SERIES HISTORY

SCSU leads the all-time series against St. Thomas, 11-4-2, but have struggled over the last five games against the Tommies (2-3-0). The Huskies are 7-3-0 in the last 10 meetings though and own a 7-1-1 record against UST at the Herb Brooks National Hockey Center. Last season, SCSU went 2-1-1 against the Tommies including 2-0-0 at home and 0-1-1 in Mendota Heights. Both road games went to overtime and the first one ended as a tie and a shootout loss and the second was won in overtime by St. Thomas.

BLIZZARD'S BULLETS

LAST TIME OUT

SCSU was swept by No. 3 Minnesota in its first conference series of the season, falling 4-1 at Ridder Arena on Friday and 5-3 at home on Saturday.

Notes from the games

GAME 5 - 4-1 loss @ #3 Minnesota (10-10-25)

- SCSU moved to 6-109-4 all-time against Minnesota and 1-61-2 all-time against the Gophers on the road.
- The Huskies moved to 1-2-0 this season against ranked teams and 1-2-0 in road games.
- SCSU blocked 12+ shots for the third consecutive game.
- SCSU went 4-for-4 on the penalty kill and 0-for-1 on the power play. For the season, SCSU is 16-for-18 (88.9%) on the penalty kill and 2-for-10 on the power play (20.0%).
- Freshman forward **Maria Mikaelyan** (Moscow, Russia) scored the lone SCSU goal. It was her third career goal in her fifth game.
- Freshman forward **Raili Mustonen** (Kalajoki, Finland) provided the only assist on the Husky goal. She recorded her first career assist in her fifth game.
- Sophomore defender **Siiri Yrjölä** (Vantaa, Finland) blocked four shots which marked a new single game high this season.
- Graduate goaltender **Jojo Chobak** (Chicago, Ill.) made 29 saves for the second straight game.

GAME 6 - 5-3 loss @ #3 Minnesota (10-11-25)

- SCSU moved to 6-110-4 all-time against Minnesota and 4-46-2 all-time against the Gophers at home.
- The Huskies moved to 1-3-0 this season against ranked teams and 2-1-0 in home games.
- SCSU went 3-for-3 on the penalty kill and 1-for-5 on the power play. For the season, SCSU is 19-for-21 (90.5%) on the penalty kill and 3-for-15 on the power play (20.0%).
- Freshman forward **Maria Mikaelyan** (Moscow, Russia) was one of two Huskies with multiple points (1 goal/1 assist) and was named the game's third star. She scored a goal for the second consecutive game and recorded her first career assist and first career multi-point game. Mikaelyan's four goals lead the team by two and her five points are tied for the most.
- Senior forward **Avery Farrell** (Rogers, Minn.) was the other Husky with multiple points (1 goal/1 assist). It was her first goal since last season (Feb. 8, 2025). She has three assists this season which ranks second on the team.
- Redshirt junior forward **Laura Zimmermann** (Ringgenberg, Switzerland) scored the Huskies first goal of the game. It was her first goal since last year's final game against Minnesota Duluth on March 1, 2025.
- Before leaving the game due to injury in the second period, sophomore goaltender **Emilia Kyrkkö** (Nokia, Finland) made 30 saves on 32 shots (.938 save percentage). Her 30 saves were the second most in a game this season.
- Graduate defender **Grace Wolfe** (Owatonna, Minn.) was the lone Husky to skate to a positive mark (+2).
- Redshirt sophomore defender **Sydney Bryant** (Traverse City, Mich.) and junior forward **Sidney Jackel** (Ann Arbor, Mich.) tallied their second assists of the season.

WCHA WEEKLY HONORS

Freshman forward **Maria Mikaelyan** (Moscow, Russia) was named Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) Rookie of the Week by the league on Oct. 13. She tallied three points (2 goals/1 assist) including her first two-point game in the series against No. 3 Minnesota. It is her first WCHA weekly award of the season and of her career.

