QUICK HITTERS

- The Seawolves enter the game following their bye week with a 3-3 (1-1 CAA) record this season.
- In their last outing, the Seawolves dominated the Great Danes to secure their second straight Golden Apple victory with a 47-12 win over UAlbany on Oct. 4.
- Stony Brook owns a 4-8 all-time record against Monmouth, falling to the Hawks in their last three meetings since joining the CAA.
- Monmouth is currently ranked No. 10/11 in the FCS by Stats Perform and the AFCA Coaches Poll with a 5-1 (2-0 CAA) record. This marks the first time Stony Brook will face a ranked team since battling No. 9 Rhode Island on Sept. 6.
- Stony Brook is 12-38 all-time against ranked opponents.
- On offense, RB Roland Dempster ranks in the top three in the CAA in rushing yards, rushing yards per game, and rushing touchdowns. He also ranks 13th in the FCS and second in the CAA in all-purpose yards per game.
- The Stony Brook defense is led by Anthony Ferrelli, who has a team-best 53 tackles, 3.0 tackles for loss, and one interception. Dyshier Clary and Franco Milano have combined for 6.5 sacks this season, while Miles McGoy ranks 11th nationally and leads the CAA in passes defended in 2025.
- Monmouth enters the game as the highest ranked team in the CAA and also has the No. 1 ranked offense in the FCS, leading the nation in first downs, passing offense, and ranking fifth in scoring offense.
- The Seawolves return multiple starters on both sides of the ball, including Niko Papic (OL), Roland Dempster (RB), Rodney Faulk (DE), Dez Williams (WR), Enda Kirby (K), Sebastian Regis (DE), Chayce Chalmers (LB), AJ Roberts (LB), Anthony Ferrelli (LB), Kollin Melendez (OL), Cole Bunnicci (TE), Jayce Freeman (WR), Jayson Allen (S), and Cam Johnson (DB).
- In the portal, Stony Brook was active in getting players from across Division I, II, and III. SIDELINES

Stony Brook follows guidelines set forth by the NCAA Public Relations Committee, the NCAA Football Rules Committee, the American Football Coaches Association and the National Press Photographers Association. PRESEASON AWARD HONORS

- Stony Brook football team has been picked to finish fourth in the CAA Preseason Coaches Poll, with six players earning spots on the CAA Football Preseason All-Conference Team. Roland Dempster, Niko Papic, Enda Kirby, AJ Roberts, Rodney Faulk, and Anthony Ferrelli were named to the Preseason All-CAA team.
- Dempster and Papic were named Phil Steele FCS Preseason All-Americans.
- Dempster, Papic, Kirby, Roberts, Ferrelli, Faulk, Dez Williams, Jayce Freeman, Sebastian Regis, Aidan Kaler and Cole Bunicci were named Phil Steele Preseason All-CAA recipients.
- Dempster was honored as a Preseason All-American by Stats Perform and FCS Football Central.

LEADING THE TEAM

- OL Niko Papic, DE Rodney Faulk, LB AJ Roberts, LB Chayce Chalmers, and LB Anthony Ferrelli have been named the captains for the 2025 season.
- Papic, who was a captain last season, was named a Male NSCA All-American and earned Phil Steele All-CAA and All-CAA Third Team honors. One of only two Seawolves to start every game, he anchored a line that boosted Stony Brook's offense to 403.9 yards per game, including 170.3 on the ground. Papic helped pave the way for Roland Dempster's record-setting season and contributed to the Seawolves leading the CAA in time of possession. This season, he was named to the All-CAA Preseason Team and named a Preseason All-American by Phil Steele.
- Faulk, who was also a captain last season, played in all 12 games for the Seawolves. He recorded 37 tackles, including 17 solo stops, while finishing second on the team with 10.0 tackles for loss and 4.5 sacks. Faulk also led the defense with four quarterback hurries and three forced fumbles. His highlights included a season-high three tackles for loss and two sacks against New Hampshire on Nov. 16, 2.5 tackles for loss and a forced fumble in a win over Morgan State on Sept. 28, and his first sack of the season at Fordham on Sept. 14. He was also named to the Preseason All-CAA Team.
- Roberts earned Second Team All-CAA and Phil Steele All-CAA honors after leading Stony Brook with 86 tackles. He added 4.5 tackles for loss, a sack, an interception, three pass breakups, three quarterback hurries, a forced fumble, and a fumble recovery. Roberts posted at least four tackles in every game, highlighted by 11 tackles and a pick-six against William & Mary. He is also a member of the Preseason All-CAA Team.
- Chalmers had a career season in 2024 as he appeared in all 12 games, totaling 56 tackles (26 solo, 30 assisted) and ranking fourth on the team in tackles. He added 7.5 tackles for loss and 3.5 sacks, highlighted by a 38-yard fumble return against Towson and a 26-yard interception return versus William & Mary. Chalmers recorded a season-high 10 tackles against Marshall.
- 2025 Preseason All-CAA Honorable Mention, Ferrelli returns to the Seawolves after his breakout 2024 season. a CSC Academic All-District honoree and Phil Steele Fourth Team All-CAA selection, led the defense with a career-best 84 tackles (38 solo, 46 assisted). He added 5.5 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks, three pass breakups, and a fumble recovery, ranking in the CAA's top 20 in total tackles with a 7.0-per-game average. Ferrelli recorded at least five tackles in 11 games, including double-digit stops against Marshall and William & Mary.

