## GAME EIGHT | SAINT VINCENT BEARCATS VS. WESTMINSTER TITANS

October 28, 2023 | 1 p.m. | Chuck Noll Field | Latrobe, Pa.

### THIS WEEK'S GAME

Saint Vincent will face Westminster for the first time since 2021, while it will be the first time Westminster travels to Chuck Noll Field in more than five years, with the last matchup in Latrobe between the Bearcats and Titans coming on Sept. 15, 2018... The Bearcats look to snap a three-game losing skid, having most recently dropped a 49-0 decision at PAC-leading Grove City in week seven. The Bearcats trailed just 7-0 after the first quarter, before the Wolverines scored two touchdowns in each of the final three quarters to pull away for the win... Westminster is coming off of a 27-17 home victory over Allegheny. The Titans jumped out to a 10-0 lead just three minutes into play, and then shut out the Gators over the second half. Ryan Gomes amassed 181 yards of total offense and scored a pair of touchdowns for the Titans, who forced four turnovers and kept the Gators off the scoreboard over the game's final 30 minutes... Saint Vincent will seek its first win over Westminster since Nov. 5, 2011, as Westminster has won nine straight in the series, and owns a 17-3 record all-time against Saint Vincent in a series that stretches back to 1949.

SAINT VINCENT - LAST TIME OUT	
GROVE CITY, Pa. (Oct. 21) – Grove City, ranked 22nd in the latest D3Football.com national poll, improved to 8-0 with a 49-0 win over Saint Vincent in a Presidents' Athletic Conference football matchup at Robert E. Thorn Field.	
After taking a 7-0 lead late in the first quarter, Grove City (8-0, 8-0 PAC) scored two touchdowns in each of the final three quarters to pull away and extend its winning streak over Saint Vincent (2-5, 2-5 PAC) to seven games.	
The stout Grove City defense limited the Bearcats to just 139 in total offense, including -13 rushing yards, while recording seven sacks and 12 tackles for loss. The Wolverines amassed 482 yards of total offense on the day.	
Saint Vincent quarterback Austin Slye completed 14 of 24 passes for 152 yards. Freshman receiver Austin Wells was Slye's favorite target on the day, as the rookie turned in a career game with nine catches for 111 yards.	
Defensively, junior linebacker Wiley Purry matched a career-high by leading both sides with 14 tackles. A week after pacing SVC with nine tackles at Waynesburg, rookie defensive back Alex St. Julien continued his strong play, tallying six tackles (five solo), forcing a fumble and defending a pass. Sophomore safety Kyle Murray had six tackles and recovered a fumble, while freshman corner Devon Dean-Coles recorded his first career interception and junior corner Brian Boyd had two pass breakups.	
Nico Flati, the PAC's leading rusher, ran for 144 yards and a touchdown on 24 carries to lead a Grove City ground game that totaled 219 yards. The Wolverines threw for five touchdowns, with three from Logan Pfueffer, who completed 12 of 24 passes for 150 yards. Scott Fraser made eight receptions for 75 yards and two scores.

## SAINT VINCENT VS. WESTMINSTER - LAST MEETING

NEW WILMINGTON, Pa. (Nov. 13, 2021) – The Saint Vincent football team closed its 2021 road schedule with a 41-6 loss at Presidents' Athletic Conference co-leader Westminster College.

Hampered by a number of injuries, the Bearcats (4-5, 3-5 PAC) committed five turnovers and were held to just 240 of total offense by a stout Westminster (7-2, 6-1 PAC) defense.

The Bearcats opened the game in fine fashion, as Cam Norris recovered a Westminster fumble on the opening kickoff on the Titans' 14 yardline. However, SVC was unable to cash in on the field position, turning the ball over just two plays later on a fumble near the goal line.

Westminster scored the game's first points midway through the opening quarter on a 49-yard touchdown pass from Cole Konieczka to Tylon Elon to make it 7-0 with 8:50 left in the quarter.

Saint Vincent committed its second turnover of the quarter with another fumble with 3:53 left, and the Titans responded by embarking on a 6-play, 47-yard drive that capped off with a 1-yard rushing touchdown by Nicholas Treloar with 44 seconds remaining in the quarter.

