY: 2022-23 marks the 25th season of St. Cloud State Women's Hockey. First taking the ice in 1998-99 under the direction of Kerry Brodt, Huskies Women's Hockey has earned six top-four finishes in the always-rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association. Six head coaches have led the program: Brodt, Jason Lesteberg, Jeff Giesen, Eric Rud, Steve Macdonald and Brian Idalski. Three Huskies - Caitlin Hogan, Holly Roberts and Roxanne Stang - reached the 100-point club while Felicia Nelson earned

WCHA Co-Player of the Year honors and was a Top-10 Patty Kazmaier finalist in 2009-10. Numerous alumna have gone on to grow the women's game in a variety of channels ranging from playing professionally to coaching at all levels of girl's and women's hockey.

CHAPTER XXV - ENTER IDALSKI: Brian Idalski was named the sixth head coach in the history of St. Cloud State Women's Hockey on May 19, 2022. The 2022-23 campaign marks his 16th as a collegiate head coach, carrying a 277-177-50 record into his first season leading the Huskies. He has coached 10 Olympians, 26 national team members from eight countries, three All-Americans, three Academic All-Americans, four Patty Kazmaier Top-10 finalists, two NCAA Great Eight Award winners and 62 WCHA Scholar Athletes throughout his career.

NOT-SO-UNFAMILIAR FACE: In 2006-07 Idalski served as an assistant coach on the St. Cloud State bench - a season in which the Huskies went 12-18-7, one of only 10 campaigns with double-digit wins in the program's 24-year history. He led the defenders, coordinated advance scouting and oversaw the Huskies' recruiting efforts. His recruiting class was headlined by legendary SCSU goaltender Ashley Nixon, who graduated second all-time in saves, fourth in save percentage and fifth in goals against.

WORLDWIDE HUSKIES: The 2022 IIHF Women's World Championships held in Herning and Frederikshavn, Denmark featured four current and former St. Cloud State Huskies. Klára Hymálová led Czechia to their first-ever Senior National Team medal with a Bronze finish while Jenniina Nylund, Laura Zimmermann and Laura Kluge (21') headlined Finland, Switzerland and Germany respectively. Hymálová made her fifth appearance at the Worlds, spanning a timeframe that has seen SCSU extremely well-represented.

A "CHANGE IN THE LIND: Taylor Lind will wear a letter for the first time in her collegiate career this season. The Shaunavon, Saskatchewan native led the Huskies in both assists and points while delivering an 8-17-25 line as a junior. A two-time WCHA All-Academic Team honoree, Lind is one point away from reaching the SCSU

50-point club.

- NEW YEAR, SAME NIINERS:** Jenniina Nylund served as an assistant captain in 2021-22 for St. Cloud State, earning her third WCHA All-Academic honor. She earned Bronze at the 2022 Winter Olympics with Finland, becoming the first active Huskies Women's Hockey player to medal at the Games. A product of Pietarsaari, Nylund skated to a Huskies-leading plus-five over 18 games while delivering a 7-8-15 line. Nylund is 20 points away from entering the program's top-10 in career scoring.
- DISCIPLINED D:** Huskies grad student defender donned the "A" midway through last season in a critical time for the Huskies, returning as an assistant captain in 2022-23. A three-time WCHA All-Academic selection, Geier blocked 37 shots and provided six assists over 29 games while anchoring a young defensive corps. The Verona, Wisconsin native has skated in 117 games over her four seasons with St. Cloud State. Geier has taken just six penalties across her collegiate career, including just two last season. She once maintained a 51-game stretch without hitting the penalty box, spanning from March 2, 2019 to February 6, 2021.
- CENTER CZECH:** Klára Hymelárová adds a captaincy to an already well-decorated career, having appeared in five World Championships with Czechia and earning Bronze this past August. The two-time WCHA All-Academic recipient participated in the 2022 Winter Olympics and skated in 15 games for St. Cloud State. Hymelárová has provided an 11-28-39 line over 69 collegiate games played.
- OLYMPIC PRESENCE:** Jinelle Siergiej begins her ninth season with St. Cloud State Women's Hockey in 2022-23 and her fourth as associate head coach. Joining the staff at SCSU in 2014-15 as an assistant coach, Siergiej was promoted to Associate Head Coach prior to the start of the 2019-20 season. Working primarily with the forwards and leading recruiting efforts, the 2010 Olympic Silver Medalist has guided eight Huskies to All-WCHA honors including five All-Rookie Team selections. 11 Huskies have delivered 20-point seasons under Siergiej's tutelage while 11 have posted double-digit goal campaigns. Siergiej has recruited and coached three Olympic forwards in Jenniina Nylund (Finland, Beijing 2022), Klára Hymelárová (Czech Republic, Beijing 2022) and Laura Zimmermann (Switzerland, Beijing 2022).
- DIRECTING THE DEFENSE:** Mira Jalosuo begins her first season as the Huskies' assistant coach in 2022-23. A highly-decorated member of Finland's National Team, the two-time Olympian and five-time Women's World Championships bronze medalist will primarily work with the St. Cloud State defenders. Jalosuo had been a steady presence on Finland's blue line until her retirement in 2018, skating for 12 years as a member of the Senior National Team. She appeared in the 2014 and 2018 Olympic Games – earning bronze at Pyeongchang in 2018 – and added five bronze medals at the IIHF Women's World Championships. From 2019 to 2022, Jalosuo spent three seasons leading Stillwater Area High School girls' hockey as the program's head coach. Under her direction, the Ponies were 52-19-4 (.693) and boasted a strong penalty kill.

