POST-GAME POLICY

Stony Brook's post-game interviews will take place in the team meeting room located across the training room in the football building in the south endzone. Media can access the room through the tunnel on field level. Seawolves' head coach **Chuck Priore** and requested players will be available in the post game interview approximately 10 minutes after the game. Stony Brook's locker room is closed. The visitor's locker room is located inside the Indoor Sports Complex. The SID of the visiting school will establish admittance policies to the visiting locker room and designate an interview area.

PRESS BOX SERVICES

The press box, located on the east side of LaValle Stadium, is accessible by elevator or stairs. The press box will open three hours prior to game time. Game notes, programs, a flip card and statistics will be provided prior to the game. Play-by-play and quick statistics, final team, individual and defensive statistics, drive charts and coaches' quotes also will be provided. Complete sets of information will be available approximately 20 minutes after the game.

SIDELINES

Stony Brook follows guidelines set forth by the NCAA Public Relations Committee, the NCAA Football Rules Committee, the American Football Coaches Association and the National Press Photographers Association. Photographers are not permitted between the 25-yard lines and must have credentials visible at all times. Photographers are required to go behind the team benches to pass from one end of the field to the other. Uniformed security personnel will patrol the sidelines and anyone holding a media pass who is not actively involved in coverage of the game will be escorted from the sideline. Children under 12 will not be issued media or sideline credentials. Similar procedures will be in effect in the press box.



STONY BROOK ON THE AIRWAVES

Stony Brook and SNY have partnered up to broadcast four of the Seawolves' home games in 2019 that include Wagner, James Madison, New Hampshire, and UAlbany. The broadcast team of **Jonny Wincott** on play-by-play, NFL veteran **Erik Coleman** as the analyst and **Ariel Epstein** on the sideline, will handle the call for these four games.

DOWN THE FIELD(S) FOR THE WIN

Junior **Tyquell Fields**, Stony Brook's starting QB for all 12 games in 2019, successfully engineered three game-winning or game-tying fourth-quarter drives. The first came at Rhode Island on Sept. 28 to defeat the Rams, the second came at home against No. 2 James Madison on Oct. 5 to send the game to overtime and the third was at No. 5 Villanova on Oct. 26 to defeat the Wildcats.

NEW YORK (BACKFIELD) STATE OF MIND

The Seawolves had an offensive backfield made up of New Yorkers. The three running backs - **Isaiah White** (Gordon Heights, N.Y.), **Ty Son Lawton** (Staten Island, N.Y.) and **Seba Nekhet** (Brooklyn, N.Y.) - all hail from the Empire State, while QBs **Tyquell Fields** (Yonkers, N.Y.) and **Jack Cassidy** (Bohemia, N.Y.) are also New York natives.

YONKERS PIPELINE

Three starters for the Seawolves in 2019 all hail from Archbishop Stepinac High School in Yonkers, N.Y., and all played together during their HS careers. Senior captain **Gavin Heslop** and junior **TJ Morrison** are slated to be the starting cornerbacks for Stony Brook and have been teammates and friends since the age of eight. Junior **Tyquell Fields** also donned the Archbishop Stepinac uniform with Heslop and Morrison. True freshman WR **Shawn Harris Jr.** also comes from Stepinac HS.

ANDERSON'S NEAR RECORD GAME

Redshirt senior WR **Nick Anderson** came just 12 yards from breaking Stony Brook's single-game record for receiving yards when he pulled down 205 yards on eight catches against Towson. Anderson was just the fifth Seawolf to record at least 200 yards receiving in a game. The school record of 216 yards is by Londre Blocker set in 2001 against Wagner.

WHITE THRIVING BACK ON OFFENSE

Senior captain **Isaiah White** was back on the offensive side of the ball for 2019 after he spent the three years on defense. White carried the ball 62 times for 243 yards as a running back during his true freshman season in 2015. In 2019, White had 709 yards and five touchdowns on 130 carries. He also had five career 100-yard rushing games that include four in 2019 (Wagner, Fordham, Rhode Island and at Delaware).

50-YARD FIELD(S)

Junior QB **Tyquell Fields** took matters into his own hands in the Sept. 28 thrilling victory at Rhode Island. Fields, looking to get a first down on the 4th-and-6 play with under 20 seconds remaining, took off running and got more than the first down as he scrambled into the end zone for a 50-yard rush to give Stony Brook the lead and eventually the victory. The play helped earn him CAA Football Offensive Player of the Week and was on ESPN's Sportcenter.

