Slow Starts=Strong Finish: Despite getting off to a 2-8 start, the Dolphins have shown the ability in the past to shake off a slow start and have a great finish.

The 2009-10 team started 1-7 before finishing with a 20-14 record and the Atlantic Sun Conference title.

Low Scoring Night: Jacksonville posted just 45 points in its loss to Winthrop, setting a new low point total in the Cliff Warren. It is the third time in the Warren era that JU has been held to less than 50 points in a game.

The 45 points vs. Winthrop is tied for the 11th lowest scoring output in program history since 1957. The fewest points in a game is 31 - done twice (1960 and 1998).

Long Streak Continues: With its win over UNF on Feb. 8, 2011 JU tied the program record for longest winning streak over one opponent - set in 1965 with the 11th straight win over Rollins.

The Dolphins have one streak active against an A-Sun rival, having won eight in a row over Kennesaw State. Here's a look at the longest winning streaks over an opponent:

BCS Busting: The Dolphins have become a thorn in the side of BCS opponents. Last year, JU was 2-1 against teams from BCS leagues - including a 2-0 mark against the SEC. The Dolphins are 0-4 this season with losses to Alabama, Florida State, Florida and Marquette.

Been a Long Time: It's been a long time since JU has allowed 100 points in a game.

Florida's 107 points is the most allowed by the Dolphins since giving up 101 to the Gators back on Dec. 18, 2005 (JU lost 101-58 to the eventual national champions).

It is only the 19th time in program history that the Dolphins have allowed 100 points.

The loss also marked JU's first loss by more than 40 points since the 2005 trip to Florida. The 45-point loss is the second-largest margin in program history, with the record being a 46-point loss to South Alabama in the 1989 Sun Belt Conference title game.

Making a Mark: With five straight winning seasons, Cliff Warren is moving up the all-time wins list at JU.

Entering tonight's game, Warren has racked up 94 wins at JU - the third highest total in program history among the 15 head coaches. He needs 14 wins to become the school's all-time winningest head coach.

Tonight's game marks the 198th of his head coaching career, placing him second on the most games coached at JU. He needs 27 more to pass Hugh Durham for the record, which will have to wait until the 2012-13 season to be broken.

One big run in the first half was the difference as Belmont held off several second half charges from Jacksonville for a 75-63 win.

Belmont used a 15-2 run over seven minutes late in the first half and got a game-high 19 points from Drew Hanlen, leading four Bruins in double figures for the win.

Jacksonville got a team-high 16 points from Aloys Cabell off the bench, but was unable to overcome a cold shooting first half. The Dolphins were 6-of-29 from the floor and just 1-of-7 in the opening half.

"The effort by our guys tonight was good," said JU head coach Cliff Warren. "We made a few mistakes there in the first half and Belmont is going to make you pay for those."

The Dolphins out scored Belmont in the second half by three after trailing at halftime, 34-19, thanks to 14-of-26 shooting. Jacksonville fell behind by as many as 20 in the second half, but rallied to cut the deficit to 12 on a Cabell 3-pointer with 14:52 left and eventually down to 11 on a Glenn Powell dunk with 42 seconds remaining.

Belmont hit a season-low four 3-pointers, with Hanlen hitting all three attempts. The Bruins though made a living at the free throw line, hitting 31-of-42 at the stripe.