Stillwater killed 89.3% of their chances on the PK, including 90 of 98 (91.8%) kills in 2019-20.

- IVY TEACHING:** 2022-23 marks Megan Van Beusekom-Sweerin's first season with Huskies Women's Hockey as the volunteer goalie coach. A legendary First Team All-Ivy goaltender at Princeton from 2000-04, Van Beusekom-Sweerin graduated as the program's all-time leader in wins and save percentage while finishing second in goals against average and career saves. Well-decorated on the international level, she earned Gold twice with Team USA at the IIHF Women's World Championships in 2005 and 2009. Owning a career .926 save percentage at the World Championships, she recorded a shutout at the 2009 tournament. She also was a member of the Four Nations Team in 2007. Van Beusekom-Sweerin spent 12 seasons playing professionally with the Minnesota Whitecaps before retiring in 2016.
- GROWING THE GAME:** The U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Museum announced its matchup for the Women's Face-off Classic, once again featuring St. Cloud State. The Huskies will face Minnesota on Monday, Nov. 7 at 7:00 p.m. CT at the Andover Community Center in Andover, Minn. The Huskies and Gophers, both members of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association, will battle for the Hall of Fame Game Trophy. The annual game raises awareness for the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame Museum in Eveleth, Minn., and showcases women's college hockey at its highest level. Two members of the 2022 Hall of Fame Class - Jocelyne Lamoureux-Davidson and Monique Lamoureux-Morando - played for Huskies head coach Brian Idalski during his time at North Dakota.
- NEW THREADS:** St. Cloud State added three transfers to the fold entering 2022-23 as goaltender JoJo Chobak (Minnesota Duluth) alongside forwards Bailey Burton (Providence) and Avery Myers (New Hampshire) each don the Huskies sweater this winter.
- FRESH FACES:** The 2022-23 Huskies freshman class features forwards Laura Zimmermann and Svenja Voigt, defenders Lauren Tuzik and Regan Bulger along with goaltender Julia Bachetti.
- PRESEASON POLLING:** Huskies Hockey was selected to finish seventh in the 2022-23 WCHA Coaches Poll. The Huskies earned 15 points in the poll, one behind the sixth-place team. Last season SCSU went 9-23-3 with a 4-20-3 mark in WCHA play, finishing the season seventh in the conference standings.

Brian Idalski was named the sixth head coach in the history of St. Cloud State Women's Hockey on May 19, 2022. The 2022-23 campaign marks his 16th as a collegiate head coach, carrying a 277-177-50 record into his first season leading the Huskies. He has coached 10 Olympians, 26 national team members from eight countries, three All-Americans, three Academic All-Americans, four Patty Kazmaier Top-10 finalists, two NCAA Great Eight Award winners and 62 WCHA Scholar Athletes throughout his career.

Idalski was chosen to serve as the head coach for China at the 2022 Winter Olympics in Beijing. His team earned two wins in pool play and operated as the top penalty kill in the Olympics at 90.0% with nine kills on 10 chances. Under his guidance, goaltender Jiaying Zhou posted the best save percentage at .955 with 85 stops on 89 shots.

