OPENING SHOTS

No. 1 St. Cloud State Wrestling begins their appearance at the Chadron State Duals with a bout against No. 16 Western Colorado. The Huskies are 3-1-1 all-time versus the Mountaineers in a series that began in 1965-66. SCSU defeated Western 33-16 in 2019-20 at home in their last meeting behind four bonus-point wins.

SIZING UP THE MOUNTAINEERS

No. 16 Western Colorado enters the Chadron State Duals 1-1 with a 27-9 win over then-No. 10 Colorado Mesa and a 29-18 loss to Air Force. The Mountaineers are led by four NWCA-ranked wrestlers with a particularly-strong middle weight group - No. 4 Hunter Mullin competes at 165, No. 5 Jason Hanenberg is a staple at 149 with No. 9 Cole Hernandez at 174 and No. 12 Patrick Allis at 125. Mullin and Allis have each earned All-American honors in their careers while Hanenberg is a two-time NCAA qualifier. Head coach Charlie Pipher is fresh off earning his 50th collegiate win in Western's dual with Colorado Mesa.

NOT MUCH HISTORY

Very few Huskies have collegiate matches against WCU wrestlers under their belts. No. 2 Joey Bianchini lost by fall to Jason Hanenberg in 2019 at 141 pounds - one of just three losses that the redshirt senior has taken in 64 collegiate bouts. Both wrestlers are listed at 149 pounds entering the duals.

OPENING SHOTS

Dual two for No. 1 St. Cloud State matches the Huskies up with host (RV) Chadron State. The Huskies are 3-0 all-time against the Eagles with a 36-9 win in the 2018-19 home opener marking their last meeting. Five bonus-point wins, including a pin by current SCSU graduate assistant Jake Barzowski, set the tone in a Huskies romp at Halenbeck Hall.

SIZING UP THE EAGLES

Chadron State is 2-1 entering the duals with wins over NJCAA programs Northwest and Northeastern alongside a 24-13 road loss to then-No. 1 Nebraska-Kearney. 125-pounder Quade Smith and 133-pounder Quentrevion Campbell are each ranked No. 8 at their classes by the NWCA.

REMEMBER WHEN?

Huskies fans will remember Chadron State playing a key role in four-time All-American James Pleski's (20') legacy at SCSU. Pleski took his lone regular season loss of 2017-18 to Chadron 149-pounder Chase Clasen in a tight 2-1 decision, then proceeded to go 25-1 over the course of the season before meeting Clasen again in the opening round of the 2018 NCAA Championships. The Huskies' star put away Clasen 3-1 in SV-1 before going on to take fourth at the NCAA's.

OPENING SHOTS

The final dual in Chadron for the No. 1 Huskies pits them against San Francisco State, who enters the duals 2-2 with wins over New Mexico Highlands and (RV) Fort Hays State alongside losses to then-No. 10 Colorado Mesa and (RV) Colorado Mines. SCSU is 1-1 all-time against San Francisco State, last meeting the Gators at the 2017 NWCA National Duals. The Huskies dropped SFSU 37-11 in the dual with pins recorded by Austin Goergen, Brett Velasquez, Mike Rhone and Travis Holt alongside a major decision courtesy of Clayton Jennissen.

SIZING UP THE GATORS

San Francisco State has struggled with injuries at a few weights in the early stages of 2022-23, forfeiting at 125 their first two duals. 133-pounder Tony Margiotta leads the travel roster with nine wins while heavyweight Emilio Franco-Sandoval is 8-3 with three dual wins. Only three members of the travel roster are seniors as the Gators feature a relatively young team.

MIDWEST TIES

Sixth-year San Francisco State head coach Jason Welch is well-known to wrestling fans of the midwest, having enjoyed a three-time All-American career at Northwestern. As a senior in 2013, Welch finished as the National Runner-Up at 157 pounds and won a Big Ten Championship. Gators assistant coach Anthony Mancini is no stranger to the state of Nebraska - he was the Super Region starter at 184 pounds for Nebraska-Kearney in 2019-20 before serving as a volunteer assistant with the Lopers.

QUOTING COSTANZO

"It's always a different atmosphere of competition at duals versus an open tournament. We'll see what we have - it takes a team effort in these duals to come out on top. We've got three pretty solid teams that we're dualing. We're excited, but we have some work to do once we get there."

"I'm looking forward to seeing all of our weights compete. We've got some guys that we're moving around a little bit and experimenting with. We certainly have some weights that are up for grabs, in my opinion, so we're looking for someone to go out there and take the reigns of those classes. We're looking for people we can depend on the rest of the year."