SCORING ON D

Senior DBs **Synceir Malone** and **Gavin Heslop** each scored a defensive touchdown in 2019. Malone had a pick-six in the opening win over Bryant with a 22-yard interception return for a touchdown, while Heslop picked up a fumble and returned in seven yards for a touchdown against UAlbany in the season finale. Malone's score marked the fifth pick-six for the Seawolves since the second game of the 2018 season and the two defensive TDs marked the seventh and eighth for Stony Brook over the past two seasons.

DOUBLE TROUBLE X2

Running backs **Isaiah White** and **Seba Nekhet** each rushed for over 100 yards in the Sept. 21 victory over Fordham. Nekhet tallied 182 yards on the ground that included the first two rushing touchdowns of his career, while White posted his thirteenth career and second straight 100-plus yard game with 127 yards on the ground. White and true freshman **Jadon Turner** also accomplished the feat at Delaware when White gained 188 yards and Turner collected 101 yards and a touchdown.

HELLO, END ZONE

11 Seawolves crossed the goal line for the first time in 2019. WR **Brandon Benson** (UAlbany), RB **Jadon Turner** (Delaware), WR **Delante Hellams Jr.** (Richmond), WR **Shawn Harris Jr.** (Villanova), RB **Isaiah White** (Bryant), RB **Seba Nekhet** (Fordham) RB **Ty Son Lawton** (Fordham), DB **Synceir Malone** (Bryant), QB **TyQuell Fields** (Bryant), TE **Isaiah Givens** (Fordham) and TE **Peter McKenzie** (Wagner) all scored for the first time in their careers.

STONY BROOK SEAWOLVES FOOTBALL

AGAINST THE FCS RANKS

Stony Brook is now 12-25 all-time against FCS ranked opponents after the Oct. 26th win at No. 5 Villanova. Stony Brook defeated No. 13 Villanova and No. 11 Delaware in 2018. The Seawolves had victories over No. 12 New Hampshire and No. 17 Richmond in 2017. The Seawolves' also posted two ranked wins in 2016. Stony Brook earned a 42-14 win over No. 2 Richmond and a 13-9 season-opening victory against No. 19 North Dakota. Richmond's No. 2 ranking equals the highest ranked opponent to come into Kenneth P. LaValle Stadium (No. 2 Towson on Sept. 28, 2013). The win over Richmond also marked the program's first victory over a top 10 team.

SEASON OPENERS UNDER PRIORE

Head coach Chuck Priore is now 7-7 in openers at Stony Brook, including a 6-2 record when playing at home to open the season.

A total of 16 Seawolves made their collegiate debuts in 2019. 11 players - RB **Ty Son Lawton**, DB **Gregory Young II**, WR **Lukas Merluzzi**, RB **Alex Indelicato**, DB **Will Corchado**, DB **Kendall Nero-Clark**, DL **Ryan Lopez**, OL **Matt Mirabito**, LB **Souleymane Camara**, TE **Thomas Dutton** and DL **Mayke Smith** - made their debuts in the season opening win over Bryant. Later in the season against JMU, WR **Shawn Harris Jr.** made his debut, while DL **Jovani Duran** debuted against Towson and RBs **Jadon Turner** and **Tahshawn Brinson** debuted at Delaware and LB **Aiden Kaler** debuted against UAlbany. In addition, transfers WR **Jean Constant**, WR **Brandon Benson**, TE **Carter McCarthy**, DL **Sean Hammonds Jr.** and OL **James Tunstall** made their Stony Brook debuts against the Bulldogs in week 1.

CAA FOOTBALL OPENERS

Stony Brook began its seventh season as a member of CAA Football on Sept. 28 at Rhode Island. The Seawolves are now 6-1 in the conference openers since joining the league, including the 31-27 win at URI in 2019. Stony Brook recorded a 36-10 win over Richmond in 2018. A win at URI in 2013, an OT loss at home to No. 13 William & Mary in 2014, a victory at home over No. 13 New Hampshire in 2015, a home win against No. 2 Richmond in 2016 and a 35-18 victory at URI in 2017 are the results.

