GENEVA LEADERS

OPENING KICKOFF

Saint Vincent wraps up its rare three-game homestand this week by hosting Geneva on Homecoming at Chuck Noll Field. The Bearcats are looking to snap a two-game losing streak after dropping a 21-7 decision to Waynesburg in week four... Saint Vincent has defeated Geneva in each of the past two seasons, and has won five of its past eight meetings with the Golden Tornadoes. The Bearcats have also won three straight Homecoming games... Geneva is 1-3 on the season, with all three losses coming to PAC teams either ranked or receiving votes in the D3Football.com national poll, including last week's 56-14 home setback to Case Western Reserve... The Bearcats and Golden Tornadoes possess two of the more run-heavy offenses in the PAC, as the Golden Tornadoes average 45.7 rushes and 135.5 yards per game, and the Bearcats 35 rushes for 128.5 yards.

BEARCAT BRIEFS

HAPPY HOMECOMING: Saint Vincent celebrates Homecoming this week as it hosts Geneva. The Bearcats have won three straight Homecoming matchups at Chuck Noll Field, all of which were decided by single digits. Last season, Saint Vincent held off Allegheny for a 23-19 win, while the Bearcats topped Thiel, 24-16, in 2023, and earned a dramatic 42-40 comeback victory over Case Western Reserve in 2021.

TOPPING THE CENTURY MARK: In last week's loss to Waynesburg, sophomore Dontae Sanders ran 15 times for 106 yards and a touchdown, marking his first career 100-yard game and the first time this season that a Bearcat has topped 100 rushing yards. Sanders, who averages 6.6 yards per carry and ranks seventh in the PAC with 250 rushing yards this season, became the first Bearcat to amass 100 rushing yards since sophomore teammate Gino Caesar ran for 111 in a win over Bethany in last year's season finale. Sanders' rushing touchdown against Waynesburg was his second of the season, as he enters week five as one of just nine players in the PAC with multiple rushing TDs.

PURRY ON THE PROWL: Last week against Waynesburg, senior linebacker Wiley Purry amassed 10 total tackles, marking the fourth straight game this season, and ninth straight game dating back to the 2023 season, in which he totaled 10 or more tackles. Purry, who led the PAC with 111 stops last season, currently ranks second in the conference this season with 41 tackles. Since the beginning of the 2023 campaign, Purry's 152 tackles lead all active NCAA Division III players.

PICK IT: Despite failing to record an interception in last week's loss to Waynesburg, the Saint Vincent defense remains tied with Geneva for second in the PAC this season with five picks. Sophomore safety Robbie Labuda leads the PAC - and is tied for third in NCAA Division III - with three interceptions, while Purry has picked off two passes. The Bearcats are the only team in the PAC to have two players with multiple interceptions

HEALTHY RETURNS: Saint Vincent sophomore Austin Wells enters this week ranked second in the PAC in kick return average at 21.8 yards. Nine of Wells' 12 kick returns this season have been longer than 20 yards, while he had two career-high, 29-yard returns in last week's game with Waynesburg.

CAPTAIN 'CATS: Saint Vincent's co-captains for the 2024 season are Purry, graduate student quarterback Israel Reed and junior defensive tackle Josiah Weyandt.

UP NEXT: After playing three straight home games, Saint Vincent will travel north to take on Case Western Reserve next Saturday night at 7 p.m. The first of two straight road games for the Bearcats, it is the only game on SVC's docket this season with a scheduled start time other than 1 p.m. After Case, the Bearcats will travel to Westminster on Oct. 12, before returning home to take on Carnegie Mellon on Oct. 19.

LATROBE, Pa. (Sept. 28) - Saint Vincent fell to 1-3 with a 21-7 loss to Waynesburg at Chuck Noll Field.

Saint Vincent scored on its first drive of the afternoon, with Dontae Sanders banging through the line for 4-yard touchdown to cap off an impressive 9-play, 91-yard trip. on which Sanders gained 43 yards.

It would be the last lead of the day for the hosts, as Waynesburg tied it late in the first quarter, before scoring one touchdown in the second and third quarters.

The Bearcats were hampered by 13 penalties for 79 yards, while also struggling on third down, converting on just three of 13 opportunities. Conversely, Waynesburg recorded first downs on seven of their 11 third downs.

Sanders became the first Bearcat back to amass 100 yards this season,

as he gained a career-high 106 on just 15 carries, good for a 7.6 yard average. Teammate Billy Beck averaged 6.0 yards per rush, gaining 30 yards on five tries.

In his first career start under center, Stevie Oursler completed five of six attempts for 30 yards before leaving due to injury in the second quarter. Luke Levendosky came on to complete eight passes for 66 yards. Keegan O'Brien led the receiving corps with three catches for 33 yards.

Wiley Purry amassed a team-high 10 tackles, while KeShawn Davis made eight tackles and Josiah Weyandt, Robbie Labuda, and Nathan Parker tallied seven stops. Labuda made 1.5 tackles for loss.

The Yellow Jackets outgained the Bearcats in total offense 293-262, while also owning a 32:25-27:35 margin in time of possession.

LAST MEETING

BEAVER FALLS, Pa. (Sept. 30, 2024) -- Behind 21 unanswered second-quarter points, Saint Vincent came back to earn a 28-19 road win over Geneva in Presidents' Athletic Conference action under the lights at Reeves Field.

After a disastrous start saw the Bearcats fall behind 14-0 less than four minutes into play, SVC flipped the script in the second quarter to gain a lead over Geneva it would not relinquish.

The Bearcats were led by a herculean effort from Max Pisula, who recorded 11 tackles, including four tackles for loss, two sacks, three forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries from the defensive end spot, while he also rushed for a second quarter touchdown, his third of the season.

Geneva needed just four plays to score its first touchdown of the day on an 11-yard run by Logan Kent with 13:22 left in the quareter, and got the ball right back after a fumble on the ensuing kickoff. Taking over at the SVC 20, the GTs needed five plays to take a 14-0 lead on a 1-yard quarterback keeper by Brutus Ogilvie.

SVC got on the scoreboard on the final play of the first quarter with a 9-yard touchdown run from Ty Martin. A field goal with 9:18 left in the second quarter upped the Geneva lead to 17-7, but SVC roared back in a big way. Martin picked up his second TD of the night on SVC's next trip to close the gap to 17-14, before Pisula's strip sack gave the ball right back to the Bearcats. He would then finish what he started by bullying into the end zone from four yards out to give SVC a 21-17 lead with 1:29 to go.

Eighty seconds later, the SVC defense forced a Geneva punt on the 32-yard line. The snap sailed over the head of the Golden Tornado punter and was pounced upon in the end zone by SVC's Austin Wells to push the Bearcat advantage to 28-17 with six seconds left in the half

After the explosive first half, the team's defenses took over in the second, with Geneva scoring the only points on an intentional safety by the Bearcats with 30 seconds left in the fourth quarter.

SVC's Austin Slye completed 13 of 18 passes for 168 yards, while Martin gained 92 rushing yards on 27 carries. Matt Esdelle made two catches for 69 yards.

Pisula was one of a a host of Bearcat defenders to enjoy a big night. Josiah Weyandt recorded a career-high 12 tackles, including a sack, while KeShawn Davis amassed 11 tackles and Nathan Sullivan six tackles and an interception.
