JoJo Binda Jr., San Diego
Senior (RS) | Running Back

Binda Jr. became the fourth PFL runner to record a 200-yard rushing day, amassing 227 yards on 13 carries in San Diego's 51-7 PFL victory at Stetson, Saturday. His 17.5 yards per carry was the best mark in the PFL this season. Binda Jr. took seven of his 13 carries for 10-plus yards and three runs went for 30-plus yards. He finished with just one touchdown carry, a 36-yard dash in the third quarter, but also had a 71-yard run to start the fourth quarter that set up a San Diego score on the next play. It was the best rushing yardage total by a San Diego rusher since 2014 (Jonah Hodges vs. Stetson).

DEFENSIVE

Clifford had a hand in two turnovers as Dayton downed Marist, 59-35, Saturday. He forced a fumble and picked off a pass while also recording eight tackles (seven solo) against the Red Foxes. Clifford forced a fumble on Marist's opening drive of the third quarter and it was recovered by Dayton, the ensuing drive resulting in a touchdown and a 35-14 lead. In the fourth quarter, he intercepted a pass on the first play of a Marist drive and returned it 38 yards to set up Dayton's offense for its final touchdown.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Brandon Eickert, San Diego
Freshman | Kicker

Eickert became the first PFL kicker to score 15 points in a game since 2017, helping San Diego score a 51-7 PFL victory at Stetson, Saturday. He hit field goals from 30, 37 and 37 yards and connected on all six PATs. Eickert's first two field goals (30 and 37 yards) provided the game's first six points and he hit his second 37-yarder to give the Toreros a 16-0 halftime lead. In the second half he was only called on for PAT duty, connecting five times as San Diego broke the game open. Eickert also was called on for one kickoff late in the fourth quarter and Stetson did not post any yards on the kick return.

WEEK 12 BREAKDOWNS

VALPARAISO AT BUTLER, NOON

The Hoosier Helmet will be up for grabs when Valparaiso travels down Interstate 65, Saturday. Valparaiso has won the last two meetings in the series and is seeking its first three-game win streak against Butler since winning seven straight from 1994-00. Neither team's offense has been able to find stable footing in 2019, Butler ranking ninth (19.2 ppg) and Valparaiso 10th (18.7 ppg) in scoring offense in their six previous PFL games. Valparaiso does hold an edge defensively, ranking ahead of Butler in both scoring defense (5th vs. 8th place) and total defense (4th vs. 6th place). CRUSADER TO WATCH: Senior Jamari Booker leads that Valparaiso defensive effort with 11.2 tackles per game, ranking second among league defenders in PFL play. He also has two interceptions and two fumbles forced in league play and returned a punt for a touchdown against Central Connecticut State. BULLDOG TO WATCH: While Booker ranks second in PFL tackles, Butler senior linebacker Luke Sennett is third in PFL tackles (8.7 pg) and is one of four Butler defenders ranked among the league's Top 20 in tackles per game.

JACKSONVILLE AT MARIST, 1 P.M.

Jacksonville makes the trip north this week to face Marist in a series that has proven to be uncomfortably close for the two teams, with the last six games each decided by seven points or less. Both teams are coming off road losses in Week 11, Jacksonville falling at Drake while Marist dropped a game at Dayton. The Red Foxes offense put up 35 points - its second-straight 30-point outing - and 417 yards but could not overcome a second and third quarter outburst that saw Dayton post 38 points. Jacksonville out-gained Drake by a 383-376 margin thanks to 339 rushing yards from six different runners. But Drake's touchdowns after an interception and missed field goal proved to be the difference. DOLPHIN TO WATCH: Calvin Turner Jr. has been the Dolphins offense in 2019, entering this weekend's game with 1,105 total offensive yards out of Jacksonville's 2,115 offensive yards. He is the only PFL runner with more than 1,000 rushing yards through 11 weeks this season, with 1,080 yards in 10 games with two games remaining. RED FOX TO WATCH: Quarterback Austin Day broke out for season bests in passing yardage (262 yards) and touchdown throw (3) in the loss at Dayton. His outing helped Marist to its first 300-yard passing day since Sept. 28 against Drake and its third 400-yard offensive outing this season.

DAVIDSON AT STETSON, 1 P.M.

