THIS WEEK'S GAME

Saint Vincent and Bethany will close out the 2022 regular season with the annual "Green Game" at Chuck Noll Field. The Bearcats improved to 4-3 in the PAC with last week's rousing 53-16 victory over Waynesburg. Molayo Irefin returned the game's opening kickoff for a 100-yard touchdown and the Bearcats never looked back, jumping out to a 19-0 lead in the first quarter and a 39-10 halftime advantage. The 53 points were the most in a game for Saint Vincent in nearly three seasons... Last week, Bethany dropped to 1-8 after a 20-17 overtime loss to Allegheny. The Bison jumped out to a 10-0 lead in the second quarter, before the Gators came back and eventually sealed the win with a 19-yard field goal in the extra session... Bethany's Tre'Jour Owens, who ran for 149 yards against Allegheny, enters the regular season finale as the PAC's leading rusher with 875 yards... Bethany is 10-5 all-time against Saint Vincent in a series that stretches to 2007, but the Bearcats have won three straight over the Bison, most recently earning a 52-7 win at Chuck Noll Field in the 2021 regular season finale.

BEARCAT BRIEFS

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: Saint Vincent will be searching for its fifth win of the season this week. After posting five wins in 2021, it would mark the first time in the program's modern era in which the Bearcats finish with five or more wins in back-to-back seasons. Historically, the last time the Bearcats did so was in the 1955 and '56 seasons, in which they posted records of 5-2-1 and 6-2-1, respectively.

RECORD RETURNS: Saint Vincent couldn't have gotten off to a better start in last week's win over Waynesburg, as junior Molayo Irefin returned the opening kickoff for a 100-yard touchdown. The longest play in program history, it was just the third kick return touchdown in Saint Vincent's modern era and first since a 99-yarder by Darius Brown Sept. 13, 2014, also against Waynesburg. It was also just the fourth 100-yard kickoff return in PAC history and first since October 8, 2005, when Westminster's Sean Buggy had a 100-yard return against W&J. Irefin is one of just three players in NCAA Division III this season to record a 100-yard kickoff return. He now holds Saint Vincent records for longest kickoff return and punt return, after his 85-yard punt return touchdown in week one of this season against Stevenson.

MORE MOLAYO: Along with his kick return touchdown against Waynesburg, Irefin also made two touchdown receptions, while he tallied game-highs with eight catches for 85 yards. It marked the first three-touchdown game for a Bearcat since running back Mike Stasko scored three times in the 2019 season-opener against Ithaca, and just the seventh three-touchdown performance for a Saint Vincent player since 2007, a span of 155 games.

THERE'S SOMETHING ABOUT QBs NAMED BRADY: After throwing for four touchdowns in last week's win over Waynesburg, senior quarterback Brady Walker upped his total to 18 TD passes on the season, tied for the PAC lead and the third most in a single-season in SVC program history. It was the fifth time in Walker's career in which he threw for at least four touchdowns. He enters the 2022 season finale as Saint Vincent's all-time career leader in every passing category, including yards (5,893), attempts (774), completions (462) and touchdowns (55).

SHUTDOWN SHAW: Last week against Waynesburg, senior Ahmad Shaw intercepted his team-leading third pass of the season, upping his career total to six interceptions, tied for fourth most in the modern era of Saint Vincent football.

MAD MAX: With a 9-yard touchdown on a fourth down run in the first quarter of SVC's win over Waynesburg, junior Max Pisula upped his team leading total to six rushing TDs on the season, good for fourth in the PAC. A goal line specialist on offense and linebacker/defensive end on defense, Pisula also added a quarterback sack in the victory. His six touchdowns this season have come on just seven carries.

FANTASTIC FIFTY: Saint Vincent's 53 points in last week's win marked the fifth-highest scoring output in the team's modern era, behind only a 65-14 win over Thiel on Oct. 3, 2015; a 57-32 victory over Grove City on Sept. 24, 2016; a 56-26 triumph over Waynesburg on April 17, 2021; and a 55-3 win on Sept. 10, 2011, vs. FDU-Florham. Last week was Saint Vincent's second 50-plus point performance of the season, after a 52-35 win at Allegheny on Oct. 22. This marks the first season in program history in which Saint Vincent scored more than 50 points in two different games.

SENIOR SENDOFF: Prior to the Bethany bout, the Saint Vincent football team's graduating seniors will be honored. The list includes defensive backs Nathan Ault, Kyle Coombe, Ahmad Shaw and Isaiah McElroy; quarterbacks Brady Walker and Devin Gleason; linebackers Kevin Childress and Caleb Green; defensive linemen Desonio Powell, Dwight Collins Jr., Thomas Hedgepeth II and Kody Johnson; wide receiver Logan Carns; running back Evan Walsh; offensive linemen Austin Nicely and T.J. Tagliati and student assistant David Shelnutt.

UP NEXT: On Sept. 2, 2023, Saint Vincent will welcome Washington & Jefferson College to Chuck Noll Field to open up the season. Beginning with the 2023 campaign, each of Saint Vincent's 10 regular season games will be played against Presidents' Athletic Conference opponents.

SAINT VINCENT VS. BETHANY - LAST MEETING (Nov. 13, 2021)

In its 2021 season finale at Chuck Noll Field, the Saint Vincent football team sent its seniors off in style, defeating Bethany, 52-7.

The Bearcat offense amassed a school-record 31 first downs and gained 517 yards, while SVC's defense limited Bethany (1-9, 1-8 PAC) to just 165 yards – including -22 rushing yards - and picked off three Bison interceptions, with two returned for touchdowns.

Julian Howard ran 19 times for a career-high 117 yards and two touchdowns, while Brady Walker completed 23 of 34 passes for 309 yards and three touchdowns. Kaelib McElroy made six catches for 78 yards and two touchdowns, while Phil Harding made seven grabs for 107 yards and a touchdown in the final home game of his career.

Ahmad Shaw intercepted two passes, including a 40-yard pick-six in the third quarter, while Derius May tallied SVC's third interception of the afternoon, returning it for a 36-yard touchdown early in the fourth quarter.

The Bison scored on their first possession of the day, but Saint Vincent shrugged off the early deficit, opening up a 28-7 lead at halftime before adding three more touchdowns and a 26-yard Adam Koscielicki field goal in the second half.

Dom Salinetto completed 14 of 33 passes for 168 yards for Bethany, with De'Vaughn McWhorter making five receptions for 107 yards and a touchdown.

AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

**Fourth season
Saint Vincent, 2012**

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He enters his fourth season as head coach in 2022, bringing a record of 10-15 into the new year.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Quarterback Brady Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Sophomore receiver Molayo Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/gm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District™.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witche (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.



A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modern-day career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff, Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFA title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive

Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

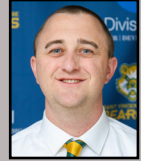
After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as quarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
