# HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

## JULIE CHAUVIN - INDUCTION 1995

Julie Chauvin is the epitome of an all-around athlete. The 1988 graduate lettered in four different sports while at St. Edward's University. She was named All-Conference in both volleyball and softball, and all-district in volleyball. In 1985, Chauvin led the volleyball team to the Big State Conference Championship and helped secure a spot in its first-ever NAIA National Tournament.

## DIANE DANIELS - INDUCTION 1989

Diane Daniels was a professor of physical education at St. Edward's University from 1970 to 1988. During that time, she began the women's athletic program coaching all of the women's athletic teams (volleyball, basketball and tennis) until 1981. In 1985, the volleyball team advanced to the National Tournament. The tennis and volleyball teams also earned conference championships. Daniels was named Conference Coach of the Year (tennis) and Conference and District Coach of the Year (volleyball). Daniels passed away on Oct. 21, 1989. The St. Edward's University softball field is named in her honor.

## RHONDA DARLING - INDUCTION 2002

Rhonda Darling was a member of the famed "Fab Five" basketball program that dominated the Heart of Texas Conference and NAIA District Four during the early 1990s. During her three years at St. Edward's, her team posted an 89-8 record, won three conference titles and two district championships, and earned three trips to the NAIA National Tournament, including a berth in the Final Four in 1992. Individual honors include two-time All-Conference, NAIA All-District, NAIA All-American and NAIA Academic All-American.

## AARON FARRIS-SEAFOUS - INDUCTION 2006

Aaron Farris-Seafous was a three-year letterwinner for the Hilltoppers as she helped lead the team to a 77-17 record and two conference championships. Farris-Seafous was named All-Conference and All-District in each of her three seasons. During her senior season, she helped lead the Hilltoppers to their first-ever NAIA National Tournament bid. Farris-Seafous is a member of the 1,000-point club and ranks 10th on the all-time scoring list with 1,115 points. She ranks in the St. Edward's University top-10 all-time list for field goals made (448), field goal percentage (.537), rebounds (603) and rebounding average (8.6). After college, Farris-Seafous played overseas professionally for Clube Amigos de Bossuete in Portugal.

## GINNY GREEN-KOCH - INDUCTION 1993

Ginny Green-Koch graduated from St. Edward's University in 1986 with a bachelor's in accounting. For four consecutive years, she lettered in both volleyball and basketball. Playing post for the Hilltoppers, she captained the basketball team during the 1983-1984 and 1985-1986 seasons. As hitter/setter for the volleyball squad, she received the Most Improved award for two years and was named All-Conference in 1985.



# HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

## **KENDRA HARRELL - INDUCTION 2014**

Kendra Harrell was a four-year letterwinner during her stay on the Hilltop, starting all 110 games in her career. Harrell tallied 1685 points, averaging 15.3 points and 6.9 rebounds per contest. As a freshman, Harrell was awarded the Heart of Texas Conference Freshman of the Year award. Every year following, from her sophomore to senior year, Harrell was selected to the Heart of Texas Conference First Team. As a junior, she was named an Academic All-American and an Honorable Mention All-American both her junior and senior years. Currently, Harrell holds records for free throw attempts in a single game (17), career free throws made (393), and career free throws attempted (537). In the standout's junior year, she recorded 34 blocks and 74 steals, which are good enough for second and third all time in a single season. Not only did Harrell excel on the court but in the classroom as well, making the dean's list four times in her tenure.

## **KATHRYN HOPKINS - INDUCTION 1989**

Kathryn Hopkins attended St. Edward's University from 1978 to 1983. She received four letters in volleyball (outside hitter) and basketball (post), and earned Academic All-Conference, All-Conference, the Ed Norris Award and All-Tourney at the Big State Conference Tourney. Hopkins graduated Magna Cum Laude in 1983, won the Austin Association for Physical Education and Recreation Outstanding Service Award in 1988 and the AAPER Pepi Award in 1988.

## **LISA HUDSON - INDUCTION 1995**

Lisa Hudson was a three-year letterwinner for the Hilltoppers from 1987 to 1989. During her three years, she helped lead the squad to a 69-21 record and two Big State Conference Championships. Hudson was named all-district once and All-Conference twice. She graduated Magna Cum Laude in 1990.