The freshman became the first Husky to be named Rookie of the Week since **Emilia Kyrkkö** (Nokia, Finland) earned the honor last season on 10/21/24 and the first skater to earn the honor since **Alice Sauriol** (Sherbrooke, Quebec) did so on 10/16/23. Mikaelyan is the second Husky to win WCHA weekly honors this season, following sophomore defender **Siiri Yrjölä** (Vantaa, Finland), who was named Defender of the Week on Sept. 22.

The Moscow, Russia native scored SCSU's lone goal on her only shot attempt in Friday's game at No. 3 Minnesota and contributed a goal and an assist in Saturday's series finale against the Gophers. She was one of two Huskies with multiple points on Saturday and was named the game's third star. It was her first career two-point game and her first career assist. For the weekend, she ranked No. 1 in shot percentage (66.7% - 2-for-3), tied for No. 2 in goals and tied for No. 4 in points among WCHA skaters.

JOJO IS CHO-BA(C)K

Graduate student goaltender **Jojo Chobak** (Chicago, Ill.) is back for her final year of collegiate eligibility after a redshirt season in 2024-25. In her first start between the pipes in since March 2, 2024 (567 days) on Sept. 20, she picked up right where she left of in 2023-24, earning her 10th career shutout as a Huskies to tie former teammate Sanni Ahola (2020-25) for the most career shutouts in program history.

This summer, Chobak was invited to the USA Hockey National Goaltender Camp and National Festival and was a U.S. Collegiate Select Team selection. In 2023-24, she went 7-11-1 over 17 starts and established new program records for single season save percentage (.939) and goals against average (1.64) while recording four shutouts. Chobak currently owns seven season top 10 marks and four career top 10 spots in the record book. She is a two-time WCHA All-Academic Team member and a two-time WCHA Scholar-Athlete. In her four-year career, she owns a 27-25-3 record with a 2.02 GAA, a .929 SV% and 13 shutouts over 53 starts/63 appearances.

NEW LEADER OF THE PACK

Former assistant coach, **Mira Jalosuo** (MEER-ah YAH-loh-SUE-oh) was named the seventh head coach of the St. Cloud State Women's Hockey team on June 27, 2025. She is just the second woman to lead the Huskies during the program's 27-year history, following in the footsteps of Kerry Brodt Wethington, who was the programs first head coach from 1998-99 to 2001-02.

Jalosuo picked up her first win as the Huskies bench boss in her first game, a 5-0 win over Lindenwood (Mo.) on September 19. She earned her first series sweep the next day after SCSU took down the Lions 5-0 for the second straight game. It was the first time in program history that a team posted back-to-back shutouts to open a season and the fourth season in a row that the Huskies opened their season with a series sweep.

A highly decorated member of Finland's National Team, the two-time Olympian and five-time World Championships Bronze medalist spent the last two seasons as an assistant coach with the Minnesota Frost (formerly PWHL Minnesota), helping the franchise win back-to-back PWHL Walter Cups in each of the first two seasons of the Professional Women's Hockey League (PWHL).

ALL-FEMALE COACHING STAFF

For the first time in program history, the Huskies have an all-female coaching staff. SCSU is one of two programs in the WCHA and one of six programs in all of NCAA DI Women's Hockey with an all-female staff.

WELCOME TO THE PACK

The Huskies welcomed 13 newcomers to the team this fall (10 freshmen and three transfers. Of the 10 freshmen, six are forwards - **Lily Erickson** (Roseau, Minn. / Roseau HS), **Payton Remick** (Roseau, Minn. / Roseau HS), **Raili Mustonen** (Kalajokki, Finland / Team Kuortane (AuroraLiiga)), **Reese Strauts** (Brandon, Wis. / Windy City Storm (19U AAA)), **Julianne Labbé** (Wendake, Quebec / Cégep Limoilou Titans (QCHL)) and **Maria Mikaelyan** (Moscow, Russia / North York Storm (OWHL U22 AA)) and four are defenders - **Hannah Arnold** (Winnipeg, Manitoba / St. Mary's Academy (CSSHL U18)), **Sydney Lamb** (Lombard, Ill. / Windy City Storm (19U AAA)), **Aruba Skiston** (Bensenville, Ill. / Chicago Mission (19U AAA)) and **Maélie Pion** (Sherbrooke, Quebec / Stanstead College (CAHS)).