STONY BROOK SEAWOLVES FOOTBALL

THE BIGGEST TURNAROUND IN THE FCS

- Cosh transformed a team predicted to finish last in the CAA Preseason Coaches Poll in 2024 into a national contender as the Seawolves finished with the largest turnaround in the FCS last season (0-10 to 8-4).
- The Seawolves achieved their highest national ranking last season since 2018 (No. 16 on Nov. 11).
- With the eight victories, the Seawolves reached their most wins since 2017 (10-3).
- Stony Brook captured their first winning season last year since 2018 (7-5).
- Stony Brook recorded their first Golden Apple Victory over UAlbany since 2021.

COSH OF THE YEAR

- After leading the team to the historic turnaround, Cosh was named the 2024 Walter Camp FCS Coach of the Year. He was the first head coach in program history to earn the award.
- Cosh was also named the AFCA FCS Coach of the Year, AFCA Regional Coach of the Year, and CAA Coach of the Year.
- Cosh was the first head coach in program history and second ever first-year FCS head coach to receive the AFCA FCS Coach of the Year Award.
- At just 32 years old last season, Cosh was the second-youngest head coach in the FBS or FCS.
- Cosh's eight regular season victories also placed him third top-performing first-year head coaches and is now the fastest head coach in program history to reach this milestone.

NUMBERS NEVER LIE

- Offensively, the team improved from 15.2 points per game in 2023 to 29.6 points per game in 2024.
- Total offensive yardage jumped from 314.2 to 403.9 yards per game, including a surge in rushing yards from 104.1 to 170.3 and passing yards from 210.1 to 223.6.
- The team's touchdown count skyrocketed from 19 in 2023 to 44 in 2024.
- The defense also saw substantial improvements, limiting opponents to 24.0 points per game compared to 39.2 the previous year.
- Total yards allowed dropped from 470.7 to 373.5 per game, and the Seawolves reduced touchdowns allowed from 53 to 32.
- In 2024, Stony Brook led the CAA and ranked in the FCS 1-10 for fumbles recovered, turnover margin, turnovers gained, and blocked punts allowed. They also ranked in the CAA's top three—and the FCS's top 25—in fourth-down conversion percentage, defensive touchdowns, passes intercepted, red zone offense, red zone defense, tackles for loss allowed and time of possession.

THE FRESH WOLVES

- Stony Brook welcomes 21 freshman to the team this season from five different states (New York, New Jersey, Maryland, Pennsylvania, and Georgia).
- The signing class included three-star Brooks Martin, QB prospect Tavion Byrd, DL prospect Mark Beasley, all-state kicker Michael Mannino and the Commack High School duo of Andrew Riggs and Tyler Burbatsky.

SEASON OUTLOOK

- San Diego State is the only FBS team on the 2025 slate for the Seawolves. The week one trip to SDSU continues Stony Brook's streak of playing an FBS opponent in every full season since 2010.
- Stony Brook will play 12 games in its regular season slate for the second time since 2019, the last being in 2024.
- The Seawolves will play six times at home, also reaching that mark for the second time since in 2019 (six in 2024).

- The squad will face two in-state teams during their 2024 campaign (Fordham and UAlbany).
- Stony Brook will be facing SDSU, Lindenwood and North Carolina A&T for the first time in program history.

WELCOME TO THE STAFF!

