## HATTERS TWEETABLES

- While last week's home game against Butler was senior day for 11 members of the Stetson football who played their final college football game at Spec Martin Stadium, today's game at Jacksonville is the final college football game for them as Hatters. They are LB Jake Bartha, LB Jeb Boudreaux, DT Eddie Curry, DE Jeff Fallabel, DB Chance Jackson, DB Dre Long, DB Eric Martin, WR Jordan Sabo, WR Ja'Vonta Swinton, TE Austin Tyrrell and DT Shayne White.
- During Stetson's loss against Butler last week, junior quarterback Colin McGovern became the first Stetson quarterback to pass for over 2,000 yards in a season. He has passed for 2,058 entering today's game.
- In week ten's loss to Butler the Hatters were held to -21 yards rushing, the lowest output for Stetson since the restart of the program, and the second first time they netted negative yardage for a game this season..
- In the week eight loss at Morehead State, defensive end Eddie Curry returned an interception for a touchdown. It was Stetson's first interception return for a touchdown since Eric Martin returned one for a touchdown against Ave Maria on 11/14/15.
- with a 2-8 record entering today, Stetson will have to wait another year to finish better than .500 in a season. Since restarting the program in 2013, the Hatters' best finish was a 5-6 showing in 2014. Stetson's last season of finishing better than .500 remains 1951 when they went 8-1-2.
- Stetson's JJ Henderson returned a punt 81 yards for a touchdown in week seven against Davidson. His 81 yard return was the longest punt return in Hatter history and his touchdown was the first Stetson non blocked punt return for a touchdown. Stetson's two previous punt returns for touchdowns were at Warner (8/30/14) and at Jacksonville (11/6/13), both on blocked punts.
- Stetson's win over Brown University in week six on 10/7 snapped a five game losing streak to start the season and nine game losing streak overall.

- Before Stetson's week seven win over Davidson on 10/14/17, the Hatters last PFL win was at Campbell on 10/24/16.
- Prior to week seven's win against Davidson, Stetson had not won a home game against a Pioneer Football League opponent since beating Marist College, 22-14 on 11/8/14.
- In Stetson's week seven win over Davidson, the Hatters' Gordon Stetson had a 95 yard touchdown run, the longest TD run in Hatter history.
- Stetson's week six win over Brown marked the first time the Hatters failed to rush for 100 yards as a team, but still win the game. Stetson was 0-20 in its modern history when failing to rush for 100 yards in a game as a team.
- In the week five loss at Valpo, Colin McGovern passed for a career-high 383 yards, completed 35 passes on a career-high 52 attempts to set Hatter records for most in a game in all three statistical categories.
- After going the first five games without making an interception, the Hatters have recorded four interceptions in the last five games. Sophomore linebacker Colby Duncan has made two, while graduate defensive back Dre Long and graduate defensive end Eddie Curry have had one each.
- In the Hatters' week five win against Brown, quarterback Colin McGovern ran for two touchdowns. It was the first time a Stetson quarterback ran for multiple touchdowns in a game.
- In the week five game at Valparaiso, Stetson outgained its opponent for the first time this season, holding a 450-303 advantage in total yards. It is still the only game so far this season that the Hatters have outgained their opponents.
- After allowing an average of over 245 rushing yards per game through the first four games, Stetson held week five opponent Valparaiso to just 49 yards rushing, which set a Stetson record for fewest rushing yards allowed in a game by the Hatters. The previous low by an opponent was 53 at Valpo on 10/24/15.
- Former Stetson standout Donald Payne made his NFL debut on September 10th for the Jacksonville Jaguars in a win over the Houston Texans. The three-time PFL defensive player of the year is one of five former PFL players currently on NFL active rosters. Payne is the only rookie in that group.
- Overall, Stetson had 24 players make their collegiate debuts in the season opening game at Sacred Heart. That group included 10 true freshmen, 10 redshirt freshmen and four others.
- In the Hatters' win over Brown in week five, three Hatters made their first NCAA starts, including wide receivers Bensley Bornelus and Jordan Sabo, along with linebacker Tyler Mirabella.
- In Stetson's week five win over Brown, it was the first time all season the Hatters led after each quarter. The last time Stetson led at the end of each quarter of a game was against

