BLIZZARD'S BULLETS

ENTERING THE WEEKEND: No. 8 St. Cloud State Volleyball continues their nonconference schedule with four matches this weekend at the Hyatt Place Bash at the Beach. The Huskies play a pair of matches on both Friday and Saturday – September 2 and 3 – beginning with Barton at 1:00 p.m. CT followed by a tilt with host Palm Beach Atlantic at 6:00 p.m. CT. An early morning 8:00 a.m. CT match against Lynn opens Saturday's competition before the Huskies wrap up the Bash with New Haven at 3:30 p.m. CT.

LET'S GO POLLING: St. Cloud State moved up one spot to No. 8 in the AVCA Top-25 poll on Monday following a 4-0 start to their season at the SCSU/CSP Invite. This week's rank marks the eighth time SCSU has appeared in the top-10 of an AVCA poll in the Braegelmann era.

LAST TIME OUT: The Huskies' punctuated a perfect start to the season with a four-set win over RV Ashland on Saturday evening at Halenbeck Hall. Phebie Rossi was phenomenal as both an attacker and a blocker, putting down 18 kills on .340 hitting while adding eight blocks. Linsey Rachel settled in after a quiet first, delivering her second double-double of the season with 13 kills and 20 digs. Kenzie Foley likewise double-doubled for the second time in 2022 - adding 14 kills and 18 digs - and dominated the service line with a career-high five aces. SCSU limited Ashland to 46 kills and a .145 hitting percentage on the night, forcing them into 22 errors.

LEADING THE PACK: Through the first weekend of the 2022 season, Huskies can be found all over the NSIC leaderboards. Kenzie Foley leads the conference in points per set (5.88), ranks second in kills per set (4.69), is fourth in aces per set (0.77) and lands 18th in hitting percentage (.295). Phebie Rossi is the NSIC block per set leader (1.46) while ranking eighth in points per set (3.92) and 12th in kills per set (3.00). Keely Kurschner leads the league in digs per set (5.31) and is second in digs (69). Emma Berran lands fourth in assists per set (11.46) while Linsey Rachel is top-20 in digs/set (3.77, 10th) and kills/set (2.85, 16th). Sam Zimmerman rounds out the leaderboard at 11th in hitting percentage with a .346 mark.

CAN'T STOP KENZIE: Junior outside Kenzie Foley enters the weekend third in the country with 5.88 points per set while ranking seventh in kills a set with 4.69. She posted two double-doubles in the SCSU/CSP Invite and is hitting .295 with a team-leading 76.5 points.

BERRAN GOES TO NEW HEIGHTS: True freshman setter Emma Berran directed the Huskies offense brilliantly in her debut weekend. With 35 assists on Opening Night, Berran posted the most in a Huskies debut since Marissa Kline had 36 back in 2013. The Eagan product closed out the week with a career-high 51 assists against Ashland.

BLIZZARD'S BULLETS (CONTINUED)

