BLIZZARD'S BULLETS

- TONIGHT'S TILT: 2022 NSIC Tournament Champion No. 7 St. Cloud State battles national giant Concordia-St. Paul in the Sweet 16 as a rematch of the NSIC Tournament Championship, looking to punch their ticket to Seattle and the Elite 8 with a Central Region Championship. First serve is set for 4:00 p.m. at Rice Auditorium.
- LET'S GO POLLING: SCSU jumped up two spots to No. 7 in this week's AVCA Top-25 poll - remaining in the top-10 for the 13th straight week this season and 15th consecutive week dating back to 2021. This week's rank marks the 19th time SCSU has appeared in the top-10 of an AVCA poll in the Braegelmann era.
- LAST NIGHT: Outside hitter Kenzie Foley hit .431 with a 30-kill, 20-dig double-double as No. 7 St. Cloud State took down top-seeded No. 2 Wayne State on their home court in Saturday's Round of 32. Foley's 30 kills are the third-most ever recorded by a Husky in a single match as she became the first player to send down 30 or more kills since Cami Selbitschka put away 32 on October 18, 1996 against South Dakota State. She is the first player in program history to have 30 kills and 20 digs in a single match. The Sergeant Bluff native's herculean night was supported by Linsey Rachel's 22 kills and 19 digs alongside a 12 kill, seven-block night from Phebie Rossi. Freshman setter Emma Berran continued her phenomenal postseason run, piling up 63 assists and converting on 44.7% of her sets - adding 14 digs for a double-double as the Huskies sent down a season-high 75 kills — establishing a new program record for kills in a four set match.
- AS THE DUST SETTLES: Friday's Round of 64 saw a NSIC sweep at the Central Region Tournament. No. 7 St. Cloud State downed No. 12 Northwest Missouri State in four sets as the lone upset of the day in the 4-5 match. Top-seeded No. 2 Wayne State swept GAC Champion No. 24 Harding while No. 3 Concordia-St. Paul defeated No. 13 Nebraska Kearney in four sets in the 2-7 Quarterfinal. In the 3-6 match, No. 6 Minnesota Duluth handled MIAA Champion No. 15 Washburn in four sets. On Semifinal Saturday, the Huskies took down Wayne in four sets after CSP defeated UMD in four.
- HUSKIES AT THE NCAA TOURNAMENT: 2022 marks the eighth St. Cloud State appearance at the NCAA Tournament with tonight's Sweet 16 match against Wayne State being the 12th match the Huskies have played at the national tournament. The Huskies are 4-7 all-time in the NCAA's, making their deepest run in 1995 with Round of 32 and Sweet 16 wins over Morningside and Northern Colorado respectively before falling to eventual National Champion Barry in the Elite 8. St. Cloud State's four-set win over Northwest Missouri State on Friday was their first NCAA Tournament win since November 18, 1995 – 27 years (9,862 days) to the day of Friday's match. Including AIAW Tournament play, the program is 14-17 at the National level.

BLIZZARD'S BULLETS (CONTINUED)

- SCOUTING NO. 3 CONCORDIA-ST. PAUL: Perennial national power Concordia-St. Paul has downed No. 13 Nebraska Kearney and No. 6 Minnesota Duluth thus far in the National Tournament, appearing in their seventh straight Sweet 16. The Golden Bears lead the country in hitting percentage (.304) and are second in kills/set at 14.65, leaning on a terminal offense headlined by star opposite Jasmine Mulvihill (3.89 K/S, .283, 2.24 D/S). Outsides Makenna Berger (1.86 K/S, .326) and Emma Schmidt (3.02 K/S, .282, 3.17 D/S) anchor the pins alongside Mulvihill while middles Kennedy Brady (2.26 K/S, .387, 0.94 B/S) and Katie Mattson (2.38 K/S, .378, 1.02 B/S) form a formidable duo. Teagan Starkey (12.68 A/S) directs the CSP offense while Ellie Sieling (3.33 D/S) serves as a key piece of the Golden Bear defense.
- NSIC CHAMPIONSHIP REMATCH: Tasked with beating the No. 3 team in the country on their home floor, then-No. 9 St. Cloud State earned their second-straight Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Tournament Championship by taking down Concordia-St. Paul in a five-set thriller at the Gangelhoff Center on Sunday afternoon. The Huskies faced a difficult path to an at-large NCAA bid entering the conference tournament, taking matters into their own hands and controlling their own national tournament destiny by earning the NSIC's automatic bid. Just as they had done in the first two rounds of the tournament, SCSU relied on a balanced offense and strong passing to keep themselves in system. Linsey Rachel led Huskies with 17-kill, 13 dig double-double while Phebie Rossi added 15 kills on .367 hitting and Sam Zimmerman recorded 13 kills on .400 to put three players in double figures.