"It's similar to a tournament with the three duals on one day - you're going to have a match, then sit there for a while before the next one. Our guys certainly need to be engaged in the process and help each other out. It is a team event, and we're trying to win the team dual. We're going to have to go out and wrestle each match individually one at a time, and regardless of the outcome get ready for the next one."

"With the long travel time, we focus on keeping the guys hydrated, keeping them comfortable and making sure they get enough rest. The nice thing about being on the road is the ability to monitor our rest a bit more. It's a nice opportunity to bring our guys closer together, a lot of times these long road trips help out with that."

"We have to try and get some momentum, especially starting out at 125. You want to get started off on the right note - regardless of a win or a loss, we want our guys going out those first few matches competing hard and wrestling for seven minutes."

UNANIMOUS TOP DOG

St. Cloud State enters dual season as the unanimous No. 1 team in the nation per the 2022-23 polls, ranked No. 1 by the NWCA and No. 1 in both Dual and Tournament rankings per The Open Mat. A total of eight Huskies are ranked headed into the weekend with six recognized by the NWCA. Abner Romero is unanimously No. 1 at 174, joined in the consensus ranks by No. 2 Joey Bianchini at 141 and No. 10 Anthony Herrera at 165. 157-pounder Colby Njos is No. 2 according to The Open Mat and No. 4 per the NWCA, while 149-pounder Nick Novak slots in at No. 5 and No. 4 respectively. Paxton Creese is the No. 6 125-pounder in the country by the NWCA and No. 9 by The Open Mat with 197-pounder Dominic Murphy appearing at No. 5 and No. 10. Both Caleb Meekins (133) and Elijah Novak (HWT) are found only among The Open Mat's rankings, sliding in at No. 5 and No. 17 at their respective classes.

MOVING UP

Following a strong debut season that saw him become a mainstay in the individual rankings at 174, redshirt junior and Huskies captain Dominic Murphy takes the climb to 197 this fall. Murphy went 23-6 with an 11-3 mark in duals last year, earning fourth at the Super Region. Thus far, Dom has impressed at his new weight - going 9-1 with a decision over then-No. 4 Matt Kaylor of Mary and a lone loss to now-No. 4 Tereus Henry of Fort Hays State.

HAPPY HOMECOMING

The Chadron State Duals will serve as a homecoming of sorts for redshirt senior 149-pounder Cameron Riggs - a Nebraska product who hails from North Platte, just over three hours south of Chadron. Riggs was a record-setting 204-0 four-time Nebraska State champion at Maxwell High School before joining the Huskies. He has gone 35-10 with SCSU, earning the Jim and Dave Hazewinkel Tough Man of the Year award last season.

LAST TIME OUT

Then-No. 2 St. Cloud State earned titles at six of 10 weight classes and placed 16 Huskies total at the Dakota Wesleyan Open on November 12 in Mitchell. No. 8 Anthony Herrera enjoyed a dominant Open on his way to the title at 165, going 5-0 with a pin, a tech fall and one major decision while outscoring his opponents 49-9. No. 5 Paxton Creese added a title at 125 while going 5-0 with three bonus-point wins (1 PF, 1 TF, 1 MD).

141-pounder Alyeus Craig continued a strong start to his season with his second-straight open title, winning all five matches with a pin and a major. The redshirt freshman shut out each of his final two opponents in the Semis and Finals. No. 8 Nick Novak was 6-0 with a pin and a major decision of his own to earn the title at 149, outscoring his final four foes 21-1 with three shutouts. 157-pounder Jimmy Pierandozzi impressed at 157 with a tech and a fall, going 5-0 to earn a title with a decision over Augustana's Miles Fitzgerald – an NSIC foe who entered the year ranked at 165 pounds. Bryce Dagel rounded out the Huskies' champs with a 4-0 effort in his first bouts at 174, earning three decisions over NSIC rivals and one over a Nebraska-Kearney wrestler.

Caleb Meekins also earned a Finals berth at 133, taking second after going 3-1 with a pin and a major. A whopping five Huskies won their third-place matches: Sam Spencer (5-1, 2 MD, PF) at 133, Cameron Riggs (6-1, TF) at 149, Shaeden Scheidt (5-1, 2 MD, 2 PF) at 184, Dominic Murphy (5-1, MD, TF, PF) at 197 and Jadon Mims (6-1) at heavyweight. Nolan Throne (5-2, MD, 2 TF, PF) took fourth at 149 while 125-pounder Ashton Clark (4-2), 157-pounder Blake Legred (4-2, MD) and heavyweight Elijah Novak (5-2, 2 PF) placed fifth at their weights.

