ABOUT THE SEAWOLVES

- Stony Brook returns one starter from last season: Andre Snoddy.
- The Seawolves welcomed eight newcomers to the program for the 2024-25 season, five transfers and three freshmen. Collin O'Connor leads the team in minutes and has twice been named CAA Rookie of the Week (Nov. 11 & Dec. 9).
- Stony Brook won 20 games a season ago, advancing to the CAA Final in its second year as a member of the league. The Seawolves fell just short, upsetting No. 2 Drexel and No. 3 Hofstra before falling in overtime to topseeded Charleston.
- The Seawolves' returners account for 22 percent of its scoring output from a season prior. Stony Brook's top five scorers are no longer on the roster, having accounted for 77.3 percent of its scoring in 2023-24.
- Head coach Geno Ford is in the midst of his sixth season at the helm of the Stony Brook men's basketball program.

ABOUT THE BLUE HENS

- Delaware owns the second-best scoring offense in the league this season, averaging 79 points per game. Through four games in conference play, Delaware is averaging a league-leading 84 points per game. The Blue Hens are top in the conference in field goal percentage and three-point field goal percentage as well.
- The Blue Hens' leading scorer, John Camden, averages 15 points/game, fifth in the CAA. Niels Lane averages 14 points/game, 15th best in the league.
- Martin Ingelsby is in his ninth season as the head coach at Delaware. A 2001 graduate of Notre Dame, Ingelsby has guided the Blue Hens' program to at least 17 wins in the last five full seasons. He returned Delaware basketball to a place it has only been six times in program history with the CAA Championship title and NCAA Tournament First Round appearance in 2022, the first conference crown since 2014.

2023-24 REWIND

- Stony Brook put together a 20-win campaign, advancing to the CAA Championship as the seven seed. Stony Brook became the second seven seed to play in the CAA Final (East Carolina, 1993).
- The Seawolves began CAA Tournament play with a win for the second time in as many seasons, downing Northeastern.
- Stony Brook proceeded to upset No. 2 Drexel in double OT and take down No. 3 Hofstra to advance to the CAA Final against top-seeded Charleston. The Seawolves took the reigning league champions to the brink, ultimately falling in overtime.
- Stony Brook played in its sixth conference championship game at the Division I level and first since 2016.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

- Stony Brook was selected to finish ninth in the 2024-25 CAA Preseason Poll, as voted on by the league's head coaches.
- Joe Octave earned Preseason All-CAA Honorable Mention distinction.

SEAWOLVES ON SNY

• The Stony Brook University Athletics Department announced a linear television agreement with SNY for 19 home basketball games during the 2024-25 season. SNY will air 9 Stony Brook men's basketball home games and 10 women's basketball home games this season.

WELCOME TO STONY BROOK

- Stony Brook men's basketball welcomed eight newcomers to the roster for the 2024-25 season: two grad transfer, three JUCO transfers and three freshmen.
- Ford and the Seawolves started with the addition of Falls Church, Virginia native Quin Gorman, who signed his National Letter of Intent. A 6-9 forward, Gorman played scholastically at the Flint Hill School and on the AAU circuit for Team AKT.
- The Seawolves added three more during the Spring Signing Period: Collin O'Connor, Ben Wight and Nick Woodard. O'Connor played a post-grad year at Western Reserve Academy, where he won a National Championship. Wight, a grad transfer, played collegiately at William & Mary and most recently Toledo. Woodard was the No. 39 ranked JUCO nationally, per JucoRecruiting.com, was a standout during his two seasons at Southwest Tennessee CC. He was named the TCCAA Freshman of the Year (2022-23) and earned First Team All-TCCAA distinction last year.
- The next addition was CJ Luster, the No. 22 JUCO player in the nation, according to JucoRecruiting.com. He was the leading scorer at Salt Lake CC, averaging 16.4 ppg. Salt Lake CC was the No. 3 ranked team in the NJCAA and won the Scenic West Athletic Conference Regular Season Championship, finishing with a 30-4 record.
- Joe Octave followed, an All-Patriot League Third Teamer (2023-24) at Holy Cross. Over two seasons with the Crusaders, he averaged 13.3 ppg, shooting better than 43% from the field and better than 31% from three-point range. He eclipsed 1,000 career points this past season at Holy Cross.
- Jeremiah Nyarko was the next piece, by way of Western Texas College and the University of San Diego. Nyarko played scholastically at Sierra Canyon High School and St. John Bosco HS. He represented his home country of Ghana for the NBA Academy and Basketball Without Borders.
- Bryan Mitchell, a walk on, was the eighth and final newcomer. He is a New Jersey native and played at IMG Academy.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Stony Brook Arena has proven to be one of the best homecourt advantages over the last decade-plus, with Stony Brook boasting a 160-64 record at home since 2009-10.
- With 13 wins on the Island last year, the Seawolves have posted 10 or more wins at home in 11 of the last 15 seasons.
- Under the guidance of head coach Geno Ford, Stony Brook is 50-29 on its home court.

