## THIS WEEK'S GAME

Saint Vincent closes its 2023 home slate with this week's game against PAC foe Thiel. The Bearcats are coming off of a 22-20 defeat to Westminster in week seven, a game in which the Bearcats scored 20 unanswered second half points, only to see the comeback effort fall just short. The Bearcats outgained the Titans 339-263 in total offense and recorded 22 first downs to Westminster's 18, but were hamstrung by four turnovers... Thiel enters the penultimate game of the season riding a three-game losing streak, most recently falling by a 27-3 score at Allegheny. The Tomcats were limited to just 154 yards of total offense in the game that saw all of its scoring in the first half... mn While Thiel has struggled on the offensive side of the ball this season, its defense surrenders just 303.4 yards per game, the fourth-lowest mark in the PAC. The Tomcat defense has picked off 10 interceptions, ranking third in the PAC... Saint Vincent has won seven straight in its series with Thiel and owns a 13-11 all-time advantage in the set that dates back to 1930... Prior to this week's game, Saint Vincent will honor its senior class with traditional Senior Day festivities.

## **BEARCAT BRIEFS**

**IT'S TOUGH TO SAY GOODBYE:** This week marks the final home game of the 2023 season, and in the careers of 16 Bearcats, who will be recognized prior to the game with traditional senior day festivities. The group includes offensive linemen Nathan Bettwy, C.J. Ciecierski, Joel Loomis, Colby Missel and Connor Petrunak; receivers Dammion Bundridge, Zac Herbinko, Molayo Irefin and Kaelib McElroy; tight end/long snapper James Sword; defensive linemen Max Pisula and Dwight Collins Jr., defensive backs Ahmad Shaw and Laird Stover; quarterback Austin Slye; and linebacker Nathan Sullivan.

**QUITE A COMBO:** After rushing for a pair of touchdowns in week eight against Westminster, Saint Vincent senior Max Pisula is now third all-time in his team's modern era (2007-present) with 11 rushing touchdowns, while his five rushing TDs this season are tied for fourth-most in the PAC. When not playing wildcat quarterback, Pisula has also shined at the defensive end spot this season, as he leads the PAC and ranks second in NCAA Division III with four forced fumbles, and is sixth in the conference with 8.5 tackles for loss.

**PURRY ON THE PROWL:** Saint Vincent junior linebacker Wiley Purry recorded a team-high 11 tackles against Westminster, and enters this week leading the PAC with 82 stops on the season, seven more than than the league's second-place tackler. Purry's 82 tackles are already the most in a season for a Bearcat since Matt Jenkins recorded 88 tackles in 10 games during the 2016 campaign. A Saint Vincent player has amassed 90 or more tackles in a season just four times since 2007, with the last 90-plus tackle campaign for a Bearcat coming in 2012, when Renny LaRue-Holloman registered 102.

**BIG BOOTS:** Saint Vincent enters the penultimate game of the 2023 season tied for the PAC lead in punting average (37.7 yard), while the Bearcats' 33.3 yard net punting average ranks third in the conference. Sophomore Kyle Murray averages 37.7 yards on 40 punts, placing nine inside the 20-yard line, while he leads the PAC with six punts of more than 50 yards, including two that went over 60 yards, highlighted by a career-high 66-yarder in the season-opener against W&J, which remains the second-longest punt by a PAC player this season.

**JOINING THE CENTURY CLUB:** In last week's loss to Westminster, senior wide receiver Kaelib McElroy caught five passes for a career-high 107 yards, including a 49-yard touchdown reception in the opening minutes of the fourth quarter. It marked McElroy's first career 100-yard receiving game, and the second consecutive week in which a Bearcat receiver amassed 100 yards, after Austin Wells had 111 yards on nine grabs in SVC's previous outing at Grove City.

**UP NEXT:** Next week, Saint Vincent will travel to Bethany to close out the 2023 season with the annual "Green Game." The Bearcats are 6-12 all-time against their West Virginian rivals, but have won four straight in the series. It marks SVC's first trip to West Virginia since the COVID-abbreviated spring 2021 season, when the Bearcats earned a 35-6 win.

## **SAINT VINCENT - LAST TIME OUT**

LATROBE, Pa. (Oct. 28) - The Bearcats saw a furious second half rally come up short, falling 22-20 by Westminster College at a soggy Chuck Noll Field. Trailing 22-0 four minutes into the second half, Saint Vincent erupted for three unanswered touchdowns, including two in a 2-minute span midway in the third quarter. The comeback would run out of steam late in the fourth quarter, however, as the Bearcats were handed their fourth straight loss.

Saint Vincent quarterback Austin Slye completed 16 of 29 passes for a career-high 232 yards, highlighted by a 49-yard touchdown pass to Kaeilb McElroy, who finished with five catches for 107 yards. Brandon Saint-Preux ran for a season-high 74 yards on 18 totes, while Max Pisula gained 38 yards on eight carries, and scored two third-quarter touchdowns. Defensively, Wiley Purry posted 11 tackles to lead the Bearcats, while Robbie Labuda made nine tackles. Keshawn Davis recorded two tackles behind the line of scrimmage, and Pisula made five stops, including one TFL.