- The Seawolves made changes on both sides of the ball during the offseason.
- Damian Mincey was announced as the running backs coach for the 2025 season after Mincey spent the last three seasons (2022–24) at UMass, where he led the running backs room and helped elevate the team's rushing attack.
- Jim Nelson joins the staff as the new safeties coach for the upcoming season. Nelson spent five seasons on staff at Fresno State, serving as a full-time defensive assistant coach from 2022 to 2024 after working as a defensive quality control coach in 2020 and 2021
- Matt Oehl comes to the Island as the recruiting coordinator and director of player personal after his 2024 at East Carolina where he was the Director of Scouting for the Pirates football program.
- Jacob Liebert will serve as the Video Operations Assistant this season.
- Numerous coaches were elevated to new roles for the 2025 season. Billy Barber (director of football operations), Dermot McDonough (Defensive Quality Control), Bryan Valenti (Offensive Quality Control), and Sam Howson Offensive Assistant.

SEAWOLVES IN THE PROS

- Over the past seven seasons Stony Brook has sent a total of 21 student-athletes to NFL training camps.
- This past offseason, Eric Black signed a contract with the Ottawa Redblacks in the Canadian Football League (CFL) after spending time with the Roughriders last season.
- Most recently, former Stony Brook linebacker Sam Kamara was signed to the Browns on Nov. 16, 2024 as he continues to train in camp with the team from Cleveland. He appeared in the final four games of the season, including six tackles against the Ravens in Week 18.
- Tyrone Wheatley Jr. is currently playing with the Atlanta Falcons on their practice squad.
- Alums Tyler Santucci is currently the ILB coach for the Ravens and Greg Delimitros is the VP of Equipment Operations for the Eagles.

THE GOLDEN VICTORY

- The Stony Brook football team captured its second consecutive Golden Apple victory with a dominant 47-12 win over the Great Danes on Saturday afternoon in Albany. The win marked Stony Brook's largest margin of victory and highest point total in Golden Apple history.
- QB Chris Zellous led the way for the Seawolves offensively. The graduate student finished the day with 272 total yards, tying his season-high with four total touchdowns. He went 20-of-30 for 241 yards through the air, tossing one touchdown, and added 31 yards on 10 carries with a season-high three rushing touchdowns.
- Roland Dempster was all over the stat sheet. The running back posted his third 100-yard rushing game of the season, finishing with 105 yards on 20 carries and his sixth touchdown of the year. He also added a season-best 61 receiving yards on a season-high five receptions, wrapping up the day with 166 total yards.
- Dez Williams was a threat all afternoon out wide, leading the team with 87 yards on a team-best six receptions and a touchdown. Jayce Freeman contributed 40 yards on three catches, while Justin Reshard recorded a season-high 21 yards on two catches. Marqeesse Dietz, in his first game back at UAlbany since transferring to Stony Brook, hauled in four catches for 27 yards.
- Dyshier Clary led the defense, tying for the team-high with five tackles, including three tackles for loss, one sack, a fumble recovery, and a quarterback hurry. Bryson Parker snagged an interception, while AJ Roberts and Franco Milano each recorded a sack. Aidan Kaler and Anthony Ferrelli also tied for the team-high with five tackles.
- Stony Brook totaled 473 yards on 80 plays, compared to UAlbany's 198 yards on 52 plays. The Seawolves posted 250 passing yards and 223 rushing yards, while UAlbany managed just 50 rushing and 148 passing yards.
- This marked the largest-ever win over UAlbany, surpassing the previous margin from the 2021 season (22 points). The 47 points were also the most Stony Brook has ever scored against UAlbany, eclipsing their 40-point mark from their first meeting on Nov. 23, 1995.
- Stony Brook improves to 12-15 all-time against UAlbany and has now won the last two matchups. This was the 27th meeting in 30 seasons and the 12th straight year since both joined the CAA.

ABOUT THE HAWKS

- Monmouth is led by 33rd-year head coach Kevin Callahan, who holds a career record of 193-149 and is the longest-tenured coach in

the FCS.

