THIS WEEK'S GAME

Saint Vincent comes off of its bye week looking to get back into the win column after a 42-7 loss at Grove City on Sept. 24. The Bearcats trailed just 7-0 with less than a minute left in the second quarter, only to see the Wolverines score 35 unanswered points into the middle stages of the fourth. SVC's D.J. Gray Jr. tallied the lone Bearcat touchdown on a 6-yard run in the closing minute of the fourth quarter. The Bearcats committed a pair of costly turnovers and came up empty on a first-and-goal situation early on... Like Saint Vincent, Case Western Reserve is also coming off of a loss to Grove City, with the Spartans falling 14-13 to the Wolverines last week. Case Western Reserve outgained Grove City by 115 yards, but three second half turnovers for the Spartans proved to be costly. The Spartans defense limited the Wolverines to just 225 yards of total offense, but a fumble and two interceptions in the second half, along with a missed extra point in the second quarter, proved to be the difference. In the loss, Case Western Reserve quarterback Drew Saxton set a program record for career touchdowns passes and became the first quarterback in team history to surpass 10,000 career yards... Last season, Saint Vincent defeated Case Western Reserve 42-40 in a wild Homecoming battle at Chuck Noll Field. It was only Saint Vincent's second victory all-time over the Spartans, and first since 2014.

GAME NOTES

GRAY DAY: After rushing for 69 yards for the Bearcats in week four at Grove City, D.J. Gray Jr. upped his season rushing total to 317 yards. It is the most rushing yards through the first four games of a Saint Vincent player's career since Tyler Donahue ran for 347 yards over the opening four weeks of the 2015 campaign. Gray is one of just four first-year Saint Vincent players to rush for 300+ yards in their first four games, joining Donahue, Shavonta Craft (354 yards - 2014) and Huey Ehredt (355 yards - 2011). Gray's 79.2 rushing yards per game this season rank fifth in the PAC.

MO'S MOVING UP: After recording 9 catches for 41 yards for the Bearcat at Grove City, junior wide receiver Molayo Irefin became just the fourth player in program history to eclipse 100 career receptions. Through his first 16 career games, irefin has 104 receptions, good for third alltime in the program record books, behind only Damon Black Jr.'s 187 catches (2014-17) and D.J. Oceant-Kelly's 140 (2014-17). Irefin also ranks fourth in SVC history in both career punt return yards (196) and kick return yards (906), while his career kick return average of 22.3 yards is third-best in team history. This season, irefin ranks second in the PAC with a kick return average of 24.7 yards.

WE'RE BREAKING UP: In week four at Grove City, Saint Vincent sophomore cornerback Marvelle Cromerdie recorded three pass break-ups, increasing his total to five on the season, tied for the most in the Presidents' Athletic Conference.

EXTRA, EXTRA: Through four games this season, the Saint Vincent placekickers are a perfect 10-for-10 on extra point attempts, with sophomore Adam Koscielicki 7-for-7 and freshman Justin Emigh 3-for-3. The Bearcats are one of just three teams in the PAC to have not yet missed a point-after kick this season.

THE STREAK CONTINUES: In week four at Grove City, Saint Vincent sophomore safety Jaden Edmonds recorded seven tackles, including one tackle for loss. Edmonds leads the Bearcats with 4.0 TFLs, and has at least one in all four games this season. His 4.0 TFLs are the most in the PAC by a player who doesn't play linebacker, defensive end or defensive tackle.

CROSS COUNTRY 'CATS: Eleven states are represented on the Bearcats' 114-man roster. Sixtytwo Pennsylvanians are joined by teammates from Florida (18), Maryland (15), Virginia (7), Ohio (3), Delaware (2), Georgia (2), New Jersey (2), Michigan (1), New York (1) and Texas (1).

OH CAPTAIN(S), MY CAPTAIN(S): Per a vote of their teammates, the 2022 Saint Vincent College football captains are graduate safety Kyle Coombe, senior quarterback Brady Walker, senior defensive back Ahmad Shaw and junior receiver Molayo Irefin.

UP NEXT: Next Saturday, the Bearcats will return home to the friendly confines of Chuck Noll Field for the first time iin 28 days when they host PAC foe Geneva College at 1 p.m. The Bearcats will be looking for their first win over the Golden Tornadoes since 2017.

SVC VS. CASE WESTERN RESERVE - LAST MEETING

On Oct. 2 of last season, Saint Vincent scored 35 second half points, capped off with a pair of fourth quarter touchdown runs from Billy Beck, to defeat Case Western Reserve, 42-40, in a wild Homecoming battle at Chuck Noll Field. After being out-gained 235-88 in the first half, SVC came back to score five touchdowns and amass 298 yards over the game's final 30 minutes.

The Bearcats trailed 14-0 at the close of the first quarter, before cutting the gap to 14-7 at halftime on a 7-yard touchdown pass from Brady Walker to Antonio Zambrano in the closing minute of the second quarter. SVC scored two touchdowns in a 2-minute span in the third quarter, first on an 11-yard pass from Walker to Phil Harding and then a 35-yard INT return touchdown from Joanes Polynice that made it 21-14 with 10 minutes left in the third. The Spartans tied it at 21 with 3:32 left in the third, but SVC answered right back with a 5-yard Julian Howard touchdown run on the opening play of the fourth quarter. On the opening play of the ensuing drive, the Spartans' Drew Saxton and Lucas DeCaro hooked up for a 74-yard touchdown, but the extra point was no good, and SVC held the lead, 28-27. A four-yard Beck touchdown run gave SVC a 35-27 lead with 9:44 to go, but Case answered back to score with 5:07 left. This time, the two-point conversion failed, and SVC led 35-33. With 1:58, Beck scored what proved to be the game-winning touchdown on a 48-yard sprint up the middle. Casse scored on its final drive of the game to make it 42-40, but the Bearcats recovered the on-side kick to seal the win.

The two teams combined for 892 yards of total offense. Walker completed 17 of 28 passes for 219 yards, while the SVC ground game totaled 173 yards, led by 88 from Beck. Saxton threw for 462 yards with two touchdowns and three interceptions for Case Western Reserve.



AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

Fourth season Saint Vincent, 2012

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He enters his fourth season as head coach in 2022, bringing a record of 10-15 into the new year.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Quarterback Brady Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Sophomore receiver Molayo Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/gm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District™.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witchey (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.



A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modern-day career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff, Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFL title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive

Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as quarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
