## MAJOR PAYNE FOR OPP.

- ◆ Dawg safety Donald Payne was named the PFL's Defensive Player of the Week following each of Stetson's first three games.
- ◆ No player has ever won that award three times in an entire season, let alone a single month, since the PFL began play in 1993.
- ◆ Last year, only four players in all of Division I were thrice named their conference's defensive Player of the Week all season.
- ◆ Payne was also named the national Freshman of the Week by TSN (The Sports Network) following the Warner game and the College Football Performance Awards' (CFPA) national Linebacker of the Week following the Birmingham-Southern game.
- ◆ In addition to Payne's awards, placekicker James LaGamma was named the PFL's co-Special Teams Player of the Week along with Mercer kicker John Shutter after the Warner game.
- ◆ Payne recorded a season-high 15 tackles in the Hatters' game against Campbell last week. He also recovered his third fumble of the year in that game, earning another PFL nomination.

## HATTER HEADLINES

- ◆ The Stetson football team returned to the gridiron this fall for the first time since the program was discontinued in 1957.
- ◆ The Hatters close the home portion of the 2013 schedule against Davidson for Homecoming. Stetson's record books do not indicate past Homecoming games, so there is no record available for the Hatters in past Homecoming games.
- ◆ Davidson is one of just three teams on the 2013 Stetson schedule that the Hatters have faced in the past. The Wildcats hold a 3-1 advantage in the series, which included wins over Stetson in each of the Hatters' final three seasons in 1954-55-56. The Hatters also previously played Birmingham-Southern and Mercer.
- ◆ Both teams come into the game this week looking to snap long losing skids. The Wildcats have lost 10 straight games since an overtime victory over Valparaiso last Nov. 10. The Hatters are looking to end a seven-game losing streak, which is just one loss shy of the longest such streak in school history. Stetson has dropped eight consecutive games on two previous occasions.
- ◆ The Stetson football roster includes three players from the state of North Carolina. Running back Dre Long is from Concord, linebacker Justin Oldja is from Matthews and offensive lineman Griffin Vari is from Davidson.
- ◆ Stetson offensive line coach and run game coordinator Terry Tilghman also has North Carolina ties. Tilghman was named this past summer as one of the top 50 offensive players of all-time at East Carolina University, where he played from 1990-94.
- ◆ Stetson's offense showed signs of life last week against Campbell, piling up 373 yards of total offense. Most of that production came from the passing game, which produced 285 yards. The Hatters failed to compile at least 100 yards rushing as a team for the third straight game.
- ◆ The Stetson defense was held without an interception against Campbell, marking the first time this year that the defense failed to record a pick. To make up for that, the Hatters posted their first safety of the year.
- ◆ The Hatters lineup with a distinctly Floridian flair. The team's roster boasts 67 homegrown student-athletes from the Sunshine State.
- ◆ Youth reigns on the roster. All but six Hatters are considered freshmen. The team boasts a junior and five sophomores, none of whom had played in a Division I game prior to this fall.

## 'Twas Fall, 1956

- ◆ NFL: The New York Giants defeated the Chicago Bears, 47-7, in the NFL Championship Game at Yankee Stadium. The Giants' Frank Gifford was league MVP.
- ◆ MLB: The New York Yankees beat the Brooklyn Dodgers in the World Series. Don Larsen threw a perfect game in Game 5 on Oct. 8. The AL MVP was New York's Mickey Mantle. The NL MVP and unified Cy Young winner was Brooklyn's Don Newcombe.
- ◆ NASCAR Grand National (Sprint Cup) Champion: Buck Baker

### ENTERTAINMENT

- ◆ Music: Elvis Presley ruled the airwaves all season. "Don't Be Cruel/Hound Dog" was No. 1 for 11 weeks until Nov. 3 when it was beaten out by "Love Me Tender".
- ◆ Movies: Major fall releases included "The Ten Commandments" (Oct. 5), "Giant" (Oct. 10) and "Around The World in 80 Days" (Oct. 17).
- ◆ TV: "I Love Lucy" topped the ratings followed by "The Ed Sullivan Show", "General Electric Theatre" and "The \$64,000 Question". Elvis made his Ed Sullivan debut on Sept. 19, famously shot from the waist up.