OHIO'S OWN, FORD'S A HALL OF FAMER

- Prior to his coaching career, Geno Ford made a name for himself on the court in his home state of Ohio. This past summer, Ford was inducted into the Ohio Basketball Hall of Fame as part of the class of 2023.
- While playing for his father, the renowned coach Gene Ford (inducted into the Ohio Basketball Hall of Fame in 2018) at Cambridge High School in eastern Ohio, Ford registered an impressive 2,680 career points.
- To this day, that total stands as the fourth highest in Ohio's rich basketball history, surpassing basketball icons such as LeBron James, Jerry Lucas, and Bob Huggins.
- Ford ranks second in the state's record books, only behind Luke Kennard, for both single-season and career free throws made, tallying 288 and 697 free throws made, respectively.
- In 1993, Ford's exceptional performance on the court earned him the prestigious honor of being named Ohio's "Mr. Basketball", solidifying his status as one of the state's standout players.
- He continued his basketball journey at Ohio University, starting in 113 out of 123 games for the Bobcats. In his final two seasons, he led the team in scoring, contributing a total of 1,752 points during his collegiate career. Ford maintained an impressive scoring average of 14.2 points per game, displaying his accuracy with a 79.6 percent success rate from the free-throw line and shooting 36.8 percent from beyond the arc.
- Following a season with the Leicester Riders in the British Basketball League, he returned to the United States to embark on his coaching career.
- In recognition of his outstanding contributions to the sport, Ford was inducted into the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference Hall of Fame in 2004 and enshrined in the Ohio University Athletics Hall of Fame in 2008. Now, he adds another prestigious honor to his list of achievements as he enters the Ohio Basketball Hall of Fame, a well-deserved tribute to his remarkable career and lasting impact on the game he loves.

THE FORD FILE

- Head coach Geno Ford enters his sixth full season at the helm of the Seawolves, leading Stony Brook to a 78-77 record through his first five full campaigns as head coach.
- Ford was elevated to head coach on March 26, 2019, after his former Ohio teammate and former head coach Jeff Boals resigned to accept the head coaching job at Ohio.
- Ford served as interim head coach for Stony Brook's loss to UCF at the 2019 Roman College Basketball Invitational.
- His coaching career began as an assistant coach at his

- alma mater, Ohio University. He then assumed head coaching positions at Shawnee State, Muskingum, and Kent State, accumulating valuable experience and success along the way.
- For four years, he served as the head coach at Bradley University before taking charge of the men's basketball program at Stony Brook, where he has been making a significant impact for the past six years.
- Ford and the Seawolves put together a 20-win campaign in 2023-24, advancing to the CAA Championship as the seven seed. Stony Brook became the second seven seed to play in the CAA Final (East Carolina, 1993).
- In Ford's first season, Stony Brook won 20 games for the eighth time in the last 11 seasons and finished in second place in the America East, their ninth top-two finish over that time period.
- Coach Ford celebrated his 200th career win on December 14, 2021, against Central Connecticut State.