- The Hawks enter the game as the No. 10/11 ranked team in the FCS with a 5-1 (2-0 CAA) record.
- In their last outing, Monmouth defeated Towson after Derek Robertson threw for 244 yards and two touchdowns, while the rushing attack, powered by Rodney Nelson and Elijah Jennings, led the Hawks past Towson 42–31 on Saturday afternoon at Johnny Unitas Stadium.
- Monmouth has defeated all five of their FCS opponents this season, with their only loss coming against FBS opponent Charlotte.
- The Hawks are 14-8 all-time in games played as a ranked team.
- QB Derek Robertson leads the No. 1 offense in the FCS, pacing the country in passing touchdowns, passing yards, passing yards per game, total offense, and points responsible for per game.
- WR Josh Derry is tied for the FCS lead with eight receiving touchdowns this season. He also ranks third in the FCS in receiving yards and receiving yards per game, and fourth in receptions per game.
- RB Rodney Nelson ranks third in the FCS in all-purpose yards per game, while leading the nation in rushing yards per game. He also ranks 12th in rushing touchdowns.
- Leading the defense is Josiah Graham, who ranks fourth in the FCS and leads the CAA in sacks. Lamont Lester Jr. is also a force on the line, ranking second in the CAA and 14th in the FCS in sacks. Jaden Jones leads the Hawks in tackling, ranking fourth in the CAA and 19th in the FCS.

HISTORY AGAINST RANKED TEAMS

- This will be the second ranked opponent the Seawolves face this season after hosting No. 8/9 Rhode Island on Sept. 6. Stony Brook is 12-38 all-time against nationally-ranked FCS opponents.
- The Seawolves' most recent win over a ranked opponent came against No. 15 William & Mary at LaValle Stadium last season on Oct. 26, 2024.
- Stony Brook knocked off No. 2 Richmond at LaValle Stadium in Week 3 of 2016, marking the program's highest-ever ranked-opponent victory.
- The last ranked road win for Stony Brook came in Philadelphia, where the Seawolves defeated No. 5 Villanova on Oct. 26, 2019.
- The Seawolves have three FCS teams that are currently receiving votes or are ranked inside the top 25 on their 2024 schedule (Monmouth, Rhode Island, and Villanova).

CLAYTON NAMED NFF AWARD SEMIFINALIST

- Clayton Taylor was one of six CAA Football student-athletes that were selected as semifinalists for the prestigious William V. Campbell Trophy, as announced by the National Football Foundation on Wednesday morning.
- The Campbell Trophy recognizes an individual as the absolute best scholar-athlete in the nation for combined academic success, football performance and exemplary leadership. There were 178 student-athletes selected as semifinalists across all divisions, with the group having a combined grade point average of 3.60. Of the 177 semifinalists, 43 were from the FCS level.
- This season, Taylor is currently leading the CAA in touchbacks (2) and ranks second in the conference for punts (25) and yards (1051), and punts inside the 20 (8).
- Taylor returns for the 2025 season after appearing in all 12 games last year, punting for a career-high 2,622 yards with a 42.3-yard average, including a season-long 62-yard punt. He recorded 20 fair catches and placed 20 punts inside the 20-yard line, while logging nine punts of 50 yards or more. His 42.3-yard average was the second-highest single-season mark in program history, earning him CSC Academic All-District honors.
- Over the course of his career, Taylor has solidified his place in the Stony Brook record books. He ranks second all-time in single-season punting average (42.3), tenth in career punting average (39.1), and second in career punts (184).

ROLAND IS ROLLING!

- The Seawolves' leading back for the last two seasons continues to shine in 2025.
- This season, Dempster has rushed for 617 yards on 118 carries with six rushing touchdowns. He has also caught 16 passes for 142 yards.
- The RB has rushed for over 100 yards in three of six games this season. He has accumulated over 100 all-purpose yards in five of six games, dating back to the opener against FBS opponent SDSU.
- Dempster is averaging 126.5 all-purpose yards per game, which ranks 13th in the FCS and second in the CAA. The graduate student ranks top four in the CAA in rushing yards, rushing yards per game, rushing touchdowns, and rushing yards per carry.

Billy Cosh was named the third head coach in Stony Brook football's Division I era on December 13, 2023. Cosh joined Stony Brook for his first career head coaching job after spending the 2023 season at Western Michigan as the Broncos' offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach. In his first season at the helm, Billy Cosh was named the AFCA FCS Coach of the Year, AFCA Regional Coach of the Year, CAA Coach of the Year, and Walter Camp FCS Coach of the Year.

At just 32 years old, Cosh — the second-youngest head coach in either the FBS or FCS — engineered a historic turnaround for Stony Brook football in his debut season. Taking over a program that went 0-10 (0-8 CAA) in 2023 and was picked to finish last in the CAA preseason poll, Cosh led the Seawolves to an 8-4 overall record (5-3 CAA). The dramatic improvement marked Stony Brook's first winning season since 2018, its highest national ranking in six years (No. 16), and a No. 24 spot in the final regular-season Stats Perform FCS Top 25.