A lot of offense is in the offing when Davidson travels to Stetson, Saturday. Both teams are averaging over 400 offensive yards in PFL play this season. The Hatters have been the more balanced team this season, averaging 218 rushing yards (4th in PFL) and 182.5 passing yards (6th in PFL). Meanwhile, the Wildcats are one of the league's run-heavy teams, leading the league in rushing yardage (326.5 ypg) while posting the third fewest passing yards in the league (118.5 ypg). Stetson has won the last three meetings in the series with the average scoring leaning 38-32 in their favor. WILDCAT TO WATCH: Junior running back Wesley Dugger became Davidson's all-time leading rusher at Butler Saturday, passing John Leverett's 2004 mark of 3,165 yards. He currently sits at 3,247 yards and is 125 from his third consecutive 1,000-yard campaign. HATTER TO WATCH: Freshman running back Jalen Leary had his streak of four straight games with 100-rush yards snapped against San Diego. He needs 44 yards this week to break the modern era Stetson record for rush yards in a season and needs just 121 yards in the last 2 games to reach 1,000 rush yards for the year.

DAYTON AT DRAKE, 2 P.M.

Drake will work to keep its PFL title hopes alive when it hosts Dayton in the 35th meeting between the two teams. Drake won last season's meeting between the teams in Dayton, 28-17, and two of the principal actors - Dayton quarterback Jack Cook and Drake running back Drew Lauer - from that game return for the 2019 edition. The game will pit the league's No. 1 scoring offense against its No. 2 scoring defense, but probably not in the order most PFL observers are used to seeing. Dayton brings the top-rated offense to Des Moines, averaging 41.2 points per game in its six league outings. Drake owns the No. 2-rated defense, holding PFL opponents to 22.8 points and 354.8 yards per game. FLYER TO WATCH: Jack Cook passed for 194 yards but his only touchdown came on the ground in last season's meeting. This season the Flyers quarterback is the second-ranked signal caller in both yardage (247.9 ypg) and efficiency (167.1 rating), but has thrown more TDs (29) than any other quarterback in PFL play. BULLDOG TO WATCH: Drew Lauer ran for a game-best 136 yards and two touchdowns in last season's meeting. He is the PFL's No. 3 running back in rushing yardage (99.7 ypg), all-purpose yardage (124.0 ypg) and in rushing TDs (nine) this season.

MOREHEAD STATE AT SAN DIEGO, 5 P.M.

San Diego looks to put a wrap on the 2019 PFL Championship race with its Week 12 contest against Morehead State. The Toreros offense has found a different gear in its last three PFL outings, averaging 50 points and 567.7 yards per game in wins against Dayton, Drake and Stetson. The bulk of that offense has come on the ground, where the Toreros have averaged 287.0 yards per game. Morehead State has leaned on its passing game over its last four games, posting 300 passing yards in each of those four outings while the run game has surpassed 100 yards in only the last two games. TORERO TO WATCH: Running back Emilio Martinez had just 23 yards at Stetson after missing the Toreros' Week 10 contest against Drake. Prior to missing that game, he broke off a 161-yard outing against Dayton. Martinez still ranks eighth among PFL runners with 66.4 yards per game this season. EAGLE TO WATCH: Quarterback Mark Pappas has moved up to third on the PFL passing yardage list (249.8 ypg) thanks to his 311.2 yards per game over the Eagles last four games. He's one of only three PFL quarterbacks to average more than 200 yards passing in 2019 and also ranks third in touchdown passes (19).

WEEK 12 TWO-MINUTE DRILL

San Diego can clinch a share of the 2019 PFL Championship, and the league's automatic bid to the 219 FCS Playoffs, with a win against Morehead State at Torero Stadium, Saturday... The Toreros have not lost a PFL home game since the 2010 season, a streak the Eagles will need to snap if they wish to play spoiler in Week 11... Drake will have its opportunity to apply pressure first when it hosts Dayton in a game that kicks off three hours before the San Diego-Morehead State match... Drake must defeat Dayton and hope for a Morehead State win for the chase for the league's AQ into Week 12... The week's action kicks off with the annual Hoosier Helmet battle between Valparaiso and Butler, taking place this year in Indianapolis... Jacksonville will look to pick up its first PFL win when it travels north to Poughkeepsie, where the forecast high is 36 degrees (nearly 30 degrees colder than Jacksonville's forecast high)... Two of the league's higher scoring offense face off when Davidson travels to Stetson, the Wildcats are seeking a fifth PFL win that would be their most since 2006, the first year of the return of single-division play.