CAA OUTLOOK

- Towson was tabbed as the favorite in the 2024-25 CAA Preseason Poll, receiving 166 votes and 10 of the league's 14 first-place votes.
- Charleston was picked second, receiving three first-place votes, while UNC Wilmington claimed the last remaining first-place vote and was selected to finish third in the poll.
- Charleston's Ante Brzovic was picked by the league's coaches as the 2024-25 Preseason Player of the Year.

O'CONNOR IMPRESSING AS A ROOKIE

- Collin O'Connor has already picked up a pair of CAA Rookie of the Week honors this season, earning the award in both November and December.
- The guard from Dayton, Ohio opened his season averaging 11.5 points and 4.0 assists, shooting nearly 60% from the field, in a 1-1 week for Stony Brook. O'Connor scored a gamehigh 16 points, including the game-winning layup with 3.7 seconds left, to help the Seawolves erase a 12-point, secondhalf deficit and top Central Michigan, 73-72. In his first collegiate start on the road at No. 18 Marquette, he tallied seven points and added five assists.
- In December, O'Connor scored 13 points, secured two rebounds and dished out two assists over a season-high 37 minutes of action in Texas against Air Force. The rookie was 5-for-9 from the floor and finished a perfect 3-for-3 at the free throw line.

HONORABLE MENTIONS FROM MBWA

- CJ Luster earned Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Player of the Week Honorable Mention after leading the Seawolves to a road win over Rider in December.
- The JUCO transfer poured in 20 points, shooting 7-for-11 from the field and connecting on six of his nine attempts from beyond the arc to earn regional recognition.
- The designation is unique in that it encompasses players from 21 Met area Division I schools.

SNODDY SEEING DOUBLE

- Andre Snoddy has notched a pair of double-doubles this season, adding to his career total.
- The Melville, Long Island native posted 13 points and 11 rebounds in a home loss to Norfolk State, registering the first double-double of the season by a Seawolf.
- Snoddy secured a season-high 12 rebounds, adding 10 points in a road win over Rider to notch his second double-double of the 2024-25 campaign.
- He has tallied double-digit rebounds in three games this season and has corralled seven or more boards in seven contests this year.
- A season ago, Snoddy grabbed at least seven rebounds in 21 of Stony Brook's 34 games and posted a double-double against Hofstra.

BEN WIGHT APPROACHING 1K POINTS

- \bullet Ben Wight, in his fifth season, has a massed 981 career points over 120 career appearances between William & Mary, Toledo and Stony Brook.
- Wight played the first three seasons of his collegiate career in the CAA with William & Mary (2020-23). Wight scored 801 points in his three seasons with the Tribe before transferring to Toledo.
- Appearing in 23 contests as a Rocket, Wight tallied 30 points in one season with Toledo.
- On January 9 against Drexel, Wight made the 100th start of his collegiate career.

Geno Ford enters his sixth season as head coach of the Stony Brook University men's basketball program in 2024-25. Ford guided the Seawolves to the CAA Championship Game in the school's second season as a member of the conference in 2023-24. The Seawolves won 20 games for the ninth time in the program's Division I history and the second time under Ford. Stony Brook entered the CAA Tournament as the No. 7 seed, defeating No. 10 Northeastern and producing upsets of No. 2 Drexel in double overtime and No. 3 Hofstra to advance to the CAA Final for the first time in program history. Stony Brook ultimately fell to top-seeded Charleston in overtime.

Stony Brook went 13-3 at home in 2023-24, posting double-digit home victories for the 10th time in the last 15 seasons. Under the tutelage of Ford and his staff, graduate guard Tyler Stephenson-Moore earned All-CAA, All-MBWA and NABC All-District honors in 2023-24, while the team as a whole posted a cumulative grade point average above 3.0 during the academic year.