Under Cosh's leadership, the Seawolves saw a major resurgence on both sides of the ball. Offensively, the team jumped from 15.2 points per game in 2023 to 29.6 in 2024. Total yardage climbed from 314.2 to 403.9 yards per game, with rushing output improving from 104.1 to 170.3 and passing yards rising from 210.1 to 223.6. Stony Brook's touchdown total more than doubled, going from 19 in 2023 to 44 in 2024. Defensively, the Seawolves made similar strides. The unit cut opponents' scoring from 39.2 points per game in 2023 to 24.0 in 2024, and total yards allowed dropped from 470.7 to 373.5. Stony Brook also held opponents to just 32 touchdowns, compared to 53 the year before.

Cosh's debut season also propelled several players into the national spotlight. Running back Roland Dempster was nominated for the Walter Payton Award, becoming just the second player in program history to receive the honor. He also earned First Team All-CAA recognition and four All-American selections. On defense, Rushawn Lawrence collected First Team All-CAA honors and two All-American nods, while standout freshman Sebastian Regis was named to the Freshman All-America team. Additional postseason honors included tight end Cal Redman, kicker Enda Kirby, and cornerback Rudy Silvera, who were named Second Team All-CAA. Offensive linemen Niko Papic and AJ Roberts were selected to the CAA Third Team, while Anthony Ferrelli and Cole Bunicki earned spots on the Phil Steele CAA All-Conference squad.

With Western Michigan in 2023, Cosh guided the Broncos to top-five ranks in the Mid-American Conference (MAC) in five different statistics — second in passing offense (211.2), third in total offense (365.0) and first downs (19.8), and fifth in scoring (23.7) and offensive efficiency (123.3).

Individually, WMU quarterback Hayden Wolff ranked first in the MAC in completion percentage, completing 65.5 percent of his passes. Wide receiver Kenneth Womack led the league with 6.3 receptions per game and 691 receiving yards. Freshman running back Jalen Buckley ranked third in the league with 91.2 rushing yards per game and tied for fourth with 10 rushing touchdowns.

Cosh's offense was well-represented in the MAC's postseason awards, taking two First Team selections and three Third Team picks, while Buckley was also garnered as the league's Freshman of the Year and later selected to The Athletic Freshman All-America Team.

Prior to Western Michigan, Cosh spent three years as an FCS offensive coordinator, most recently with Richmond in 2022. That season, the Spiders went 9-4 and earned a trip to the second round of the FCS Playoffs, scoring 31.3 points per game, third-most in the CAA.

In the FCS ranks, Richmond finished top-25 in 10 offensive statistics, including second in completion percentage (73.2%), fifth in total first downs (314), and tied for sixth in fewest interceptions thrown (5) in 2022.

Cosh came to Richmond from VMI, where he led the Keydets to top-20 FCS ranks in scoring offense and passing efficiency as the offensive coordinator during his final two seasons. In his first season as offensive coordinator in Lexington, Va., Cosh led the Keydets' offense to seven different top-two SoCon statistical ranks including scoring offense, passing offense and passing efficiency, as VMI took a SoCon title in 2020-21 under his Air Raid offense.

Before becoming an offensive coordinator at VMI, Cosh served as the wide receivers coach in the 2018 and 2019 seasons. He coached 1,000-yard receivers each season, and had three receivers in the top 10 of the SoCon in receiving along with four All-Conference selections among his wideouts during those two seasons.

He started his coaching career at Concord University (Md.) as an offensive graduate assistant and quarterbacks coach. Later, he served as a graduate assistant at Indiana, assisting with the passing game plan and working with quarterbacks and wide receivers, among other duties.

Cosh played five seasons of college football as a quarterback, playing at Houston (2013-14), Butler Community College (2012), James Madison (2011) and Kansas State (2010). He led Butler C.C. to the 2012 NJCCA National Championship, throwing for 2,856 yards and 25 touchdowns that season. He graduated with a degree in sociology from Houston in 2015.

A native of Gambrills, Md., Cosh is the son of long-time college football coach Chris Cosh, who recently served as defensive coordinator at Delaware (2017-19) and Hampton (2022), and most recently served as a senior analyst for Western Michigan in 2023. He and his wife Kelsey have a daughter, Charli.
