## THIS WEEK'S GAME

Saint Vincent faces a tough task in week seven, traveling to undefeated and PAC-leading Grove City College, ranked 22nd in the most recent D3Football.com national poll. The Bearcats will be looking to snap a two-game losing streak, most recently dropping a 24-0 decision at Waynesburg. The host Yellow Jackets outgained the Bearcats 411-138 in total offense, while holding a 36:50 - 23:10 edge in time of possession... Grove City moved to 7-0 with last week's 31-7 road win over Allegheny. Nico Flati and Clayton Parrish each ran for two touchdowns, as the Wolverines outrushed the Gators 280-16, averaging 6.8 yards per carry. Flati enters this week leading the PAC with 707 rushing yards, while Parrish has scored a conference-leading eight rushing touchdowns... Grove City holds a 12-6 all-time lead in the series with Saint Vincent, and has won six straight over the Bearcats. Saint Vincent's last win over Grove City came by a 57-32 score on Sept. 24, 2016, in Latrobe.

SAINT VINCENT - LAST TIME OUT	
WAYNESBURG, Pa. (Oct. 14) – The Saint Vincent football team was defeated, 24-0, by host Waynesburg University in a Presidents' Athletic Conference battle at a rainy John F. Wiley Stadium.	
The Bearcats (2-4, 2-4 PAC) struggled on both sides of the ball, as they were outgained 411-138 in total offense and saw the Yellow Jackets (1-5, 1-5 PAC) hold a more than 13-minute advantage in time of possession.	
The teams traded punts over the opening three possessions, before Waynesburg used a trio of long passes and took advantage of a 15-yard Bearcat penalty to close out a 5-play, 60-yard drive with a 13-yard touchdown pass from Samuel Barber to Isaac Trout to open up a 7-0 lead with 6:35 left in the first quarter.	
The Bearcats were forced to punt on their ensuing drive, with Kyle Murray's 56-yard boot pinning the Yellow Jackets inside their own 20. The hosts would end the quarter driving, using two more lengthy pass plays to advance inside the red zone. The Bearcat defense held on third down, however, as the second quarter began with a missed 39-yard field goal to keep the deficit at 7-0.	
Saint Vincent responded by matriculating the ball deep into Waynesburg territory. Gino Caesar ran twice for 13 yards, before the next three snaps resulted in Waynesburg penalties totaling 35 yards and moving the Bearcats inside the 20-yard line. The visitors were unable to sustain the drive, however, which ended in a missed 31-yard field goal attempt.	
The Yellow Jackets' next drive ended with the third missed field goal of the half on a 41-yard attempt, but the Bearcats could not take advantage. Waynesburg would then put together a 10-play drive and move inside the 25-yard line, before Josiah Weyandt and Alex St. Julien teamed up for a third down sack. This time, however, the Yellow Jackets converted on the field goal to go up 10-0.	
Saint Vincent forced Waynesburg to punt on each of its first two trips of the third quarter, but the second punt was fumbled and recovered by the Yellow Jackets on the SVC 20. The visitors promptly made the Bearcats pay, with Barber hooking up with Justin Flack on the third play of the drive for a 12-yard touchdown to increase the lead to 17-0.	
On the Bearcats' ensuing possession, quarterback Austin Slye twice connected with Matthew Esdelle for first downs, first on an 18-yarder that moved the ball to midfield and then a 12-yarder on third down at the Waynesburg 35. However, a pair of penalties would push the ball back into SVC territory, before a third down pass was fumbled and recovered by the Yellow Jackets.	
Waynesburg put the game away late in the fourth quarter, using a long, 7-minute, 11-play, 68-yard drive that was capped off by a Flack rushing touchdown with just over two minutes left to play.	
St. Julien led the Saint Vincent defense with a career- and game-high nine tackles, while Wiley Purry and Nathan Sullivan each produced eight stops, including a tackle for loss from Purry. Robbie Labuda and Andrew Gelin each had five tackles and one pass break-up.	
Slye completed 14 of 26 passes for 115 yards, with Esdelle hauling in four grabs for 53 yards. Caesar led SVC with 37 rushing yards on eight carries.

## SAINT VINCENT VS. GROVE CITY - LAST MEETING

GROVE CITY, Pa. (Sept. 24, 2022) – The Saint Vincent College football team was hurt by a number of missed opportunities, falling 42-7 at Presidents' Athletic Conference foe Grove City College.

The Bearcats committed two turnovers and came up empty on an early first-and-goal situation, before the Wolverines pulled away over the second half to earn the win.

D.J. Gray Jr. ran for 69 yards and a touchdown on 16 carries for SVC, while quarterback Brady Walker completed 20 of 26 passes for 145 yards. Molayo Irefin hauled in a game-high 9 passes.