BLIZZARD'S BULLETS (CONTINUED)

- ALL-TOURNAMENT HUSKIES: Sam Zimmerman, Kenzie Foley, Phebie Rossi and Linsey Rachel were each named to the All-Tournament Team as the Huskies led all NSIC teams with four selections. Zimmerman hit .412 with 2.82 kills/set while Rossi put away 2.91 kills/set on .409 hitting. Rachel led the Huskies at the tournament with 3.27 kills and 3.68 points per set while adding 3.55 digs/set. Foley took her defense to another level, averaging 5.09 digs/set to go with 3.09 kills/set.
- NATIONAL NOTICE: Junior outside hitter Kenzie Foley was named AVCA DII National Player of the Week for the second time this season after leading the Huskies to the NSIC Championship. Foley averaged 5.09 digs/set to anchor the Huskies' defense in the NSIC Tournament and led a serve receive that was aced just seven times. The Sergeant Bluff, lowa product put down 3.09 kills/set and provided 3.45 points/set during the tournament.
- THE BIG THREE: St. Cloud State's offense has been led by their three returning All-Americans middle blocker Phebie Rossi pressures defenses as an intimidating presence alongside fearsome outsides Linsey Rachel and Kenzie Foley. The Huskies are one of just four teams in all of DII who feature three qualifying players who average 3.00 or more kills/set, alongside No. 2 Wayne State, No. 21 Quincy and Texas A&M International. SCSU is one of just seven programs who feature three hitters with 300 or more kills on the year.
- BERRAN'S BRILLIANCE: True freshman setter Emma Berran has provided a marvelous season for SCSU, ranking 12th nationally in assists/set (11.05) while directing the offense to rank seventh in hitting percentage (.279) and 14th in kills/set (14.07) across the NCAA. She set a new first-year program record for assists in a single season last night, building on an incredible campaign. Berran took her game to another level at the conference tournament, posting 11.64 assists/set and converting on 40.0% of her sets while guiding the offense to hit .269.
- LINSEY'S LEGACY: 2022 NSIC Most Outstanding Senior of the Year Linsey Rachel enters the final chapter of her incredible St. Cloud State career at the National Tournament. Rachel is the program's all-time leader in kills and the only 1500x1500 Club member (kills and digs) in program history while ranking second in points and fourth in digs. A two-time All-American and four-time All-NSIC selection, Rachel has guided the Huskies to three straight NCAA Tournament bids.
- ROSSI'S REIGN: Senior middle blocker Phebie Rossi ranks sixth nationally with 1.26 blocks/set and is 20th in hitting percentage at .382. The senior ranks fourth all-time in blocks and block assists, third in hitting percentage and seventh in solo blocks. Rossi recorded her 400th career block on Friday and could make a significant jump in the all-time solo block leaderboard with a strong national tournament.
- DEFENSIVE DOMINANCE: The Huskies owned the second-best defense in the Northern Sun in the regular season, holding opponents to a .162 hitting percentage while allowing the second-fewest kills/set in the league at 10.55. SCSU allowed the fewest kills in the league at 1023 and ranked second in blocks/set with 2.29. The Huskies' work at the service line consistently kept opponents out of system, averaging 1.94 aces/set second-most in the league.
- POSTSEASON PHENOMS: Linsey Rachel has been dominant in postseason play throughout her collegiate career, averaging 3.85 kills/set, 4.35 points/set and 3.80 digs/set on .228 hitting over 11 career matches. Kenzie Foley has hit .276 in the postseason, recording 3.96 kills/set and 3.81 digs/set while providing 4.44 points/set. Phebie Rossi has averaged 1.49 blocks/set across 11 postseason matches, racking up 61 blocks in her playoff career to go with 3.43 points/set on .296 hitting.
- POINTS ON PASSING: St. Cloud State's serve receive enjoyed an outstanding NSIC Tournament, going 201-for-208 (.966) with just seven aces allowed in 11 sets played. In wins this season SCSU receives a .933 with 1.13 aces allowed per set with those two marks falling to .930 and 1.43 in losses.
- LEADING THE PACK: Multiple Huskies could be found among the NSIC leaderboards at the conclusion of the regular season. Phebie Rossi led the league in blocks (126) and blocks/set (1.31) while ranking third in hitting percentage (.379), seventh in points/set (4.03) and 16th in kills/set (3.08). Kenzie Foley landed second in kills/set (3.98), third in points/set (4.65) eighth in aces/set (0.37) and tied for 19th in digs/set (3.03). Chad Braegelmann enters his eighth season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University volleyball program and 22nd season overall in 2022. A two-time NSIC Coach of the Year honoree, Braegelmann has built Huskies Volleyball into a national power. Under his guidance SCSU has earned both a NSIC Tournament and Regular Season Championship, two NCAA Central Region Tournament appearances, two NSIC Tournament berths and multiple AVCA Top-25 rankings. He enters the 2022 season with a 386-248 collegiate head coaching record, 11 20-win seasons, six Conference Coach of the Year honors and has led his teams to five conference championships.

