About the Game

For the fourth time this season the Hatters will face off against a former Atlantic Sun Conference foe when Stetson hosts Georgia Southern on Thursday ... tonight's game is the 72nd meeting between the teams in a series which dates back to 1933 ... the Hatters are looking to snap a three-game losing streak ... Stetson is 2-2 at home this season, with wins over Edward Waters and Palm Beach Atlantic, and losses to FIU and IPFW.

The Coaches

Stetson's **Corey Williams** begins his second season with the Hatters this season. The 21st head coach in school history, Williams led the Hatters to a 7-24 record as a rookie. The former Florida State and Oral Roberts assistant coach was a standout at Oklahoma State, and spent parts of two seasons as a player in the NBA with the Chicago Bulls and Minnesota Timberwolves. He was a member of Chicago's 1993 NBA championship squad.

Mark Byington is in his first second as head coach at Georgia Southern. The former College of Charleston interim head coach, Byington is 20-21 with the Eagles.

About Georgia Southern

The Eagles are in their first season as members of the Sun Belt Conference after spending the previous 22 years (1992-2014) in the Southern Conference. Georgia Southern was a member of the Atlantic Sun from 1979-1992.

The current Eagles' squad enters Thursday's game following an impressive 68-63 win at USF on Monday. Senior guard Jelani Hewitt scored 33 points to lead the Eagles.

Last Time Out

Kentwan Smith scored a season-high 20 points and Stetson mounted a furious effort in the second half but the Hatters came up on the short end of a 79-69 score in a loss to Florida Atlantic, Tuesday at FAU Arena.

Smith was 9-of-12 from the field, including a pair of three-pointers. But as good as the senior forward was on Tuesday, his effort couldn't overcome Stetson's poor first half.

Florida Atlantic opened the game by scoring 16 of the game's first 18 points. The Owls (5-3) stretched the lead to 21-4 on DeAndre Johnson's three-pointer with 11:24 to play in the half. The FAU lead swelled to over 20 points for the first time when a C.J. Turman layup made it 32-11 with 7:11 to go.

The second half was a different story for the Hatters. Stetson (3-8) opened the half on a 21-7 run, pulling within 52-46 on a **Wyatt Sikora** dunk with 12:50 to play.

FAU's Solomon Poole stopped Stetson's run by scoring eight consecutive points to push the lead to 60-46, but Stetson eventually got as close as five points when Smith scored three straight baskets to get the Hatters within 65-60 with 3:20 to go.

But FAU did just enough down the stretch to deny the Hatters what would have been a near-miraculous come-from-behind win.

Florida Atlantic Leftovers

Kentwan Smith scored a season-high 20 points, the third time in his Stetson career he's scored 20 or more points ... senior center **Kyle Sikora** enjoyed the best game of his career with 11 points, six rebounds and three blocks ... Stetson shot 51.9 percent for the game, the fifth time this season the Hatters have shot 50 percent or better ... Stetson shot 50 percent or better just four times last year.

Three Dot Data

Through nine games the Hatters own a 3-8 record. They were 1-10 through 11 games a year ago ... it's early, but freshman point guard **Angel Rivera** is on pace to break the Stetson freshman record for assists ... Rivera has 48 assists in 11 games (4.4) ... the record is 115 by Terry Johnson in 1985-86 ... through 11 games Stetson's freshmen are accounting for 52.2 percent of the team's points (373 of 715) ... freshmen are leading the Hatters in the following individual categories: assists (48, Rivera), steals (12, **Divine Myles**), 3-point field goals (17, **Grant Lozoya**), 3-point percentage (.405, Lozoya), minutes (325, Myles).

Hello, My Name Is...

There is no truth to the rumor that Stetson men's basketball head coach **Corey Williams** asked his team to wear name tags to the first practice of the season. But one could hardly blame him if he had. The 2014-15 Hatters feature one of the youngest rosters in the country, with seven scholarship freshmen, one true sophomore and two red-shirt sophomores on the roster.

There are actually eight eligible first-year Hatters on the roster if you count sophomore **Cameron Harvey**, who sat out last year as a transfer from Eastern Illinois.

Mr. Smith Goes to Work

To say senior **Kentwan Smith's** season got off to a slow start would be an understatement. As Stetson's most experienced player entering the season, Smith was being counted on for not only leadership on a young team, but for production as well. However, in the first five games of the season Smith produced just 6.6 points and shot just 32.3 percent from the field.

But somewhere on Stetson's long Thanksgiving road trip Smith found his offensive groove and he now resembles the player he was thought to be this year. Over his last six games Smith is averaging 13.3 points and shooting 66.7 percent from the field, including 7-for-15 from 3-point range.

Freshmen of Influence

With such a young roster and so few upperclassmen, Stetson's freshmen are being thrown into the fray. Through the season first 10 games, all five of the Hatters' eligible freshmen (Kevin Ndahiro is redshirting) have averaged at least 13.2 minutes of playing time per game. By contrast, only six other freshmen in the Atlantic Sun Conference were averaging 12 minutes per game or more through games of Dec. 16.