DAYTON'S EASTERLING ADDED TO BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST

Dayton junior safety Brandon Easterling was added to the STATS FCS Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, Nov. 7. At that time, Easterling led all FCS leaders in tackles per game (13.1), solo tackles (7.6) and was tied for first in fumbles recovered (3). Earlier this season he had 19 tackles against Duquesne, the most by a Dayton player since James Vercammen had 19 at San Diego in 2009. In addition, Easterling had a string of four consecutive games with at least one opponent turnover gained. He has led Dayton in tackles in seven of the eight games this season.

SAN DIEGO'S SINNETT JOINS PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

San Diego quarterback Reid Sinnett was one of 16 players added to the 2019 STATS FCS Walter Payton Award watch list, Nov. 6. In his first season as a starter, Sinnett was the FCS leader in passing efficiency and completion percentage while he was among the top four in passing touchdowns (3rd), passing yards per game (3rd), points responsible for (3rd) and total offense (4th) at the time of the announcement. The redshirt senior's current passing efficiency (186.4) ranked as the fifth-best in FCS history with three weeks remaining in the regular season.

DRAKE'S CORWIN, STETSON'S LEARY NAMED TO INITIAL RICE AWARD WATCH LIST

Drake freshman quarterback Ian Corwin and Stetson freshman running back Jalen Leary were each among the 24 freshmen named to the initial Jerry Rice Award Watch List, Nov. 5. Corwin has completed 129-of-228 passes (56.6 percent) for 1,480 yards and 14 touchdowns. He was named the STATS FCS National Freshman Player of the Week on Sept. 30 after leading Drake to a 41-17 road win over Marist. With 806 rushing yards through eight games, Leary had the second-most single-season rushing yards in modern Stetson history and had three games left to become the first Hatter with 1,000 rushing yards in a season in the modern era.

DAYTON'S TRAUTMAN ACCEPTS SENIOR BOWL INVITE

Dayton tight end Adam Trautman has accepted an invitation to play in the Senior Bowl college all-star game in Mobile, Ala. on Jan. 25, 2020. Senior Bowl Executive Director Jim Nagy extended the invitation personally to Trautman after Dayton's Nov. 6 practice. The Flyer co-captain will be the first Dayton player to play in the Senior Bowl since 1972. Only five other Flyers have played in the Senior Bowl - tight end Fred Dugan (1958), linebacker Email Karas (1959), center Bob DeMarco (1961), center Leo Dillon (1971) and running back Gary Kosins (1972).

SAN DIEGO'S PFL WIN STREAK THIRD LONGEST IN FCS HISTORY

With its win at Stetson in Week 11, San Diego's extended its PFL win streak to 2534 games. It is the third-longest conference win streak in FCS history. It trails a 39-game win streak by Duquesne in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Association (1999-06) and a 36-game win streak by Jacksonville State of the Ohio Valley Conference (2013-18).

CHAMBERLIN RECORDS 500TH GAME AS A FLYER

There are few things that can challenge the longevity of Dayton's scoring streak. However, Rick Chamberlin's tenure as a Flyer surpasses even that streak. When he took up his position on the sideline against San Diego in Week 9 it was his 500th appearance as a Flyer. He played 45 as an All-American linebacker, then 326 games as an assistant coach under College Football Hall of Fame coach Mike Kelly, before taking over for his mentor and now 129 games - and counting - as Dayton's head coach.

VALPARAISO'S BOOK NAMED STATS FCS DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Stetson entered the game with the most-potent offense in FCS statistics, but Booker helped Valparaiso stymie the fellow Pioneer Football League squad 19-10 to earn its first win of the season. Booker had 13 tackles (seven solos), two interceptions for the second time this season and a pass breakup. Both picks came inside Valpo's 25, with the first one leading to a go-ahead field goal and the second clinching the win. He had 32 interception return yards. It is the third national STATS FCS honor by a PFL athlete this season.

FOSTER NAMED STATS FCS SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Morehead State kicker Andrew Foster became the second PFL athlete to earn STATS FCS weekly honors in 2019, picking up the organization's National FCS Special Teams Player of the Week award after Week 7 action. Foster made three field goals and scored 12 points as Morehead State downed Jacksonville, 30-22, for the first time since 2005. He became the second PFL kicker to convert twice from 40 yards in the same game this season, hitting from 45 and 43 yards while making all three of his field goal attempts.