Since 2019, the Huskies are a combined 25-9 against AVCA Top-25 opponents and opponents receiving votes in the AVCA poll. In that same span, SCSU is 23-3 at Halenbeck Hall.

Throughout his 22-year collegiate coaching career, Braegelmann has coached six American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) All-Americans, 10 All-Region players, seven conference Freshmen of the Year, three conference Players of the Year, six Libero/Defensive Players of the Year and 58 All-Conference athletes.

Braegelmann repeated as the NSIC Coach of the Year last season, leading the Huskies to their first NSIC regular season title since 1982 and earning the program's first NSIC Tournament Championship. St. Cloud State went 27-5 with a 19-1 mark in NSIC play to finish alone atop the conference standings. The Huskies earned the No. 2 seed at the Central Regional in Warrensburg, Missouri, closed the season ranked No. 10 in the final AVCA top-25 poll and set new program standards for fewest losses and best single-season winning percentage. Braegelmann's offense was one of the most terminal units in the Nation, ranking seventh in hitting percentage (.270), 10th in assists (1576), 13th in kills (1682), 15th in assists per set (13.0) and 17th in kills per set (13.9). The Huskies' fearsome block ranked seventh in total blocks (305.0) and ninth in blocks per set (2.5) at the conclusion of the season.

Multiple AVCA Top-25 teams fell at the hands of St. Cloud State throughout 2021 as the Huskies were 8-3 against ranked opponents. SCSU dispatched the No. 5 (2x), 8, 9,14, 15 (2x) and 16 teams in the country over the course of their historic season, including three ranked wins in their NSIC Tournament Championship run. The Huskies swept No. 16 SMSU in the Quarterfinal, took down No. 15 Wayne State in a five-set Semifinal thriller then defeated No. 8 Winona State in four sets to earn the conference crown.

Several student-athletes received recognition during 2021 headlined by Kenzie Foley, who was named the AVCA Division II National Freshman of the Year, AVCA Central Region Freshman of the Year and NSIC Freshman of the Year while earning First Team All-America, All-Region and All-Conference recognition after a breakout season with St. Cloud State. Maddy Torve graduated as one of the most successful setters in program history, earning First Team All-America (AVCA, D2CCA), All-Region (AVCA, D2CCA), All-NSIC, Academic All-District (CoSIDA) and Academic All-America (CoSIDA) honors while being named the NSIC Outstanding Senior of the Year. Linsey Rachel became the program's first two-time All-American, adding AVCA All-America Honorable Mention, First Team AVCA All-Region and





First Team All-NSIC honors to an already-stacked trophy case. Phebie Rossi ranked sixth in the nation in blocks at the conclusion of the season and earned First Team All-NSIC, AVCA All-Region Honorable Mention and AVCA All-America Honorable Mention honors.

Braegelmann led the Huskies to new heights in 2019, earning NSIC Coach of the Year after helping St. Cloud State record its best season in over 20 years. Under Braegelmann's guidance, the Huskies posted an overall record of 25-7 and a 15-5 mark in NSIC play, landing them fourth place in the NSIC rankings and earning their first-ever trip to the NSIC Tournament. St. Cloud State earned its first AVCA top-25 ranking since 1997, cracked the organization's top-10 for the first time since 1996, finished No. 10 in the final AVCA top-25 poll and earned an atlarge berth to the NCAA Regional for the first time since 2004. St. Cloud State defeated 14 nationally and regionally ranked opponents during the season, going 10-5 against AVCA Top-25 opponents and finished runner-up in the NSIC Tournament.

