### **BLIZZARD'S BULLETS**

- ENTERING THE TOURNAMENT: Reigning Northern Sun Champion No. 9 St. Cloud State opens play at the 2022 NSIC Tournament by squaring off with No. 7 Southwest Minnesota State in the Quarterfinal at the Gangelhoff Center in St. Paul on Friday evening. First serve is scheduled for 5:00 p.m. CT. The Huskies earned the No. 5 seed in the tournament with a 15-5 conference finish, squaring off with the No. 4-seeded Mustangs in a rematch of last season's NSIC Quarterfinal. SMSU also finished 15-5, earning the higher seed by a strength of schedule tiebreaker.
- LET'S GO POLLING: SCSU slid back one spot to No. 9 in this week's AVCA Top-25 poll - remaining in the top-10 for the 12th straight week this season and 14th consecutive week dating back to 2021. This week's rank marks the 18th time SCSU has appeared in the top-10 of an AVCA poll in the Braegelmann era.
- THE FIELD: St. Cloud State enters the 2022 NSIC Tournament as the No. 5 seed, paired in the Quarterfinal with No. 7 Southwest Minnesota State. No. 2 Wayne State earned the top seed, facing off with Augustana in the other Quarterfinal on the Huskies' side of the bracket. On the other side, No. 3 Concordia-St. Paul draws Northern State in the 2-7 Quarterfinal while No. 4 Minnesota Duluth battles Sioux Falls in the 3-6 match.
- NCAA IMPLICATIONS: Despite entering the tournament ranked No. 9 in the country by the AVCA, the Huskies appear to be on the outside looking in at a NCAA Tournament berth — although plenty of work can be done at the conference tournament. St. Cloud State was ranked No. 9 in this week's Central Region poll, trailing four conference rivals and four MIAA teams. As the GAC is guaranteed an automatic bid with their conference champion, SCSU's clearest path a third-straight NCAA appearance is by winning the tournament outright. The Huskies are 0-5 against the four NSIC teams ranked ahead of them with three heart-wrenching five-set defeats, creating a murky outlook for an at-larae bid.
- QUARTERFINAL REMATCH: The Huskies and Mustangs also met in the Quarterfinals of the 2021 NSIC Tournament in the 1-8 matchup. SCSU took straight sets from Southwest, recording 12 blocks with eight provided by Phebie Rossi while the offense outhit the Mustangs .303 to .107. Linsey Rachel hit .292 with 11 kills and nine digs in the match. Errors were key — SCSU committed just eight while forcing SMSU into 25 attacking

## **BLIZZARD'S BULLETS (CONTINUED)**

- SCOUTING NO. 7 SOUTHWEST MINNESOTA STATE: Four-seed SMSU enters the tournament with an identical record as the Huskies at 23-5, 15-5 in conference play. The Mustangs' attack revolves around star senior opposite Meg Schmidt, who averages 3.13 kills/set on .281 hitting with 62 blocks on the year. Senior setter Alisa Bengen averages 10.72 assists/set while directing the offense to hit .248 with 14.02 kills/set good for 16th in the NCAA and is one of the more aggressive scoring setters in the league, putting away 1.11 kills/set on .313 hitting. Sophomore outside Saari Kuehl (2.69 K/S, .213) along with middles Karli Arkell (1.99 K/S, .288) and Emma VanHeel (2.51 K/S, .264) have provided alternative options to Schmidt although VanHeel did not appear last weekend after a difficult five-match stretch. Sophomores Brooklyn Kusler (1.97 K/S, .226) and Katelyn Nichols (1.59 K/S, .230) have seen more time as of late at outside and middle blocker respectively. None of the Mustangs' hitters play six rotations instead SMSU utilizes a complement of three defensive specialists alongside libero Natalee Rolbiecki (3.23 D/S) as McKenzie Tolk (2.45 D/S), Rachel Fink (2.25 D/S) and Abby Meister (2.18 D/S) see significant action in the back row.
- LAST MATCH VS. THE MUSTANGS: Then-No. 4 St. Cloud State dropped a five-set heartbreaker to No. 7 Southwest Minnesota State on October 1 in Marshall, losing a 2-1 lead in the match and a 14-11 advantage in the fifth set. Phebie Rossi delivered a career day for SCSU, terminating a career-high 27 kills on .458 hitting to go with two aces and four blocks. The senior middle blocker scored 32.0 points, leading all players. Kenzie Foley added 14 kills, four blocks and four digs while fellow outside Linsey Rachel kicked in 11 kills and five digs. Sam Zimmerman provided 10 kills on .318 hitting, leading SCSU with five blocks including three solo stuffs. Emma Berran directed the offense to 71 kills, dishing out a career-best 58 assists and adding eight digs. Keely Kurschner led the Huskies with 10 digs.

