THIS WEEK'S GAME

For the first time in program history, Saint Vincent will travel to Meadville, Pennsylvania, to face new PAC foe Allegheny College. The Bearcats are coming off of a 41-25 victory over Geneva, a game in which SVC's offense amassed a season-high 410 yards and its defense forced four turnovers. Six different players scored touchdowns for the Bearcats, who recorded 221 passing yards and 189 rushing yards... Allegheny brings a three-game losing streak into this week, most recently falling 44-17 to Grove City in week seven. The Wolverines pulled away in the second quarter by scoring four unanswered touchdowns. Declan O'Brien caught seven passes for 152 yards for the Gators, including an 80-yard touchdown in the waning moments of the first half... This week marks just the third road game of the year for the Bearcats, who are looking for their first victory away from Chuck Noll Field. Allegheny is 1-2 at home.

GAME NOTES

LONG TIME, NO SEE: Though the two institutions have been in existence a combined 384 years and are separated by just 125 miles, Saint Vincent and Allegheny have met just once prior on the gridiron. On Sept. 28, 1929, Allegheny traveled to Latrobe for a 28-6 victory over Saint Vincent in the Bearcats' season-opener. That season, the Bearcats, under head coach Clem Crowe, finished 4-4-1, while the Gators and head coach Harry Crum went 2-6-1.

TWICE AS NICE: Saint Vincent had its most productive rushing performance of the season in the 41-25 victory over Geneva, as the Bearcats totaled a season-high 189 rushing yards, their most in a game since the spring 2021 finale against Waynesburg (April 17, 2021) when they gained 204. Sophomore D.J. Gray Jr. led the way against Geneva with 93 yards, while teammate Ja'Tier Berkley rushed for 92 and a touchdown. It marked just the second time in the team's modern era (2007-present) in which two players ran for more than 90 yards in a game. The previous instance occurred Nov. 2, 2019, when David Marshall ran for 96 yards and Mike Stasko 93, in a 35-20 loss to Grove City.

ANOTHER WALKER HAT TRICK: Against Geneva, Saint Vincent senior quarterback Brady Walker threw for 221 yards and three touchdowns, both season-highs. It marked the fifth time in Walker's career in which he threw for at least three touchdowns, while it was the 14th multi-touchdown performance of his career. Walker has thrown for at least one touchdown in 22 of 24 career games. He holds the Saint Vincent career record with 45 touchdown passes.

A TEAM EFFORT: In the win over Geneva, Saint Vincent's six touchdowns were scored by six different players. Quarterback Brady Walker opened the scoring with a 9-yard touchdown run midway through the first quarter. In the second quarter, Ja'Tier Berkley ran for a 42-yard score before Walker and Molayo Irefin connected for a 9-yard TD strike. Walker then fired touchdown strikes to Nick Domico (21 yards) and Ryan Whitman (14 yards), before SVC closed the scoring on a 2-yard fumble recovery touchdown by Joanes Polynice. It was just the fifth time in the team's modern era, spanning 152 games, in which six different players found the end zone.

SIX FOR SIX: In last week's win over Geneva, Saint Vincent closed out its scoring with a 2-yard fumble recovery touchdown return by sophomore linebacker Joanes Polynice late in the fourth quarter. It marked Polynice's third career defensive touchdown in his 15th career game. Last season, he had a pair of pick-sixes, including a 35-yarder in SVC's 42-40 win over Case Western Reserve on Oct. 2 and a 34-yard interception return against Grove City on Oct. 16.

POOR RETURNS: Through Saint Vincent's first six games of the 2022 season, opponents are averaging just 1.8 yards per punt return. The Bearcats are one of just two teams in the PAC to have not punted into a touchback, while eight of freshman punter Kyle Murray's 30 boots have been downed inside the 20-yard line.

OH CAPTAIN(S), MY CAPTAIN(S): Per a vote of their teammates, the 2022 Saint Vincent College football captains are graduate safety Kyle Coombe, senior quarterback Brady Walker, senior defensive back Ahmad Shaw and junior receiver Molayo Irefin.

UP NEXT: Saint Vincent will play its final road game of the 2022 season next week, traveling to Pittsburgh to take on PAC-leading Carnegie Mellon, ranked No. 18 in this week's D3football.com national poll. The Bearcats will be looking for their first win over the Tartans since the 2014 campaign.

AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

**Fourth season
Saint Vincent, 2012**

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He enters his fourth season as head coach in 2022, bringing a record of 10-15 into the new year.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Quarterback Brady Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Sophomore receiver Molayo Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/gm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District™.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witche (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.



A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modern-day career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff, Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFA title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive

Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

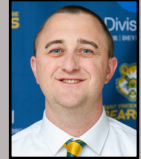
After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as quarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