The Bearcat defense turned the Titans over four times in the second quarter. Jack Poling earned his second interception of the season with 11:22 left until the break, Jermel Ward recovered a fumble at the 8:51 mark and Ahmad Shaw intercepted a pass with 6:30 remaining. However, the SVC offense was unable to turn the first three miscues into points, and Westminster upped its lead to 21-0 on a 27-yard run by Vincent Giles with 1:50 left in the half.

With 30 seconds remaining, Westminster set up to punt at its own 34-yard line. The snap was misplayed by the punter, and the Bearcats made their second fumble recovery of the half. This time, SVC was able to find the scoreboard, with Billy Beck bursting through the middle from 13 yards out to cut the deficit to 21-6 at the intermission.

The Titans wasted little time in the second half to add onto the lead, as Brayden Thimons stepped in front of a Gleason pass on the sideline and returned it 27 yards for the pick-six, making the score 27-6.

On the Bearcats' next drive, Gleason began with a pair of passes to Phil Harding, covering 22 yards and advancing the ball into Westminster territory. A 9-yard rush by Julian Howard and a 3-yard run from Beck on third-and-one set up first-and-goal for SVC at the Westminster 7. However, the Titans would abruptly end the SVC scoring chance with an interception in the end zone with just under 7 minutes left in the quarter.

The Titans would again make SVC pay, with Thimons hauling in a 9-yard touchdown pass from Konieczka to make it 34-6 heading into the final minute of the third.

The Bearcat offense was unable to cut into the deficit, while the Titans added a final score on their first trip of the fourth quarter to close out the day's scoring.

Gleason completed 11 of 23 passes for 101 yards in relief of Walker, who went 4-for-8 through the air for 24 yards. Austin Slye completed all three of his pass attempts for 45 yards in the fourth quarter.

Beck led SVC's ground game, rushing for 53 yards on 13 carries, while Howard gained 34 yards on 13 totes. In the penultimate game of his career, Harding was SVC's top receiver, making five catches for 77 yards.

Defensively, Norris and Kevin Childress each made 10 tackles, with Norris making 1.5 stops behind the line of scrimmage. Kyle Coombe added 7 tackles, including 0.5 TFLs, while Desonio Powell had 1.5 TFLs, including a sack.

Konieczka went 10-for-22 through the air for 145 yards, with two touchdowns and two interceptions, while Ryan Gomes ran for a game-high 123 yards on 19 tries, with one touchdown.

## UP NEXT FOR SAINT VINCENT

Next week, the Bearcats will be back at home to face Thiel College at 1 p.m. on Senior Day at Chuck Noll Field. Saint Vincent has won seven straight over Thiel on the gridiron.



## AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

**Fifth Season  
Saint Vincent, 2012**

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He completed his fourth season as head coach in 2022.

In 2022, the Bearcats finished 5-5 overall and 5-3 in the Presidents' Athletic Conference, with the five conference wins the team's most since 2011. The Bearcats scored 37 touchdowns and averaged 28.6 points per game, both third best in the PAC. Eight Saint Vincent players earned All-PAC accolades, highlighted by junior receiver/return specialist Molayo Irefin. Irefin, who led the PAC in kick return (27.2) and punt return (15.9) average, recorded the longest punt return in the team's modern era with an 85-yard touchdown in the season-opener against Stevenson, before posting a 100-yard kick return touchdown in a week nine victory over Waynesburg. Irefin also ranked second in the PAC in receptions (62) and touchdown receptions (8) and third in receiving yards (732). Along with his All-PAC honor, Irefin was also named First Team All-Region and Third Team All-America by D3football.com, becoming the first SVC football All-American since 1960. Quarterback Brady Walker led the PAC with 21 touchdown passes and 165 completions, while ranking third with 2,015 passing yards. Defensively, cornerback Ahmad Shaw was named Second Team All-PAC after picking off a team-high four interceptions.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/gm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District™.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witche (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.

A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modern-day career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.


During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff,

Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFL title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as quarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