# **BLIZZARD'S BULLETS (CONTINUED)**

- ALL-AMERICAN ATTACK: St. Cloud State's offense has been led by their three returning All-Americans middle blocker Phebie Rossi pressures defenses as an intimidating presence alongside fearsome outsides Linsey Rachel and Kenzie Foley. The Huskies are one of just three teams in all of DII who feature three qualifying players who average 3.00 or more kills/set, alongside No. 2 Wayne State and Texas A&M International. Rossi is four kills away from making SCSU join just five other programs who have three hitters with 300 or more kills on the year. Foley, Rachel and Rossi combine for 72.6% of the Huskies' kills and 66.9% of their points on .298 hitting. The rest of the SCSU attack is hitting .237 this season with 3.87 kills/set.
- QUARTERFINAL REMATCH: The Huskies and Mustangs also met in the Quarterfinals of the 2021 NSIC Tournament in the 1-8 matchup. SCSU took straight sets from Southwest, recording 12 blocks with eight provided by Phebie Rossi while the offense outhit the Mustangs .303 to .107. Linsey Rachel hit .292 with 11 kills and nine digs in the match. Errors were key SCSU committed just eight while forcing SMSU into 25 attacking errors.
- NOT DONE YET: Graduate student outside hitter and NSIC Most Outstanding Senior of the Year Linsey Rachel became St. Cloud State's all-time career kill leader in the regular season finale, entering the conference tournament with 1,569 kills. She ranks third all-time in points and fourth all-time in digs 20 shy of joining the 1500x1500 kills and digs club.
- POSTSEASON PHENOMS: Linsey Rachel has been dominant in postseason play throughout her collegiate career, averaging 4.07 kills/set, 4.60 points/set and 3.90 digs/set on .247 hitting over eight career matches. Kenzie Foley hit .312 in the postseason last year, recording 4.56 kills/set and 2.94 digs/set. Phebie Rossi has averaged 1.73 blocks/set across eight postseason matches, racking up 52 blocks in her playoff career.
- ROSSI'S REIGN: Senior middle blocker Phebie Rossi has been on a ridiculous tear over her last 13 matches, putting down 3.30 kills/set on .399 hitting with 4.42 points/set and 1.40 blocks/set. On the season, Rossi ranks fifth nationally with 1.31 blocks/set and is 25th in hitting percentage at .379. The senior ranks fourth all-time in blocks and block assists, third in hitting percentage and eighth in solo blocks. Rossi is 10 blocks away from recording her 400th career block and could make a significant jump in the all-time solo block leaderboard with a strong tournament.
- LEADING THE PACK: Multiple Huskies can be found among the NSIC leaderboards entering the conference tournament. Phebie Rossi leads the league in blocks (126) and blocks/set (1.31) while ranking third in hitting percentage (.379), seventh in points/set (4.03) and 16th in kills/set (3.08). Kenzie Foley is second in kills/set (3.98), third in points/set (4.65) eighth in aces/set (0.37) and tied for 19th in digs/set (3.03). Keely Kurschner is second in the league with 0.44 aces/set and eighth with 3.90 digs/set. Emma Berran ranks fourth in assists/set (10.98). Linsey Rachel lands seventh in kills/set (3.42), ninth in points/set (3.88), 18th in aces/set (0.32) and 19th in digs/set (3.03). Sam Zimmerman rounds out the leaderboards at 12th in blocks/set (0.90) and 18th in hitting percentage (.278).
- BERRAN'S BRILLIANCE: True freshman setter Emma Berran has provided a marvelous season for SCSU, ranking 15th nationally in assists/set (10.98) while directing the offense to rank seventh in hitting percentage (.280) and 12th in kills/set (14.09) across the NCAA. She is just one assist away from reaching 1,000 on the season and is 185 from setting a new first-year record.
- DEFENSIVE DOMINANCE: The Huskies own the second-best defense in the Northern Sun entering the tournament, holding opponents to a .162 hitting percentage while allowing the second-fewest kills/set in the league at 10.55. SCSU has allowed the fewest kills in the league at 1023 and are second in blocks/set with 2.29. The Huskies' work at the service line has consistently kept opponents out of system, averaging 1.94 aces/set second-most in the league.
- SOLVING TRENDS: St. Cloud State has taken all five of their losses to ranked teams this fall, going 0-5 in matches against AVCA Top-25 opponents. Comparing their statistics in wins noted in parentheses, the Huskies produce 12.43 kills/set (14.55), 1.67 blocks/set (2.46), 0.90 aces/set (2.22) and 12.24 digs/set (15.17) on .218 hitting (.296) while allowing opponents to hit .251 (.138).
- POSTSEASON UNDER BRAEGELMANN: St. Cloud State head coach Chad Bragelmann is 5-3 in postseason play at SCSU with a 5-1 career mark at the NSIC Tournament, earning the Championship in 2021.

