









## Syracuse And Niagara Clash

Two longtime state rivals clash when Syracuse hosts Niagara on Dec. 3 in the Carrier Dome. Saturday's pairing will be the 83rd in a series that dates to the 1909-10 campaign.

The Orange lead the overall series, 54-28. Syracuse has won the last nine matchups with the Purple Eagles.

Syracuse won last year's competition, 82-70.

The Orange begin the season by defeating Bryant, 85-84. Niagara opens its schedule with the Syracuse game.

### Syracuse Notes

- ✓ Forward **Marek Dolezaj** loaded up his stat line against Bryant with 20 points, 10 assists, five rebounds, and four steals.
- ✓ **Alan Griffin** (17 pts., 13 rebs.), **Quincy Guerrier** (15-13) and **Dolezaj** gave the Orange three double-doubles in one game for the first time since 2016. Tyler Lydon (14-10), Tyler Roberson (13-12) and Frank Howard (10-11 assists) were the last trio to accomplish the feat.
- ✓ **Bourama Sidibe**, who had started 33 straight games at center for the Orange, suffered a left knee injury against Bryant. He will not dress for the Niagara game.





- ✓ Niagara coach Greg Paulus was a scholastic standout at local CBA.

- ✓ Niagara features junior guard Marcus Hammond (14.3 ppg., 4.6 rebs.)

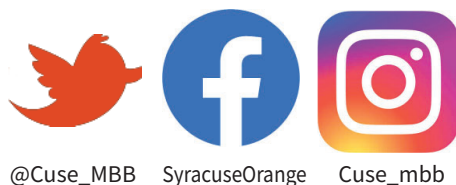

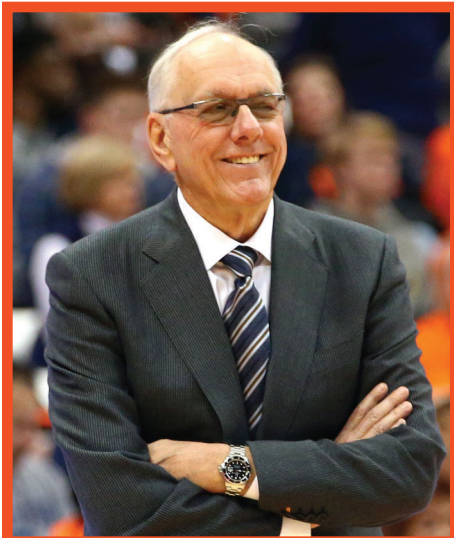

## Boeheim Second All-Time In Wins

**Jim Boeheim** embarks on his 45th season as head coach at his alma mater, Syracuse. He earned the \*965th win of his coaching tenure when the Orange defeated Bryant in the club's season opener against Bryant on Nov. 27, 85-84.

Mike Krzyzewski (Army, Duke) is the only active Division I coach who is ahead of Boeheim on the wins and games-coached list.

Boeheim's 44 seasons completed put him first on the list of Division I coaches at their current schools. Krzyzewski is second with 39 campaigns at Duke.

## The Book On Boeheim

Boeheim owns a career record of \*965-399 (.707).

His 1,364 games (total reflects 101 games vacated between 2004-07 and 2010-12 by the NCAA) ranks first for coaches who have served at only one institution in the Division I ranks.

The 2019 NCAA berth gave SU 40 post-season appearances under Boeheim, including 34 NCAA Tournaments. He has guided his alma mater to the NCAA title game three times, winning it for the first time in 2003.
