## THIS WEEK'S GAME

Saint Vincent will close out the road portion of its 2022 schedule with this week's trip to Presidents' Athletic Conference leader Carnegie Mellon University. The Bearcats have won two straight, most recently defeating PAC foe Allegheny, 52-35, last week on the road. Brady Walker threw for 315 yards and five touchdowns as Saint Vincent recorded season-highs with 419 yards of total offense and 28 first downs... Carnegie Mellon, ranked No. 18 in this week's D3Football.com national poll, improved to 8-0 on the season with last week's 41-0 blanking of Geneva. The Tartans limited the Golden Tornadoes to just 218 yards of total offense and scored both a special teams and defensive touchdown. This season, Carnegie Mellon's defense has surrendered just 11 touchdowns and have allowed an average of just 11.3 points per game, while they lead the PAC in both interceptions (14) and quarterback sacks (29)... SVC has dropped each of its past four meetings to CMU, with the Bearcats' last win over the Tartans coming in 2014.

## **GAME NOTES**

**FABULOUS FIFTY:** Last week's 52-35 win at Allegheny marked the sixth time in Saint Vincent's modern history (2007-present) in which the Bearcats scored 50 or more points in a game, and the first time it's happened on the road. The Bearcats have won all six times. Previous occurrences included Nov. 13, 2021 vs. Bethany (52-7), April 17, 2021 vs. Waynesburg (56-26), Sept. 24, 2016 vs. Grove City (57-32), Oct. 3, 2015 vs. Thiel (65-14) and Sept. 10, 2011 vs. Fairleigh Dickinson-Florham (55-3).

**AWARD-WINNING PERFORMANCE:** After throwing for 315 yards and five touchdowns in Saint Vincent's win over Allegheny, senior quarterback Brady Walker was named the Presidents' Athletic Conference Offensive Player of the Week for the third time in his career. It was Walker's second career five-touchdown performance, and just the fourth in the program's modern era. It also marked Walker's fifth career 300-yard passing effort.

**FABULOUS FACEY:** After recording three tackles, an interception, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery in the win at Allegheny, Saint Vincent freshman safety Ethan Facey was named the Presidents' Athletic Conference Rookie of the Week. Through the first seven games this season, Facey has totaled 39 tackles, two interceptions, two forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries.

**RECORD-BREAKING ROOKIE:** Late in the second quarter of last week's win at Allegheny, freshman kicker Justin Emeigh connected on a 42-yard field goal that gave the Bearcats a 24-13 lead. It was the longest successful field goal in the team's modern history, breaking the previous record of 41 yards set on Oct. 13, 2007, by Matt Houston against Thomas More College.

**SPREAD IT AROUND:** For the second time in as many weeks, six different players scored touchdowns for Saint Vincent in its win at Allegheny. While junior Max Pisula rushed for a pair of touchdowns, quarterback Brady Walker's five touchdown passes went to five different receivers, including Wayne Corbin Jr., Molayo Irefin, Jeffrey Downs, Ja'Tier Berkley and Ryan Whitman.

**TWO BIG WEEKS**: The Bearcats' 52-35 victory last at Allegheny followed their 41-25 win over Geneva in week six. In the two wins, Saint Vincent amassed 829 yards of total offense. It is Saint Vincent's most prolific two-week span since weeks four and five of the 2015 campaign, when they gained a total of 921 yards and racked up 113 points in wins over Grove City (48-28) and Thiel (65-14).

**CLIMBING THE RANKS**: Saint Vincent junior receiver Molayo Irefin recorded game-highs of nine catches for 103 yards in last week's victory at Allegheny. It was Irefin's second 100-yard receiving performance of the season and seventh of his career. In just 19 career games, Irefin ranks third in Saint Vincent program history in career receptions (123) and receiving yards (1,462), while his 11 touchdown catches rank fifth all-time. This season, Irefin ranks second in the Presidents' Athletic Conference with 44 receptions and fifth with 466 receiving yards.

**UP NEXT:** Saint Vincent returns home next week (Nov. 5) to take on Waynesburg University at 1 p.m. at Chuck Noll Field. The Bearcats will be looking for their fourth straight win over the Yellow Jackets. Waynesburg is Saint Vincent's most frequent foe on the gridiron, as the two teams have met 40 times dating back to the 1929 campaign.

## **SAINT VINCENT VS. CARNEGIE MELLON - LAST MEETING**

On Oct. 30 of last season, Presidents' Athletic Conference co-leader Carnegie Mellon jumped out to an early lead and then used a stifling defense to hold Saint Vincent in check, earning a 34-7 win on a rainy afternoon at Chuck Noll Field. Saint Vincent quarterback Brady Walker became his team's all-time career leader in touchdown passes on a 18-yarder to Molayo Irefin late in the second quarter, but it was one of the lone highlights of the afternoon for the Bearcats, who were limited to just 208 yards of total offense and committed three turnovers.

Carnegie Mellon jumped out to a 28-0 lead midway through the second quarter on three rushing touchdowns from Tre Vasiliadis and a 25-yard touchdown pass from Ben Mills to Kris Hughes. Walker's touchdown pass to Irefin to cut the halftime deficit to 28-7, but the Tartans' Minwoo Eom would return the opening kickoff of the third quarter 91 yards for a touchdown to account for the final score.

Carnegie Mellon amassed 333 yards of total offense, led by 102 rushing yards from Vasiliadis and 99 receiving yards from Hughes. The Tartans held the Bearcats to 0 rushing yards, fueled by four quarterback sacks. Joanes Polyince totaled a game-high nine tackles and a forced fumble for SVC, while Jaden Pratt recorded his second interception of the season. Irefin recorded a game-high 10 receptions.



## AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

# Fourth season Saint Vincent, 2012

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He enters his fourth season as head coach in 2022, bringing a record of 10-15 into the new year.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Quarterback Brady Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Sophomore receiver Molayo Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/gm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District™.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witchey (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.



A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modern-day career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff, Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFL title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive

Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as quarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