- Coached two AVCA Central Region Freshmen of the Year (Linsey Rachel - 2018, Kenzie Foley - 2020)
- Has earned five conference championships as a head coach
- 58 student-athletes have earned All-Conference accolades under Braegelmann's guidance
- Has coached 10 All-Region honorees
- Has led 11 20-win teams in his collegiate coahing career

Chad Braegelmann enters his eighth season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University volleyball program and 22nd season overall in 2022. A two-time NSIC Coach of the Year honoree, Braegelmann has built Huskies Volleyball into a national power. Under his guidance SCSU has earned both a NSIC Tournament and Regular Season Championship, two NCAA Central Region Tournament appearances, two NSIC Tournament berths and multiple AVCA Top-25 rankings. He enters the 2022 season with a 386-248 collegiate head coaching record, 11 20-win seasons, six Conference Coach of the Year honors and has led his teams to five conference championships.

Since 2019, the Huskies are a combined 25-9 against AVCA Top-25 opponents and opponents receiving votes in the AVCA poll. In that same span, SCSU is 23-3 at Halenbeck Hall.

Throughout his 22-year collegiate coaching career, Braegelmann has coached six American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) All-Americans, 10 All-Region players, seven conference Freshmen of the Year, three conference Players of the Year, six Libero/Defensive Players of the Year and 58 All-Conference athletes.

Braegelmann repeated as the NSIC Coach of the Year last season, leading the Huskies to their first NSIC regular season title since 1982 and earning the program's first NSIC Tournament Championship. St. Cloud State went 27-5 with a 19-1 mark in NSIC play to finish alone atop the conference standings. The Huskies earned the No. 2 seed at the Central Regional in Warrensburg, Missouri, closed the season ranked No. 10 in the final AVCA top-25 poll and set new program standards for fewest losses and best single-season winning percentage. Braegelmann's offense was one of the most terminal units in the Nation, ranking seventh in hitting percentage (.270), 10th in assists (1576), 13th in kills (1682), 15th in assists per set (13.0) and 17th in kills per set (13.9). The Huskies' fearsome block ranked seventh in total blocks (305.0) and ninth in blocks per set (2.5) at the conclusion of the season.