St. Cloud State's defense closed 2019 as one of the top units in the nation, leading the NSIC in digs and digs/set. The Huskies broke the program record for single-season digs, compiling 2213 over the course of 31 matches. Senior libero Clara Krenz became the program's all-time dig leader, concluding her impressive career with 2227. Braegelmann saw three student-athletes earn All-NSIC honors as Krenz was named the conference's Libero of the Year for the second consecutive season and earned First Team All-NSIC, AVCA First Team All-Central Region, D2CCA Second Team All-Region and AVCA All-America Honorable Mention honors while junior setter Maddy Torve earned Second Team All-NSIC honors and ranked top-five nationally in assists and assists/set. Finally, a program-record 11 student-athletes earned Academic All-NSIC honors in 2019.

2018 saw the Huskies continue to build, posting a 15-11 overall record with an 11-9 mark in NSIC play and a seventh-place finish in the conference standings. St. Cloud State defeated two top-10 nationally-ranked opponents while several individuals find success during the 2018 season. Freshman outside Linsey Rachel and junior libero Clara Krenz received Second Team All-NSIC honors in 2018 and were named the conference Freshman and Libero of the Year. Both also earned NSIC Player of the Week honors at least once during the season while seven student-athletes earned Academic All-Conference honors in Braegelmann's fourth season with the program.

In 2017, Braegelmann led the Huskies to a 16-14 record an an 8-12 mark in NSIC play. The 16 wins were the most for the program since 2004, when St. Cloud State posted an overall record of 19-12, and marked just the third time in the last 20 years the Huskies won more than 15 matches in a season. Sophomore libero Clara Krenz led the Northern Sun with a whopping 5.92 digs per set and earned Second Team All-NSIC honors at the end of the season, becoming Braegelmann's second All-NSIC libero in three years with the program. The Huskies defense ascended to third in the NSIC with 17.26 digs a set, limiting opponents to the sixth-fewest kills per set in the league.

Year two at St. Cloud State served as a rebuilding year for the program as the Huskies were 8-21 overall, 3-17 in the NSIC. Four student-athletes earned Academic All-NSIC notice in 2016. The Huskies showed vast improvement at the service line, leaping to fifth in the NSIC with 1.52 aces per set. SCSU's serve receive was seventh in the conference, allowing just 123 aces. Nicole Miller led the Northern Sun with 76 aces - 24 more than the next-best serve specialist - and averaged just over half an ace per set. Freshman libero Clara Krenz opened her collegiate career with 4.30 digs per set, landing her seventh in the NSIC.

In his first season with the Huskies, Braegelmann posted a 9-19 overall record with a 5-15 NSIC mark in NSIC play. St. Cloud State's defense ranked fifth in the NSIC with 16.50 digs per set, led by All-NSIC libero Brianne Stamer's conference-leading 5.46 digs a set. Stamer was one of six Huskies on the Academic All-NSIC squad while Macy Weller ranked top-20 in the conference with 0.83 blocks per set.

Chad Braegelmann was named the fifth head coach in St. Cloud State Volleyball history on July 6, 2015.

Prior to his move to SCSU, Braegelmann was the head women's volleyball coach at the University of Minnesota-Morris where he also served as the Sports Studies and Athletics Discipline Coordinator and an Assistant Athletic Director. In seven seasons at Minnesota-Morris, Braegelmann posted a 130-91 record while earning UMAC Coach of the Year honors in 2010 and 2013. His team won a share of the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference title in 2013 before closing his Minnesota-Morris career with a 23-12 (12-2 UMAC) showing in 2014.

At Colby-Sawyer, Braegelmann departed as the all-time winningest coach in program history with a 156-80 record over seven seasons spanning from 2001-07. He guided the Chargers to Commonwealth Coast Conference Championships in 2003 and 2005 while twice advancing to the NCAA Division III National Tournament. Braegelmann led Colby-Sawyer to six conference championship match appearances with double-digit wins in all seven seasons, attaining the most single-season wins in school history in any sport. Volleyball athletes were successful off the court as well, earning the top team academic grade point average of Colby-Sawyer's athletic programs multiple times.