St. Cloud State tied for the most tech falls at the Open with nine and posted the best winning percentage of any team at 73.2% – standing as the lone team to win more than 70% of their matches. SCSU also scored the second-most pins with 22 total falls. Creese, Herrera, Pierandozzi and Scheidt were part of a five-way tie for the highest-scoring wrestler at the Open with 20.5 team points each.

ALYEUS ANSWERS

Redshirt freshman Alyeus Craig has responded well in his debut season at 141 pounds, opening his season 8-0 with titles at the Yellowjacket and Dakota Wesleyan Open. Craig is one of four unbeaten attached wrestlers on the Huskies' roster and has provided three bonus point wins.

NOW THAT'S A DEBUT

Redshirt junior 133-pounder Caleb Meekins was named NSIC Wrestler of the Week after his debut weekend with the Huskies, marking back-to-back seasons in which a Husky earned weekly honors after his first week of competition. Meekins went 3-0 at the Yellowjacket Open to earn the title at 133 pounds, earning bonus points in each of his three matches with a pin of No. 1 Reece Barnhardt (Mary) in the Finals.

"I was really proud of his performance," said head coach Steve Costanzo, "He had a pin, a tech fall and a major in there as well. Bonus points in all three matches, then you wrestle the No. 1 guy in the country and come out on top in that fashion is pretty impressive."

Meekins joined SCSU this fall after a redshirt season at Northern Illinois and two All-American campaigns at Indian Hills College. The Livonia, Michigan product earned ICCAC and NJCAA North Central District Championships at Indian Hills while placing fourth and third at the 2021 and 2022 NJCAA Championships.

ONE LAST RIDE, HUSKIES STYLE

2021 NCAA DII 174-pound Champion Abner Romero will wrestle his final collegiate season with St. Cloud State, transferring in after three seasons at Lindenwood. Romero enters 2022-23 as the No. 1 ranked wrestler at 174 per the NWCA and has gone 59-2 attached over his career.

LEADING THE WAY

St. Cloud State has named six captains in advance of the 2022-23 season: redshirt seniors Joey Bianchini, Anthony Herrera and Abner Romero; senior Robby Horsman along with redshirt juniors Dominic Murphy and Phillip Kue.

Steve Costanzo will begin his 17th season leading St. Cloud State Wrestling in 2022-23. A three-time NCAA DII National Coach of the Year, Costanzo has molded Huskies Wrestling into a dynasty with five DII National Championships since 2015.

Named the 13th head coach in the history of SCSU Wrestling on May 18, 2006, Costanzo is 243-29 (.893) with a 100-10 (.900) conference record at St. Cloud State. He has led the Huskies to 11 consecutive Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Championships dating back to 2012 along with nine Super Region Championships, winning six NWCA DII National Duals along the way.

While at St. Cloud State, Costanzo has coached 118 NCAA qualifiers, 83 NCAA All-Americans, 20 NCAA Finalists and seven NCAA Champions. 97 Huskies have earned All-NSIC honors with Costanzo matside. The eight-time NSIC Coach of the Year and three-time Super Region Coach of the Year has coached seven NSIC Wrestlers of the Year, six NSIC Rookies of the Year, a NWCA National Wrestler of the Year and a NWCA National Rookie of the Year.

2022-23 also marks Costanzo's 24th season overall as a collegiate head coach, carrying a record of 304-59-2 (.833) while coaching 183 National Qualifiers, 106 All-Americans, eight National Champions and 137 NWCA All-Academic recipients. He is a six-time National Champion as his Huskies earned the NCAA Division II National Championship in 2015, 2016, 2018, 2019 and 2021. Costanzo punctuated his Dana College Hall of Fame coaching career by leading his team to the NAIA National title in 2006.

A primary building block of Costanzo's program has been developing success in the classroom. The Huskies have landed among the Top-20 wrestling programs nationally in team GPA in 12 of the past 16 seasons, finishing as high as second in 2010 (3.35) and consistently delivering GPA marks above 3.00. At St. Cloud State alone, a whopping 137 wrestlers have earned NWCA All-Academic notice, 84 have been named to the conference All-Academic team and seven have earned CoSIDA Academic All-American honors during Costanzo's time leading the program.