- SCOUTING BARTON: Barton opened their 2022 season by going 1-2 at the USC-Aiken Invitational in South Carolina, sweeping Paine while dropping straight sets to the host and Lenoir-Rhyne. A year ago the Bulldogs were 9-15 and 6-11 in Conference Carolinas play, falling in five to Belmont Abbey in the conference tournament. All-CC outside hitter Allison Gambill averaged 4.15 kills/set in 2021 and has opened her senior campaign with 21 kills and a double-double through three matches.
- SCOUTING PALM BEACH ATLANTIC: Host Palm Beach Atlantic received votes in the latest AVCA Top-25 poll after winning three of four matches at the Tony Banner Invitational in Clarion, Pennsylvania. The Sailfish were 18-14 and 11-8 in Sunshine State Conference play in 2021, graduating all but two starters entering this fall. Freshman outside Abbie Zylstra has supplied most of the offense, putting down 3.15 kills a set on .205 hitting. Kaileigh Ammons (.452) and Anna Gregerson (.314) have been efficient as the MH pairing while Eastern Michigan transfer Jayden Otto is directing the offense to the tune of 9.38 assists/set.
- SCOUTING LYNN: Lynn is off to a 3-0 start in 2022, taking nine of 10 sets at the FSC Volleyball Classic last weekend. The Fighting Knights chartered a 19-12 record last season, going 14-6 in Sunshine State Conference action. Outside hitter Nadia Linder earned Honorable Mention AVCA All-American honors last season with 3.54 kills a set and has opened her senior campaign with 35 in 10 sets. Middle blocker Monica Mazzoleni is hitting .382 with 2.90 kills and 0.70 blocks per set this fall. Lynn's defense has held offenses to hit .095, featuring an impressive 2.10 blocks/set.
- SCOUTING NEW HAVEN: Picked to finish second in the Northeast-10 in the preseason coaches' poll, New Haven went 2-2 in their season-opening trip to New York. The Chargers earned a trip to the NCAA Tournament last season while going 22-10 with a 10-3 conference mark. First Team All-Northeast 10 outside Macy Brown has been dominant, posting 3.69 kills a set on .244 hitting with three double-doubles. Fellow outside Avery Moore has added 2.73 kills a set while middle Kylie Reynolds-Martin is hitting .322 to open the year.

- ❖ **RACHEL'S RECORD WATCH:** Graduate student outside hitter Linsey Rachel begins play this weekend ranked fifth on the Huskies all-time kills list with 1288 and sixth in digs with 1247. She is just five kills away from moving into fourth and needs 35 to move into third, which would pass Lisette Hayden (93') and Kim Pellmann (99') respectively. Rachel is the program's only two-time All-American honoree and is within striking distance of becoming the Huskies' first member of the 1500x1500 club (kills and digs).

- ❖ **DEFENSIVE STANDOUTS:** Senior middle blocker Phebie Rossi ranks No. 15 in the country with 1.46 blocks a set while sophomore libero Keely Kurschner is 20th in digs/set with 5.31.
- ❖ **CAN YOU DIG IT?:** The Huskies are first in the NSIC and 15th nationally with 17.92 digs per set. Keely Kurschner leads the conference and is No. 20 in DII with 5.31 a set while Linsey Rachel is 10th in the league with 3.77.
- ❖ **BIG SWINGS:** St. Cloud State ranks 11th in the NCAA with 14.23 kills per set. The Huskies are fourth in kills/set and hitting percentage across the Northern Sun.
- ❖ **SERVE-AND-PASS SUCCESS:** SCSU has excelled in the serve-and-pass game this season, allowing the fewest aces (7) and aces per set (0.54) in the NSIC while posting the third-most aces per set of their own (2.15) Linsey Rachel and Kenzie Foley have combined for a perfect serve receive, going 133-for-133 with zero reception errors. This continues a theme of success for the program: last season, St. Cloud State allowed the second-fewest aces in the NSIC.
- ❖ **HERE COMES KENZIE:** 2021 served as collegiate volleyball's introduction to star Huskies outside hitter Kenzie Foley, who was named AVCA DII National Freshman of the Year as she finished fourth in the NSIC with 3.92 kills per set and hit .295, leading SCSU in kills with a first-year record 451. Foley earned AVCA First Team All-American honors along with Central Region and NSIC Freshman of the Year accolades, posting 19 double-doubles and putting down 20+ kills in eight matches. She picked up NSIC Offensive Player of the Week laurels twice while forming a formidable duo with Linsey Rachel on the outside.
- ❖ **RESPECT ROSSI:** All-American middle blocker Phebie Rossi anchored one of the best blocks in the country by leading the NSIC – and finishing sixth across all of DII – in blocks (160) while ranking fifth in hitting percentage at a .340 mark last season. She also led the NSIC in blocks per set (1.38) and was the only student-athlete to earn both NSIC Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week honors throughout the season.
- ❖ **ANCHORING THE OPPOSITE:** Versatile right side Rachel Houle rounds out the Huskies' experienced core, having appeared in every single match dating back to 2019. Houle has played in 93 of 94 possible matches throughout her career, routinely ranking among the conference leader in aces while occupying a critical role in one of the league's top defenses.
- ❖ **HOME SWEET HALENBECK:** St. Cloud State has gone 27-3 at Halenbeck Hall since 2019 and has won 30 of their last 34 home matches dating back to the end of 2018.
- ❖ **NO LONGER THE UNDERDOG:** The Huskies are a combined 29-9 against AVCA Top-25 opponents and opponents receiving votes in the AVCA poll since 2019. Last season St. Cloud State was 8-3 against Top-25 foes including three NSIC Tournament wins over ranked opponents.
- ❖ **A SEASON TO REMEMBER:** SCSU earned their first NSIC regular season title since 1982 and won the program's first NSIC Tournament Championship last season, going 27-5 with a 19-1 mark in NSIC play to finish alone atop the conference standings. The Huskies earned the No. 2 seed at the Central Regional in Warrensburg, Missouri, closed the season ranked No. 10 in the final AVCA top-25 poll and set new program standards for fewest losses and best single-season winning percentage.