## HATTER CAPTAINS

The Hatter football team has voted and selected four captains for the 2013 season, DL Davion Belk, OL Fletcher Eldemire, DB Donald Payne and QB Ryan Tentler.

- ◆ Belk is a starter at defensive end for Stetson. He was a class 7A 2011 academic all-state pick for Young Magnet HS in Chicago.
- ◆ Starting center and one of the student-athletes responsible for getting the program off the ground, Eldemire enrolled in 2011 and was involved in hosting recruits.
- ◆ Payne is one of Stetson's most gifted athletes and the starter at "dawg" (strong) safety. He was a first-team all-state pick and was named Atlanta all-metro.
- ◆ Tentler was the signal caller as Stetson returned to competition vs. Warner. He threw for 8,234 career yards at St. Patrick in Chicago where he was named academic all-state.

## HEAD COACH ROGER HUGHES

- ◆ Roger Hughes is the ninth different head coach in Stetson football history.
- ◆ With Stetson's win over Warner, the nine Hatter head coaches have combined to go 7-2 in their debut contests.
- ◆ Before coming to DeLand, Hughes already had 10 years of head coaching experience, posting a 47-52 mark at Princeton from 2000-09.
- ◆ Hughes' Tigers shared the 2006 Ivy League title, going 9-1 overall and 6-1 in "the ancient eight".
- ◆ Hughes has previously served as an assistant with the Omaha Nighthawks of the UFL and collegiately at Dartmouth, Cameron, Wisconsin-Whitewater, Nebraska and, his alma mater, Doane College in Crete, Nebraska.
- ◆ Hughes graduated from Doane in 1982 after playing both football (tight end) and golf.

## ABOUT THE WILDCATS

- ◆ Davidson has been playing football since 1897, only taking off during WWII. Over 115 years the Wildcats have had four winless seasons, the last coming in 1988.
- ◆ Since joining the PFL for the 2001 season, Davidson has a 26-45 league record, including an 0-6 mark so far this year.
- ◆ The Hatters and Wildcats first met in 1912, a game Stetson won 21-6. The schools met three more times, in 1954-55-56, with Davidson winning all three contests.
- ◆ Davidson relies on the passing of QB Jonathan Carkhuff, who has thrown for 1,987 yards this year. His top target is William Morris, who has 60 catches for 945 yards.

## HATTER HISTORY

- ◆ Stetson may be playing its first season since 1956, but the program is not new.
- ◆ This marks the 49th season of play for the Hatters.
- ◆ Stetson began play in 1901, defeating the Florida Agricultural College, 6-0, on Nov. 22 (Thanksgiving Day) at the state fairgrounds in Jacksonville.
- ◆ The Hatters compiled a 155-127-27 (.545) mark in their history prior to this season.
- ◆ Stetson participated in the 1951 Tangerine Bowl, defeating Arkansas State, 35-20.
- ◆ The Hatters have claimed the Florida state championship six times (1901, 1903, 1905, 1906, 1907 and 1909).
- ◆ The program had been halted thrice before, not competing in 1915, 1917-18 (World War I) and 1941-45 (World War II).
- ◆ All four times that Stetson has missed a season of play, the Hatters won their first game upon the program's resumption, downing Rollins College in 1916, the Florida Military Academy in 1919, Troy in 1946 and Warner in 2013.
- ◆ Stetson football has produced 22 coaches and players who have been inducted into the Stetson Athletics Hall of Fame, in addition to the 1927, 1938 and 1951 teams.

SEEING RED

- ◆ Stetson has done well when backed up ranking amongst the best in the country in red zone defense.
- ◆ Defensively, Stetson ranks 12th nationally, 2nd in PFL, with a 70.0-percent (22-for-32) ratio, yielding 18 touchdowns and four field goals.
- ◆ In ideal momentum-swinging efforts, three of Stetson's 10 red zone stops this year have been on interceptions in the end zone with Chris Atkins making one against Warner and another against Marist and Donald Payne making one at Florida Tech.