## **PAULA JASEK-WEBB - INDUCTION 1999**

Paula Jasek-Webb was a member of the famed "Fab Five" basketball program that dominated the Heart of Texas Conference and NAIA District Four during the early 1990s. She was a four-year letterwinner from 1989 to 1993. Her name is listed in five different categories for career records, which include games played (127), free throws made (308), free throws attempted (420) and assists (445). Jasek-Webb was an Academic All-America selection during the 1991-1992 season.

## **HEAD COACH DAVID MCKEY - INDUCTION 2014**

In 10 seasons as head coach for the St. Edward's Women's Basketball Team, David McKey led the Hilltoppers to eight-straight winning seasons. Of the 10 seasons in his stay, McKey won six conference championships and garnered a .736 winning percentage, the highest in school history. McKey, who owns the most wins in school history, made two NAIA Final Four appearances and three national tournament appearances. McKey's success on the Hilltop was widely recognized as he was awarded the District Coach of the Year three times and the Big State Conference Coach of the Year three times.

## **TAJ MCWILLIAMS-FRANKLIN - INDUCTION 1999**

McWilliams-Franklin is arguably the most successful Hilltopper Athlete in the history of St. Edward's Athletics. She lettered three years for the Hilltoppers from 1991 to 1993. During her three years, McWilliams-Franklin was a three-time all-conference honoree, two-time all-district pick and two-time all-America selection. She was also named the NAIA National Player of the Year in 1992-93.

She finished her career as the school's all-time scoring (1,837) and is second in all-time rebounding (950). After college, McWilliams-Franklin has played overseas for the past 18 years. She is also in her 14th season in the WNBA. While in the WNBA, McWilliams-Franklin has been selected to the All-Star team six times. She has also won two WNBA titles: Detroit (2008), Minnesota (2011).

## **NICHOLE STROUP (WIATREK) - INDUCTION 2020**

Nichole Stroup name is all over the SEU record book. She ranks in the top five all-time in career points (1,520/3rd), rebounds (779/4th), blocks (68/5th), and she has the fifth- and eighth-best single-season point totals with 535 points during the 1999-00 season and 467 in 1998-99. Stroup also is tied for second for most blocks in a season with 24 during the 1997-98 campaign. A three-time all-conference selection, Stroup earned second-team all-region honors in 1999-00 and led the Hilltoppers to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 1999. Stroup led the Hilltoppers to a 20-7 mark in 1997-98 and 20-6 record in 1999-00.



# J.J. RIEHL

## HEAD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



### HEAD COACHING BIO

J.J. Riehl became the sixth head coach of the St. Edward's University women's basketball team in 2012. She now enters her 14th season. She captured her 100th career win on January 26, 2019 against Newman.

In 2016, Riehl led the Hilltoppers to their second regular-season Heartland Conference title in program history and second conference tournament title in four years. Riehl coached SEU to an overall record of 20-9 and a conference mark of 13-3 – both career bests for the fifth-year head coach. Riehl was named the Heartland Conference Coach of the Year as the Hilltoppers produced the program's first all-American in its NCAA history and three All-Heartland Conference performers.

Under Riehl, SEU appeared in its first NCAA Tournament in program history in the 2013-14 season, and she led St. Edward's to a second NCAA Tournament in the 2016-17 season. Riehl has led SEU to three conference tournament finals in the last four years. In 2013-14 the Hilltoppers won the conference tournament as the No. 4 seed. Riehl followed that up in 2015-16, leading St. Edward's to a conference tournament finals appearance as the No. 7 seed before winning the tournament again in 2016-17. She is the only head coach in program history to win two Heartland Conference Tournament titles.

Over the years, Riehl has developed two All-Americans, 25 All-Conference performers



and the 2019-20 Lone Star Conference Newcomer of the Year. A total of nine individuals have earned Heartland Conference All-Tournament honors with two earning Most Valuable Player distinction.

Riehl's roots tie deep into St. Edward's University, as she served as an assistant coach from 2002-12. While assisting, she played an instrumental role in the program's first Heartland Conference regular-season championship (2005-06), six consecutive conference tournament appearances stretching from 2006 to 2011, 24 all-conference players, one conference Player of the Year, one Defensive Player of the Year and two professional players.

