UNDER THE HAT

•Stetson placed six players in double figures for the first time this season in Monday's win over Florida National. B.J. Glasford (16), Divine Myles (15), Angel Rivera (15), Luke Doyle (14), Abayomi Iyiola (12), and Christiaan Jones (10) all reached double digits.

•The Hatters' bench tallied 34 points against FNU, as Iyiola and Jones combined for 22 of those points. Stetson's reserves have scored 20 or more points in seven straight games.

•Divine Myles tied former Hatter Garfield Blair (2005-09) at No. 4 on the career scoring list. Both players now have 1,582 career points.

•After going 0-for-12 from three-point range in three straight games, Luke Doyle is 6 of 13 from the arc in the last two contests

About the Game

•The Hatters begin their 32nd season of play in the ASUN Conference on Saturday. Stetson has been a member of the ASUN since the 1986-87 season and the Hatters are currently the longest tenured league member.

•The Hatters are 241-291 (.453) all-time in ASUN regular season games

•Saturday's game is the 25th meeting all-time between Stetson and FGCU, with the Eagles owning a 17-7 advantage. Stetson has lost three straight to FGCU, including an 87-57 defeat in last season's ASUN Tournament quarterfinals

•The two teams are meeting for the third straight time in Fort Myers. Last year's regular-season finale and ASUN Tournament meetings were also at Alico Arena.

Chasing History

Seniors **Divine Myles** and **Angel Rivera** have an opportunity this season to cement their status as the greatest back court tandem in program history by breaking a pair of long-standing career records.

Myles enters Saturday's game with Florida National needing 245 points to become Stetson's all-time leading scorer. With 1,582 points, Myles is well within range of Kerry Blackshear's (1992-96) all-time mark of 1,826 points. Myles is the ASUN Conference's active career scoring leader and is currently 31st all-time in league history.

Rivera is on track to become Stetson's all-time leader in assists. The ASUN leader a year ago, Rivera has 506 career assists, and is 21 shy of breaking the record of 526 set by Frank Ireland (1987-91). He is currently 14th on the ASUN career list.

The 1,000-Point Club

Last season was a historic one for the Hatters in terms of 1,000-point scorers as Brian Pegg, Derick Newton and **Divine Myles** all reached the milestone. This season might be no different.

Seniors **Luke Doyle** and **Angel Rivera** both figure to knock on the door of Club 1000 by season's end.

Doyle enters Saturday's game with 828 points and is 172 points shy with at least 16 games remaining on the schedule.

Rivera, whose career scoring average is 7.4 points per game, has a little more work to do as he needs 189 points to reach 1,000. Rivera's season high is the 240 points he scored last year.

Myles Named Preseason All-ASUN; Hats Picked Sixth

Stetson's **Divine Myles** was named preseason all-conference and the Hatters were picked to finish sixth in the league's annual Men's Basketball Preseason Poll, the ASUN Conference office announced in late October.

Myles, a 5-11 senior, was one of ten players to make the preseason team. As a junior last year, Myles averaged 16.5 points, 4.7 rebounds and 3.9 assists per game while shooting 51 percent overall from the floor, 39 percent from 3-point range and 71 percent at the free throw line.

The Hatters were picked to finish sixth in the eight-team ASUN. Stetson was 11-21 last season, including 3-11 in conference play. In addition to Myles, the Hatters feature returning starters Luke Doyle, Angel Rivera and Larry Dennis.

Iyiola Named ASUN Newcomer of the Week

Stetson freshman Abayomi Iyiola has been named ASUN Conference Newcomer of the Week, the league announced on Nov. 13.

Iyiola, a 6-9 forward from Atlanta, Ga., averaged 16.0 points and 9.5 rebounds as Stetson opened the 2017-18 season with wins in its first two games. He shot 60 percent from the field (15-25) in the two games.

In addition to home games on ESPN3, a total of 12 home games will also be carried on longtime radio partner WSBB AM 1230 & 1490.