Multiple AVCA Top-25 teams fell at the hands of St. Cloud State throughout 2021 as the Huskies were 8-3 against ranked opponents. SCSU dispatched the No. 5 (2x), 8, 9,14, 15 (2x) and 16 teams in the country over the course of their historic season, including three ranked wins in their NSIC Tournament Championship run. The Huskies swept No. 16 SMSU in the Quarterfinal, took down No. 15 Wayne State in a five-set Semifinal thriller then defeated No. 8 Winona State in four sets to earn the conference crown.

Several student-athletes received recognition during 2021 headlined by Kenzie Foley, who was named the AVCA Division II National Freshman of the Year, AVCA Central Region Freshman of the Year and NSIC Freshman of the Year while earning First Team All-America, All-Region and All-Conference recognition after a breakout season with St. Cloud State. Maddy Torve graduated as one of the most successful setters in program history, earning First Team All-America (AVCA, D2CCA), All-Region (AVCA, D2CCA), All-NSIC, Academic All-District (CoSIDA) and Academic All-America (CoSIDA) honors while being named the NSIC Outstanding Senior of the Year. Linsey Rachel became the program's first two-time All-American, adding AVCA All-America Honorable Mention, First Team AVCA All-Region and





First Team All-NSIC honors to an already-stacked trophy case. Phebie Rossi ranked sixth in the nation in blocks at the conclusion of the season and earned First Team All-NSIC, AVCA All-Region Honorable Mention and AVCA All-America Honorable Mention honors.

Braegelmann led the Huskies to new heights in 2019, earning NSIC Coach of the Year after helping St. Cloud State record its best season in over 20 years. Under Braegelmann's guidance, the Huskies posted an overall record of 25-7 and a 15-5 mark in NSIC play, landing them fourth place in the NSIC rankings and earning their first-ever trip to the NSIC Tournament. St. Cloud State earned its first AVCA top-25 ranking since 1997, cracked the organization's top-10 for the first time since 1996, finished No. 10 in the final AVCA top-25 poll and earned an atlarge berth to the NCAA Regional for the first time since 2004. St. Cloud State defeated 14 nationally and regionally ranked opponents during the season, going 10-5 against AVCA Top-25 opponents and finished runner-up in the NSIC Tournament.

St. Cloud State's defense closed 2019 as one of the top units in the nation, leading the NSIC in digs and digs/set. The Huskies broke the program record for single-season digs, compiling 2213 over the course of 31 matches. Senior libero Clara Krenz became the program's all-time dig leader, concluding her impressive career with 2227. Braegelmann saw three student-athletes earn All-NSIC honors as Krenz was named the conference's Libero of the Year for the second consecutive season and earned First Team All-NSIC, AVCA First Team All-Central Region, D2CCA Second Team All-Region and AVCA All-America Honorable Mention honors while junior setter Maddy Torve earned Second Team All-NSIC honors and ranked top-five nationally in assists and assists/set. Finally, a program-record 11 student-athletes earned Academic All-NSIC honors in 2019.

2018 saw the Huskies continue to build, posting a 15-11 overall record with an 11-9 mark in NSIC play and a seventh-place finish in the conference standings. St. Cloud State defeated two top-10 nationally-ranked opponents while several individuals find success during the 2018 season. Freshman outside Linsey Rachel and junior libero Clara Krenz received Second Team All-NSIC honors in 2018 and were named the conference Freshman and Libero of the Year. Both also earned NSIC Player of the Week honors at least once during the season while seven student-athletes earned Academic All-Conference honors in Braegelmann's fourth season with the program.

In 2017, Braegelmann led the Huskies to a 16-14 record an an 8-12 mark in NSIC play. The 16 wins were the most for the program since 2004, when St. Cloud State posted an overall record of 19-12, and marked just the third time in the last 20 years the Huskies won more than 15 matches in a season. Sophomore libero Clara Krenz led the Northern Sun with a whopping 5.92 digs per set and earned Second Team All-NSIC honors at the end of the season, becoming Braegelmann's second All-NSIC libero in three years with the program. The Huskies defense ascended to third in the NSIC with 17.26 digs a set, limiting opponents to the sixth-fewest kills per set in the league.

