#ASunBSB Notes

• ETSU's Clinton Freeman continues to shine for the Buccaneers as the junior leads the A-Sun in batting average (.481), slugging percentage (1.056), on-base percentage (.569), total bases (57) and homers (6). The multi-positional player also owns three wins on the mound with two saves.

• Currently, six A-Sun student-athletes are batting over .400 this season. Forty-seven hitters have batted .400 or better in A-Sun history with the last occurring in the last occurrence in 2011; Jacksonville's Adam Brett Walker (.409). Eleven players have hit for .400 since the 2008 season.

• Conference play begins this weekend with Mercer at Kennesaw State and ETSU at USC Upstate. Over the past three seasons, FGCU, Stetson and Mercer own the most league wins. The Eagles have 56 A-Sun victories ahead of the Hatters with 52 and the Bears at 48. Kennesaw State is fourth with 45.

• Through the first month of play, the A-Sun has racked up 20 wins against 2012 NCAA Tournament Participants. A-Sun teams have squared off against 15 of the 64 postseason teams and earned at least one win against eight of them. This year's 20 wins matches last year's win total of 20 vs. 2011 tournament teams.

• Mercer's David Teasley is active leader for several pitching categories among conference hurlers. The senior leads all active players in wins (23) and appearances (130). Teasley ranks second in strikeouts with 170. Teasley's 130 career appearances rank as the second-most in A-Sun history. He needs 22 more appearances to take over first place.

• Jacksonville's Chris Anderson picked up his second A-Sun Pitcher of the Week honor after striking out 10 batters in a 4-0 win vs. UCF. On the season, Anderson has already fanned 45 batters in only 31 innings pitched. Anderson's 153 career strikeouts rank fifth-most among active A-Sun student-athletes.

• North Florida's Tyler Marincov picked up the A-Sun Player of the Week honors after registering 10 RBI in four contests including a five-RBI effort vs. South Alabama. The offensive outburst propelled Marincov into a tie for fourth in the A-Sun for RBIs this season with 19.

• FGCU remained in the polls this weekend with a top ranking of No. 23 in the Collegiate Baseball Poll. The Eagles are riding a seven-game win streak dating back to March 2nd. The Eagles have only two games this coming week; Ave Maria (3/17) and FIU (3/20), before transitioning into conference play with a trip to ETSU from 3/22-24.

• Kennesaw State's James Connell owns the A-Sun lead in saves this season with four. The last two seasons, the A-Sun leader in saves has tallied 18, which is tied for the conference record. Stetson's Robbie Powell (2012) and ETSU's Bo Reeder (2011) share the A-Sun record.

• Four A-Sun teams are collectively batting over .300 for the season after one month of play; North Florida (.310), FGCU (.306), USC Upstate (.306) and ETSU (.305). Last season, only one team reached the mark for the year; Mercer (.302).

• FGCU's pitching staff has a sterling ERA of 1.79 through 16 contests, which ranks seventh in the country. The Eagles' ERA would rank as the best in conference history by 0.61 runs if the season ended today. USC Upstate is second in the A-Sun this season at 2.96, which would be the second-best ERA all-time.

• The A-Sun has two of the top-three home run teams in the nation as ETSU leads all teams by averaging 1.17 homers per game just ahead of Mercer in third place with 1.12 per outing. The two squads have finished first and second in the conference over the past three seasons for homers.

• The A-Sun owns the 10th best non-conference winning percentage among the 31 NCAA Conferences at 54.27 percent. The Atlantic Sun owns a .500 or better against 12 of the 21 conferences it has faced o far this season.

• In the latest WarrenNolan.com RPI release, two teams from the A-Sun appeared in the top-25; Mercer (22nd) and North Florida (25). Three A-Sun squads are in the top-90 as FGCU ranks 88th.
