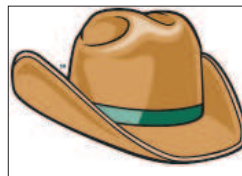

GAME DAY STORY LINES

- Tonight's game will be the 99th season-opener in Stetson Basketball history. The Hatters' first season of intercollegiate basketball was 1900-01. That team played Rollins College three times, winning twice.
- Stetson has an all-time record of 56-42 in 98 previous season openers. The Hatters have their last two season-openers, including last year's 89-79 upset victory at Wake Forest. Stetson has won seven of its last 10 season openers.
- The Hatters are 70-26 all-time in home openers in 98 previous seasons. There were two seasons (1907-08 and 1921-22) in which Stetson did not play a home game. Stetson is looking to bounce back after dropping the 2010-11 home opener to UCF 85-58.
- Hatters coach **Casey Alexander** will be the first Stetson coach to make his debut at home since Loren Ellis in 1950 (his only season as coach). Alexander will attempt to join his predecessor, Derek Waugh, as a winner in his Stetson debut, giving the Hatters consecutive victorious coaching debuts for the first time since Bob Tricolor (1949-50) and Ellis (1950-51) both won in their debut games.
- With just 12 games on the schedule at the Edmunds Center for the 2011-12 season, the Hatters will be looking to post a winning home record this season after going 5-8 at home last year.
- The Hatters will have four players who are expected to make their Stetson debut in the game against Bethune-Cookman. The newest Hatters who should see action are freshman **Dennis Diaz**, sophomore **Willie Green**, sophomore **Chris Perez** and junior **Adam Pegg**.
- The Hatters should have another player eligible to make his Stetson debut after fall semester classes end. Junior **Amara Thompson** must sit out the first semester after transferring from UCF.
- One member of the Stetson team will miss the entire season while sitting out as a transfer. Guard **Hunter Miller**, a Nashville native and nephew of Sawyer Brown lead singer Mark Miller, is a transfer from Florida Gulf Coast. He will have two seasons left to play for the Hatters after this year.
- The Hatters will be looking for new areas of offensive production this year after the departure of 62.7 percent of the scoring from the 2010-11 squad. Junior **Tyshawn Patterson** (8.3) and sophomore **Aaron Graham** (6.1) are the leading returning scorers on the 2011-12 team

SERIES HISTORY

- Friday's game will be the 25th meeting between the Hatters and Wildcats in a series that started in 1968. Stetson leads the all-time series 19-5.
- The Hatters have a 15-2 all-time series lead against Bethune-Cookman in games played in DeLand. That mark includes a forfeit during the 1992-93 season.
- The longest win streak for either team in the series is nine games, which Stetson had from Feb. 9, 1984 until Dec. 1, 1990.
- The Hatters and Wildcats have played just one overtime game in the series, a 64-58 Stetson victory on Nov. 18, 2008.

LAST MEETING

- Coming off a season-opening upset victory over Wake Forest, the Hatters were their own worst enemies in a 78-66 loss at Bethune-Cookman last November. Stetson turned the ball over 21 times in the game while forcing the Wildcats into just eight. B-CU turned those turnovers into 21 points, building as much as a 17 point lead in the second half before settling for a 12-point victory. The game also featured 51 free throws, which were the product of 45 fouls called. The Wildcats were led by Holloman, who had a double-double with 14 points and 13 rebounds.

LOOKING AT THE WILDCATS

- The Wildcats return three starters from the 2010-11 MEAC championship squad that posted a 21-13 overall record that resulted in a trip to the NIT. B-CU returns senior forward Garrius Holloman, who averaged 11.5 points and 6.6 rebounds per game last year. In addition to Holloman, senior guard Stanley Elliott and junior forward Javoris Bryant return as starters. The Wildcats also have three other returning players to go with seven newcomers on the 2011-12 squad, which will be led by first-year head coach Gravelle Craig.

UP NEXT

- The Hatters will make their first road trip of the season next week for a pair of games in Tallahassee. Stetson will take on the Rattlers of Florida A&M on Monday night before facing the Florida State Seminoles on Wednesday. The game against FSU will be available online on ESPN3.com. It will be the first meeting with FAMU since 1999 in a series the Hatters lead 5-1. The Hatters trail FSU 42-11 in the all-time series that goes back to 1948 and the Seminoles have won 16 straight against Stetson.