Chad Braegelmann enters his eighth season as head coach of the St. Cloud State University volleyball program and 22nd season overall in 2022. A two-time NSIC Coach of the Year honoree, Braegelmann has built Huskies Volleyball into a national power. Under his guidance SCSU has earned both a NSIC Tournament and Regular Season Championship, two NCAA Central Region Tournament appearances, two NSIC Tournament berths and multiple AVCA Top-25 rankings. He enters the 2022 season with a 386-248 collegiate head coaching record, 11 20-win seasons, six Conference Coach of the Year honors and has led his teams to five conference championships.

Since 2019, the Huskies are a combined 25-9 against AVCA Top-25 opponents and opponents receiving votes in the AVCA poll. In that same span, SCSU is 23-3 at Halenbeck Hall.

Throughout his 22-year collegiate coaching career, Braegelmann has coached six American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) All-Americans, 10 All-Region players, seven conference Freshmen of the Year, three conference Players of the Year, six Libero/Defensive Players of the Year and 58 All-Conference athletes.

Braegelmann repeated as the NSIC Coach of the Year last season, leading the Huskies to their first NSIC regular season title since 1982 and earning the program's first NSIC Tournament Championship. St. Cloud State went 27-5 with a 19-1 mark in NSIC play to finish alone atop the conference standings. The Huskies earned the No. 2 seed at the Central Regional in Warrensburg, Missouri, closed the season ranked No. 10 in the final AVCA top-25 poll and set new program standards for fewest losses and best single-season winning percentage. Braegelmann's offense was one of the most terminal units in the Nation, ranking seventh in hitting percentage (.270), 10th in assists (1576), 13th in kills (1682), 15th in assists per set (13.0) and 17th in kills per set (13.9). The Huskies' fearsome block ranked seventh in total blocks (305.0) and ninth in blocks per set (2.5) at the conclusion of the season.

Multiple AVCA Top-25 teams fell at the hands of St. Cloud State throughout 2021 as the Huskies were 8-3 against ranked opponents. SCSU dispatched the No. 5 (2x), 8, 9, 14, 15 (2x) and 16 teams in the country over the course of their historic season, including three ranked wins in their NSIC Tournament Championship run. The Huskies swept No. 16 SMSU in the Quarterfinal, took down No. 15 Wayne State in a five-set Semifinal thriller then defeated No. 8 Winona State in four sets to earn the conference crown.

