THIS WEEK'S GAME

Saint Vincent closes out the 2023 season with a trip to West Virginia to take on Bethany College. The Bearcats are looking to end the year on a high note after suffering back-to-back losses by a combined five points, most recently falling 30-27 to Thiel last week at Chuck Noll Field. Trailing 30-13 midway through the fourth quarter, Saint Vincent scored two touchdowns in a six-minute span, but saw its last drive stall with an interception with less than 10 seconds remaining... Bethany will be looking for its first win of the 2023 campaign after suffering a 35-26 loss to Waynesburg last week. The Bison led 26-21 after three quarters, before the Yellow Jackets came back to score two fourth-quarter touchdowns and earn the comeback win. The Bison recorded 197 rushing yards in the loss, as Charlie Mills ran 20 times for 95 yards and teammate T.J. Owensby 13 times for 90 yards... Bethany holds a 10-6 lead in the series between the two teams, but the Bearcats have won four straight... The Bearcats and Bison have met in the regular season finale in the "Green Game" each year since 2008, but this marks the final installment of the PAC's annual season-ending "Rivalry Week."

BEARCAT BRIEFS

WILD WILEY: In last week's loss to Thiel, Saint Vincent junior linebacker Wiley Purry led both sides with 13 tackles and enters the season finale as the Presidents' Athletic Conference leader with 95 stops. Purry has recorded 10 or more tackles in five different games this season, and is on pace to record the first 100-tackle season for a Bearcat since 2012, when Renny LaRue-Holloman registered 102 stops.

TWO-WAY TERROR: With his one-yard plunge in the fourth guarter of last week's loss to Thiel, senior Max Pisula recorded his sixth rushing touchdown of the season as a wildcat quarterback. It marks the fifth-highest single-season rushing TD total for a Bearcat in the team's modern era (2007-present), while his 12 career rushing touchdowns are third all time in the team's modern record books. Primarily a defensive end, Pisula also leads the Bearcats - and the PAC - with four forced fumbles, while his team-high 10.5 tackles for loss rank seventh in the conference.

SLYE SLINGS IT: In last week's loss to Thiel, senior quarterback Austin Slye notched careerhighs in pass completions (19) and passing yards (253). It marked his second consecutive week with more than 200 yards passing, and third 200-yard performance of the season. He enters the 2023 season finale ranked fifth in the PAC with 1,483 passing yards on the year, and eighth in the league with 1,468 yards of total offense.

LOSING IT: Last week against Thiel, the Saint Vincent defense totaled seven tackles for loss, their second-most in a game this year behind only a 9-TFL performance in its week four win over Geneva. Eight different players were credited with at least a half TFL, including Purry (1.0), Pisula (1.0), Ethan Facey (1.0), Nathan Sullivan (1.0), Ryan Snyder (1.0), Kyle Murray (0.5), KeShawn Davis (0.5), Tyler Harpst (0.5) and Sam Dippolito (0.5).

PUNTING PROWESS: Saint Vincent sophomore Kyle Murray enters the final game of the 2023 season averaging 37.9 yards on 45 punts, good for third in the PAC. He leads the league with six punts of more than 50 yards, while he has placed 10 inside the opponent 20-yard line, which is thrd-most in the league. Murray's 37.9 yard season average is the fifth-highest for a Bearcat in the team's modern era, and the team's best since 2019, when Christian Witchey averaged 38.7 yards per boot.

UP NEXT: Saint Vincent will open the 2024 season on Saturday, Sept. 7, at Washington & Jefferson College. The Bearcats' 2024 home-opener is slated for Sept. 14 when they will welcome Carnegie Mellon to Chuck Noll Field.

SAINT VINCENT - LAST TIME OUT

LATROBE, Pa. (Nov. 4) -- For the second week in a row, Saint Vincent saw its late rally come up just short, as the Bearcats were defeated 30-27 on Senior Day at Chuck Noll Field.

