ACADEMY DESCRIPTIONS

Session I - Developmental Academy - June 12-15, 2011

Ages 6 and Above

The goal of the Developmental Academy is to create a positive learning environment for each individual camper. It is through this environment that my staff and I will challenge every level of player to push their comfort zones to become a better player. Players will begin the week in their respective age groups. However, the camp staff will constantly evaluate the talent level of each camper, and may make adjustments throughout the week. This evolution is designed to challenge each camper in all aspects of their game. This camp is for female players of all levels from ages six and older. Individual technique is especially highlighted throughout the week for the younger players, with an emphasis on small group tactics for older players. Session is limited to 60 participants.

Session II - College Prep Camp - June 23-26, 2011

High School Age Elite Players

This camp is designed to give current high school age players the opportunity to experience a NCAA Division I training environment, as well as, be evaluated by the Stetson University Coaching Staff. The camp curriculum provides 18+ hours of training and 3+ hours of classroom sessions to allow prospective student-athletes the best opportunity to develop their talents and understand the true dynamics of Stetson University and its Women's Soccer Team. This camp is open to all girls currently enrolled in high school. This camp is intended for those players that have a high level of interest in playing at the Division I level. Session is limited to 48 participants.

Goalkeeper Academy

June 12-15, 2011 - Beginners age 9-13

June 23-26, 2011 - Elite ages 14-18

The Goalkeeper Academy will focus on beginning goalkeepers during Session I and elite level goalkeepers during Session II. During each session of camp, the goalkeepers will participate in functional training for the first half of the session in order to develop the individual techniques necessary to build a solid goalkeeping foundation. The 2nd half of training they will combine with the field players to put their talents to the test. This will enable all keepers to get the necessary repetitions to hone their skills and then compete in a competitive environment which involves decision making and execution. Each session is limited to 12 participants. Be sure to register as a goalkeeper for your desired session.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Will there be medical staff present? Yes! An athletic trainer will be present at all academy functions. If something needing greater attention should arise, Florida Hospital DeLand is less than 10 minutes away. Please be assured that we make every effort to ensure the health and safety of our athletes. **Each registrant must have the Guardian Statement of Approval portion of the application completed and notarized in order to participate.**

Will there be supervision? Yes! Players at the Stetson Soccer Academy have adult supervision during all camp activities. Our staff resides with the participants and is available 24 hours a day. Understand, however, that the academy is designed for players who are serious about developing their soccer talents. It is expected that athletes will conduct themselves in a disciplined manner both on and off the field. Remember - we are here to train and play soccer.

Will I need to bring any equipment? Yes! Players should bring with them: **a soccer ball**, personal items, swimsuit, alarm clock, bed linens, pillow, pillowcase, towels, washcloths, soccer shoes (new shoes can cause blisters), socks, shorts, shirts, etc. Telephone jacks are available but you must bring your own phone, calling card or cell phone. Coin operated washers/dryers are available. Please do not bring jewelry or other valuables. The academy will not be responsible for lost articles.

I am a senior, am I eligible to attend camp? Yes! In compliance with NCAA rules, seniors may attend summer camps.

Can parents and coaches come watch the sessions? Yes! All sessions are open and parents and coaches are encouraged to attend. The evening sessions will be devoted to playing games and are generally the most popular with parents. Don't forget to bring your video camera!

DIRECTIONS:

From Orlando (I-4) - Take Exit 114 onto State Road 472. Travel west (straight) for approximately five miles. Go north (toward DeLand) on 17-92. Travel through DeLand to Stetson campus. Pass school gates on right and then take a right on Pennsylvania Ave. Turn right onto Amelia ave. After the crosswalk light, turn right on Arizona and enter parking lot. Carson Hollis will be on your right.

From Daytona Beach, Miami, Jacksonville (I-95) - Take Exit 261(B) and follow Highway 92 (west) toward DeLand. At intersection of 17-92 (Friendly's & Wendy's), take left onto Woodland Blvd. Campus is 1.5 miles away. Take a left on Pennsylvania Ave. Turn right

Academy Director, Julie Orlowski

Stetson Women's Soccer Head Coach

The Stetson Girl's Soccer Academy enters its ninth year under the direction of Head Coach Julie Orlowski. In eight seasons as Stetson's head coach, Orlowski has brought the Hatters program to one of the best in the Atlantic Sun Conference.

Orlowski reached a major coaching milestone earning her 100th win on October 19, 2008. In 2006 she was honored as the Atlantic Sun Conference Coach of the Year and the Central Florida chapter of The National Intercollegiate Soccer Officials Association's (NISOA) Coach of the Year. Under her tutelage, Stetson has reached six consecutive A-Sun Tournaments, including the finals twice. Orlowski has coached two Atlantic Sun Players of the Year, two Atlantic Sun Defensive Players of the Year and 26 all-conference performers. Her ten year total of Atlantic Sun All Academic Honors has surpassed the 200 mark.

A 1991 graduate of Florida International University (B.A., mass communication) Orlowski was the starting goalkeeper all four years and team captain for three years for the Golden Panthers. She received her master's in sports administration from St. Thomas in 1995. Orlowski holds a United States Soccer Federation "B" License and is a member of the National Youth Teaching Staff for US Soccer. She is a 17 year member of the Florida Youth Soccer Association state staff and will serve on the USYS Region III Olympic Development Staff this summer.

Assistant Director, Brittany Jones

Stetson Assistant Soccer Coach

Brittany Jones is entering her fifth season as an Assistant Coach at Stetson. She is hardly a stranger to the program. Jones spent four years as a starter and 90-minute player in the Hatters back line, culminating with a first team all-conference season in 2006. Jones was also a three-year team captain.

In addition to her success on the field, Jones was highly successful in the classroom, where she earned academic all-conference honors all four years at Stetson. In 2006, she was also an NSCAA All-South Region Scholar and graduated from Stetson Magna Cum Laude with a degree in rehabilitative studies.

Jones holds a USSF National "C" license and is a member of the Florida Youth Soccer Association State Coaching Staff.