DUGGER PUSHES PAST 3,000 YARDS

Davidson running back Wesley Dugger pushed past the 3,000 career yard mark against Marist, Oct. 26. One of two juniors among the FCS Top 10 Active Career Leaders, he is ranked third in total rushing yardage (3,231), averaging 107.7 yards per game (2nd among active career leaders). He is just ahead of Monmouth junior Pete Guerriero (3,170 yards) on the list. Dugger needs 62 yards to move into the PFL's career Top 10 in rushing yards (3,292 yards, Drake's Jonathan Taylor).

THE EFFICIENT COOK

Seeing a PFL quarterback listed on the FCS Active Career Leaders list in passing efficiency is a normal occurrence. However, that quarterback not having San Diego next to their name is a new twist. Dayton signal caller Jack Cook is ranked No. 2 on the FCS' active career leader list with a 161.05 career pass efficiency rating. That would rank third all-time on the PFL's career pass efficiency list, behind San Diego's Josh Johnson's 176.68 mark (2004-07).

SINNETT JOINS EFFICIENCY EFFORT

Cook was joined on the NCAA FCS Active Career Leaders list by San Diego's Reid Sinnett, who qualified for inclusion after Week 11. The Torero signal-caller boasts a 168.23 career pass efficiency rating that would be second-best in PFL history.

BANDY CATCHES 3,000 YARD TRAIN

Meanwhile, San Diego wide receiver Michael Bandy moved past the 3,000 receiving yard plateau in Week 9. He now is ranked fourth among FCS active career leaders with 3,102 career receiving yards. Bandy is the ninth PFL receiver to record 3,000 career receiving yards and enters this week ninth all-time, 10 yards from moving past Dylan Ching (3,111 yards) for eighth on the list.

WARNER BACK ATOP FCS CAREER LEADERS

Drake's defensive back Will Warner nabbed four interceptions in a three-week span (Weeks 7-9) and has regained the top spot on the NCAA's Active Career Leaders list for picks. He now has 15 career interceptions, the eighth PFL defender to record 15 career INTs. Morehead State's David Hyland and Dayton's Mark Kasmer hold the PFL record with 21 interceptions each.

PFL REPRESENTED AMONG CAMPBELL SEMIFINALISTS

Five Pioneer Football League student-athletes were named as semifinalists for the 2019 William V. Campbell Trophy presented by Mazada and The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame. The five PFL student-athletes recognized as semifinalists were: Brad Sznajder, Butler; Ethan Steinbacher, Davidson; Tim Simon, Dayton; Andrew McElroy, Marist; and Gaven DeFilippo, Stetson. That quintet joins a group that now includes 82 PFL student-athletes who have been named a semifinalist for the Campbell Trophy, or its predecessor the Draddy Trophy, since 1998.

CORWIN NAMED STATS FCS FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Drake freshman Ian Corwin put it all together in his best performance and Drake's first win of the season, 41-17 at Marist, Sept. 28. Corwin completed 20 of 29 passes (69 percent) for 255 yards and four touchdowns with one interception. The four touchdown passes went to four different receivers and were one more than he threw in the first three games combined.

DAVIDSON'S HATALOWICH NAMED TO ALLSTATE AFCA GOOD WORKS TEAM

Davidson linebacker George Hatalowich was named to the 2019 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team Sept. 12. As the founder and current president of Davidson Football Uplifting Athletes, George has been responsible for raising more than \$25,000 to benefit the rare disease community. George has also taken the Davidson Chapter a step further to engage with local patients, families and caregivers through the Uplifting Athletes Bowling event, which allows the families the opportunity to bowl alongside the football team. The Allstate AFCA Good Works Team will be invited to the 2020 Allstate® Sugar Bowl® and will join Tebow and Allstate volunteers to give back to New Orleans through a special community service project. Allstate will recognize the team during the halftime show. Fans are invited to visit ESPN.com/Allstate to vote for the 2019 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team captain once per day, now through Nov. 22.

DAYTON FLIES TO HISTORIC WIN

Facing the No. 14 team in the FCS, Dayton faced daunting odds to win its season opener at Indiana State. But when Sean Proffit scored with 1:57 left the Flyers had an opportunity. Then Zach Rumpke turned that opportunity into reality with an interception to seal the win. It was the highest-ranked FCS opponent

a Dayton team had defeated in program history and was the PFL's third win all-time against the Missouri Valley Football Conference.