Trailing 30-13 midway through the fourth quarter, Saint Vincent (2-7) scored a pair of unanswered touchdowns, including a 1-yard pass from Max Pisula to Pete Billey with 29 seconds left in regulation. The Bearcats would then recover the onside kick and quickly advance inside the Thiel 40-yard line, but the Tomcats (3-6) would quash the comeback with an interception with three seconds left on the clock.

Thiel jumped out to a 14-0 lead at the end of the first quarter, before SVC's Brandon Saint-Preux put the Bearcats on the board with a 4-yard touchdown run on the opening trip of the second quarter. However, the extra point attempt was blocked and returned for a 98-yard safety, and the Bearcats trailed 16-6, which is how the score would stand at halftime.

Saint Vincent would make it a 3-point game with a methodical drive midway through the third quarter. The 11-play, 55-yard journey included a 16-yard completion from Austin Slye to Vinny Chirdon, and a 22-yard screen pass to Gino Caesar, before Pisula battered his way into the end zone from a yard out to make it 16-13 with 6:26 left in the third.

Thiel would counter with a pair of unanswered touchdowns to open its largest lead of the day, 30-13, with 11:31 left in the fourth quarter, before Slye completed four passes for 60 yards on SVC's second drive of the fourth quarter, capped off with a 14-yard touchdown strike to Keegan O'Brien to make it 30-20 with 6:45 left in regulation.

Thiel's next trip resulted in a missed field goal, giving the Bearcats the ball at their own 18, and they would go to the air, with Slye engineering another productive scoring drive, completing six passes for 72 yards, including two to McElroy for 39, to set up first-and-goal at the Thiel 1-yard line. Lining up from the Wildcat spot, Pisula then took the next snap and flipped it over the line to Billey for the touchdown to close the gap to 30-27 with 30 seconds left.

Billey pounced on the ensuing onside kick on the Thiel side of the 50-yard line, before Slye connected with Austin Wells for a 12-yard gain to set up first down at the Thiel 40 with 12 seconds left. The Bearcats would get no closer, however, as Slye's pass over the middle was picked off by Thiel's Justin Logan at the 25.

Slye completed 19 of 34 passes for 253 yards, with one touchdown and two interceptions. McElroy was his favorite target, hauling in five grabs for a game-high 91 yards, while O'Brien finished with four catches for 34 yards and the fourth-quarter score. Caesar led Saint Vincent on the ground, with 22 yards on eight carries. Defensively, Wiley Purry and Nathan Sullivan each recorded 13 tackles to lead the Bearcats, with Sullivan adding a solo sack and Purry an interception and pass break-up. Ethan Facey made seven solo tackles and one TFL, as the Bearcats recorded a season-high seven tackles behind the line of scrimmage.

SAINT VINCENT VS. BETHANY - LAST MEETING

Latrobe, Pa. (Nov. 12, 2022) — Saint Vincent rolled up 517 yards of total offense and 27 first downs to comfortably defeat Bethany College, 36-7, in the 2022 regular season finale at a rainy Chuck Noll Field. With the win, the Bearcats posted their second consecutive 5-win campaign, while their five conference victories matched the 2011 squad for most in a season.

Saint Vincent quarterback Brady Walker celebrated his Senior Day in fine fashion, completing 19 passes for a season-high 322 yards and three touchdowns. Junior receiver Molayo Irefin made five catches for 146 yards and two touchdowns, including a 90-yarder midway through the first quarter, while also adding a rushing score. Sophomore running back D.J. Gray Jr. eclipsed the 100-yard mark for the second consecutive week, with 24 carries for a career-high 140 yards.

The Bearcats (5-5, 5-3 PAC) limited the Bison (1-9, 0-8 PAC) to just 190 yards of total offense and 11 first downs, while forcing three Bethany turnovers. The Bearcat defense was led by a trio of seniors, with Desonio Powell recording a fumble recovery and Ahmad Shaw and Nathan Ault each picking off interceptions.