A graduate of the University of Minnesota-Morris, Braegelmann received his master's degree in education from Northern State University.

A native of Richmond, Minn. and graduate of nearby ROCORI H.S., Braegelmann and his wife Natalie have four sons.

St. Cloud State associate head volleyball coach Marci Taumalolo enters her 13th season with Huskies Volleyball in 2022. At the conclusion of the 2019 season, Taumalolo was promoted from top assistant to associate head coach. Honored as part of the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Thirty Under 30 in February of 2011, Taumalolo has helped shape St. Cloud State Volleyball into a national power.

In 12 years with the program, Marci has recruited and coached six AVCA All-Americans, eight AVCA All-Region honorees, 13 All-NSIC selections, two NSIC Libero and Freshmen of the Year recipients, two AVCA Central Region Freshmen of the Year honorees and an AVCA DII National Freshman of the Year. 64 student-athletes have earned Academic All-NSIC honors under Taumalolo's watch.

The Huskies defense has developed into one of the top units in the NSIC during Taumalolo's time with SCSU, ranking top-six across the Northern Sun in digs per set in five of the past six seasons. St. Cloud State led the NSIC in both digs and digs/set in 2019, holding opponents to the fifth-lowest hitting percentage across

Throughout her career at St. Cloud State, liberos have flourished as Taumalolo has recruited and coached back-to-back record-setters. Of the top-10 single-season dia leaders in program history, seven performances have been overseen by Taumalolo. Four of the Huskies' top-six career dia leaders have played for Taumalolo: Clara Krenz (2016-19), Brianne Stamer (2012-15), Chelsea Nagle (2008-11) and Linsey Rachel (2018-22). Krenz established herself as one of the all-time St. Cloud State greats in her time with the program, racking up a Huskies-record 2227 digs and becoming the program's first-ever 2000 Dig Club member. She was named an All-American, a two-time NSIC Libero of the Year and garnered All-NSIC honors three times while leading the Northern Sun in digs per set during the 2017, 2018 and 2019 seasons. Stamer preceded Krenz as the program's all-time dig leader, posting 1929 digs in her illustrious career and earning All-NSIC honors during the 2015 campaign with a conference-leading 5.46 dias per set. Rachel paced all NSIC outside hitters in dias and dias per set during the 2021 campaign, developing into one of the best six-rotation players in the nation under Taumalolo's watch. Nagle provided the third-most single-season digs with 481 in Marci's first season with the Huskies, going on to finish third all-time in digs at the time of her graduation.

Taumalolo helped guide the Huskies to their first NSIC regular season title since 1982 and earning the program's first NSIC Tournament Championship in 2021. St. Cloud State went 27-5 with a 19-1 mark in NSIC play to finish alone atop the conference standings. In 2007, the Cardinals finished fifth with 14.57 digs per set, while the back court improved two spots in 2008, ranking third with 15.43 digs per set.

Before her tenure with the Cardinals, Taumalolo was a four-year member of the University of Minnesota Golden Gophers women's volleyball team. She finished her career at Minnesota (2003-06) ranked second on the school's all-time career digs list at 1,401. After leading the Big Ten with a 5.22 digs per set her senior season, Taumalolo earned American Volleyball Coaches Association All-America Honorable Mention accolades, was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year and was a First-Team All-Big Ten honoree. She was also a four-time Scholar Athlete and garnered the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week accolades three times during her collegiate stint.

Prior to her collegiate career, Taumalolo was a two-time AAU All-American (2001 & 2002) for the Kaepa Northern Lights Club, while being named an All-American at the 2000 Junior National Championships (16-Open) and picking up the "Best Setter" award at the 2002 National Junior Championships.



During her prep career at Armstrong High School in Plymouth, Minnesota, Taumalolo was an All-American and All-State player as a junior and senior. During her senior campaign, she led her team to an undefeated (29-0) record, while collecting 31 kills and 28 dias in the team's state championship victory over Eagan High School, As a junior, she collected a school-record 53 kills in one match.

Taumalolo has earned a Master's Degree in Physical Education and Sports Administration (Ball State) along with a Bachelor's Degree in Business & Marketing (Minnesota, 2007). A native of Plymouth, Minn., Taumalolo is married with five children. She has nine siblings, including three older sisters and one younger sister who all played collegiate volleyball, along with five brothers.