Saint Vincent outgained Westminster 339-263 in total offense, while SVC finished with 22 first downs to the visitors' 18 and averaged 5.3 yards per play to the Titans' 4.0. Saint Vincent was also an impressive 9-for-14 on third down conversions.

After Westminster scored two touchdowns in a four-minute span to open the third quarter, the Bearcats embarked on a 6-play, 66-yard scoring drive, capped off with Pisula's 2-yard plunge up the middle. After successfully recovering the on-sides kick, the Bearcats needed just five plays to find the end zone once again, on another scoring run from Pisula, this time from six yards out, to close the gap to 22-14. The SVC defense kept the Titans at bay, before Slye and McElroy connected for the long touchdown pass five minutes into the fourth quarter to make it 22-20 after a failed two-point conversion.

Following the bomb to McElroy, the game turned into a defensive battle, with SVC limiting Westminster to just 37 yards over the game's final nine minutes. With just 2:25 left, the Bearcats forced a punt and looked to have favorable field position, taking over on the Westminster 40-yard line. However, a roughing the kicker penalty kept the drive alive for Westminster, which chewed up the clock before another punt gave SVC the ball back on its own 13-yard line with 40 seconds left. The Bearcats were unable to make any headway, however, with the drive ending on an interception with 29 seconds to go, SVC's fourth turnover of the day.

## SAINT VINCENT VS. THIEL - LAST MEETING

LATROBE, Pa. (Sept. 17, 2022) — D.J. Gray Jr. ran for a career-high 118 yards to help lead Saint Vincent to a 24-16 victory over Thiel on Homecoming at Chuck Noll Field. The Bearcats overcame a sluggish day offensively by limiting Thiel to just 286 yards of total offense and forcing a pair of Tomcat turnovers.

Gray gained 118 yards on 18 carries, averaging 6.6 per try, while he also added a 26-yard reception to finish with 144 all-purpose yards. Molayo Irefin led the Bearcats with three receptions, as quarterback Brady Walker completed seven passes for 91 yards, including a 9-yard scoring pass to Irefin early in the second quarter.

Defensively, Ethan Facey topped SVC with nine tackles, while also forcing and recovering a fumble. Ahmad Shaw made six tackles, while Jaden Edmonds made five, including one for a loss. Kyle Coombe and Ryan Brown each registered quarterback sacks.

After the teams traded scoreless possessions to open the game, the Bearcats rode Gray to the game's first touchdown, as the rookie gained 57 yards on four straight runs, capped off with a 3-yard touchdown plunge, to make it 7-0 with 5:40 left in the quarter. Saint Vincent would then double-up the lead on Walker's 9-yard scoring strike to Irefin on the first trip of the second quarter. Thiel answered the Irefin touchdown run by embarking on a 10-play, 75-yard, 6-minute scoring drive that ended with 0wen Trumbull's three-yard quarterback keeper and a successful two-point conversion with 7:17 left in the quarter to close the gap to 14-8, which is what the score remained at halftime.

On the third play of the third quarter, SVC's Peyton Hrehovchak forced and recovered a Thiel fumble at the Tomcat 30, and Irefin would make the visitors pay with his 9-yard touchdown scamper to open up a 21-8 lead with 10:23 left in the third. After SVC turned Thiel over on downs, Justin Emeigh's 34-yard field goal put the Bearcats up 24-8 in the closing minutes of the quarter.

Trumbull's 14-yard touchdown pass to Donnovan Blue, with a successful 2-point try, brought the Tomcats to within 24-16 with 3:15 left in the fourth, but the Bearcats recovered the ensuing on-side kick and milked the clock the rest of the way.

# AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

# Fifth Season Saint Vincent, 2012

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He completed his fourth season as head coach in 2022.

In 2022, the Bearcats finished 5-5 overall and 5-3 in the Presidents' Athletic Conference, with the five conference wins the team's most since 2011. The Bearcats scored 37 touchdowns and averaged 28.6 points per game, both third best in the PAC. Eight Saint Vincent players earned All-PAC accolades, highlighted by junior receiver/return specialist Molayo Irefin. Irefin, who led the PAC in kick return (27.2) and punt return (15.9) average, recorded the longest punt return in the team's modern era with an 85-yard touchdown in the season-opener against Stevenson, before posting a 100-yard kick return touchdown in a week nine victory over Waynesburg. Irefin also ranked second in the PAC in receptions (62) and touchdown receptions (8) and third in receiving yards (732). Along with his All-PAC honor, Irefin was also named First Team All-Region and Third Team All-America by D3football.com, becoming the first SVC football All-American since 1960. Quarterback Brady Walker led the PAC with 21 touchdown passes and 165 completions, while ranking third with 2,015 passing yards. Defensively, cornerback Ahmad Shaw was named Second Team All-PAC after picking off a team-high four interceptions.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/qm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District<sup>TM</sup>.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witchey (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.

A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modernday career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff,

Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFL title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as guarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