Year two at St. Cloud State served as a rebuilding year for the program as the Huskies were 8-21 overall, 3-17 in the NSIC. Four student-athletes earned Academic All-NSIC notice in 2016. The Huskies showed vast improvement at the service line, leaping to fifth in the NSIC with 1.52 aces per set. SCSU's serve receive was seventh in the conference, allowing just 123 aces. Nicole Miller led the Northern Sun with 76 aces - 24 more than the next-best serve specialist - and averaged just over half an ace per set. Freshman libero Clara Krenz opened her collegiate career with 4.30 digs per set, landing her seventh in the NSIC.

In his first season with the Huskies, Braegelmann posted a 9-19 overall record with a 5-15 NSIC mark in NSIC play. St. Cloud State's defense ranked fifth in the NSIC with 16.50 digs per set, led by All-NSIC libero Brianne Stamer's conference-leading 5.46 digs a set. Stamer was one of six Huskies on the Academic All-NSIC squad while Macy Weller ranked top-20 in the conference with 0.83 blocks per set.

Chad Braegelmann was named the fifth head coach in St. Cloud State Volleyball history on July 6, 2015.

Prior to his move to SCSU, Braegelmann was the head women's volleyball coach at the University of Minnesota-Morris where he also served as the Sports Studies and Athletics Discipline Coordinator and an Assistant Athletic Director. In seven seasons at Minnesota-Morris, Braegelmann posted a 130-91 record while earning UMAC Coach of the Year honors in 2010 and 2013. His team won a share of the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference title in 2013 before closing his Minnesota-Morris career with a 23-12 (12-2 UMAC) showing in 2014.

At Colby-Sawyer, Braegelmann departed as the all-time winningest coach in program history with a 156-80 record over seven seasons spanning from 2001-07. He guided the Chargers to Commonwealth Coast Conference Championships in 2003 and 2005 while twice advancing to the NCAA Division III National Tournament. Braegelmann led Colby-Sawyer to six conference championship match appearances with double-digit wins in all seven seasons, attaining the most single-season wins in school history in any sport. Volleyball athletes were successful off the court as well, earning the top team academic grade point average of Colby-Sawyer's athletic programs multiple times.

A graduate of the University of Minnesota-Morris, Braegelmann received his master's degree in education from Northern State University.

A native of Richmond, Minn. and graduate of nearby ROCORI H.S., Braegelmann and his wife Natalie have four sons.





# ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH MARCI TAUMALOLO

St. Cloud State associate head volleyball coach Marci Taumalolo enters her 13th season with Huskies Volleyball in 2022. At the conclusion of the 2019 season, Taumalolo was promoted from top assistant to associate head coach. Honored as part of the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Thirty Under 30 in February of 2011, Taumalolo has helped shape St. Cloud State Volleyball into a national power.

In 12 years with the program, Marci has recruited and coached six AVCA All-Americans, eight AVCA All-Region honorees, 13 All-NSIC selections, two NSIC Libero and Freshmen of the Year recipients, two AVCA Central Region Freshmen of the Year honorees and an AVCA DII National Freshman of the Year. 64 student-athletes have earned Academic All-NSIC honors under Taumalolo's watch.

The Huskies defense has developed into one of the top units in the NSIC during Taumalolo's time with SCSU, ranking top-six across the Northern Sun in digs per set in five of the past six seasons. St. Cloud State led the NSIC in both digs and digs/set in 2019, holding opponents to the fifth-lowest hitting percentage across

Throughout her career at St. Cloud State, liberos have flourished as Taumalolo has recruited and coached back-to-back record-setters. Of the top-10 single-season dia leaders in program history, seven performances have been overseen by Taumalolo. Four of the Huskies' top-six career dia leaders have played for Taumalolo: Clara Krenz (2016-19), Brianne Stamer (2012-15), Chelsea Nagle (2008-11) and Linsey Rachel (2018-22). Krenz established herself as one of the all-time St. Cloud State greats in her time with the program, racking up a Huskies-record 2227 digs and becoming the program's first-ever 2000 Dig Club member. She was named an All-American, a two-time NSIC Libero of the Year and garnered All-NSIC honors three times while leading the Northern Sun in digs per set during the 2017, 2018 and 2019 seasons. Stamer preceded Krenz as the program's all-time dig leader, posting 1929 digs in her illustrious career and earning All-NSIC honors during the 2015 campaign with a conference-leading 5.46 dias per set. Rachel paced all NSIC outside hitters in dias and dias per set during the 2021 campaign, developing into one of the best six-rotation players in the nation under Taumalolo's watch. Nagle provided the third-most single-season digs with 481 in Marci's first season with the Huskies, going on to finish third all-time in digs at the time of her graduation.