Several student-athletes received recognition during 2021 headlined by Kenzie Foley, who was named the AVCA Division II National Freshman of the Year, AVCA Central Region Freshman of the Year and NSIC Freshman of the Year while earning First Team All-America, All-Region and All-Conference recognition after a breakout season with St. Cloud State. Maddy Torve graduated as one of the most successful setters in program history, earning First Team All-America (AVCA, D2CCA), All-Region (AVCA, D2CCA), All-NSIC, Academic All-District (CoSIDA) and Academic All-America (CoSIDA) honors while being named the NSIC Outstanding Senior of the Year. Linsey Rachel became the program's first two-time All-American, adding AVCA All-America Honorable Mention, First Team AVCA All-Region and



First Team All-NSIC honors to an already-stacked trophy case. Phemie Rossi ranked sixth in the nation in blocks at the conclusion of the season and earned First Team All-NSIC, AVCA All-Region Honorable Mention and AVCA All-America Honorable Mention honors.

Braegelmann led the Huskies to new heights in 2019, earning NSIC Coach of the Year after helping St. Cloud State record its best season in over 20 years. Under Braegelmann's guidance, the Huskies posted an overall record of 25-7 and a 15-5 mark in NSIC play, landing them fourth place in the NSIC rankings and earning their first-ever trip to the NSIC Tournament. St. Cloud State earned its first AVCA top-25 ranking since 1997, cracked the organization's top-10 for the first time since 1996, finished No. 10 in the final AVCA top-25 poll and earned an at-large berth to the NCAA Regional for the first time since 2004. St. Cloud State defeated 14 nationally and regionally ranked opponents during the season, going 10-5 against AVCA Top-25 opponents and finished runner-up in the NSIC Tournament.

St. Cloud State's defense closed 2019 as one of the top units in the nation, leading the NSIC in digs and digs/set. The Huskies broke the program record for single-season digs, compiling 2213 over the course of 31 matches. Senior libero Clara Krenz became the program's all-time dig leader, concluding her impressive career with 2227. Braegelmann saw three student-athletes earn All-NSIC honors as Krenz was named the conference's Libero of the Year for the second consecutive season and earned First Team All-NSIC, AVCA First Team All-Central Region, D2CCA Second Team All-Region and AVCA All-America Honorable Mention nods. Sophomore outside Linsey Rachel earned First Team All-Conference, AVCA First Team All-Region and AVCA All-America Honorable Mention honors while junior setter Maddy Torve earned Second Team All-NSIC honors and ranked top-five nationally in assists and assists/set. Finally, a program-record 11 student-athletes earned Academic All-NSIC honors in 2019.

2018 saw the Huskies continue to build, posting a 15-11 overall record with an 11-9 mark in NSIC play and a seventh-place finish in the conference standings. St. Cloud State defeated two top-10 nationally-ranked opponents while several individuals find success during the 2018 season. Freshman outside Linsey Rachel and junior libero Clara Krenz received Second Team All-NSIC honors in 2018 and were named the conference Freshman and Libero of the Year. Both also earned NSIC Player of the Week honors at least once during the season while seven student-athletes earned Academic All-Conference honors in Braegelmann's fourth season with the program.

In 2017, Braegelmann led the Huskies to a 16-14 record and an 8-12 mark in NSIC play. The 16 wins were the most for the program since 2004, when St. Cloud State posted an overall record of 19-12, and marked just the third time in the last 20 years the Huskies won more than 15 matches in a season. Sophomore libero Clara Krenz led the Northern Sun with a whopping 5.92 digs per set and earned Second Team All-NSIC honors at the end of the season, becoming Braegelmann's second All-NSIC libero in three years with the program. The Huskies defense ascended to third in the NSIC with 17.26 digs a set, limiting opponents to the sixth-fewest kills per set in the league.

Year two at St. Cloud State served as a rebuilding year for the program as the Huskies were 8-21 overall, 3-17 in the NSIC. Four student-athletes earned Academic All-NSIC notice in 2016. The Huskies showed vast improvement at the service line, leaping to fifth in the NSIC with 1.52 aces per set. SCSU's serve receive was seventh in the conference, allowing just 123 aces. Nicole Miller led the Northern Sun with 76 aces - 24 more than the next-best serve specialist - and averaged just over half an ace per set. Freshman libero Clara Krenz opened her collegiate career with 4.30 digs per set, landing her seventh in the NSIC.

