WAYNESBURG LEADERS

OPENING KICKOFF

Saint Vincent faces Waynesburg University in the second bout of a rare, three-game home stand. The Yellow Jackets are the Bearcats' most frequent opponent, as this week marks the 43rd all-time meeting between the two squads dating back to 1929... Both teams are coming off of week three losses to perrenial Presidents' Athletic Conference powers, as Saint Vincent was defeated, 56-7, by defending PAC champ Grove City, ranked No. 8 in this week's D3football.com national poll, while Waynesburg fell, 55-16, to Washington & Jefferson, which is receiving votes in the D3Football.com poll... The Bearcats have won four of the past five matchups, though Waynesburg earned a rainy 24-0 home victory on Oct. 14 of last season. Saint Vincent has won each of the past two meetings at Chuck Noll Field, and is 4-1 at home against Waynesburg since 2015.

BEARCAT BRIEFS

SO WE MEET AGAIN: Since the initial launch of Saint Vincent football in 1923, Waynesburg University is SVC's most frequent foe on the gridiron, as this week marks the 43rd all-time meeting between the two squads. Waynesburg holds a 22-16-4 advantage in the series, but the Bearcats have won four of the past five meetings, and two of the past three contests played in Latrobe.

NOSE FOR THE BALL: In the Bearcats' week three matchup against Grove City, sophomore safety Robbie Labuda recorded his team- and Presidents' Athletic Conference-leading third interception, halting a potential Wolverine scoring drive on the game's opening possession. Labuda, who was named the PAC Defensive Player of the Week after recording two picks in SVC's Sept. 14 win at Allegheny, is one of just eight NCAA Division III players with three interceptions this season. He also led all players with 11 tackles in the Grove City contest.

PICK PARTY: The Saint Vincent defense is tied for first in the PAC, and fifth in NCAA Division III, with five interceptions, receiving three from Robbie Labuda and two from Wiley Purry. It marks the most interceptions by a Bearcat defense through three games in modern pay program history, eclipsing the 2011 squad that recorded four picks over its first three contests.

TEN MORE FOR NO. 8: Saint Vincent senior linebacker and co-captain Wiley Purry recorded 10 tackles, along with an interception, in the week three loss to Grove City. It marked the third time in as many games this season, and the ninth time in the past 13 games dating back to the beginning of the 2023 season, in which Purry amassed 10 or more tackles. Purry, who led the PAC and set a Saint Vincent single-season record with 111 tackles in 2023, enters week four ranked third in the PAC with 31 stops on the year.

SPREADING THE WEALTH: Through three games this season, five Saint Vincent players have rushed for a touchdown, already tied for the most number of players to record a rushing TD in a season since 2021. In last week's loss to Grove City, Isaiah Sosak got the Bearcats on the board with a 7-yard run with just under five minutes left in the fourth quarter. Along with Sosak, freshman Julian Walker, sophomore Dontae Sanders, senior Billy Beck and grad student Israel Reed have all found paydirt on the ground this season.

NO LACK OF DISCIPLINE: Through three games, Saint Vincent has committed only 14 penalties for 120 yards. The team's average of 4.7 penalties per game is the third-lowest in the Presidents' Athletic Conference

CAPTAIN 'CATS: Saint Vincent's co-captains for the 2024 season are graduate student quarterback Israel Reed, senior linebacker Wiley Purry and junior defensive tackle Josiah Weyandt.

UP NEXT: Next week, Saint Vincent will celebrate Homecoming and wrap up its three-game homestand with a 1 p.m. machup against Geneva College at Chuck Noll Field. The Bearcats have defeated the Golden Tornadoes in each of the past two seasons. It will be the final home game for Saint Vincent until an Oct. 26 meeting with Carnegie Mellon.

LATROBE, Pa. (Sept. 21) - Saint Vincent's 2024 home debut was spoiled by defending PAC champ Grove City, which earned a 56-7 win at Chuck Noll Field.

The Wolverines broke open a one-score game by scoring three unanswered touchdowns in the second quarter and never looked back, limiting the Bearcats to just 94 yards of total offense and five first downs for the game. Saint Vincent broke through with 4:53 remaining in the fourth quarter when Isaiah Sosak rumbled into the end zone from seven yards out for his first collegiate score. It capped off the Bearcats' most successful drive of the game, a 7-play, 75-yard trip that included a 30-yard pass completion from Stevie Oursler to Chris Downs, and a 24-yard run by Julian Walker.

Walker ran for a team-best 41 yards on just four carries, while Sosak had a pair of runs totaling 13 yards. Oursler, the third quarterback to see action for the Bearcats on the day, completed both of his pass attempts for 35 yards. Downs' 30-yard fourth quarter

reception was SVC's longest play of the afternoon, while Keegan O'Brien led the hosts with three receptions for 20 yards. Robbie Labuda recorded a game-high 11 tackles while also picking off his team- and conference-leading third interception of the season, which halted Grove City's first possession of the afternoon.

Wiley Purry notched 10 tackles and also recorded a second quarter interception, picking off a pass in the end zone to cut short another potential Wolverine scoring drive.

Grove City gained 606 yards of total offense, amassing 330 passing yards and 276 yards on the ground. The Wolverine defense recorded four sacks and six tackles for loss, holding the Bearcats to just 25 rushing yards.

The game was delayed for 76 minutes due to a severe thunderstorm and torrential rain that struck the SVC campus during halftime.

LAST MEETING

WAYNESBURG, Pa. (Oct. 14, 2023) - In a rainy Presidents' Athletic Conference matchup, Saint Vincent was defeated on the road, 24-0, by Waynesburg University.

The Bearcats struggled on both sides of the ball, as they were outgained 411-138 in total offense and saw the Yellow Jackets hold a more than 13-minute advantage in time of possession.

Waynesburg had 23 first downs to Saint Vincent's 8, while outgaining SVC 204-23 in rushing yards and forcing a pair of SVC fumbles.

The Yellow Jackets also recorded three quarterback sacks and seven tackles for loss.

Waynesburg quarterback Samuel Barber completed 17 of 26 passes for 207 yards and two touchdowns, while Yellow Jacket running back Justin Flack ran for 125 yards on 25 carries with one touchdown.

Waynesburg opened the scoring midway through the first quarter

on a 13-yard touchdown pass from Barber to Isaac Trout. The Yellow Jackets extended the lead to 10-0 with a 45-yard field goal by Rico Sastoque on the final play of the first half.

The Yellow Jackets took advantage of a fumbled punt to take a 17-0 lead with 7:31 left in the third quarter on a 12-yard pass from Barber to Flack, before sealing the victory with an 11-play, 69-yard drive that took more than seven minutes off the clock capped off by a 5-yard Flack touchdown rush with 2:30 left in the final stanza.

In the physical, chippy affair, the two teams committed a combined 19 penalties for 192 yards. They also combined for 10 punts.

SVC quarterback Austin Slye completed 14 of 26 passes for 115 yards. Gino Caesar led the Bearcats with 37 rushing yards on eight carries, while Matthew Esdelle led the SVC receiving corps with four catches for 53 yards. Alex St. Julien had 9 tackles to lead the Bearcats, including a half sack, while Wiley Purry made a team-best 9 tackles, including 1.0 TFL.
