### THIS WEEK'S GAME

After opening the 2022 season with the first three-game homestand in program history, Saint Vincent will play its first road game of the campaign, with a 7 p.m. matchup at conference foe Grove City... The Bearcats are coming off of their first victory of the season, a 24-16 Homecoming win over Thiel in which SVC sophomore D.J. Gray Jr. ran for a career-high 118 yards and a touchdown and the Bearcat defense surrendered just 287 yards of Thiel offense and forced two Tomcat turnovers.... Grove City dropped an exciting 40-33 decision to PAC-leading Carnegie Mellon in week three. Grove City amassed 535 total yards and 31 first downs, but committed four costly turnovers. Scott Fraser caught 10 passes for 209 yards and a touchdown for Grove City, with quarterback Logan Pfueffer completing 16 passes for 327 yards and three touchdowns and running for 45 yards and a score. The Grove City defense limited Carnegie Mellon to just 54 rushing yards and held the Tartans to just 1-of-9 third down conversions... Through their first three games, the Wolverines are averaging a conference-leading 50.3 points and 568.3 yards of total offense... Saint Vincent will be looking to snap a five-game losing streak in its series with Grove City. The Bearcats' last win over the Wolverines came by a 57-32 score on Sept. 24, 2016.

### **GAME NOTES**

**HEY DJ:** In SVC's Homecoming win over Thiel, sophomore running back D.J. Gray Jr. ran for 118 yards and a touchdown. It marked a season-high for Gray and the Bearcats, and the highest single-game output for a Saint Vincent running back since Mike Stasko, the program's all-time leading rusher, ran for 121 yards in a home win over Waynesburg on April 17, 2021, a span of 15 games. Gray's 32-yard run in the first quarter last week was Saint Vincent's longest rush of the season and the team's longest since a 48-yard touchdown from Billy Beck against Case Western Reserve in week four of last season. Through the first three games of the 2022 campaign, Gray has run for 248 yards to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference.

**ANOTHER GAME, ANOTHER TD:** In last week's victory over Thiel, Saint Vincent quarterback Brady Walker fired a 9-yard second quarter touchdown pass to junior Molayo Irefin. After that throw, Walker has now tallied at least one touchdown pass in 20 of his 21 career starts dating to the 2019 campaign. His 41 career touchdowns are most in program history, while he is third among active Presidents' Athletic Conference quarterbacks in career TDs, behind only Case Western Reserve's Drew Saxton (85) and Westminster's Cole Konieczka (63).

**CLIMBING THE RANKS:** Through the first three games of the 2022 season, Saint Vincent junior Molayo Irefin leads the Bearcats and ranks fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference with 16 receptions. Irefin enters week four with 95 career catches, good for fourth all-time in program history behind only Damon Black Jr., who made 187 between 2014-17, D.J. Oceant-Kelley (140, 2014-17) and Matt Duffey (102, 2011-14). Irefin also owns the only punt return touchdown in the PAC this season, with a school-record 85-yarder in week one against Stevenson.

**SENSATIONAL SAFETY:** Saint Vincent sophomore safety Jaden Edmonds recorded his second quarterback sack of the season in last week's win over Thiel. He enters week four as one of just nine players in the Presidents' Athletic Conference with two or more sacks. Edmonds also has a team-leading 3.0 tackles for loss on the season, good for 14th in the league.

**BIG BOOT:** Saint Vincent freshman kicker Justin Emeigh booted three touchbacks in last week's win over Thiel, upping his total to four on the season, third most among Presidents' Athletic Conference kickers. Emeigh's 12 kickoffs this season have traveled a conference-leading average of 62.3 yards.

**CROSS COUNTRY 'CATS:** Eleven states are represented on the Bearcats' 114-man roster. Sixtytwo Pennsylvanians are joined by teammates from Florida (18), Maryland (15), Virginia (7), Ohio (3), Delaware (2), Georgia (2), New Jersey (2), Michigan (1), New York (1) and Texas (1).

**OH CAPTAIN(S), MY CAPTAIN(S):** Per a vote of their teammates, the 2022 Saint Vincent College football captains are graduate safety Kyle Coombe, senior quarterback Brady Walker, senior defensive back Ahmad Shaw and junior receiver Molayo Irefin.

**UP NEXT:** Following the Grove City fray, Saint Vincent will head into its Oct. 1 bye week. The Bearcats will be back in action on Oct. 8, traveling to PAC foe Case Western Reserve for a 1 p.m. kickoff.

#### SAINT VINCENT VS. GROVE CITY - LAST MEETING

On Oct. 16 of last season, visiting Grove City scored 20 unanswered fourth quarter points to come back for a 41-29 win over the Bearcats at a rainy Chuck Noll Field. The Bearcats led 17-7 midway through the second quarter and 24-14 in the early stages of the third, before Grove City scored three fourth quarter touchdowns to complete the comeback.

After Joanes Polynice gave SVC a 17-7 lead with a 34-yard interception return touchdown midway through the second quarter, Grove City scored with 5:29 left to make it a 3-point game at the break. SVC received a third-quarter touchdown run from Brady Walker and a 31-yard field goal from Adam Koscielicki to take a 27-21 lead into the fourth, before the Wolverines' Clayton Parrish scored three fourth quarter touchdowns to open up a 41-27 lead. Jaden Pratt blocked the ensuing extra point and returned it 98 yards for two points, but they were the final points scored on the day.

Walker completed 22 passes for 235 yards, while SVC's Molayo Irefin made 10 grabs for 133 yards. Kyle Coombe led SVC with 11 tackles. Parrish was the story for Grove City, as he ran for 144 yards and four touchdowns, while Cody Gustafson made eight catches for 157 yards and two scores.



## AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

# Fourth season Saint Vincent, 2012

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He enters his fourth season as head coach in 2022, bringing a record of 10-15 into the new year.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Quarterback Brady Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Sophomore receiver Molayo Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/gm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District™.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witchey (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.



A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modern-day career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff, Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFL title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive

Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as quarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedv.