In his first season with the Huskies, Braegelmann posted a 9-19 overall record with a 5-15 NSIC mark in NSIC play. St. Cloud State's defense ranked fifth in the NSIC with 16.50 digs per set, led by All-NSIC libero Brianne Stamer's conference-leading 5.46 digs a set. Stamer was one of six Huskies on the Academic All-NSIC squad while Macy Weller ranked top-20 in the conference with 0.83 blocks per set.

Chad Braegelmann was named the fifth head coach in St. Cloud State Volleyball history on July 6, 2015.

Prior to his move to SCSU, Braegelmann was the head women's volleyball coach at the University of Minnesota-Morris where he also served as the Sports Studies and Athletics Discipline Coordinator and an Assistant Athletic Director. In seven seasons at Minnesota-Morris, Braegelmann posted a 130-91 record while earning UMAC Coach of the Year honors in 2010 and 2013. His team won a share of the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference title in 2013 before closing his Minnesota-Morris career with a 23-12 (12-2 UMAC) showing in 2014.

At Colby-Sawyer, Braegelmann departed as the all-time winningest coach in program history with a 156-80 record over seven seasons spanning from 2001-07. He guided the Chargers to Commonwealth Coast Conference Championships in 2003 and 2005 while twice advancing to the NCAA Division III National Tournament. Braegelmann led Colby-Sawyer to six conference championship match appearances with double-digit wins in all seven seasons, attaining the most single-season wins in school history in any sport. Volleyball athletes were successful off the court as well, earning the top team academic grade point average of Colby-Sawyer's athletic programs multiple times.

A graduate of the University of Minnesota-Morris, Braegelmann received his master's degree in education from Northern State University.

A native of Richmond, Minn. and graduate of nearby ROCORI H.S., Braegelmann and his wife Natalie have four sons.

St. Cloud State associate head volleyball coach Marci Taumalolo enters her 13th season with Huskies Volleyball in 2022. At the conclusion of the 2019 season, Taumalolo was promoted from top assistant to associate head coach. Honored as part of the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Thirty Under 30 in February of 2011, Taumalolo has helped shape St. Cloud State Volleyball into a national power.

In 12 years with the program, Marci has recruited and coached six AVCA All-Americans, eight AVCA All-Region honorees, 13 All-NSIC selections, two NSIC Libero and Freshmen of the Year recipients, two AVCA Central Region Freshmen of the Year honorees and an AVCA DII National Freshman of the Year. 64 student-athletes have earned Academic All-NSIC honors under Taumalolo's watch.

The Huskies defense has developed into one of the top units in the NSIC during Taumalolo's time with SCSU, ranking top-six across the Northern Sun in digs per set in five of the past six seasons. St. Cloud State led the NSIC in both digs and digs/set in 2019, holding opponents to the fifth-lowest hitting percentage across the league.

Throughout her career at St. Cloud State, liberos have flourished as Taumalolo has recruited and coached back-to-back record-setters. Of the top-10 single-season dig leaders in program history, seven performances have been overseen by Taumalolo. Four of the Huskies' top-six career dig leaders have played for Taumalolo: Clara Krenz (2016-19), Brianne Stamer (2012-15), Chelsea Nagle (2008-11) and Linsey Rachel (2018-22). Krenz established herself as one of the all-time St. Cloud State greats in her time with the program, racking up a Huskies-record 2227 digs and becoming the program's first-ever 2000 Dig Club member. She was named an All-American, a two-time NSIC Libero of the Year and garnered All-NSIC honors three times while leading the Northern Sun in digs per set during the 2017, 2018 and 2019 seasons. Stamer preceded Krenz as the program's all-time dig leader, posting 1929 digs in her illustrious career and earning All-NSIC honors during the 2015 campaign with a conference-leading 5.46 digs per set. Rachel paced all NSIC outside hitters in digs and digs per set during the 2021 campaign, developing into one of the best six-rotation players in the nation under Taumalolo's watch. Nagle provided the third-most single-season digs with 481 in Marci's first season with the Huskies, going on to finish third all-time in digs at the time of her graduation.