The transfers are junior forward **Payton Holloway** (Tomah, Wis. / Shattuck St. Mary's) from Minnesota Duluth, junior forward **Sidney Jackel** (Ann Arbor, Mich. / Pioneer HS), from Lindenwood and senior goaltender **Hali Lawrence** (Calgary, Alberta / Calgary Fire U18AAA) from Post.

SEASON PREVIEW

The Huskies bring back three of its four top scorers from last season's squad that went 15-15-6 and finished inside the top-five of the WCHA standings for the third consecutive season after most recently doing so in 2015-16. The three top returning point scorers, forward **Sofianna Sundelin** (Ulvila, Finland), forward **Alice Sauriol** (Sherbrooke, Quebec) and forward **Laura Zimmermann** (Ringgenberg, Switzerland), are all rising juniors and contributed 15+ points a season ago. The Huskies also return an elite netminder duo in All-WCHA Rookie Team selection **Emilia Kyrkkö** (Nokia, Finland) and graduate student **Jojo Chobak** (Chicago, Ill.), who redshirted last season.

O CAPTAINS! OUR CAPTAINS!

St. Cloud State named four captains ahead of the 2025-26 season on Friday. Graduate student defender **Grace Wolfe** (Owatonna, Minn.) will be the fifth Husky to wear the "C" as captain for two seasons, while redshirt junior defender **Regan Bulger** (Yellowknife, Northwest Territories), graduate student goaltender **Jojo Chobak** (Chicago, Ill.) and redshirt junior forward **Laura Zimmermann** (Ringgenberg, Switzerland) will be alternate captains and wear a letter for the first time in their career.

Wolfe, who served as a co-captain in 2024-25 and an alternate captain in 2023-24, becomes just the second Husky to wear a letter in three seasons after Katy Battis (C - 1999-2000, A - 2001-02, 2002-03).

WCHA PRESEASON COACHES POLL

St. Cloud State Women's Hockey was selected to finish fifth in the 2025-26 Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) Preseason Coaches' Poll, as announced by the league office on Sept. 8. The Huskies are coming off their third fifth place conference finish in a row and tied for the second most conference points in program history a season ago.

SCSU received 24 points overall in the coaches' poll and were selected to finish behind Wisconsin (49 points, seven first-place votes), Minnesota (40 points, one first-place vote) Ohio State (40 points), and Minnesota Duluth (31 points). Rounding out the poll was St. Thomas (17 points), Minnesota State (16 points) and Bemidji State (seven points).

JOJO REPRESENTS THE STARS AND STRIPES AT THE 2025 COLLEGIATE SELECT SERIES

Graduate student goaltender **Jojo Chobak** (Chicago, Ill.) helped lead the U.S. Collegiate Select Team to a 1-1-1-0 record in the three-game series against Canada in the 2025 Collegiate Select Series in August at the Lake Placid Olympic Center in Lake Placid, N.Y.

The graduate student goaltender is the third active SCSU player and first netminder to be named to the Collegiate Select Team (*formerly known as the U22 Team) twice in her career. Chobak and former co-captain **Emma Gentry** became the fourth and fifth Huskies to make the team back in 2023 before Gentry was a back-to-back pick in 2024. Prior to that, goaltender **Emma Polusny** was the last Husky to make the team in 2019 and before that, defender **Brittini Kuyper** made back-to-back U22 squads in 2006 and 2007 while forward **Holly Roberts** joined Kuyper at the 2007 U22 Series.

MIRA JALOSUO

HUSKIES HEAD COACH



Mira Jalosuo (MEER-ah YAH-loh-SUE-oh) was named the head coach of St. Cloud State Women's Hockey, Director of Athletics **Holly Schreiner** announced on June 27, 2025. She enters her first season at the helm in 2025-26. The former assistant coach for the Huskies became the seventh head coach in program's 27-year history and the second woman to lead the Huskies after Kerry Brodt Wethington, the program's first head coach from 1998-99 to 2001-02.