Last season the Huskies continued to rewrite collegiate wrestling history by setting a new all-time All-Division NCAA dual win streak, winning their 77th consecutive dual with a 19-14 final over Nebraska-Kearney at the National Duals. St. Cloud State finished the regular season 14-1 with a 7-0 NSIC record, earning their 11th-straight NSIC Championship before winning their sixth consecutive Super Region Championship. Seven wrestlers advanced to the NCAA Tournament with five earning All-American honors as the Huskies took fourth at the Championships, clinching their 10th top-four National finish in the past 11 tournaments.

2020-21 presented an unprecedented challenge for St. Cloud State as the pandemic significantly altered the structure of the season. Costanzo guided the Huskies to a 5-0 season wrestling solely NSIC competition, earning a share of the conference championship for the tenth-straight season. Eight members of the Super Region V Championship team advanced to the NCAA Tournament, setting the stage for one of the most thrilling title clinchers in recent memory. NWCA DII National Wrestler of the Year Kameron Teacher won the 2021 Heavyweight Championship in the final bout of the tournament to secure St. Cloud State's third-straight National Title, becoming one of seven Huskies All-Americans.



Garrett Aldrich, Joey Bianchini and Garrett Vos each were Finalists for the Huskies while Colby Njos and Devin FitzPatrick took third.

In 2019-20, the Huskies were poised to capture another NCAA title before the championships were cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. SCSU ended the year 16-0, 8-0 in NSIC competition. The Huskies captured their ninth consecutive NSIC title, their fourth consecutive NWCA DII National Duals title and gained another NCAA DII Regional Championship. A total of seven Huskies won NCAA DII regional



championships and SCSU qualified nine wrestlers for the 2020 NCAA DII championships under the direction of Costanzo. For his work, Costanzo was recognized as the NWCA DII National Coach of the Year, NCAA DII Super 5 Regional Coach of the Year and the NSIC Coach of the Year in 2019-20.

In 2018-19, SCSU won its fourth NCAA DII championship while posting a perfect 20-0, 8-0 NSIC record. The Huskies won their eighth consecutive NSIC title another NCAA DII Super Regional title and the 2019 NWCA DII National Duals crown. SCSU sent nine wrestlers to the NCAA championships and brought home seven All-America awards, including a runner-up finish for Vince Dietz at 197-pounds.

In 2017-18, SCSU won its third NCAA Division II championship while charting a perfect 19-0, 8-0 NSIC dual record. The Huskies won the 2018 NCAA DII Super 3 Regional along with the 2018 NSIC Championship and the 2018 NWCA DII National Duals crown. St. Cloud State sent 10 wrestlers to the NCAA DII championships and saw six bring back All-America honors including runner-up places by Vince Dietz (197), Larry Bomstad (157) and James Pleski (149).

In 2016-17, SCSU won its sixth consecutive NSIC championship while posting a 17-1, 8-0 NSIC record. The Huskies won top honors at the 2017 NCAA Division II Super 3 Regional and claimed the title at the 2017 NWCA Division II National Duals. The Huskies sent nine wrestlers to the NCAA DII championships and four of those athletes against All-America honors in 2017. Costanzo earned NSIC Coach of the Year status in 2016-17 and Austin Goergen received the NCAA Most Dominant Wrestler award at the NCAA championships and James Pleski was the NSIC Rookie of the Year in 2017.

Costanzo was named the NWCA Division II Coach of the Year after leading the Huskies to their second NCAA Division II national title in 2016. The Huskies posted 90 points to win the title, while Notre Dame (OH) was second with 82.0 points. SCSU was paced at the tournament by Brett Velasquez, who won the title at 125-pounds. All six of SCSU's national qualifiers gained All-America status in 2016, including Austin Goergen (3rd at 285), Clint Poster (3rd at 165), Matt Nelson (5th at 141), Jay Hildreth (4th at 149), Clayton Jennissen (7th at 174) and Uthman Rabiu (8th at 184).

SCSU placed second at the 2016 NCAA DII Super 3 Regional and won its fifth consecutive NSIC championship. Costanzo was named the NSIC Coach of the Year, while Clint Poster was the NSIC Wrestler of the Year and Brett Velasquez was the NSIC Rookie of the Y

St. Cloud State University captured its first-ever NCAA Division II wrestling championship in 2015. This marked the first time in school history that a team from St. Cloud State has won a national title in any sport. SCSU won the team title with 84.5 points, while Nebraska Kearney placed second at 75.5 points in the tournament that was held in St. Louis, Mo.