NOVEMBERS TO REMEMBER

- Since 1900 the Hatters are 48-67 (.417) in the month of November. Last year the Hatters finished November at 2-3 (.400) with victories over Wake Forest and Savannah State and losses to Bethune-Cookman, UCF and Palm Beach Atlantic.

SCARY EXHIBITION

- The Hatters got a scare in their exhibition game against Flagler College. The Saints used a 21-0 run early in the game to build a 21-4 lead. Stetson closed the deficit to 31-26 by halftime and pulled away for a 90-72 victory.
- The game was a true tale of two halves for the Hatters, who hit just 2-of-18 from

three-point range in the first half before nailing 10-of-12 attempts in the second half.

- Sophomore guard Chris Perez and junior swingman J.R. Weston were the key contributors for the Hatters in the second half. Perez scored 13 of his game-high 19 points in the second half, including the first eight of the half for Stetson. Weston connected on 4-of-5 three-point attempts in the game, with all four makes coming in the second half.
- The Hatters finished the night with four players scoring in double figures. Behind the 19 from Perez and 16 from Weston, Stetson got 12 points off the bench from Tyshawn Patterson and 11 from starting center Adam Pegg.

LOOKING FOR SUCCESS AGAINST IN-STATE TEAMS

- The Hatters will face a total of nine in-state schools during the 2011-12 season, not counting the exhibition game against Flagler. Stetson has an all-time record against those in-state foes of 99-163.
- In addition to the nine in-state schools on the 2011-12 schedule, there are 14 other programs from inside the state of Florida that the Hatters have faced in basketball over the years. Stetson has an all-time record against the other Florida schools of 268-149.
- Overall, the Hatters have an all-time record of 367-312 against in-state foes in regular season play.
- The in-state school Stetson has played the most through the years is Rollins College. The Hatters own an all-time mark of 74-15 against the Orlando school.

STETSON ADDS NOVEMBER SIGNEES

- The Hatters are expecting to add three players during the November early signing period. One, guard **Tanner Plemmons** of Sylva, NC, has made his intentions official. Paperwork on two other signees is expected in the coming days.
- Plemmons is a 6-2 shooting guard at Rabun County (Ga.) HS where he averaged 23 points per game as a junior while hitting 42 percent from three-point range.
- Entering his senior season, Plemmons has scored 1,905 career points and has hit 298 career three-pointers.
- In addition to his basketball exploits, Plemmons is also a member of the track team and was the 2011 Wendy's High School Heisman winner for the state of Georgia.
- After the three fall signees are finalized, the Hatters are expected to have one additional scholarship to offer for the 2012-13 season.

GETTING THE STARTING NOD

- The Hatters will likely have two first-time starters when they take the floor tonight. Only returning junior **Joel Narburgs** (22 career starts), sophomore **Aaron Graham** (16), and junior **Liam McInerney** (9) have previous starting experience for Stetson.
- Even though they will be making their first starts at Stetson, sophomore guard **Chris Perez** (3 starts at Liberty) and junior center **Adam Pegg** (14 starts at Delaware) both have previous collegiate starts.
- In addition to the expected starting lineup, the Hatters have others on the roster with previous starting experience. Junior **Tyshawn Patterson** has started 23 games in his Stetson career while senior **Jermol Paul** and junior **J.R. Weston** both have one career start.

PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

- The Hatters have one player sitting out the 2011-12 season as a transfer and another who will miss the fall semester after transferring.
- Guard **Hunter Miller** joined the Stetson program from Florida Gulf Coast where he spent two seasons. Over those two years he played in 59 games for the Eagles, starting eight.
- Miller is from Nashville, but has strong family ties to central Florida. His uncle,

Mark Miller, played basketball at UCF and will bring his band, Sawyer Brown, to the Edmunds Center for a concert to benefit the Hatters basketball program on December 10.

- The other new member of the Stetson program is junior **Amara Thompson**, who transferred from UCF. Thompson should be eligible to compete for the Hatters at the conclusion of the fall semester.
- Thompson saw action in 20 games over two seasons for the Knights.

DEPARTED PLAYERS

- Stetson lost six players off the 2010-11 Hatters club. That group included the top three scorers from last year, sophomore Ridge Graham (12.6), freshman Corey Walden (12.0) and freshman Lis Jacobo (9.2).
- The other three players who left following last year were freshman Steve Forbes, sophomore Spence Purnell and senior Graeme Radford.
