## **TODAY'S GAME**

Saint Vincent will close out its rare three-game homestand with a Homecoming Day matchup against Presidents' Athletic Conference foe Thiel. Both teams will be searching for their first victory of the 2022 season. Saint Vincent is coming off of a 52-21 defeat to No. 25 Washington & Jefferson last week. The Presdients jumped out to a 28-0 lead early in the second quarter and SVC couldn't recover, while the Bearcats were also hamstrung by four turnovers and 13 penalties. Matthew Esdelle caught two touchdowns on the day, while D.J. Gray Jr. added a TD catch on a second quarter flea flicker. Gray also ran for 76 yards. Despite surrendering 539 yards to W&J, the SVC defense produced three turnovers, with Ahmad Shaw, Brandon Nolder and Ethan Facey each tallying interceptions. Thiel suffered a 34-6 home loss to Allegheny in week two. The Tomcat defense yielded just 289 yards to the Gators and produced a 60-yard interception return touchdown by Andrew Plowden, but the Thiel offense managed just 217 yards and committed a pair of turnovers. Saint Vincent has won six straight over Thiel dating back to the 2015 campaign and the Bearcats have won four of the past five meetings at Chuck Noll Field.

### **GAME NOTES**

**SERVING A PURPOSE:** Through the first two games of the season, Saint Vincent junior Molayo Irefin ranks third in the PAC in all-purpose yards with a total of 310, good for an average of 155.0 per game. Irefin has 127 receiving yards, 94 punt return yards and 89 kick return yards. He also ranks second in the PAC with 13 receptions, while his 92 career receptions are tied for fifth all-time in Saint Vincent program history.

**MATTHEW MAKES 'EM COUNT:** Sophomore Matthew Esdelle hauled in two receptions for 22 yards last week against W&J, with both catches going for touchdowns. Of his four receptions this season, three have gone for touchdowns, ranking second in the PAC and 13th in the nation at the NCAA Division III level.

**PICK PARTY:** In Saint Vincent's week two loss to W&J, the Bearcat defense picked off three interceptions, with one apiece by senior Ahmad Shaw and freshmen Brandon Nolder and Ethan Facey. Dating back to last season, it was the third time in the past 10 games in which the Bearcat defense recorded at least three interceptions. Since the beginning of the 2021 season, Saint Vincent's defense has 21 interceptions, second most among PAC squads behind only Carnegie Mellon's 22.

**SEE YOU NEXT MONTH:** This week's meeting with Thiel marks Saint Vincent's third straight home game to open the 2022 season, the first time in program history that the Bearcats have enjoyed a three-game homestand. After the Thiel fray, however, the Bearcats will be home just once over their next five games, when they host Geneva on Oct. 15. The regular season will then close with back-to-back home games on Nov. 5 and Nov. 12 against Waynesburg and Bethany, respectively.

**HAPPY HOMECOMING:** This week marks Homecoming at Saint Vincent College and the Bearcats will look to continue their string of success on the football field during the annual event. Since 2014, the Bearcats have won five of seven Homecoming contests, including last year's thrilling 41-35 comeback win over Case Western Reserve University. This week marks Saint Vincent's sixth Homecoming date with Thiel, with the Bearcats winning two in a row and three of the past four.

**CROSS COUNTRY 'CATS:** Eleven states are represented on the Bearcats' 114-man roster. Sixty-two Pennsylvanians are joined by teammates from Florida (18), Maryland (15), Virginia (7), Ohio (3), Delaware (2), Georgia (2), New Jersey (2), Michigan (1), New York (1) and Texas (1).

**OH CAPTAIN(S), MY CAPTAIN(S):** Per a vote of their teammates, the 2022 Saint Vincent College football captains are graduate safety Kyle Coombe, senior quarterback Brady Walker, senior defensive back Ahmad Shaw and junior receiver Molayo Irefin.

**UP NEXT:** Saint Vincent will play its first road game of the season next Saturday, Sept. 24, with a 7 p.m. bout at PAC foe Grove City. The Bearcats will be looking to snap a five-game losing skid against the Wolverines. Saint Vincent will then have its bye week on Oct. 1, before going back on the road on Oct. 8 to face Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio.

#### **SAINT VINCENT VS. THIEL - LAST MEETING**

On Sept. 25 of last season, SVC earned its first PAC victory of the season in a big way, defeating Thiel 41-7 under the lights at Alumni Stadium. Saint Vincent more than doubled-up Thiel in total offense, gaining 422 yards to the Tomcats' 191, while five different Bearcats scored touchdowns.

Brady Walker led the Bearcat offense, connecting on 15 of 22 attempts for 275 yards and three touchdowns. A pair of Saint Vincent receivers recorded 100-yard days, as Molayo Irefin made six catches for 108 yards and Keith Kalp four grabs for 117. Both players also caught touchdowns. Irefin also gained 27 yards on the ground and ran for a touchdown, while rookie Billy Beck scored two times for SVC.

Defensively, Joanes Polynice recorded a team-high 12 tackles, including 1.5 tackles for loss. Cam Norris also made 1.5 stops behind the line of scrimmage, sharing a sack with Andrew Deaton, while Nathan Sullivan recorded a pair of TFLs. Defensive backs Evan Brozenich and Marvelle Cromerdie each tallied the first interceptions of their careers.



## AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

# Fourth season Saint Vincent, 2012

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He enters his fourth season as head coach in 2022, bringing a record of 10-15 into the new year.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Quarterback Brady Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Sophomore receiver Molayo Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/gm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District™.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witchey (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.

A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modern-day career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff, Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFL title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as quarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