Taumalolo helped guide the Huskies to their first NSIC regular season title since 1982 and earning the program's first NSIC Tournament Championship in 2021. St. Cloud State went 27-5 with a 19-1 mark in NSIC play to finish alone atop the conference standings. The Huskies earned the No. 2 seed at the Central Regional in Warrensburg, Missouri, closed the season ranked No. 10 in the final AVCA top-25 poll and set new program standards for fewest losses and best single-season

winning percentage. St. Cloud State's offense was one of the most terminal units in the Nation, ranking seventh in hitting percentage (.270), 10th in assists (1576), 13th in kills (1682), 15th in assists per set (13.0) and 17th in kills per set (13.9). The Huskies' fearsome block ranked seventh in total blocks (305.0) and ninth in blocks per set (2.5) at the conclusion of the season.

Prior to her appointment at St. Cloud State in July of 2010, Taumalolo spent the previous three seasons (2007-09) as the assistant coach at Ball State. In her three seasons with the Cardinals, she helped lead the Ball State back court to top-five rankings in the final Mid-American Conference dig rankings each season. In 2007, the Cardinals finished fifth with 14.57 digs per set, while the back court improved two spots in 2008, ranking third with 15.43 digs per set.

Before her tenure with the Cardinals, Taumalolo was a four-year member of the University of Minnesota Golden Gophers women's volleyball team. She finished her career at Minnesota (2003-06) ranked second on the school's all-time career digs list at 1,401. After leading the Big Ten with a 5.22 digs per set her senior season, Taumalolo earned American Volleyball Coaches Association All-America Honorable Mention accolades, was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year and was a First-Team All-Big Ten honoree. She was also a four-time Scholar Athlete and garnered the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week accolades three times during her collegiate stint.

Prior to her collegiate career, Taumalolo was a two-time AAU All-American (2001 & 2002) for the Kaepa Northern Lights Club, while being named an All-American at the 2000 Junior National Championships (16-Open) and picking up the "Best Setter" award at the 2002 National Junior Championships.

During her prep career at Armstrong High School in Plymouth, Minnesota, Taumalolo was an All-American and All-State player as a junior and senior. During her senior campaign, she led her team to an undefeated (29-0) record, while collecting 31 kills and 28 digs in the team's state championship victory over Eagan High School. As a junior, she collected a school-record 53 kills in one match.

Taumalolo has earned a Master's Degree in Physical Education and Sports Administration (Ball State) along with a Bachelor's Degree in Business & Marketing (Minnesota, 2007). A native of Plymouth, Minn., Taumalolo is married with five children. She has nine siblings, including three older sisters and one younger sister who all played collegiate volleyball, along with five brothers.

Voss brings a wealth of knowledge to the St. Cloud State coaching staff and helped the Huskies take home the NSIC regular season and tournament titles in 2021. Prior to 2021, Voss served as a student-assistant at Gustavus Adolphus College, guiding the Gusties to their first Minnesota Intercollegiate Conference (MIAC) Tournament appearance since the late 2000s. He also served as head coach of Upsala High School from 2017 to 2020.

GRAD. ASSISTANT COACH MORGAN PENNER

Morgan (Baufield) Penner joined the Huskies coaching staff in the spring of 2022.

Penner brings an impressive resume to her position at St. Cloud State, as she joined the Huskies roster in 2021 after an impressive playing career at Northern State. A 5'10" middle blocker from Wayzata, Minnesota, Penner earned Second Team All-Conference honors from the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) after tallying 195 kills in 31 matches for the Wolves. In her three years at Northern State, Penner appeared in 92 matches with 577 kills, 257 blocks and 141 digs before joining St. Cloud State in 2021. In her single season with the Huskies, Penner appeared in 11 matches and recorded 18 kills and 12.0 blocks.