SCSU was led at the NCAA championships by Tim Prescott, who won a national title at 125-pounds. All six of SCSU's national qualifiers gained All-America status in 2015, including Austin Goergen with a second-place finish at 285-pounds and third place finishes by Clint Poster [157] and Gabe Fogarty [165].

The Huskies placed second at the 2015 NCAA Division II Super Regional, won their fourth consecutive NSIC championship in 2014-15 and placed third at the 2015 NWCA DII National Duals. Costanzo gained NSIC Coach of the Year accolades in 2014-15.

In 2013-14, the Huskies won their third consecutive NSIC championship and placed sixth at the NCAA DII championships. SCSU also placed third at the 2014 NWCA DII National Duals and third at the 2014 NCAA Division II Super 3 Regional. The Huskies capped the year by setting a new NCAA Division II record by posting 54 consecutive wins. The streak ended in 2013-14 wth a 23-16 loss to national champion Notre Dame (Ohio).

In 2012-13, the Huskies completed their second consecutive perfect season at 21-0. SCSU captured first place in the NSIC and won top honors at the 2013 NWCA Division II National Duals. To cap the year, SCSU won its third consecutive NCAA DII Super Region 3 title and placed as the runner-up at the 2013 NCAA DII championships for the third consecutive season.

At the NCAA championships in 2013, Husky Shamus O'Grady won the championship at 184-pounds and was named the Outstanding Wrestler at the NCAA championships. Costanzo was named the NSIC Coach of the Year and the Huskies also set a new team record by posting 105.0 points at the NCAA championships.

In 2011-12, the Huskies scored a perfect 21-0 dual record and captured top honors in the NSIC at 7-0. St. Cloud State brought home a first-place finish at the NWCA Division II National Duals in 2012 and won the 2012 NCAA Division II Super Region 3 team title.

For the second consecutive season in 2012, SCSU finished as the runner-up at the NCAA Division II championships. SCSU's Derek Skala won an individual title for the Huskies at 184-pounds and Husky Tad Merritt received the 2012 NCAA Division II Most Dominant Wrestler and Most Falls award at the NCAA championships. Costanzo gained both Regional and NSIC Coach of the Year honors in 2011 and 2012.

In 2010-11, SCSU placed second in the nation at the 2011 NCAA Division II championships, won the 2011 NCAA Division II Super Region #3 title and set a team record with a 19-2 dual meet record in 2010-11. Coach Costanzo was named the 2011 NCAA Division II Coach of the Year and senior wrestler John Sundgren won a national title at 157-pounds for the Huskies.

The runner-up national finish was the highest national tournament finish for the Huskies in team history, and the Huskies also posted a solid third place finish at the elite NWCA National Duals in 2011.

In 2009-10, SCSU posted a 14-7 overall record and placed 7th in the nation at the NCAA Division II championships. At the 2010 NCAA Super Regional, the Huskies placed 2nd and SCSU also placed third in the NSIC race at 5-2 in 2009-10. SCSU advanced eight grapplers to the NCAA finals in 2010, and they also saw four of those athletes earn All-American status in 2010. This marked SCSU's best national finish since 1983.

In 2008-09, Costanzo's Huskies finished their campaign with an 8-5 (5-2 NSIC) mark. The Huskies also advanced eight wrestlers to the NCAA Division II Championships and saw three of earn All-American status. At the 2009 NCAA Division II Championships, SCSU placed 8th as a team.

Prior to joining St. Cloud State, Costanzo spent seven seasons leading NAIA program Dana College. In 2006, Costanzo led Dana College to the NAIA National Championship – setting a new Tournament record with 193.0 team points – and a NWCA National Duals Championship. His squads while at Dana College won Great Plains Athletic Conference titles in 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006. In addition, his teams claimed Regional Championships in 2001, 2002, 2005 and 2006. The Vikings finished with top 10 finishes at the NAIA National Championships in 2004, 2005 and 2006.

In 2003, Costanzo was credited with the NAIA Robert Bubb Coaching Excellence Award which epitomizes the qualities and characteristics of a role model and mentor for developing young student-athletes. In 2005, he served as the NWCA All-Star team coach at Oklahoma State University. Costanzo received the NWCA and NAIA Coach of the Year honors in 2006 and gained NAIA Regional Coach of the Year accolades in 2005 and 2006.