Riehl also played collegiate basketball at St. Edward's, arriving on the hilltop in 1998. She was a three-year starter, two-year captain and two-time all-conference honoree, and she led her team to an NAIA Championship appearance. Riehl is listed in the record books multiple times as one of the best 3-point shooters and point guards in program history to go along with more than 1,000-career points. Riehl was recognized as a member of the St. Edward's University Women's Athletics All-Era Team in 2010.

Riehl received her bachelor's degree in Kinesiology in 2002 and earned her Master of Human Services with a Sports Management concentration in 2004, both from St. Edward's.

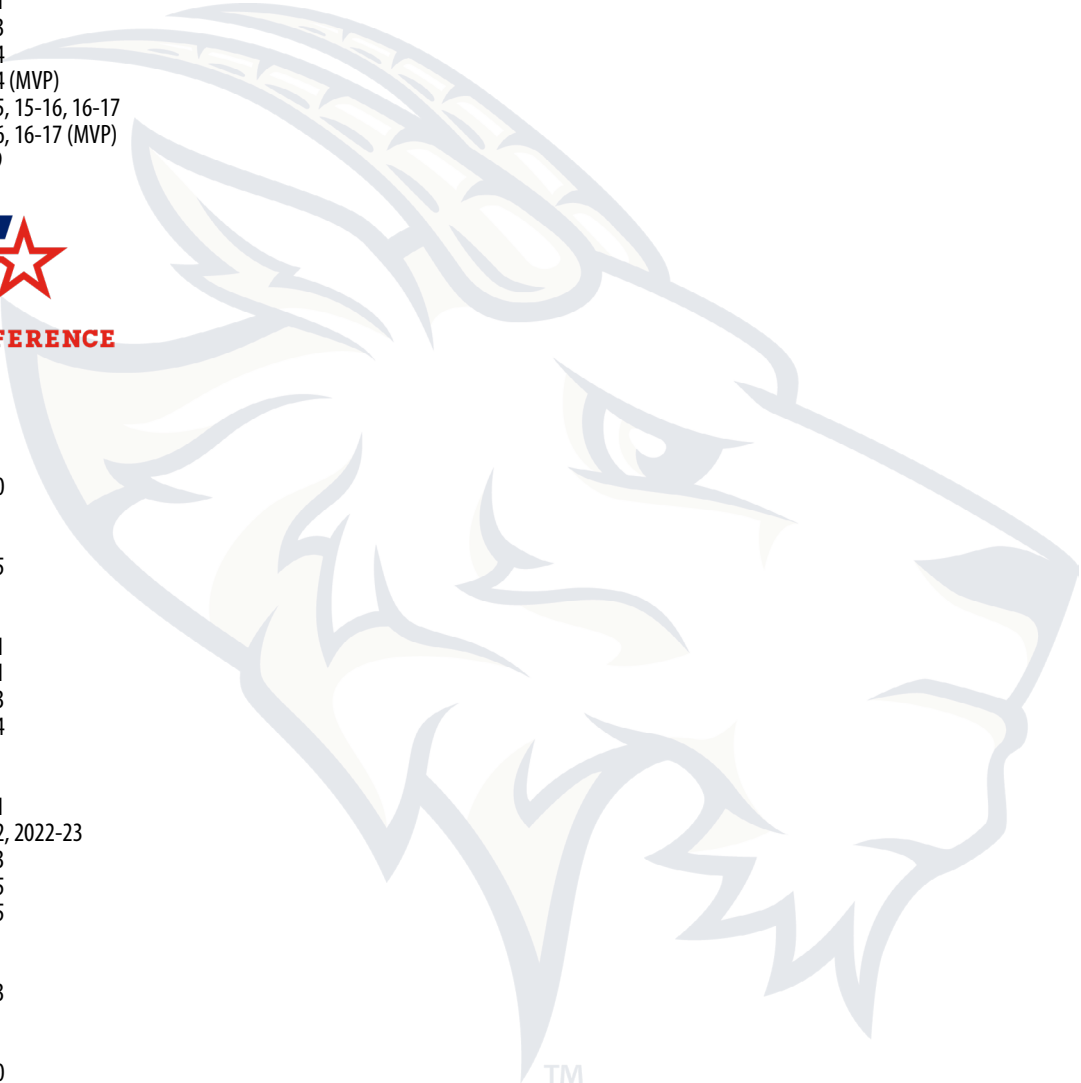