My Brothers' Keeper

While it may seem unusual to have brothers **Kyle** and **Wyatt Sikora** on the roster together this season, it really isn't. Just two seasons ago Adam and Brian Pegg were on the team at the same time. However, since Stetson joined the ranks of NCAA Division I in 1971, the only other brother combination that can be confirmed by the record books is Randy Weston (1980-81) and Brad Weston (1978-82) who played together for one season.

Wilkes Inducted into College Basketball Hall

Former Stetson men's basketball head coach Glenn Wilkes was inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame last Sunday, Nov. 23, in Kansas City, Mo.

In a ceremony held at Kansas City's The Midland Theatre, Wilkes was inducted along with Shaquille O'Neal, Zelmo Beaty, Darrell Griffith, Howard Garfinkel, Gary Williams, Dale Brown, and Grant Hill.

Inductees fall into three categories: Players, Coach and Contributors.

Wilkes, who along with Garfinkel was inducted a Contributor, entered the Hall due to his extensive work as a camp instructor and author in addition to his 36 years as head coach at Stetson. He also served as Assistant Director of the Michael Jordan Basketball Camps and spent 20 years working with the Nike All-America Basketball Camps and Skills Academy.

Aside from winning 551 games and putting Stetson Athletics on the map, Wilkes is one of the founders of Sport Tours International, an organization which arranges overseas trips for basketball teams. Following his coaching career Wilkes spent 10 years as a professor at Stetson.

Harvey Named A-Sun Newcomer of the Week

Sophomore guard **Cameron Harvey** was named the Atlantic Sun Conference Men's Basketball Newcomer of the Week, the league office announced Nov. 24.

Harvey earns his first career A-Sun weekly award after scoring a career-high 22 points on 8-of-9 shooting from the field -- which included a perfect 6-for-6 effort on 3-pointers -- in Stetson's 96-85 win over Palm Beach Atlantic.

Harvey also added three assists as the Hatters made 16 threes as a team, their most since making 17 against Southeastern Louisiana in the 1993 A-Sun Tournament, and just two shy of the school record.

ESPN3 to Carry All Basketball Home Games

Stetson Athletics has partnered with the Atlantic Sun Conference and ESPN3 to broadcast every men and women's basketball home game this season as part of the conference's E3 On-Campus Initiative.

A total of 27 home games will be streamed live at ESPN3.com and on the WatchESPN app. As an added bonus, nearly every Atlantic Sun Conference road game will be carried on ESPN3 as well. In all Stetson basketball will make 41 appearances on ESPN3 during the 2014-15 regular season -- 22 for the men and 19 for the women.

Daytona Cubs Director of Broadcasting Robbie Aaron, who served the previous two seasons as Stetson men's basketball radio voice, will handle play-by-play duties for all broadcasts. He will be joined on men's broadcasts by Jim Tarabocchia and former NBA standout Tony Battie. On the women's games, Aaron will team up with former Stetson head coach Dee Romine.

Hatters Picked Eighth in A-Sun Poll

Stetson was picked to finish eighth in the Atlantic Sun

Conference's preseason poll of head coaches. Defending regular-season champion Florida Gulf Coast was chosen as the preseason favorite.

Stetson Basketball on the Radio

All Stetson basketball games can be heard throughout Volusia County on WSBB AM 1230 in New Smyrna Beach and AM 1490 in DeLand. Rookie play-by-play man Luke Mauro will be joined on most broadcasts by veteran college and NBA coach Dan Panaggio.

Hatters Sign Prep School Forward Derick Newton

Derick Newton (Beverly Hills, Calif.), a 6-7, 215-pound forward, has signed a National Letter-of-Intent to play basketball at Stetson.

Newton, who is currently spending a post-graduate year at Wilbraham & Monson Academy in Wilbraham, Mass., is Stetson's only early signee.

Newton graduated last spring from Harvard-Westlake High in Studio City, Calif., where he averaged 18.5 points, 6.6 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game in 69 career games. He earned first-team all-Division 4AA honors as a senior after averaging 19.7 points and 6.6 rebounds in 22 games.

About Stetson

Stetson University is located in DeLand, Fla., with a second campus in Gulfport, Fla. and two satellite centers. Founded in 1883 by Henry A. DeLand as the DeLand Academy and later renamed Stetson University to honor its benefactor, John B. Stetson, the university has a storied history of leadership, values and significance. The university is home to many Florida firsts, including the first collegiate newspaper, the oldest schools of business administration and music, the first college of law and was the state's first private university to integrate.

Stetson is home to 73 academic programs in four divisional areas and with undergraduate and graduate studies offered in many areas. The university is accredited by numerous accrediting agencies, including the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges, and curriculum is closely aligned with the marketplace to prepare students for life after Stetson.

