### LETTER FROM THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR

**JOHN WILDHACK '80** 

#### **Dear Orange Nation,**

There's a lot to be excited about around Syracuse Athletics as Spring arrives. Our football program finished a 10-win season with a victory at the Holiday Bowl and Coach Fran earned multiple national coaching honors after the team ended the year ranked in every major poll. Additionally, both our cross country teams finished in the top-20 at the NCAA Championships and our field hockey team reached the NCAA Tournament for the fourth-straight season. We also had a record-setting year fall semester in the classroom. The average GPA for our student-athletes was 3.324, setting a new fall semester record. Over 70 percent of our student-athletes achieved above a 3.0 and we had 45 attain perfect 4.0s.

While we continue to celebrate our student-athletes' accomplishments and work to position our programs for championships, we are also planning for changes on the horizon. The House settlement which we anticipate will be approved this Spring, will vastly change the landscape of intercollegiate athletics. It would allow schools to directly share revenue to current student-athletes and set new roster limits in all sports we sponsor, beginning July 1, 2025.

In response to this seismic shift in college athletics, Syracuse University has launched Champion 'CUSE: The Campaign for Syracuse Athletics, a University-wide initiative focused on elevating the 20 varsity sports programs on campus. Champion 'CUSE is a three-year, \$50 Million effort to position Syracuse among NCAA Division I's most successful athletic departments in the modern era of college athletics. As part of Champion 'CUSE, Syracuse Athletics is introducing a brand-new giving option for Syracuse fans, alumni, donors and friends called 'Athletics Competitive Excellence.' At its core, Athletics Competitive Excellence will allow our coaches to recruit and retain the best and brightest student-athletes. It will directly impact our ability to compete for ACC and National Championships.

In addition to Athletics Competitive Excellence, there is still a variety of other avenues to support Syracuse student-athletes and Orange athletic programs through Champion 'CUSE. Gifts to the Athletics Opportunity Fund and sports-specific head coaches' funds will also count towards the campaign's \$50 Million goal. Purchasing or renewing your season tickets, supporting our corporate partners and buying branded Block S merchandise are additional ways to make an impact on Syracuse Athletics outside of the campaign.

I'm incredibly thankful for the continued support of Chancellor Syverud, our Board of Trustees, and the University leadership team. I'm also deeply appreciative of our loyal and passionate fans, donors, and the CNY community at large for your support of our programs. We will strive to serve you well each and every day and provide thrilling memories that will last a lifetime. Thank you and **Go Orange!**

### **DONOR RANK**

#### UNDERSTANDING HOW DONOR RANK IS CALCULATED

'Cuse Athletics Fund Donor Rank is an annual ranking that is used to assign and allocate benefits, including parking, new/upgraded tickets, premium seating, away game tickets, neutral site tickets, postseason tickets, hospitality access and more.

The goal of the 'CAF Donor Rank is to acknowledge a supporter's full investment in Syracuse University Athletics and balance both annual support through the annual membership level and loyalty and longevity through priority points.



**\*CAF ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP** | \*CAF Annual Membership Level represents a \*CAF member's annual cash support toward Syracuse Athletics. It is calculated based on the sum of:

- 1) Required seat-related donation(s) included in any season ticket purchase (part of the ticket price)
- 2) Philanthropic donations to Athletics Competitive Excellence or Athletics Opportunity Fund
- 3) Legends Society donor gifts to Athletics Competitive Excellence
- 4) Capital Improvement Contribution(s)



**PRIORITY POINTS** | Priority Points represent a 'CAF member's lifetime support of Syracuse Athletics and Syracuse University. It is calculated based on:

- 1) 2 points for every \$100 to Athletics Competitive Excellence or Athletics Opportunity Fund
- 2) 1 point for every \$100 to all other funds\*
- 3) 1 point for every \$1,000 of lifetime giving to any Athletics Fund\*
- 4) 1 point for every \$5,000 of lifetime giving to the University



#### PREPARING SYRACUSE ATHLETICS FOR THE NEW ERA OF COLLEGE ATHLETICS

#### WHAT IS ATHLETICS COMPETITIVE EXCELLENCE?

The impending House settlement will grant NCAA Division I institutions the ability to directly share revenue with student-athletes as soon as July 1, 2025. In response to this seismic shift in the landscape of college athletics, Director of Athletics John Wildhack and the 'Cuse Athletics Fund are introducing a brand-new giving option for fans, alumni, and donors dubbed "Athletics Competitive Excellence". At its core, Athletics Competitive Excellence strives to empower the athletics department's ability to maximize revenue-sharing opportunities for student-athletes, strengthening our ability to recruit and retain elite talent in an effort to build championship-caliber programs that consistently excel on the national stage. Philanthropic donations to Athletics Competitive Excellence will be a vital piece of the equation at Syracuse University as it relates to revenue sharing with our student-athletes, meaning 'Cuse Athletics Fund donors will be able to have a more direct impact on our team's ability to recruit, retain and develop top talent more than ever before!

Syracuse University is committed to fostering a culture of educational and competitive excellence and entering this transformational period in college athletics with high integrity. We will continue to provide a world-class education and student-athlete experience, while fully embracing the new revenue share model as we strive to position Syracuse as a perennial top-25 athletic department in the nation.

#### WHAT IS THE HOUSE SETTLEMENT?

The House settlement refers to the resolution of a civil class action lawsuit called the "House" case, which was filed by Division I student-athletes - including an athlete named Grant House - against the NCAA and Power 5 conferences (SEC; Big 10; ACC; Pac-12; and Big 12). If the settlement is finalized, it will end three lawsuits that challenge NCAA rules that prohibited student-athletes from earning compensation for certain things, including their name-image-likeness or "NIL" rights. The proposed settlement, which is likely to be approved by the relevant judge between April and June 2025, would result in significant changes to the college athletics landscape, including at Syracuse University.

#### WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR THE NIL ENTITIES?