A highly decorated member of Finland's National Team, the two-time Olympian and five-time World Championships Bronze medalist spent the 2023-24 and 2024-25 seasons as an assistant coach with the Minnesota Frost (formerly PWHL Minnesota), helping the franchise win each of the first two Professional Women's Hockey League (PWHL) Walter Cups.

Prior to becoming a coach for the Frost, Jalosuo spent a year as an assistant coach for the Huskies under former head coach Brian Idalski, during his first season in 2022-23. She primarily worked with the defenders, while directing the penalty kill and assisting with recruiting efforts.

In her lone season with the Huskies in 2022-23, Jalosuo helped recreate St. Cloud State as one of the best defensive teams in the country. SCSU led the NCAA and set a new program record with 576 blocked shots while holding opponents to 2.59 goals – their second-best mark in program history – and 32.24 shots per game – their best mark since 2015-16. St. Cloud State's goaltenders anchored the rejuvenated defense, recording the program's third-best team save percentage at .920 and second-best goals against average of 2.58. The Huskies posted a program-record six shutouts in 2022-23, punctuating their stingy defensive work.

St. Cloud State's young defensive corps flourished under Jalosuo's direction as sophomores Dayle Ross and Grace Wolfe each took monumental steps forward. Ross led the NCAA with a Huskies single-season record 104 blocks, Wolfe landed second in the country with 83 and true freshman Regan Bulger finished fourth nationally with 78 blocks. Wolfe increased her point total by 15 while Ross went from three points as a freshman to 15 as a sophomore, each seeing increased roles and productivity in the offensive zone. Senior assistant captain Taytum Geier established new career-highs in assists, points, plus-minus and blocks in her lone season under Jalosuo.

Jalosuo had been a steady presence on Finland's blue line until her retirement in 2018, skating for 12 years as a member of the Senior National Team. She appeared in the 2014 and 2018 Olympic Games – earning bronze at Pyeongchang in 2018 – and added five bronze medals at the International Ice Hockey Federation (IIHF) Women's World Championships (2008-09, 2011, 2015, 2017). The defender played in 193 games for Finland, scoring 11 goals and adding 22 assists for 33 points as an anchor on the blue line.

From 2019 to 2022, Jalosuo spent three seasons leading Stillwater Area High School girl's hockey as the program's head coach. Under her direction, the Ponies went 52-19-4 (.693) and boasted a strong penalty kill. Stillwater killed 89.3% of their chances on the PK, including 90 of 98 (91.8%) kills in 2019-20.

Prior to her time at Stillwater, Jalosuo had served as an assistant coach for Hamline University and Wayzata High School since 2015. She also coached with the Stillwater Area Hockey Association, leading the U12A team to a 42-6-2 record in 2018-19.

Jalosuo played professionally following her collegiate career from 2013-18, spending two seasons with SKIF Nizhny Novgorod in the Russian Women's Hockey League and earning the Russian Championship in 2014. She then spent time with Luleå HF in the SDHL before joining the Minnesota Whitecaps of the Premier Hockey Federation (PHF) in 2016-17 and 2017-18. Jalosuo also skated with Oulun Kärpät in the Naisten Liiga, the team she played with as a teenager prior to her time with the Gophers.

The Lieksa, Finland native played for the Minnesota Gophers from 2009-10 to 2012-13. She appeared in 153 career games for the Maroon and Gold, recording 57 career points with 19 goals and 38 assists. A Third Team All-WCHA honoree as a senior, Jalosuo was part of back-to-back national championship teams as a junior and senior. She was a three-time WCHA All-Academic honoree as well.

Raised in eastern Finland, Jalosuo began playing in the premier Finnish women's league with Oulun Kärpät at age 15 and was an All-Star in 2007 and 2008. She served as the team's captain in 2008-09 while still attending high school.

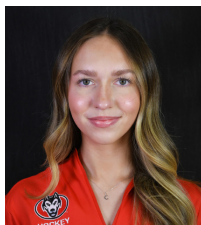

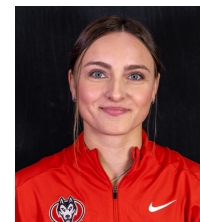
