### #ASunMBB Notes

• For the second-straight week, Mercer landed at No. 14 in the CollegenInsider.com Mid-Major Poll, while USC Upstate received votes in the mid-major rankings.

• Kennesaw State's Markeith Cummings owns 1627 career points - the most among active A-Sun student-athletes. His career point total ranks 22nd all-time in the league record books. With 22 points this week, Cummings can move into 20th place.

• USC Upstate's Torrey Craig became the third active player to reach 1,000 career points as he now sits at 1,016. North Florida's Andy Diaz is next at 930 career points followed by his teammate, Parker Smith, who has 925 career points with the Ospreys.

• Several A-Sun coaches are nearing win plateaus as Lipscomb's Scott Sanderson needs four wins for 300 in his career and ETSU's Murry Bartow is 19 away from the same mark. Mercer's Bob Hoffman needs 11 more wins to reach 400.

• FGCU defeated Miami on Tuesday with a 63-51 advantage in a sold-out and record-setting crowd in Alico Arena. The Eagles' win is the A-Sun's first against an ACC team since Mercer defeated Georgia Tech last season on Dec. 22nd.

• Mercer owns a seven-game winning streak, which dates back to the CollegenInsider.com Tournament First Round vs. Tennessee State on March 13th, 2012. The Bears' win streak is tied with Stanford at the longest in the nation dating back to last season.

• North Florida's Jerron Granberry and Parker Smith both cracked the A-Sun record book for career three-pointers in their contest on Wednesday. The duo is tied for 24th most threes in A-Sun history with 201. With four more trifectas, the tandem can move into 23rd place.

• Northern Kentucky nearly won their Division I debut before falling late at San Diego. The Norse run through a gauntlet of games this week with three games in the next four days including back-to-back games on Saturday and Sunday. However, NKU doesn't play again after that until December 1st.

• Lipscomb's Malcolm Smith recorded the A-Sun's fourth double-double of the season in a win at Gardner-Webb on Wednesday with 22 points and 13 rebounds. His 22 points tied the conference game-high so far, while his 13 rebounds are the most early on in the season.

• Kennesaw State's Aaron Anderson is picking up right where he left off last season as he tallied two double-doubles to open the season. Anderson, the A-Sun Player of the Week, totaled 11 last season and leads the A-Sun with 16 career double-doubles.

• North Florida's Will Wilson dished out 12 assists in the Ospreys season-opening win. It is the most assists in the A-Sun since FGCU's Brett Comer tallied the same amount vs. Longwood on Jan. 24th.

• Through the first week of play, Stetson's Adam Pegg is leading the conference in scoring at 20.5 points just ahead of ETSU's freshman Lester Wilson at 20. Pegg's teammate Aaron Graham is third with 18.5 points/game.

• Jacksonville is leading the conference in rebounding through two games with 42 boards per game, while Mercer holds the rebounding margin advantage at plus 14.
