## THIS WEEK'S GAME

Saint Vincent kicks off its season-ending, two-game homestand this week against longtime rival Waynesburg University. Saint Vincent is coming off of a 30-12 loss at PAC-leading Carnegie Mellon. The host Tartans showcased one of the top defenses in the nation by recording six interceptions and limiting the Bearcats to just 174 yards of total offense. CMU jumped out to a 17-0 lead in the first quarter, and Saint Vincent was unable to recover... Waynesburg dropped to 4-4 overall and 3-3 in the PAC with a 30-10 loss at Westminster in week eight. The Yellow Jackets jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first four minutes of regulation, before the Titans stormed back to score 27 unanswered points. Westminster out-gained Waynesburg 431-222, including a 256-49 margin in rushing yards, while the Titans recorded five quarterback sacks. Waynesburg has rushed for 18 touchdowns this season and ranks third in the PAC with an average of 182.5 rushing yards per game. Saint Vincent has won three in a row over Waynesburg, including a 38-7 road victory on Oct. 23 of last season. Stretching back to the 1929 season, Saint Vincent has never beaten Waynesburg in four straight meetings.

**GAME NOTES**

**SO WE MEET AGAIN:** Saint Vincent and Waynesburg will be facing off for the 41st time on the gridiron, as the Yellow Jackets are the Bearcats' most frequent foe on the gridiron. Waynesburg holds a 20-16-4 advantage in the series, but the Bearcats have won three straight and five of the last seven. In Saint Vincent's modern era of football (2007-present), the Yellow Jackets have won 9 of 15 meetings, while Saint Vincent is 3-4 against Waynesburg in games contested at Chuck Noll Field.

**TO THE MAX:** In last week's loss at No. 18 Carnegie Mellon, Saint Vincent junior Max Pisula scored the Bearcats' final touchdown with a 1-yard plunge late in the fourth quarter. This season, the goall line specialist has a team-leading five rushing touchdowns (tied for fifth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference) on just six carries.

**RARE RECEIVING COMPANY:** After posting a team-leading five receptions in week eight at Carnegie Mellon, Saint Vincent junior receiver Molayo Irefin upped his season total to 49. It ranks second in the PAC and is tied for fifth all-time in a single-season in program history. With his next reception, Irefin will become just the second player in team history to record 50 or more catches in two different seasons, joining Damon Black Jr., who hauled in 65 grabs in 2016 and a team-record 73 in 2017. Irefin's 128 career receptions rank third in team history, behind Black's 187 and D.J. Oceant-Kelly's 140.

**ADDING ON:** Saint Vincent senior quarterback Brady Walker's 6-yard touchdown pass to Ryan Whitman midway through the second quarter of last week's loss at Carnegie Mellon was his 14th of the season, good for second in the PAC. It was Walker's 51st touchdown pass of his career, extending his own program record, while he has at least one touchdown pass in 24 of his 26 career starts.

**FRIENDLY FOE:** Two of Walker's top performances under center for the Bearcats have come in SVC's last two meetings with Waynesburg, as he went a combined 38-for-50 for 700 yards and nine touchdowns in the two wins. During the 2020 spring season, Walker completed 14 of 16 passes for 329 yards and five touchdowns in a 56-26 home win over the 'Jackets. In last year's meeting at Waynesburg, he went 24-for-34 through the air for a career-high 371 yards and four touchdowns in the 38-7 win.

**BIG BOOT:** Saint Vincent freshman kicker Justin Emeigh's 42-yard field goal in the Bearcats' week seven win at Allegheny was the longest in the team's modern era, while it is also the second longest made by a PAC kicker this season, behind only a 44-yarder by Geneva's Ryan Reitler. Emeigh has also notched nine touchbacks on kickoffs, second-most in the PAC.

**CAPTAIN CATS:** Per a vote of the team, Saint Vincent's four co-captains for the 2022 season are graduate safety Kyle Coombe, senior quarterback Brady Walker, senior corner back Ahmad Shaw and junior wide receiver Molayo Irefin.

**UP NEXT:** Saint Vincent will close out the regular season by hosting the annual "Green Game" against Bethany College. Prior to the 1 p.m. kickoff, Saint Vincent will hold a traditional Senior Day ceremony for its senior class.

## SAINT VINCENT VS. WAYNESBURG - LAST MEETING (OCT. 23, 2021)

After spotting host Waynesburg an early 7-0 lead, the Bearcats scored 38 unanswered points to cruise to an emphatic 38-7 win in a Presidents' Athletic Conference battle at Wylie Stadium

Saint Vincent quarterback Brady Walker threw for a career-high 371 yards and four touchdowns, tying head coach Aaron Smetanka's team record with 31 career touchdown strikes, while the SVC defense allowed just 241 yards of total offense and set a team record with four interceptions, two each by Kyle Coombe and Marvelle Cromerdie. Saint Vincent doubled up Waynesburg in both total offense (480-241) and first downs (26-12), averaging 7.5 yards per play. SVC owned a healthy advantage in time of possession, holding the ball for 34 minutes, 55 seconds, while the Bearcats went 7-for-14 on third down conversions and a perfect 2-for-2 on fourth down.

Molayo Irefin continued his stellar sophomore season, making 10 receptions, including two touchdowns, for 173 yards, one shy of his team's single-game record, while the Bearcats' 26 offensive first downs were also just one shy of a team record.

A 34-yard strike from Walker to Phil Harding tied the game at 7-7 in the final minute of the fourth quarter, before the Bearcats scored twice in a 90-second span in the second, first on a 41-yard hookup from Walker to Irefin, and then an 18-yard Walker pass to Andre Dixon. Adam Koscielicki closed out the half's scoring with a 24-yard field goal to beat the second quarter gun.

Irefin's second touchdown of the afternoon, this one from 28 yards, was the lone score of the fourth quarter, before Devin Gleason tallied his first career touchdown pass on a 24-yarder to Jeffrey Downs to make it 38-7 with 2:07 left in regulation.

Dakota Romantino led the way for the Yellow Jackets, hauling in 11 receptions for 142 yards, including a first quarter TD from quarterback Trevor Miller. Miller completed 18 of 32 passes for 191 yards, while Justin Flack paced the Waynesburg ground game with 34 yards on 12 totes.

## AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

**Fourth season  
Saint Vincent, 2012**

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He enters his fourth season as head coach in 2022, bringing a record of 10-15 into the new year.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Quarterback Brady Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Sophomore receiver Molayo Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/gm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District™.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witche (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.



A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modern-day career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff, Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFA title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive

Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

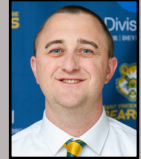
After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as quarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