- Warner on 9/10/16.
- Stetson's home win over Brown in week five was the first home win for Stetson since beating Warner College 30-15 on 9/10/16. It was the Hatters' first home win against an NCAA Division I team since 11/8/14 when they beat Marist College at Spec Martin Stadium.
- After making one catch the entire season, Bensley Bornelus was Stetson's leading receiver with eight catches in the week five win over Brown.
- In the game against Dartmouth in week three, Colin McGovern found freshman receiver Justin Jordan for a touchdown. It was the first passing touchdown in McGovern's NCAA career and the first receiving touchdown in Jordan's NCAA career.
- In the week four loss to Campbell, Stetson players including junior wide receiver Ja'Vonta Swinton, freshman wide receiver Bensley Bornelus and freshman running back Gordon Stetson all scored their first NCAA touchdowns.
- While Stetson has a group of five players who serve as captains for the 2017 season, the four players who went to midfield for the coin toss at Sacred Heart were the four closest friends of Nick Blakely. That group included redshirt freshmen JJ Henderson and Jeremiah Nails along with sophomores Cam Adams and Reggie Gantt.
- The Hatters were held to just three points in the loss to Sacred Heart, the first time Stetson has been held to just a field goal since Sept. 26, 2016 in a 41-3 loss at Drake.
- Backup quarterbacks Cole Martin (1) and Nick Andreas (3) both made starts during the 2016 season, which saw Stetson use five players at QB.
- Stetson has never returned a kickoff for a touchdown.
- The Hatters are 5-8 in games decided by a touchdown or less (7 points) since restarting the program in 2013.
- The Hatters have won just as many games away from home (8) than at home (8) since the start of the 2013 season.
- Almost half of the players on the Stetson squad to open the season came from the state of Florida (50). In addition to the Sunshine State the Hatters hail from 17 other states and one US Territory. Behind Florida, Georgia (18) and California (5) are the most represented states on the roster.
- The Hatters have five captains for the 2017 season: LB Jeb Boudreaux, RB Arkee Brown, DE Jeff Fallabel, DB Dre Long and QB Colin McGovern.
- The Sacred Heart game was the first for Stetson in which no players from the original team in 2012 were on the roster.
- For the first time since restarting the program, the entire Stetson schedule consists of NCAA Division I opponents.
- Stetson was held to less than 100 yards rushing as a team in nine of 10 games this season and rank 121st of 123 FCS teams in rushing yards per game. The Hatters have failed to

rush for at least 100 yards in a game in 24 of 55 games since restarting the program. Not surprisingly, the Hatters are 1-23 in those games and 15-16 in all other games. Stetson's week six win over Brown marked the first time the Hatters did not rush for 100 yards but still won the game.

- Eight of the 10 lowest rushing outputs in Stetson's history since restarting the program in 2013 have come this season. The Hatters' highest rushing output this season was 118 yards against Davidson in week seven, the only time this season Stetson had over 100 yards rushing. Here is a look at the games when the Hatters were held to less than 100 yards on the ground.

- On the flip side, the Hatters have rushed for more than 200 yards in a game five times over the last four plus seasons. Stetson is 3-2 in those games.

- Extremes in passing yards in a game does not provide an accurate measure of success for the Hatters. Stetson has failed to throw for at least 100 yards in a game six times, and is 0-6 in those games. The Hatters have passed for more than 200 yards in a game 24 times, but are just 7-17 in those games.
- Over 55 games, the Hatters have scored defensive or special teams touchdowns 16 times. Amongst current players, Eric Martin has two, while Eddie Curry, JJ Henderson and Shayne White have one each. The Hatters have also posted two safeties, one in 2014 and one in 2016 against Valpo.

## The Coaching Staff

- The 2017 season mark's head coach Roger Hughes' 32nd season of college football. He joins linebackers coach Bob Majeski to have reached three decades of college coaching.
- Roger Hughes is the ninth different head coach in Stetson football history. He has a career record of 63-91 in 13 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- With Stetson's 2013 win over Warner, the nine Hatter head coaches have combined to go 7-2 in their debut contests.
- Before coming to DeLand, Hughes already had 10 years of head coaching experience, posting a 47-52 mark at Princeton from 2000-09.
- Hughes' Tigers shared the 2006 Ivy League title, going 9-1 overall and 6-1 in "the ancient eight".
- Hughes has previously served as an assistant with the Omaha Nighthawks of the UFL and collegiately at Dartmouth, Cameron, Wisconsin-Whitewater, Nebraska and, his alma mater, Doane College in Crete, Nebraska.
- Hughes graduated from Doane in 1982 after playing both football (tight end) and golf. His daughter, Maddison, is in her senior season as a member of the women's golf team at Doane.
- Jacob Behrns is back for his fourth season with the Hatters. He coached tight ends in 2014, but led the receivers in 2015 and 16. A graduate of Wayne State, Behrns also has a degree from the Arizona Culinary Institute.
- Nolan Behrns returns for his sixth year at Stetson where he serves as the Director of Football Operations and also works with the Hatters kickers. He was the first person hired by Hughes when he agreed to take the job of building the new Stetson program from scratch in 2011.
- Brian Boerboom came to Stetson in 2015 from Southeast Missouri State, where he had served as offensive line coach for eight seasons. Boerboom played collegiately for Tom Osborne at the University of Nebraska where he was an All-Big Eight selection. His son, Jacob, is a linebacker for the Hatters.
- Matt Diniak returns for his fourth year as running backs coach. He played collegiately at Grand Valley State for current Notre Dame head coach Brian Kelly and got his coaching start as a member of Kelly's staff in 2001. He