Luke Mauro begins his fourth season as the radio voice of the Hatters. Mauro, who is also a member Stetson football's radio broadcast team, is the Director of Communications

and lead play-by-play voice for the Daytona Tortugas Single-A baseball team.

About Stetson

Stetson University is located in DeLand, Fla., with a second campus in Gulfport, Fla. and two satellite centers. Founded in 1883 by Henry A. DeLand as the DeLand Academy and later renamed Stetson University to honor its benefactor, Philadelphia hat maker John B. Stetson, the university has a storied history of leadership, values and significance. The university is home to many Florida firsts, including the first collegiate newspaper, the oldest schools of business administration and music, the first college of law and the state's first private university to integrate.

Notable athletic alums include two-time American League Cy Young Award winner Corey Kluber; 2014 National League Rookie of the Year Jacob deGrom; Jacksonville Jaguars special teams ace Donald Payne; former NBA forward Lorenzo Williams; Ray Finkle, former Miami Dolphins kicker and later a police chief in Miami; Atlanta Falcons President & CEO Rich McKay; and college basketball Hall of Fame member Dr. Glenn Wilkes.

Some of the more notable non-athletic alums include former actor Ted Cassidy, who played Lurch the Butler in TV's The Addams Family; composer Gerard Marino; 1960s country singer Wilma Burgess; and former Marine Corps General Roy Geiger.

HEAD COACH COREY WILLIAMS

Williams was named the 21st head coach in program history on June 3, 2013 -- less than 10 weeks before the start of the school year.

"I'm excited," Williams said at the press conference announcing his hire. "To be able to lead this program means an awful lot to me and my family. I knew back when I first started out in this profession that my ambition was always to be a head coach. For Stetson University to give me this opportunity, I'm very grateful. I'm humbled, I'm grateful."

"Stetson University is privileged to be able to call Corey Williams our new men's basketball head coach."

Stetson Director of Athletics Jeff Altier said that day. "Corey is a winner, he has worked with and played for some of the finest minds in the world of basketball and as such he understands the discipline, commitment and strategy that is needed to be successful. Everywhere Corey has played or coached his teams have won and won big, and I am excited to have him as a part of the Stetson team."

Williams has been blessed throughout his basketball playing and coaching career to be surrounded by and learn from some of the finest minds in the game, including Phil Jackson, Eddie Sutton, Bill Self and Leonard Hamilton.

A native of Macon, Ga., Williams played point guard at Oklahoma State. He had a lengthy career as a professional player, spending his rookie season in the NBA with the Chicago Bulls where he was a part of the 1993 NBA Championship team, before starting his coaching career.

Prior to taking the reins at Stetson, Williams spent six seasons as an assistant at Florida State. His career with the Seminoles coincided with the team's winningest five-year period, beginning in 2007-08. During this time the team won its first ACC Championship, enjoyed a school-record run of four straight NCAA Tournament appearances, four consecutive years of double digit wins in ACC play, produced five NBA Draft picks, recorded 16 wins over nationally ranked teams and appeared in the national rankings in four straight seasons.

Williams assisted in the development of the Seminoles into one of the best programs in the ACC with the perseverance that has also made him one of the nation's top recruiters. He was instrumental in Florida State's run to the 2011 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 as well as the 2012 ACC Championship.

Before joining the Florida State staff, Williams was an assistant coach for seven seasons at Oral Roberts where he aided the Golden Eagles in achieving an average of 18 wins per season, including 20 or more wins in each of his last three seasons in Tulsa. ORU captured the Mid-Continent Conference regular season and tournament titles in 2006 and 2007, advancing to play in the NCAA Tournament each season. The 2006-07 squad not only finished with a 23-11 record, but the Golden Eagles also stunned the college basketball world when they defeated then-No. 3 Kansas, 78-71, in an early-season game at legendary Allen Fieldhouse.

Williams played collegiately at Oklahoma State from 1989-1992. He finished his career eighth on OSU's career scoring charts with 1,320 points. During his collegiate playing career he helped lead the Cowboys to consecutive NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearances under Coach Eddie Sutton in 1991 and 1992.

