THE MATCH-UP: Marist opens Pioneer Football League play with a trip to Florida to take on Stetson. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m.

HOW TO FOLLOW US: **Geoff Brault** (play-by-play) and **Mike Ferraro** (color) will have the call on Z-93 (93.3 FM) in the Hudson Valley. The pregame show will begin at 12:45 p.m. The game can also be listened to for free on iHeartRadio. The game will be carried live on ESPN+, with **Evan Weston** (play-by-play) and **Robert Goldberg** (color) on the call. Live game updates will be available on Twitter via Marist Athletics (@MaristAthletics) and Marist Football (@Marist_Football).

MARIST IN THE NFL: **K Jason Myers** (2009-12) is the New York Jets' placekicker. Myers previously kicked for the Jacksonville Jaguars from 2015-17. Through the Jets' first two games of the season, Myers is 4-for-4 on field goal attempts with a long of 55, 6-for-7 on extra point attempts, and has 12 touchbacks in 13 kickoffs.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION FOR BARRETT: Red-shirt senior LB **Willie Barrett** was one of 25 named to the Watch List for the Buck Buchanan Award, which is presented to the best defensive player in the Football Championship Subdivision. Barrett was a First Team All-Pioneer Football League selection in 2017.

OUR LEADERS: Marist has four captains this season: fifth-year senior LB **Willie Barrett**, fifth-year senior FS **Wesley Beans**, red-shirt sophomore LB **Grant Dixon**, and junior C **Dan Wittekind**. Before this year, the Red Foxes had just two captains who were selected before their fourth year in the program in head coach **Jim Parady's** tenure. That total doubled with the selections of Dixon and Wittekind.

ABOUT STETSON: The Hatters are 2-0 on the season, with victories against Point and Waldorf. Stetson's scheduled home game against Presbyterian this past weekend was canceled due to Hurricane Florence. The Hatters were picked to finish ninth in the PFL Preseason Poll, with CB **J.J. Henderson** earning Preseason All-PFL honors. Freshman RB **Jareem Westcott** has scored a team-high four touchdowns. Junior S **Reggie Gantt** has a team-high 10 tackles plus a forced fumble, fumble recovery, and blocked kick.

Jim Parady, who has guided the Marist football program through over a quarter-century of growth, is in his 27th season as the program's head coach and 28th overall with the Red Foxes. He also coaches the team's quarterbacks.

Entering the 2018 season with 133 victories, Parady is the winningest coach in program history. He has made Marist a force to be reckoned with at the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), formerly known as I-AA, level. During his tenure, Parady has coached conference championship teams and has had student-athletes excel both on and off of the playing field. The Red Foxes have made the jump from Division III to FCS status, moved into a newly-renovated stadium, won four league championships and joined the Pioneer Football League on Parady's watch.

Three former Marist football players have signed contracts with NFL teams since 2013. In 2014, the Miami Dolphins' Terrence Fede became the first former Marist football player to appear in an NFL game. Marist graduate Jason Myers was the Jacksonville Jaguars' kicker for two-and-a-half seasons. On Sept. 20, 2015, the first NFL games with Marist graduates on each team took place when Miami played at Jacksonville. Overall, nearly 20 former Marist football players have gone on to have professional opportunities in the NFL, Europe, and in arena football.

In his tenure as head coach, Parady has posted a 133-141-1 record, with four league championships and a record of 93-67-1 in league contests. The Red Foxes won a share of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League championship in 1994, 2006 and 2007, and a share of the Pioneer Football League championship in 2013.

A native of Nashua, N.H., Parady attended the University of Maine, earning a bachelor's degree in education in 1983. He was a four-year member of the football team as a quarterback and earned two varsity letters.

Parady and his wife, Kristen, reside in Poughkeepsie with their two children, Sarah Jane and Brett Kenneth. Sarah is a 2017 graduate of Marist.

- Marist has only made two previous Florida trips in September (31-9 loss at Florida Atlantic, 9/22/01; 26-14 loss at Jacksonville, 9/29/12).

PFL History

- This is Marist's 10th season in the PFL. The Red Foxes are 36-36 all-time in PFL play.
- All-time in league games Marist is 4-9 in September, 21-14 in October, 11-12 in November, and 0-1 in December.
- In PFL play, Marist is 18-19 in at home, and 18-17 on the road.
- Marist won a share of the PFL championship in 2013.

Season Stats/Trends

- Red Zone Efficiency: Marist Offense - 5 trips/4 touchdowns. Marist Defense - 9 trips/3 touchdowns/2 field goals. By allowing the opposition to score on just 56% percent of its trips to the Red Zone, the Marist defense is ranked eighth in the FCS in Red Zone Efficiency.