Prior to joining St. Cloud State, Idalski spent three seasons as the head coach of the Shenzhen KRS Vanke Rays in the Zhenskaya Hockey League. He guided the Rays to a 77-17 record, two regular season championships and the 2020 ZhHL Cup - becoming the first non-Russian team to win the league's championship. Idalski was named ZhHL Coach of the Year in 2020 and 2022 along with being selected to coach in the 2019-20 ZhHL All-Star Game.

Idalski spent the 2018-19 season as the Director of Hockey Activities at Culver Academy in Culver, Indiana, leading the program to its first USAH Tier-I Nationals appearance.

Introduced as the University of North Dakota Women's Hockey head coach in April of 2007, Idalski was the architect of a major turnaround. He compiled five 20-win seasons while leading the Fighting Hawks to NCAA Tournament appearances in 2012 and 2013, inheriting a team that went 3-31-2 prior to his arrival and rebuilding UND as a national power. His teams were consistently ranked in the Nation's Top-10 while producing a record of 169-156-39 in 10 seasons.

With Idalski at the helm, UND saw the program's first-ever Olympian in Susanne Fellner (2006 Olympics, German National Team), first-ever active student-athlete Olympians in Jocelyne and Monique Lamoureux (2010 Olympics, U.S. National Team) and first-ever recruited Olympian in Michelle Karvinen (2010 Olympics, Finnish National Team). During his time in Grand Forks, Idalski served as the Vice President of the American Women's Hockey Coaches Association and the Governor of the American Hockey Coaches Association.

Idalski led UND to back-to-back NCAA Tournament berths in 2011-12 and 2012-13, finishing runner-up in the WCHA Tournament in 2013 and 2014. North Dakota finished fourth or higher in each of their final seven campaigns, with Idalski directing a .500 record in WCHA play through his 10 seasons leading the program.

In 2006-07 Idalski served as an assistant coach on the St. Cloud State bench - a season in which the Huskies went 12-18-7, one of only 10 campaigns with double-digit wins in the program's 24-year history. He led the defenders, coordinated advance scouting and oversaw the Huskies' recruiting efforts. His recruiting class was headlined by legendary SCSU goaltender Ashley Nixon, who graduated second all-time in saves, fourth in save percentage and fifth in goals against.

Before his first stint at St. Cloud State, Idalski enjoyed a highly successful five-year tenure as head women's hockey coach at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, where he amassed a 108-21-11 (.811) record and was a four-time finalist as American Hockey Coaches Association (AHCA) National Coach of the Year.

Idalski guided UW-Stevens Point to an NCAA Division III runner-up finish in 2003-04, a third-place national finish in 2005-06 and a national quarterfinal finish in 2004-05. He led the Pointers to three Northern Collegiate Hockey Association (NCHA) regular season championships (2002, 2005, 2006), four NCHA playoff titles (2002, 2004, 2005, 2006) and was twice named NCHA Coach of the Year (2002, 2005). During his time at UW-Stevens Point, Idalski tutored three All-Americans, six Academic All-Americans and 17 All-NCHA selections.

UW-Stevens Point appeared in two DIII Frozen Fours under Idalski and became the first team to finish the NCHA regular season undefeated in 2004-05.

A four-year letterwinner at UW-Stevens Point from 1991-1995, Idalski was a member of the Pointers' NCAA Division III runner-up team in 1992 and was a sophomore on the 1993 Division III national championship team. In 97 career games as a defenseman, he tallied five goals and 20 assists.

Following his Pointer playing days, Idalski went on to play professional hockey for two years with the Madison Monsters of the United Hockey League from 1995-1997. He then played two seasons with the Columbus Cottonmouths of the Central Hockey League from 1997-1999, and won the 1998 CHL regular season and playoff championship. After his professional playing days, Idalski spent the 1999-2000 season as the full-time assistant coach with the Cottonmouths.

Idalski has also been involved for several years as an instructor at the USA Hockey National Development Camps and other instructional hockey camps throughout North America.

A Warren, Michigan native, Idalski and his wife Nicole, have four sons - Beau, Jason, David and Mitchel.



ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH JINELLE SIERGIEJ



9th Season
at SCSU

Jinnelle Siergiej begins her ninth season with St. Cloud State Women's Hockey in 2022-23 and her fourth as associate head coach. Joining the staff at SCSU in 2014-15 as an assistant coach, Siergiej was promoted to Associate Head Coach prior to the start of the 2019-20 season.