LEANINE FIRST-TEAM ALL-PFL RETURNEES HIGHLIGHT PRE-SEASON SQUAD

The 29-member Preseason All-PFL squad saw nine First-Team All-PFL selections return from the 2018 season. Three 2018 first-teamers return on offense with San Diego wide receiver Michael Bandy leading the unit. Drake defensive back Will Warner leads a group of five 2018 first-team selections on the league's preseason defensive unit. San Diego return specialist Michael Armstead is the lone returning first-team selection on the league's special teams unit. Six PFL teams have a First-Team All-PFL returnee on their roster in 2018: San Diego (3), Drake (2), Davidson, Dayton, Jacksonville and Stetson

SAN DIEGO PICKED TO WIN PFL

For the ninth consecutive year, San Diego was picked to win the Pioneer Football League regular-season race in a preseason vote of the league's coaches. San Diego, which has won regular-season title each of the past three seasons, again received the coaches' nod to win the 2019 PFL title. With seven first-place votes, the Toreros were chosen ahead of Dayton and Drake, who picked up the remaining three first-place votes.

THREE PFL PUNTERS NAMED TO FCS PUNTER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

A trio of Pioneer Football League punters were named to the inaugural FCS Punter of the Year Award Watch List presented by The Augusta Sports Council. Drake's Ross Kennedy, Morehead State's Andrew Foster and San Diego's Tanner Kuljian were each named to the 28-player list released in July. Each of the three finished 2018 ranked among the NCAA's Top 100 punters in punting average. Kuljian was ranked No. 14 nationally, averaging 42.8 yards per punt on 59 kicks. Foster was No. 26 among FCS kickers with 41.9 yards per punt. Kennedy finished the season No. 93 among FCS punters (37.1 yards per punt).

BANDY, TRAUTMAN, WARNER EARN FCS PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA NODS

San Diego wide receiver Michael Bandy, Dayton tight end Adam Trautman and Drake defensive back Will Warner made the rounds as the Preseason All-America squads were announced. Bandy was named to all four Preseason All-America teams (STATS, Athlon, Phill Steele and HERO), Warner was named to three (STATS, Phill Steele and HERO) and Trautman earned recognition on two (STATS and Phill Steele).

THIRTY-FIVE PFL ATHLETES NAMED TO 2019 NFF HAMPSHIRE SOCIETY

Thirty-five Pioneer Football League student-athletes, representing seven member institutions, were named members of the 2019 NFF Hampshire Honor Society, the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame announced in April. The NFF's Hampshire Honor Society recognizes those college football players from all divisions of play that maintained a cumulative 3.2 GPA or better throughout their college careers.

In order to meet the criteria set forth by Allstate and the AFCA, each player must be actively involved with a charitable organization or service group while maintaining a strong academic standing.

PARADY DEAN OF PFL, FCS COACHES

As 2019 gets underway, the longest-tenured coaches in Division I FCS are Marist's Jim Parady and Monmouth's Kevin Callahan, who have been head coaches at their respective schools since 1992. STETSON'S HUGHES EARNS CONTRACT EXTENSION

Coming off the best season in more than 65 years, Stetson football coach Roger Hughes was rewarded with a contract extension that will keep him on the Hatters sideline through at least the 2021 season. Hughes, who has guided the Stetson football program since 2011 when he was charged with leading the program onto the field after more than 50 years without a team, was named Pioneer Football League Coach of the Year in 2018.

DRAKE NAMES STEPSIS HEAD COACH

Todd Stepsis, the architect of the Drake football team's nationally-ranked defense, was named the head coach of the Drake football team in December. He takes the reins of the Bulldogs' program after serving as the program's defensive coordinator for the past five seasons under previous head coach Rick Fox, who resigned his position. As the defensive coordinator, Stepsis built the Drake defense into one of the nation's top units and coached a total of 42 all-conference selections including the program's all-time leading tackler and the 2018 PFL Defensive Player of the Year, Nathan Clayberg.

PFL'S 27TH CAMPAIGN

The 2019 season marks the 27th year for the Pioneer Football League – the nation's only non-scholarship, football-only NCAA Football Championship Subdivision conference. The league will feature 10 teams each playing an eight-game schedule to determine the league champion and recipient of the automatic bid to the 2018 NCAA FCS Championship.

PRESBYTERIAN TO JOIN PFL IN 2021

In 2019, the Pioneer Football League Commissioner presidents' council agreed to accept Presbyterian College's request for membership, effective for the 2021 season. Presbyterian College's football program will remain a Big South member for the 2019 season while continuing to phase out scholarships in order to obtain PFL eligibility. The Blue Hose will play one season as a Division I independent in 2020 before joining the PFL in 2021.