Notable athletic alums include 2014 American League Cy Young Award winner Corey Kluber; 2014 National League Rookie of the Year Jacob deGrom; former NBA forward Lorenzo Williams; Atlanta Braves third baseman Chris Johnson; Ray Finkle, former Miami Dolphins kicker and later a police chief in Miami; Atlanta Falcons President & CEO Rich McKay; and ESPN reporter Britt McHenry.

Some of the more notable non-athletic alums include former actor Ted Cassidy, who played Lurch the Butler in TV's The Addams Family; composer Gerard Marino; 1960s country singer Wilma Burgess; and former Marine Corps General Roy Geiger.

HEAD COACH COREY WILLIAMS



With an NBA championship and nine NCAA Tournaments as both a player and coach on his resume, Corey Williams knows what it takes to be a winner. He also knows that it doesn't happen overnight.

Named the 21st head coach in program history on June 3, 2013 -- less than 10 weeks before the start of the school year -- Williams guided Stetson to a 7-24 record in his first season with the Hatters.

After opening his rookie season with eight consecutive games away from home, Williams earned his first career head coaching victory with a 56-52 win over Volusia County rival Bethune-Cookman on Dec. 3, 2013 in DeLand.

Williams has been blessed throughout his basketball playing and coaching career to be surrounded by and learn from some of the finest minds in the game, including Phil Jackson, Eddie Sutton, Bill Self and Leonard Hamilton.

A native of Macon, Ga., Williams played point guard at Oklahoma State. He had a lengthy career as a professional player, spending his rookie season in the NBA with the Chicago Bulls where he was a part of the 1993 NBA Championship team, before starting his coaching career.

"I'm excited," Williams said at the press conference announcing his hire. "To be able to lead this program means an awful lot to me and my family. I knew back when I first started out in this profession that my ambition was always to be a head coach. For Stetson University to give me this opportunity, I'm very grateful. I'm humbled, I'm grateful."

"Stetson University is privileged to be able to call Corey Williams our new men's basketball head coach," Stetson Director of Athletics Jeff Altier said that day. "Corey is a winner, he has worked with and played for some of the finest minds in the world of basketball and as such he understands the discipline, commitment and strategy that is needed to be successful. Everywhere Corey has played or coached his teams have won and won big, and I am excited to have him as a part of the Stetson team."

Prior to taking the reins

at Stetson, Williams spent six seasons as an assistant at Florida State. His career with the Seminoles coincided with the program's winningest five-year period, beginning in 2007-08. During this time the team won its first ACC Championship, enjoyed a school-record run of four straight NCAA Tournament appearances, four consecutive years of double digit wins in ACC play, produced five NBA Draft picks, recorded 16 wins over nationally ranked teams and appeared in the national rankings in four straight seasons.

Williams assisted in the development of the Seminoles into one of the best programs in the ACC with the perseverance that has also made him one of the nation's top recruiters. He was instrumental in Florida State's run to the 2011 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 as well as the 2012 ACC Championship.

Before joining the Florida State staff, Williams was an assistant coach for seven seasons at Oral Roberts where he aided the Golden Eagles in achieving an average of 18 wins per season, including 20 or more wins in each of his last three seasons in Tulsa. ORU captured the Mid-Continent Conference regular season and tournament titles in 2006 and 2007, advancing to play in the NCAA Tournament each season. The 2006-07 squad not only finished with a 23-11 record, but the Golden Eagles also stunned the college basketball world when they defeated then-No. 3 Kansas, 78-71, in an early-season game at legendary Allen Fieldhouse.

Williams played collegiately at Oklahoma State from 1989-1992. He finished his career eighth on OSU's career scoring charts with 1,320 points. During his collegiate playing career he helped lead the Cowboys to consecutive NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearances under Coach Eddie Sutton in 1991 and 1992. The Cowboys were ranked 14th in the final Associated Press poll of the 1991 season and 10th in the final coaches' poll following the 1992 season. With Williams in Oklahoma State's line-up for 128 games during his four-year varsity career, the Cowboys ranked as one of the top teams statistically in the nation.

Following the conclusion of his collegiate career, Williams was a second round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls, but that wasn't his only professional opportunity. Despite having not played football since junior high, the Kansas City Chiefs selected Williams in the 12th round of the 1992 NFL Draft. He was the only OSU Cowboy drafted that year.

As a rookie in the NBA, Williams was a member of the Michael Jordan-led Bulls as the franchise captured its third straight NBA title. Following his one season in Chicago, Williams played parts of the next season with the Minnesota Timberwolves, while also playing for the Oklahoma City Cavalry of the CBA. He returned to Oklahoma State as a student assistant in 1994, serving as a member of the Cowboys' staff during their 1994 Final Four campaign. Williams then played and coached professionally in Taiwan, from 1995-98.

Williams, 44, earned his bachelor's degree in education from Oklahoma State in 2002. He and his wife, Nicole, have two children: Jourdan (15) and Corey, Jr. (11).