The Bearcats' totals of 195 rushing yards, 322 passing yards and 517 yards of total offense were all season-highs. Along with Gray's 140-yard effort, Ja'Tier Berkley added 51 yards on seven carries, while Irefin's 146-yard receiving day was supplemented by a 3-catch, 79-yard performance from Jeffrey Downs and a 3-catch, 30-yard effort from tight end Scott Garlock.

Chris Williams led Bethany's offense, making five receptions for 80 yards. Tre'Jour Oens ran 10 times for 43 yards, while defensively, Tsi Fofang made eight tackles, including 3.5 TFLs and a sack.

AARON SMETANKA HEAD COACH

Fifth Season Saint Vincent, 2012

A standout quarterback for the Bearcats during his playing days, Aaron Smetanka was hired as the third head coach in the Saint Vincent College football team's modern era on Dec. 5, 2018. He completed his fourth season as head coach in 2022.

In 2022, the Bearcats finished 5-5 overall and 5-3 in the Presidents' Athletic Conference, with the five conference wins the team's most since 2011. The Bearcats scored 37 touchdowns and averaged 28.6 points per game, both third best in the PAC. Eight Saint Vincent players earned All-PAC accolades, highlighted by junior receiver/return specialist Molayo Irefin. Irefin, who led the PAC in kick return (27.2) and punt return (15.9) average, recorded the longest punt return in the team's modern era with an 85-yard touchdown in the season-opener against Stevenson, before posting a 100-yard kick return touchdown in a week nine victory over Waynesburg. Irefin also ranked second in the PAC in receptions (62) and touchdown receptions (8) and third in receiving yards (732). Along with his All-PAC honor, Irefin was also named First Team All-Region and Third Team All-America by D3football.com, becoming the first SVC football All-American since 1960. Quarterback Brady Walker led the PAC with 21 touchdown passes and 165 completions, while ranking third with 2,015 passing yards. Defensively, cornerback Ahmad Shaw was named Second Team All-PAC after picking off a team-high four interceptions.

In 2021, Smetanka led the Bearcats to just their second postseason appearance since the team's 2007 rebirth, as they took part in the ECAC James Lynah Bowl. The Bearcats closed the season with five wins, tied for the second most in the team's modern era. The Bearcat offense scored 30 or more points in five different games and averaged 361.3 yards per game to rank fourth in the Presidents' Athletic Conference. The Bearcat defense also ranked in the top five in the PAC in yards allowed, while their 18 interceptions ranked second in the conference and 16th in NCAA Division III.

Walker threw for 2,721 yards and 22 touchdowns in 2021, finishing his junior season as the team's all-time record holder in career touchdown passes (37) and passing yards (4,200). Irefin set a program record with 919 receiving yards and ranked second in the PAC in receptions (68), while he led the PAC in kick return average (23.5 yards) and all-purpose yards (174.90/qm), which ranked fifth nationally.

Defensively, graduate student Cam Norris recorded 7.0 quarterback sacks and 12.5 tackles for loss, while junior Ahmad Shaw and rookie Marvelle Cromerdie each intercepted three passes. Walker, Irefin and Norris were among a seven Bearcats who earned All-PAC honors, while safety Kyle Coombe, who recorded 51 tackles and three interceptions, was named First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District.

In 2021, Smetanka guided the Bearcats to a 2-2 record during an abbreviated 2020-21 season that was played in the spring due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Over the four games, punctuated by a 35-6 victory over Bethany in week two and a 56-26 home win in the season finale against Waynesburg, the Bearcats ranked third in the Presidents' Athletic Conference in both scoring offense (29.8 points/gm) and total offense (382.5 yards/gm). Defensively, the Bearcats' allowed just a 44.4 percent conversion rate on third down, ranking second in the PAC, while they finished fourth in the league with six quarterback sacks.