Taumalolo helped guide the Huskies to their first NSIC regular season title since 1982 and earning the program's first NSIC Tournament Championship in 2021. St. Cloud State went 27-5 with a 19-1 mark in NSIC play to finish alone atop the conference standings. The Huskies earned the No. 2 seed at the Central Regional in Warrensburg, Missouri, closed the season ranked No. 10 in the final AVCA top-25 poll and set new program standards for fewest losses and best single-season

winning percentage. Prior to her appointment at St. Cloud State in July of 2010, Taumalolo spent the previous three seasons (2007-09) as the assistant coach at Ball State. In her three seasons with the Cardinals, she helped lead the Ball State back court to top-five rankings in the final Mid-American Conference dig rankings each season. In 2007, the Cardinals finished fifth with 14.57 digs per set, while the back court improved two spots in 2008, ranking third with 15.43 digs per set.

Before her tenure with the Cardinals, Taumalolo was a four-year member of the University of Minnesota Golden Gophers women's volleyball team. She finished her career at Minnesota (2003-06) ranked second on the school's all-time career digs list at 1,401. After leading the Big Ten with a 5.22 digs per set her senior season, Taumalolo earned American Volleyball Coaches Association All-America Honorable Mention accolades, was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year and was a First-Team All-Big Ten honoree. She was also a four-time Scholar Athlete and garnered the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week accolades three times during her collegiate stint.

Prior to her collegiate career, Taumalolo was a two-time AAU All-American (2001 & 2002) for the Kaepa Northern Lights Club, while being named an All-American at the 2000 Junior National Championships (16-Open) and picking up the "Best Setter" award at the 2002 National Junior Championships.



During her prep career at Armstrong High School in Plymouth, Minnesota, Taumalolo was an All-American and All-State player as a junior and senior. During her senior campaign, she led her team to an undefeated (29-0) record, while collecting 31 kills and 28 dias in the team's state championship victory over Eagan High School, As a junior, she collected a school-record 53 kills in one match.

Taumalolo has earned a Master's Degree in Physical Education and Sports Administration (Ball State) along with a Bachelor's Degree in Business & Marketing (Minnesota, 2007). A native of Plymouth, Minn., Taumalolo is married with five children. She has nine siblings, including three older sisters and one younger sister who all played collegiate volleyball, along with five brothers.

Voss brings a wealth of knowledge to the St. Cloud State coaching staff and helped the Huskies take home the NSIC regular season and tournament titles in 2021. Prior to 2021, Voss served as a student-assistant at Gustavus Adolphus College, guiding the Gusties to their first Minnesota Intercollegiate Conference (MIAC) Tournament appearance since the late 2000s. He also served as head coach of Upsala High School from 2017 to 2020.

# GRAD. ASSISTANT COACH MORGAN PENNER

Morgan (Baufield) Penner joined the Huskies coaching staff in the spring of 2022.

Penner brings an impressive resume to her position at St. Cloud State, as she joined the Huskies roster in 2021 after an impressive playing career at Northern State. A 5'10 middle blocker from Wayzata, Minnesota, Penner earned Second Team All-Conference honors from the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) after tallying 195 kills in 31 matches for the Wolves. In her three years at Northern State, Penner appeared in 92 matches with 577 kills, 257 blocks and 141 digs before joining St. Cloud State in 2021. In her single season with the Huskies, Penner appeared in 11 matches and recorded 18 kills and 12.0 blocks.