## Season Dedicated to Memory of Nick Blakely

Nick Blakely had an infectious smile, the spirit of a competitor and was looking forward to playing in his first Hatter football game on Sept. 2.

The 19-year-old accounting major had complained about being light-headed Monday evening and was on the sidelines being monitored by athletic trainers when he collapsed.

The trainers performed CPR on him until paramedics arrived. He was taken to Florida Hospital DeLand, where he passed away.

The Hatter football team and hundreds of others from the Stetson Community gathered on Tuesday, just hours after his passing, to remember Blakely.

Wearing black stickers with Blakely's number 37, the crowd overflowed from the auditorium as they held hands, prayed and embraced.

"I saw what it meant to be a Hatter last night," Head Coach Roger Hughes told the students, faculty and staff. "When a tragedy like this hits part of our family, we come together as a family. We come together to support each other ... to feel the spirit that makes us Stetson Hatters."

Football practice was canceled and flags were lowered to half-staff on the Stetson campus in Blakely's honor. A campus memorial service was

held on Thursday, August 31.

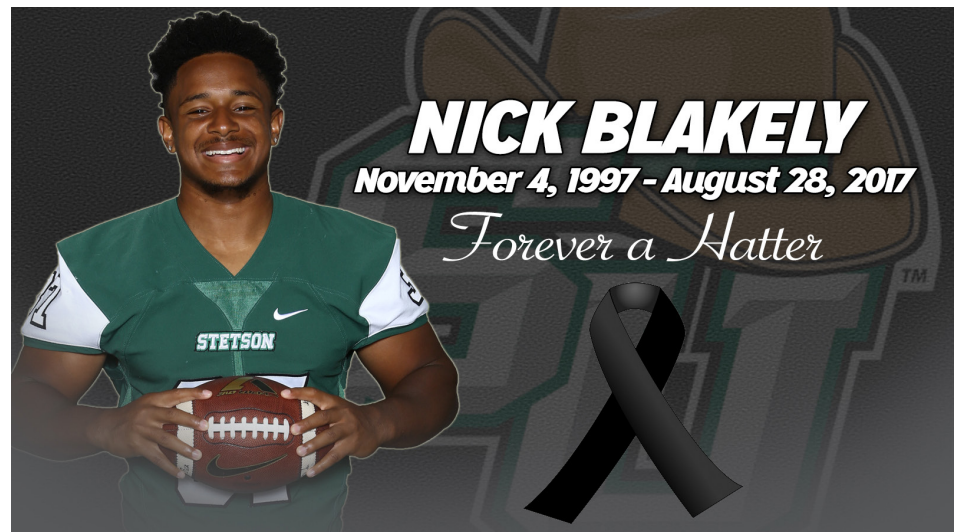

Social media was filled with kind words and condolences for Blakely. In one tweet posted Monday night, fellow teammate Matt Andreas said Blakely spoke with another player just hours before his death and said, "I'm not much of a traveler, but I'd sure like to go to heaven."

"Stories like this only confirm God," Andreas, a freshman receiver on the team, tweeted Monday night. "Literally gives me chills just thinking of it."

The Hatters will play the 2017 season with helmet stickers emboldened with NB. Several other Stetson teams will also wear stickers this year.

spent four seasons working for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers as an offensive scout.