Individually, 10 players earned All-PAC honors, highlighted by center Colton Belmont's First Team selection and Second Team picks Mike Stasko (RB), David Marshall (RB), Cam Norris (OLB) and Jared Gonzalez (P). Belmont was also recognized with All-Region honors by D3Football.com, while Stasko rolled up 370 rushing yards and four touchdowns to end his career as the Bearcats' modern era all-time leading rusher with 1,877 yards.

In 2019, Smetanka's first year at the helm, the Bearcats recovered from an 0-4 start to win three of their final six games. He recorded his first victory on Oct. 12 with a 41-18 decision at PAC rival Thiel, while the Bearcats ended the season on a high note with a 27-10 home win over Bethany College.

Seven SVC players were honored with All-PAC recognition following the conclusion of the 2019 team, including First Team selection Christian Witchey (punter) and Second-Teamers Belmont and Stasko. Stasko set new team records with 907 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, while linebacker Izaak Gray recorded six quarterback sacks to graduate as the team's all-time career leader with 16.5 QB takedowns.

Smetanka rewrote the record books during his career as the Bearcats' quarterback, before going on to play professionally for the Erie Explosion of the Continental Indoor Football League. Smetanka's coaching career began in 2012, and it includes a three-year stint as an assistant at Saint Vincent, while he served as head coach at Greensburg Central Catholic High School in 2017 and 2018.

A two-year starter under center for the Bearcats (2010-11), Smetanka ranks among the program's modernday career record-holders in passing yards (4,117), attempts (536), completions (331), and touchdown passes (31). Voted the team's offensive most valuable player in both 2010 and 2011, Smetanka was also a First Team All-Presidents' Athletic Conference selection in each season. As a senior and team co-captain in 2011, Smetanka led the Bearcats to their most successful season since the team's rebirth, as they went 6-4 in the regular season and qualified for the Eastern College Athletic Conference's Southwest Bowl. In 2014, Smetanka was named to the PAC's 60th Anniversary All-Time Team, which recognized the top football players in the conference's long history.

After graduating from SVC, Smetanka began his coaching career as the quarterback coach at Peters Township High School for the 2012 season. Following a one-year stint, he returned to his alma mater to join the Bearcat coaching staff as quarterback coach, a position he held for three seasons. Smetanka held a variety of responsibilities in this role, as in addition to coaching the team's quarterbacks, he was heavily involved in recruiting, scouting, and breakdown of game film, while also providing positive guidance and mentorship to the Bearcat players.

During his first stint on the Saint Vincent staff, Smetanka also starred under center for the Erie Explosion from 2013-14. As a rookie in 2013, he guided the team to a perfect 10-0 record and the CIFL title. A year later, Smetanka was named the Continental Indoor Football League's Offensive Player of the Year, leading the Explosion to a 9-2 record and their second consecutive league championship.

After spending the 2016 season on the staff at Chartiers Valley High School as passing game coordinator and quarterback coach, Smetanka was named the head coach of Greensburg Central Catholic in January 2017. He oversaw all aspects of the Centurion football program, as in addition to his head coaching role, he coordinated both the offense and special teams, while also serving as guarterback coach, strength and conditioning coach and equipment manager. During his time at GCC, a total of 21 Centurions were named all-conference.

In addition to his coaching experience, Smetanka has been a coach and speaker for the Coaching Boys into Men program for the past two years, an initiative aimed at promoting healthy relationships, building leadership skills and decreasing violence among high school boys. Smetanka was chosen as a featured speaker at the 2018 Coaching Boys into Men Summit, and was named the national MVP Coach of the Year, earning recognition from the United Way in its 2018 annual report.

A native of Allison Park, Pennsylvania, and graduate of North Catholic High School, Smetanka earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Saint Vincent's Alex G. McKenna School of Business, Economics and Government. He and wife Courtney are the proud parents of son Carter and daughter Kennedy.