Working primarily with the forwards and leading recruiting efforts, the 2010 Olympic Silver Medalist has guided eight Huskies to All-WCHA honors including five All-Rookie Team selections. 11 Huskies have delivered 20-point seasons under Siergiej's tutelage while 11 have posted double-digit goal campaigns.

Siergiej has recruited and coached three Olympic forwards in Jenniina Nylund (Finland, Beijing 2022), Klara Hymmlarova (Czech Republic, Beijing 2022) and Laura Zimmerman (Switzerland, Beijing 2022).

Molly Illikainen (17-15-32) gave the Huskies their first 30-point season since 2009-10 in Siergiej's second season with the program. Laura Kluge (7-17-24) and Klara Hymmlarova (8-18-26) impressed as rookies in 2017-18 and 2019-20 respectively. Julia Tylke climbed to sixth all-time in goals at the conclusion of her SCSU career under Siergiej's watch.

Prior to her move to SCSU, Siergiej served as an assistant coach at Robert Morris during the 2013-14 season.

An iconic member of Wisconsin Women's Hockey history, Siergiej played for the Badgers from 2004-08. She gained All-WCHA honors in 2006, 2007 and 2008 and was selected to the WCHA All-Rookie team in 2005. At Wisconsin, Siergiej was part of two national title teams in 2006 and 2007 and left the campus as UW's all-time leader in goals, game-winning goals and power play goals. Across her four-year career the legendary forward produced 89 goals and 67 assists for 156 collegiate points, posting three 20-goal seasons and eclipsing 40 points twice with 50 in her junior season.

Siergiej represented the United States at the 2010 Winter Olympics and helped United States Women's Hockey earn silver. She previously won silver at the IIHF Women's World Championships with Team USA in 2007 and was part of the Four Nations' tournament with Team USA in 2006, 2007, 2009 and 2010.

The owner of the Crazy Eights Hockey Camp since 2006, Siergiej has also served as the head coach of the girls' team at Arrowhead High School in Hartland, Wisconsin. She and her husband Mike Siergiej have two sons - Colden and Rory.

ASSISTANT COACH MIRA JALOSUO



1st Season
at SCSU

Mira Jalosuo begins her first season as the Huskies' assistant coach in 2022-23. A highly-decorated member of Finland's National Team, the two-time Olympian and five-time Women's World Championships bronze medalist will primarily work with the St. Cloud State defenders.

Jalosuo had been a steady presence on Finland's blue line until her retirement in 2018, skating for 12 years as a member of the Senior National Team. She appeared in the 2014 and 2018 Olympic Games - earning bronze at Pyeongchang in 2018 - and added five bronze medals at the IIHF Women's World Championships (2008-09, 2011, 2015, 2017). The defender played in 193 games for Finland, scoring 11 goals and adding 22 assists for 33 points as an anchor on the blue line.

From 2019 to 2022, Jalosuo spent three seasons leading Stillwater Area High School girl's hockey as the program's head coach. Under her direction, the Ponies were 52-19-4 (.693) and boasted a strong penalty kill. Stillwater killed 89.3% of their chances on the PK, including 90 of 98 (91.8%) kills in 2019-20.

Prior to her time at Stillwater Jalosuo had served as an assistant coach for Hamline University and the Wayzata High School program since 2015. She also coached with the Stillwater Area Hockey Association, leading the U12A team to a 42-6-2 record in 2018-19.

Jalosuo played professionally following her collegiate career from 2013-18, spending two seasons with SKIF Nizhny Novgorod in the Russian Women's Hockey League and earning the Russian Championship in 2014. She then spent time with Lulea HF in the SDHL before joining the Minnesota Whitecaps in 2016-17 and 2017-18. Jalosuo also skated with Oulun Karpat in the Naisten Liiga, the team she played with as a teenager prior to her time with the Gophers.

The Lieksa, Finland native played for the Minnesota Gophers from 2009-10 to 2012-13. She appeared in 153 career games for the Maroon and Gold, recording 57 career points with 19 goals and 38 assists. A Third Team All-WCHA honoree as a senior, Jalosuo was part of back-to-back national championship teams as a junior and senior. She was a three-time WCHA All-Academic honoree as well.

Raised in eastern Finland, Jalosuo began playing in the premier Finnish women's league with Oulun Karpat at age 15 and was an All-Star in 2007 and 2008. She served as the team's captain in 2008-09 while still attending high school.