- Jonathan Johnson is in his second season as defensive line coach for the Hatters. He came to Stetson in 2016 from Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College where he filled a variety of roles, including equipment manager and facility manager in addition to coaching the offensive line, tight ends and full backs.
- Bob Majeski is a member of the three-decade club for the Hatters. He returns to coach linebackers while also working to coordinate the Hatters' special teams. Majecki played collegiately at Kansas State and has worked in virtually every capacity possible as a coach, including multiple stops as a head coach at the junior college level, earning Jayhawk Conference Coach of the Year honors in 2010.
- Clay Mazza is in his second season as a full-time member of the coaching staff as the tight end coach. Prior to being a full-time coach, Mazza worked for two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach with the Hatters. He graduated from Lenoir Rhyne University and was a three year member of the football team. While there, the team won the conference championship each year and went to the national championship game in 2013.
- Cliff Odom is the lone new member of the Hatters coaching staff in 2017, serving as defensive backs coach. A native of Arlington, Texas, Odom worked as a graduate assistant for the University of Missouri in 2016 and Texas Christian University in 2015. As an undergraduate, he played four seasons at Baylor University and was team captain for three. He is the son of Cliff Odom, Sr., who played linebacker in the NFL for 13 seasons with the Cleveland Browns, Baltimore / Indianapolis Colts and Miami Dolphins. He is a finalist for the American Football Coaches Association, 35 Under 35 Leadership Institute. The winners for that award will be announced in early December.
- Defensive coordinator Brian Young was the first on-field coaching hire for Hughes and he has been a steady force on the staff from the very first day. Also a former player at Georgia Southern, Young played in the arena leagues before starting his coaching career and has had stops at Mississippi College and Cornell before joining the Stetson staff.

## Hatters History

- The 2017 season marks the 53rd overall season of play for Stetson football. The Hatters have an all-time record of 174-171-27.
- Stetson began play in 1901, defeating the Florida Agricultural College, 6-0, on Nov. 22 (Thanksgiving Day) at the State fairgrounds in Jacksonville.
- The Hatters compiled a 155-127-27 (.543) mark in their history prior to discontinuing the program following the 1957 season.
- Stetson participated in the 1951 Tangerine Bowl, defeating Arkansas State, 35-20.
- The Hatters claimed the Florida state cham-

pionship six times (1901, 03, 05, 06, 07 and 09).

- The program had been halted three times before, not competing in 1915, 1917-18 (World War I) and 1941-45 (World War II) in addition to 1957-2012.
- All four times that Stetson has missed a season of play, the Hatters won their first game upon the program's resumption, downing Rollins College in 1916, the Florida Military Academy in 1919, Troy in 1946 and Warner in 2013.
- Stetson football has produced 22 coaches and players who have been inducted into the Stetson Athletics Hall of Fame, in addition to the 1927, 1938 and 1951 teams.

## Noting the Hatters

- LB Jeb Boudreaux is the lone returning Hatter who was named to the All-Pioneer League team last season. He also led the team and Pioneer Football League in tackles in 2016 with 116.
- After sitting out last season with injury, Colin McGovern is the starting quarterback this season. Last season, the Hatters had three different starting quarterbacks (Nick Andreas, Gaven DeFilippo, Cole Martin)
- RB Arkee Brown was the leading rusher last season amongst the returning running backs this season with 137 yards.
- TE Donald Parham led the Hatters in receiving touchdowns in 2016 with six and was one of only two Hatters to amass more than 100 yards receiving in a game during the 2016 season. He had 109 yards receiving against Marist (11/5/16). He has looked very impressive during the 2017 preseason camp, and is expected to be a big part of the offense this season.
- LB Jacob Boerboom is the son of offensive line coach Brian Boerboom and is one of six children.
- Five members of the 2017 Hatters are enrolled as graduate students (Jeb Boudreaux, Eddie Curry, Dre Long, Austin Tyrell and Shayne White).
- DB Eric Martin is the only returning Hatter to have more than one interception last season. He had two interceptions in 2016 along with six pass breakups.
- WR Luke McDermott, who redshirted last season, was originally a quarterback but made the switch last season.
- Despite being located in DeLand, the Hatters have just two players who attended DeLand High School (Jackie Johnson and Austin Tyrell).
- FB Tony Gilotti is the only Hatter from Volusia County not from DeLand. He is a resident of Orange City and attended University HS.
- PK Jonny Messina redshirted last season, but has already proven his ability to kick from distance. He successfully connected on a 51 yard field goal attempt during a team scrimmage at preseason camp.
- QB Gaven DeFilippo, who is redshirting this season, led the Hatters last season in completions (131), passing yards (1,272) and touchdown passes (9).

## Quoting Hatters Coach Roger Hughes

## Thoughts on the Butler Game:

Words cannot describe the frustration. If it were just one problem you can fix right away it's one thing, but there seems to be a multitude of problems that appear at different times. For example, there's not just one person missing all the blocks or one running back not running the right pattern, or one receiver not running the right route. It seems like 'a' person might be doing something wrong on certain plays. It's frustrating one time when you seen them do it very well, like the drive where we scored the touchdown, we did everything well, then we turn around and we couldn't sustain a drive the rest of the game, and that is extremely frustrating. There are also a lot of mechanical things that not always where they are supposed to be like the bad snap on the punt, a motion penalty on a third and five that made it a third and ten. It's a combination of things that are leading to our lack of production. And there have been numerous times this year where it's been third and eight and we pick up seven. Too many times we fall a yard short, which prevents us from sustaining a drive.