Ford's fourth season at the helm of the Stony Brook men's basketball program was the Seawolves' first as a member of the Colonial Athletic Association, now the Coastal Athletic Association. Stony Brook finished the season at 11-22 overall and 6-12 in league play, earning the No. 10 seed in the 2023 CAA Championships. Stony Brook's first season in the conference ultimately culminated with a loss to the eventual conference champion Charleston Cougars in the quarterfinals, but the Seawolves upset the North Carolina A&T Aggies in the first round, the program's first-ever postseason victory as a member of the CAA. Under Ford's tutelage, Tyler Stephenson-Moore was voted to the All-CAA Third Team after a breakout season on the Island.

During the 2021-22 campaign, Ford was instrumental in developing one of the most dangerous backcourts in the region, with a pair of all-conference guards in Tykei Greene and Anthony Roberts leading the way. Greene was inside the top 100 nationally in numerous rebounding categories, while Roberts scored the program's first 40-point game since 2015-16. The squad was also one of the most protective in Stony Brook's Division I history, finishing with the second-lowest turnover rate since 2000. It also was the fourth-most efficient offense since 2000 and the best mark since the 2015-16 campaign. His squad finished inside the Top 25 nationally in fewest fouls and fewest turnovers, as well as the top 50 nationally in turnovers per game.

Ford guided one of the nation's most intimidating defenses in 2020-21, finishing 16th nationally in blocks per game and 36th in the country in field-goal percentage defense. In his first season at the helm of Stony Brook in 2019-20, Ford led Stony Brook to its seventh 20-win season in nine years, finishing with a 20-13 record and a berth in the America East semifinals.

They continued a decade of excellence in which they finished inside the top two in nine of the last 10 seasons, something that hasn't been done by any other America East team. He also helped lead three all-conference selections, including first-teamer Elijah Olaniyi and second-team selection Andrew Garcia to success during the season. His offense also broke records from beyond the arc this season, making a total of 274 3-pointers this year, a new team record. Makale Foreman also set a new mark individually, draining 104 shots from outside.

The Cambridge, Ohio native became the head man after three years as the Associate Head Coach under Boals, helping lead Stony Brook's offense to one of its most prolific outputs in Division I history with 71.6 points per game. That number was only bettered by the 2015-16 conference championship team. Under Ford's associate head coach tenure, Stony Brook finished inside the top two in the standings in two of his three seasons with two America East semifinal berths also during that time.

He also brings a wealth of head coaching experience with two stops coming before this. He took over at Kent State in 2008, helping lead the Golden Flashes to a 68-37 record in his three years just outside of Cleveland, Ohio. This included a 35-13 mark in the Mid-American Conference and a pair of MAC regular-season championships, becoming the first MAC coach in 48 years to win back to back regular-season crowns.

He parlayed that into a job in the Missouri Valley Conference with Bradley, guiding the program to the nation's seventh-best turnaround in his second season, leading the team from a 7-25 mark to 18-17 the following year. He also coached the second MVC player ever to record 500 points, 100 rebounds, 100 assists and 70 steals in a season in Walt Lemon, Jr.

The Ohio University graduate sits sixth in school history with 1,752 career points after averaging 18.9 and 18.7 per night in his junior and senior seasons, respectively. He was also First-Team All-MAC and Academic All-Conference selection as a senior in 1997. During the summer of 2023, Ford was inducted into the Ohio Basketball Hall of Fame.

NEWS & NOTES

MANIC MONDAY

The opening night of the 2024-25 season - the first 14-game day in league history - saw nine teams find the win column and two others put up valiant upset bids on the road.

Charleston opened the year for the league with a 90-80 win over Southern Illinois in Sioux Falls and Northeastern picked up a crosstown win over Boston University, while Campbell, Drexel, Hampton, Hofstra, N.C. A&T, UNCW, and William & Mary defeated non-D1 opponents.