SHARING THE WEALTH

- ◆ Partly as a result of having a team of freshmen needing to be evaluated, the Hatters have spread the ball around on offense.
- ◆ A total of 17 different Hatters have at least one reception through eight games.
- ◆ Four different Hatters have led the team in receiving yards through eight games played. Chris Crawford has led the team three times while Rob Coggin has been the leading receiver three times. Mike Yonker and Darius McGriff have led the team one time apiece.
- ◆ As a reflection of the diversity, Austin Marks had no catches through four games but led Stetson at Butler with three of them, good for 24 yards.
- ◆ Six different Hatters have started a game at wide receiver so far this fall.
- ◆ In the search for a consistent running attack, the Hatters have had 15 players record rushing attempts this year. Quarterback Ryan Tentler leads with 68 attempts.

STUCK IN 3RD

- ◆ Stetson's opponents have had trouble moving the chains on third down plays. The Hatters are tied for 18th nationally in third down defense at 33.3-percent (38-for-114).
- ◆ Helping this sum has been good defense on first and second down as opponents have faced third-and-long (seven yards or more) on 51.7-percent (59-of-114) of their third down attempts against the Hatters.

GIVE ME THAT!

- ◆ The Hatters have been amongst the best in the country at taking the ball away from their foes.
- ◆ Stetson is tied for 59th in the nation in turnovers gained.
- ◆ The Hatters are 31st in passes intercepted with 10.
- ◆ Unfortunately, turning the ball over has been an Achilles heel thus far. Stetson is 100th (out of 122) in turnovers lost with 20 and thus 95th in turnover margin.

A MAJOR PAYNE

- ◆ "Dawg" safety Donald Payne has made an immediate impact on the field, earning PFL defensive Player of the Week honors following each of Stetson's first three games.
- ◆ His 10 passes defended in eight games ranks him 10th in the nation. Teammate Chris Atkins ranks 18th with nine PBUs.
- ◆ Payne also ranks 43rd nationally in forced fumbles, 18th in fumbles recovered, 88th in interceptions, ninth in solo tackles and 13th in total tackles.
- ◆ As for Payne's three PFL Player of the Week performances:
- ◆ Against BSC, Payne had seven stops, 1.5 TFLs, a sack, two forced fumbles, a fumble recovery for a touchdown, an interception, a PBU and a pass pressure.
- ◆ Payne led Stetson with 14 stops at Florida Tech, intercepting a pass, breaking up four others, and sharing a tackle for loss.
- ◆ Payne also led Stetson in tackles against Warner, including two TFLs one of which was a sack. He scored the first defensive points of Stetson's new era, recovering a fumble in the end zone for a touchdown.

#HOOTYHOO

- ◆ The unusual title of the Stetson athletics magazine which serves as a football game program is a fascinating piece of Hatter history.
- ◆ At a time when the school is rediscovering football, a century-old school cheer was recently rediscovered which includes the fun phrase and convenient hash tag.
- ◆ The Stetson cheer includes beautiful linguistic relics of a foregone era, a few of which can be heard to this day in the popular Ole Miss "Hotty Toddy" cheer ("flim flam") and Texas A&M's "Aggie War Hymn" fight song ("hullabaloo").

OTHER AREAS OF NAT'L STRENGTH

- ◆ Stetson is 29th nationally in passing efficiency defense (115.61 rating).
- ◆ The Hatters are 39th nationally with 6.5 tackles for loss per game.
- ◆ Stetson is 17th nationally for fewest penalties per game at just 4.75.
- ◆ The Hatters were 46th nationally in kick-off return defense before allowing a 97 yard TD return to Campbell.

HATTER HISTORIC FIRSTS

When you are playing the first game in 57 years, there are going to be a lot of firsts. Here is a list of some of the major firsts, in chronological order.