Costanzo was a three-time NCAA Division II All-American and two-time North Central Conference champion for the University of Nebraska-Omaha. He placed seventh in 1993, third in 1994 and third in 1995 at the NCAA Championships. Costanzo was named native Nebraskan Collegiate Wrestler of the Year in 1994. He ranked as high as seventh on UNO's all-time win list with 133 career victories as a collegiate wrestler.

For his wrestling accomplishments as a student-athlete, Costanzo was inducted into the 2006 NSWCA - Nebraska Scholastic Wrestling Coaches Association Hall of Fame. In 2019-20, Costanzo was inducted into the Dana College Hall of Fame.

A native of Bennington, Nebraska, Costanzo has a bachelor's degree in Physical Education from the University of Nebraska at Omaha and a master's degree in Health, Physical Education, and Recreation from Emporia State University. He and his wife Nancy have five children – Cassandra, Sam, Katie, Brock and Lacey.

Brady Wilson enters his 12th season as the lead assistant for St. Cloud State Wrestling in 2022-23, his third campaign under the title of associate head coach.

A fixture both matside and in the wrestling room, the Huskies have gone 185-6 (.969) including a perfect 83-0 in NSIC duals since Wilson joined the staff in 2011-12. St. Cloud State has earned five NCAA Championships, six NWCA National Dual Championships, Championships, eight Super Region Championships and 11 NSIC Championships with Wilson serving as top assistant.

The former four-time All-American heavyweight has earned a strong reputation for developing upper weight stars at St. Cloud State. Wilson's heavyweight has qualified for the NCAA Tournament in 10 of his 11 seasons on staff headlined by four-time All-American Austin Goergen, two-time All-American and 2021 NCAA Champion Kameron Teacher and two-time All-American Jake Kahnke. Five straight 197-pounders have earned All-American status with Vince Dietz twice finishing runner-up and Noah Ryan earning three consecutive All-American honors. At 184, eight of Wilson's 11 seasons have sent a representative to the NCAA Tournament including National Champions Derek Skala (2012) and Shamus O'Grady (2013).

Since Wilson was appointed to the coaching staff, 67 of the Huskies' 86 NCAA Qualifiers (77.9%) have earned All-American status. 78 Huskies have earned All-NSIC recognition with six conference Wrestlers of the Year and five conference Rookies of the Year.



Wilson has been a key factor in St. Cloud State's success off the mat, as 107 wrestlers have earned NWCA All-Academic status along with 68 Academic All-NSIC honorees and seven CoSIDA Academic All-American nods.

A 2009 graduate of Minnesota State University, Wilson served as a graduate assistant coach at his alma mater in 2010-11 and he received a graduate degree in sports management from Minnesota State University in 2011. He helped lead the MSU Mavericks to a top-10 finish at the NCAA Championships, coaching three All-Americans and six national qualifiers.

Wilson brings a wealth of collegiate wrestling experience to the St. Cloud State wrestling room. At Minnesota State, Wilson was a four-time All-American, a four-time conference champion and a four-time NCAA regional champion during his collegiate wrestling career. At the NCAA Division II championships, Wilson earned top five NCAA finishes at heavyweight in all four seasons of his career, including a runner-up finish in 2010.

He set a record at Minnesota State with 143 wins during his career and he was named both MSU Athlete and Student-Athlete of the Year in 2010.

A 2005 graduate of Faribault High School in Faribault, Minn., Wilson was a 2005 MSHSL State Champion while posting a 109-30 career record as a prep athlete. At Faribault High School, Wilson also gained NHSCA, Greco Juniors and Fila Freestyle All-America accolades.



GRADUATE ASSISTANT COACH JAKE BARZOWSKI



Two-time All-American Jake Barzowski begins his first season as a member of the St. Cloud State coaching staff in 2022-23.

Barzowski carved out a stellar career for the Huskies from 2016 to 2022, finishing with exactly 100 collegiate wins while wrestling at 149 and 157. The Park Ridge, Illinois native earned All-American honors with a third-place finish at 157 in 2019 and landed the No. 2 seed at 157 ahead of the 2020 NCAA Championships. He was twice a Super Region V finalist – winning the title in 2020 – and garnered NWCA All-Academic honors in 2019.

A two-year captain for St. Cloud State, Barzowski held a strong reputation as a leader in the wrestling room. He was a member of three NCAA Championship teams and helped SCSU earn the NSIC Championship in each of his six seasons.

Barzowski attended Notre Dame College Prep and was a two-time state qualifier under head coach Augie Genovise.