Elon tested No. 9 North Carolina in Chapel Hill, as the Phoenix was tied with the Tar Heels with 6:02 to play. Out west, Towson battled with Saint Mary's to a seven-point setback in Moraga.

ROCK THE VOTE

The league calendar is quiet on Tuesday as teams are off for Election Day, although a handful of games will be played across the country. CAA action will resume on Wednesday when Campbell visits Virginia, a university founded by the third President, Thomas Jefferson, a William & Mary alum.

THE C IN CBS IS FOR... COASTAL?

CBS Sports Network, CBS, and Paramount+ will televise 29 games involving CAA men's basketball teams in 2024-25.

N.C. A&T will host NC Central and Hampton will welcome Howard on Saturday, Dec. 28 for the CBS Sports Classic: HBCU Showcase. The games will be televised as a doubleheader beginning at 2 p.m. on CBS and Paramount+.

The 24-game regular-season package on CBS Sports Network begins Thursday, Jan. 9 when Elon visits William & Mary and concludes Saturday, March 1, when the Phoenix heads to Stony Brook.

The final three games of the 2025 Jersey Mike's CAA Men's Basketball Championship will be on CBS Sports Network on March 10 and 11.

EYE ON THE TIGERS

Towson is the league's preseason favorite for the second time in the last three years. The Tigers return four of five starters from the program's third-straight 20-win season a year ago, including reigning Rookie of the Year Tyler Tejada and fellow preseason all-league pick Christian May.

ANTE UP

Charleston's Ante Brzovic was unanimously selected by the Cougars' opposing coaches as the league's Preseason Player of the Year. Brzovic was an All-CAA First Team selection a year ago and has helped Charleston to 58 wins and two CAA titles over the last two years.

NO INTRODUCTION NEEDED

The league's three new head coaches for 2024-25 include two with a wealth of experience leading Division I programs.

Charleston's Chris Mack is in his 14th year as a Division I head coach after spending nine years at Xavier and four at Louisville. William & Mary's Brian Earl spent the last eight seasons at Cornell before taking over in Williamsburg this spring. Hampton's Ivan Thomas was the Ione D1 head coaching debut in the CAA on Monday; Thomas spent the last eight seasons as an assistant at Providence and Georgetown.

HEALTHY COMPETITION

The CAA was at least .500 vs. the Horizon (4-0), MVC (3-0), CUSA (1-0), Southland (1-0), Patriot (9-1), MAAC (6-1), Big South (4-2), Sun Belt (8-3), Atlantic Sun (3-2), and MEAC (7-5) in non-conference play last year. The league claimed two wins vs. the Big East (Drexel at Vilanova, Delaware at Xavier) and The American (Northeastern vs. East Carolina, Hofstra vs. South Florida) and one vs. the Big 12 (Monmouth at West Virginia) and SEC (UNCW at Kentucky).

SELF-IMPROVEMENT

The CAA's non-conference success and offensive uptick led to the league reaching Selection Sunday with eight teams in the top 200 of the NET and KenPom after having five a year ago.

A strengthened middle of the league - including Stony Brook and Monmouth both 150+ spots higher in the NET in Year 2 as league members - contributed to the rise.

Seven league members - Charleston (53), UNCW (65), Hofstra (133), Drexel (141), Stony Brook (172), Monmouth (186), and Northeastern (195) - were in the top 200 in KenPom offensive efficiency after just three teams were in 2022-23.

STATEMENT SATURDAY

Drexel and UNCW took down AP Top 25 opponents on Dec. 2 with Drexel holding off No. 18 Villanova, 57-55, and UNCW powering past No. 12 Kentucky, 80-73. It marked the first time in league history that two CAA teams defeated Top 25 opponents in the same day.

HEN-CINNATI

Delaware bounced back from a 10-point deficit in the first half to down Xavier, 87-80, on Dec. 5. The Blue Hens shot 50% and turned the Muskeeters over 17 times while receiving a career night from Jalun Trent (27 points, 7 rebounds, 6 assists.)