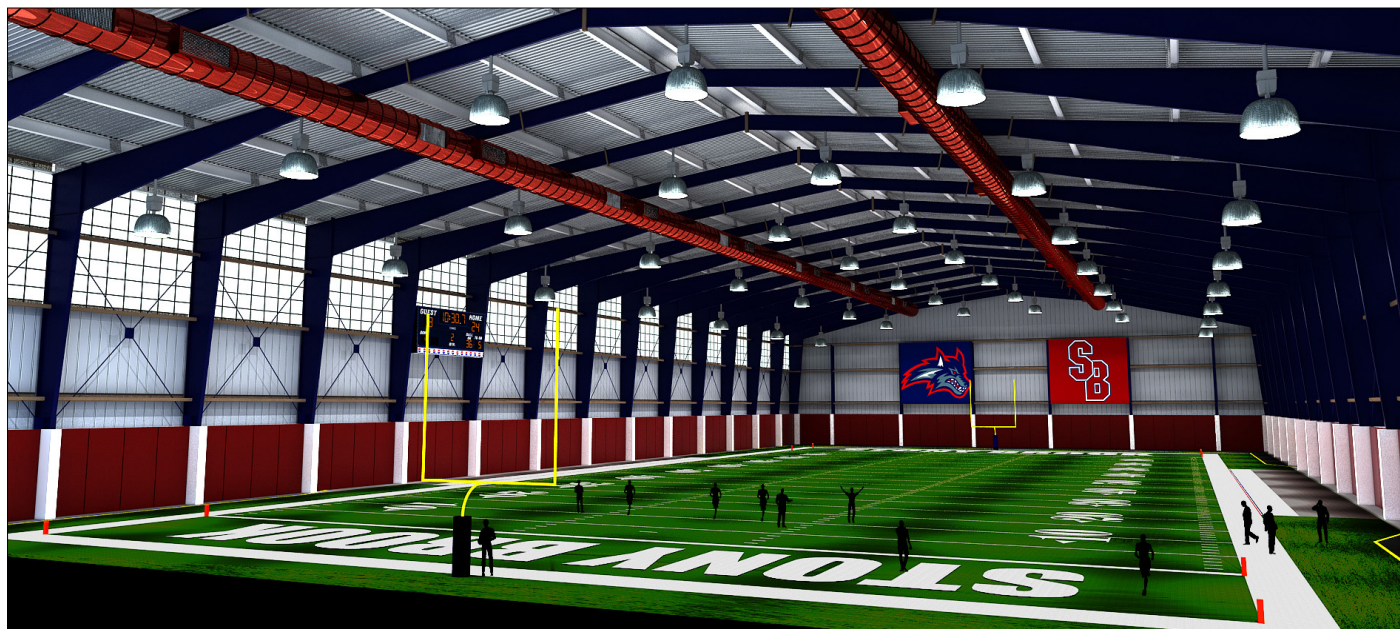


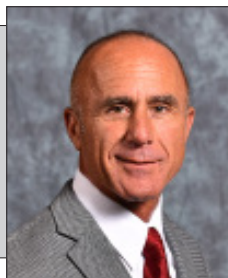

AT STONY BROOK

Since becoming Stony Brook's head football coach in the spring of 2006, Chuck Priore's tenure can be described as an usher. He's ushered the Seawolves through two conferences (Northeast and Big South), and for the past six seasons, CAA Football. During that time, Priore has ushered the program to the upper echelon of the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), guiding SBU from 20 scholarships to a fully funded program of 63 scholarship, the maximum allowed at the FCS level.

Under Priore's leadership, Stony Brook posted a number of firsts - a win over a Football Bowl Subdivision (Army - 2012), a 10-win season (2012), an at-large berth to the Division I Football Championship (2011) and produced the Seawolves first NFL player when Will Tye joined the New York Giants as an undrafted free agent and enjoyed a very successful rookie campaign.

In Priore's previous 13 seasons at the helm of the Seawolves, SBU has collected at least five wins, including a pair of 10-win season (2012 and 2017) and reached the FCS Playoffs four times (2011, 2012, 2017 and 2018).

Priore was the starting fullback for three seasons at UAlbany and the team captain as a senior. In 1982, Priore was presented the Spud Kruzan Award as UAlbany's Outstanding Athlete.