After the two teams traded quick punts to open the game, Grove City took over with 9:02 left in the quarter inside its own 13. The Wolverines would hold the ball for the remainder of the quarter, putting together a methodical drive before ending the frame with a second-and-goal on the 2. The hosts would promptly find the end zone on the first play of the second quarter, a 3-yard Nico Flati run, to go in front 7-0.

SVC's next drive ended prematurely with an interception, before the Bearcat defense forced another Grove City punt. Taking over at their 40, the Bearcats embarked on a productive drive. Two Gray rushes, aided by a Grove City penalty, advanced the ball inside the Grove City 40, before Walker completed three passes for 31 yards, including 13-yards to Irefin and Matthew Esdelle, to set up first-and-goal inside the 1-yard-line. The Bearcats, however, would go no further, with the Grove City defense stuffing three plays for a loss of a combined three yards, before a 22-yard field goal attempt went wide to keep the score 7-0 in favor of the hosts.

As they did to end the first quarter, the Wolverines would close the second frame on another long scoring drive, with Logan Pfueffer scoring on a 1-yard quarterback keeper to cap off a 12-play, 80-yard drive that spanned 6:02 and give Grove City a 14-0 lead at the intermission.

Walker began the second half by completing three passes for 38 yards, with an 18-yard toss to Ryan Whitman bringing the ball to the Grove City 30. Six-yard passes to Gray and Irefin moved the ball inside the red zone, but the drive would promptly stall out after a Grove City interception with 9:53 left in the third quarter.

The Wolverines would add two more third quarter touchdowns to open up a 28-0 lead, before scoring a pair of touchdowns on their first two trips of the final frame to up the advantage to 42-0 with 2:07 left to play.

The Bearcats would finally get on the scoreboard on their last possession of the evening. A long Molayo Irefin kick return gave SVC the ball just outside of midfield, before three Gray rushes netted 13 yards. Walker and Whitman hooked up for a 24-yard pass play to move inside the 15-yard line, with a Grove City penalty advancing it to the 7. Gray would then close out the drive by rumbling in with 16 seconds left for his third rushing touchdown of the season.

Fueled by an impressive rushing attack, Grove City owned a commanding edge in time of possession, holding the ball for nearly 35 minutes. The Wolverines rushed for 231 yards and four scores, finishing with 401 yards of total offense to Saint Vincent's 199. Clayton Parrish rushed for a game-high 107 yards on 16 carries for the hosts, while Pfueffer ran for two touchdowns while also completing 10 passes for 170 yards and two scores.

Defensively, Ethan Facey led Saint Vincent with 8 tackles, while Keshawn Davis and Jaden Edmonds finished with 7 apiece. Marvelle Cromerdie finished with 3 pass break-ups in the secondary, while Thomas Hedgepeth II came up with SVC's only sack of the night.

## UP NEXT FOR SAINT VINCENT

Next week, the Bearcats will return home for the first time in three weeks, welcoming PAC foe Westminster College for a 1 p.m. matchup at Chuck Noll Field. The Bearcats will be looking for their first win over the Titans since 2011. It will mark Westminster's first trip to Latrobe since the 2018 campaign.

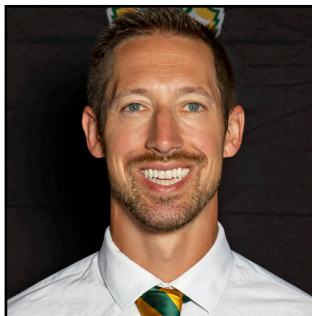

## AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

**Fifth Season**  
**Saint Vincent, 2012**

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He completed his fourth season as head coach in 2022, and holds a 17-24.

In 2022, the Bearcats finished 5-5 overall and 5-3 in the Presidents' Athletic Conference, with the five conference wins the team's most since 2011. The Bearcats scored 37 touchdowns and averaged 28.6 points per game, both third best in the PAC. Eight Saint Vincent players earned All-PAC accolades, highlighted by junior receiver/return specialist Molayo Irefin. Irefin, who led the PAC in kick return (27.2) and punt return (15.9) average, recorded the longest punt return in the team's modern era with an 85-yard touchdown in the season-opener against Stevenson, before posting a 100-yard kick return touchdown in a week nine victory over Waynesburg. Irefin also ranked second in the PAC in receptions (62) and touchdown receptions (8) and third in receiving yards (732). Along with his All-PAC honor, Irefin was also named First Team All-Region and Third Team All-America by D3football.com, becoming the first SVC football All-American since 1960. Quarterback Brady Walker led the PAC with 21 touchdown passes and 165 completions, while ranking third with 2,015 passing yards. Defensively, cornerback Ahmad Shaw was named Second Team All-PAC after picking off a team-high four interceptions.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/gm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District™.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witche (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's

all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.

A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modern-day career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff, Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFL title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as quarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