Following the conclusion of his collegiate career, Williams was a 2nd-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls, but that wasn't his only professional opportunity. Despite having not played football since junior high, the Kansas City Chiefs selected Williams in the 12th round of the 1992 NFL Draft. He was the only OSU Cowboy drafted that year.

As a rookie in the NBA, Williams was a member of the Michael Jordan-led Bulls as the franchise captured its third straight NBA title. Following his one season in Chicago, Williams played parts of the next season with the Minnesota Timberwolves, while also playing for the Oklahoma City Cavalry of the CBA. He returned to Oklahoma State as a student assistant in 1994, serving as a member of the Cowboys' staff during their 1994 Final Four campaign. Williams then played and coached professionally in Taiwan, from 1995-98.

Williams, 46, earned his bachelor's degree in education from Oklahoma State in 2002. He and his wife, Nicole, have two children: Jourdan (18) and Corey, Jr. (14).

STETSON'S DIVINE MIRACLE

Divine Miracle Myles is his given name, and he most certainly earned it.

He earned it because he wasn't supposed to live. His mother's pregnancy was wrought with complications. Doctors were so certain he was going to be stillborn they almost threw him away after he was delivered. But the Stetson freshman -- and a higher power -- had other ideas.

Myles' mother, Tonya, was 20 years old when she was pregnant with Divine. It was a difficult pregnancy, and Tonya was told by her physicians her son would likely be stillborn. Their tests indicated she wouldn't carry him to full term. They said Divine didn't have a nose or a mouth, that his eyes, lungs and heart weren't developed. Doctors also cautioned that if he survived, he would be mentally retarded, without any motor skills of any kind, and he would be dependent upon his family for the rest of his life.

On Feb. 25, 1996, at just 24 weeks, Tonya went into labor. Divine was delivered via C-section and when he was removed from his mother's womb, Divine stunned them all.

"On the day I was born I was still in the amniotic sac and they were about to dispose of me," said Myles. "But God intervened and I kicked the bag open and began crying and screaming. When I was born I was whole. I was a healthy baby."

Shocked at what they were seeing, nurses immediately asked the doctor to place a breathing tube in the newborn. But the delivery doctor resisted and instead told nurses to check Divine's Apgar score, a procedure used to assess the health of a newborn child. Divine tested at the top of the chart.

Despite what his family called a miracle birth, doctors believed Divine still had a long road of recovery ahead of him. They insisted he be placed into a series of courses and classes designed to stimulate him both physically and mentally. For three years, Divine attended those classes until his mother decided he didn't need them anymore.

"I was 2 or 3 years old when I was in those classes, and I was ahead of all of the other kids," he said. "The doctors kept telling her I needed to go to the classes. But my mom said I was fine and she stopped taking me. She continued to work with me at home. The only effect I've had from any of this is that I had stiff bones as a child but I grew out of that."

It isn't hard to imagine that the series of events immediately before and after his birth have had a profound impact on Divine. A deeply religious young man, Divine believes the faith that he and his family hold so dear had a lot to do with not only his initial survival, but how he's thrived as well.

"We talk about it a lot because it's a big testimony in my life," he said. "My mom reminds me every so often how blessed I am, and that God has a purpose for me and has great things in store for me. That's why my middle name is Miracle. No man on Earth could get me through this. It was all God."

Myles went on to lead a perfectly normal childhood and developed into one of Alabama's top prep players at Blount High School, helping lead the Leopards to a 27-4 record and runner-up finish in the 2014 Alabama 6A state tournament. Now in his fourth season with the Hatters, Myles has started all but two games. As he begins his senior year at Stetson, Myles is on pace to become the Hatters' all-time leading scorer.

And while every student-athlete has their share of challenges, Myles isn't likely to be fazed by a hostile crowd or a larger opponent. He's already faced down the biggest challenge of his life... and it's a Miracle he came out on top.
