Stony Brook's all-time winningest coach and Hall of Fame inductee, McMullen led his teams to the postseason 10 times, including two NCAA appearances.



Beckie Francis
1994-97
30-48 (.385)
3 seasons
Francis was named the third head coach in 1994, the school's last season in Division III.



Bill Zatulskis
1997-99
22-31 (.415)
2 seasons
Zatulskis was named the fourth head coach and posted a 14-12 record his first year.



Trish Roberts
1999-2004
66-76 (.465)
5 seasons
Roberts' 50 victories in three seasons equaled McMullen's mark for the most wins for a new coach in school history.

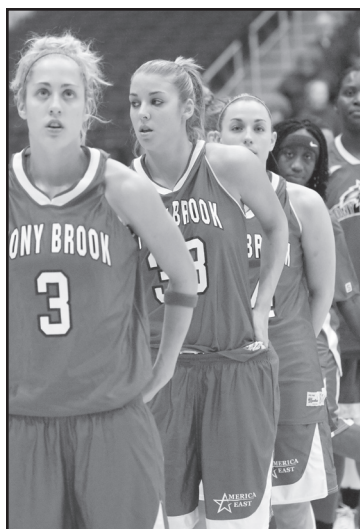