On one side you expect the defense to play well and they did. There were a few times they had to defend bad field position and still prevented Butler from scoring. I thought the defense got stronger as the game went on, and they got more confident as the game went on. What I was really pleased with is how all season our Achilles heel has been our inability to stop the quarterback run, but in this game we shut that down. We shut down every aspect of it, and we did really well, against a team that can score a lot of points. So anytime you play great defense, you have a chance to win the game regardless of how good or bad your offense is. Whenever I have built a program, the defense has always been where my concentration is. With that said, we're at the point where our offense has to get more productive and it hasn't and it has revolved around the running game. We have not been able to run the ball effectively all year long, and that's extremely frustrating because generally we approach the game as OK, you have two downs to pick up about eight yards. Once you get to third down, you have a much better chance to get that first down if it's third and two or third and three. About eighty-five percent of the time teams get the first down off a third and short. If you can't run the ball for four yards or more, you're behind the chains all the time and therefore you're ability to convert third downs decreases dramatically because you have a much longer distance to go. You go from an eighty-five percent to about a fifty percent chance, so that has been a problem for us. Creating third down and short situations to make getting a first down more manageable has been an issue for us.

## Morale of the team as the season comes to a close:

The morale has been phenomenal. Watching them at practice, you would think they are preparing for a national championship. I think our guys understand the only way to have a chance to get the results they want on Saturday is to put in the preparation during the week, and they have

handled themselves like professionals. There is not one person in this program who is happy with where we are at right now, nor is there one person in this program who expected us to be where we are at right now. And when you have a lot of disappointments, it's easy to let little things slide, and that is one thing our team hasn't done. And they're still practicing to get better every day. And that has been our mantra, to make yourself better and to make your teammates better everyday at practice and that is what I have been seeing this week.

### **The importance of the game against Jacksonville:**

Certainly Jacksonville over the past ten years has had the kind of success we would like to have, like playing for championships. They have done a good job having perennial winning seasons. We also overlap a lot with them recruiting wise, so the game, because of its geographic location, and how we overlap with the kind of kids we look to recruit are some of many reasons to see this game as important. With that said, for this to become a rivalry type game, we have to win. It's hard to say this is our big rival if you have never had a win against them, so certainly a win for us would be a big win for the program. Certainly it would be great for the kids and a great to springboard into the offseason. Certainly ending the year with a win would leave a better taste in your mouth. I think for all those reasons in addition for personal pride, being the competitors we are, are all the reasons why this game is important.

### **Scouting report on Jacksonville:**

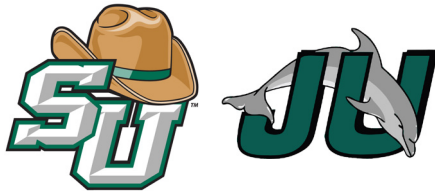
Offensively they do a great job. They run an offense we don't see all the time. It's a little more difficult, and they have a good quarterback who is great at running the ball, distributing the ball and making the right reads and making your defense pay for any mistakes. They run the ball very effectively, which means you don't get many possessions. So it can be difficult to produce points on them when you don't have the ball enough. The game is simple, if you have the ball, keep it, and if you don't, get it! The type of team Jacksonville is, when they have the ball they keep it, and you don't get it back very fast.

Defensively, they're a quick multiple front, they use a lot of three and four man fronts, they like to bring pressure both from the edges, and safeties. Their secondary is very aggressive. They do a great job of giving them a seventh or eighth person in the box that allows them to outnumber you at the point of attack. Their linebackers run very well, so it's very hard to outflank them, or out run them. They force you to take them on head up and see if you can beat them inside. They are very solid in the kicking game, they have run a few fakes, so they do some things that make you pay attention. In a game like this, the special teams can be huge. If you can create a shorter field for our offense, it will create a greater chance for us to get some points on the board. It all comes down to producing points, and hopefully we can put up some more points than we have recently.

### **On the seniors:**

It's a special group. They have done a great job of establishing the culture that will lead this program to becoming successful. They have done a great job of holding each other accountable. They have taken ownership of their own mistakes, not looking to blame anybody else, and working on fixing what they have to fix. The reason why these guys have taken such a mature and professional approach is they were some of the first guys to get in on the leadership training that we've done within the athletics department and within the football program. I think they benefited from that greatly. They have really shown our underclassman a level of professionalism and commitment that's necessary to establish a winning foundation.