- ◆ **First coin toss:** Won by Stetson. The Hatters deferred to the second half.
- ◆ **First kickoff:** By James LaGamma. His 51-yard kick went out of bounds resulting in ...
- ◆ **First penalty:** For a kickoff out of bounds. The Hatters were flagged on first four plays of the game (one was declined), but finished with just nine total penalties for 80 yards.
- ◆ **First tackle:** Glenn Adesoji ran down Warner receiver Vernnis Jenkins after Rodriguez connected with him for a 42-yard gain. The play was the longest gain of the game for the Royals and accounted for 21.7-percent of their entire offensive production. The long gain led to ...
- ◆ **First points allowed:** The Royals managed just two yards on the next three plays and settled for a 27-yard field goal by Connor Killeen. Warner threatened to score just once more, later in the quarter.
- ◆ **First pass and completion:** After Warner's kickoff went for a touchback, Ryan Tentler went to work. He completed his first pass to Devon Garnett for a nine-yard gain.
- ◆ **First rush:** Tentler followed his first pass with a run for 30 yards to the Warner 36 giving Stetson its ...
- ◆ **First 1st down:** The Hatters finished the game with 16 first downs to 14 for Warner.
- ◆ **First points:** After another Tentler rush for 10 yards, the Hatters bogged down and settled for a 34-yard field goal by James LaGamma with 10:53 left in the first quarter.
- ◆ **First interception:** Warner looked as if it would drive right down the field against the Stetson defense, putting together a 14-play drive that led to a first down at the Hatters' 16 yard line. The drive ended, however, when Chris Atkins picked off a Rodriguez pass in the end zone, ending the last scoring threat of the game for the Royals.
- ◆ **First punt:** Tentler quickly moved the Hatters to midfield, but Stetson's next drive stalled there, bringing in LaGamma, who pinned the Royals at their own six yard line with a 39-yard pooch punt.
- ◆ **First sack:** The Royals found the going a little tougher thanks to Billy Walsh, who stopped Rodriguez on a scramble for a one-yard loss for the first sack and tackle for loss.

- ◆ **First touchdown pass:** Tentler led the Hatters on a quick six-play drive after a poor punt by Warner left Stetson with outstanding field position at the Royals' 35. Tentler rolled to his right, hitting Rob Coggin for a seven-yard scoring strike. LaGamma tacked on the first PAT for the Hatters just in time because ...
- ◆ **First weather delay:** Lighting forced the teams from the field at 7:41 p.m. and, after a more than two hour wait during which there was heavy rain, wind and vivid flashes of lightning, the game was suspended until 3 p.m. on Sunday.
- ◆ **First fumble recovery/defensive touchdown:** After play resumed, Payne landed on an errant snap, giving the Hatters a second touchdown in 14 seconds on the clock and a huge momentum boost.
- ◆ **First blocked punt:** After the teams exchanged punts on the next two possessions, Stetson forced another Warner punt and Keegan Tanner was able to get a hand on the ball, resulting in a punt of just 17 yards.
- ◆ **First trick play:** With time running out in the first half, the Hatters faced a fourth and goal at the Warner eight. LaGamma went in to attempt a short field goal, but he and holder Nick LaSala saw an opportunity. With approval from the sideline, LaSala ran a perfect option, pitching to LaGamma, who crashed in for a touchdown. It was the first touchdown for the Stetson kicker in any level of football.
- ◆ **First turnover:** The Hatters didn't have a great start in the third quarter when Chris Crawford fumbled after catching a pass from Tentler. B.J. Jenkins recovered for the Royals, ending a Stetson scoring chance.
- ◆ The firsts were pretty much over after that. The Hatters added another touchdown on a second Tentler to Coggin pass play, this one covering 32 yards late in the third quarter. Stetson used a lot of players in the fourth quarter and failed to score in a quarter for the first time. There was one more first as the game clock wound down.
- ◆ **First ice bath:** Hatters coach Roger Hughes was doused with icy water by his players in celebration of the first Stetson victory in 57 years. Before Sunday, Stetson's last victory on the gridiron was a 64-0 victory over the University of Havana at the end of the 1956 season.
