- Syracuse Volleyball will open up its 2026 ACC slate at home against Louisville on Friday, Sept. 25 and Notre Dame on Sunday, Sept. 27.
- The Orange started its conference slate 5-4 in 2025.
- In the non-conference slate, the Orange won the Cornell Invite with Yuka Urano winning Tournament MVP. Charis Burge and Abby Nicholson made the All-Tournament Team.
- Syracuse will play a 20-match schedule in ACC play against all 17 other member schools.

80'S NIGHT

- Friday's theme for the match against Louisville is 80's night, with fans encouraged to wear their best 80's gear.
- Music throughout the night will be 80's themed with 80's trivia between the 2nd and 3rd sets.

STAFF APPRECIATION

- Sunday's theme against Notre Dame is Staff Appreciation Day.
- Each Syracuse player selected a staff or faculty member to throw out a t-shirt at Sunday's contest.

HITTING HER STRIDE

- Kiernan Stamey entered the Power-Four level after two seasons at Kennesaw State and has not looked back.
- Stamey leads the Orange with 117 kills and 3.77 kills per set. The junior's kills per set rank seventh in the ACC.
- Stamey has led the Orange in kills in seven of the first nine matches of the 2026 season.
- The junior has also shown her defensive prowess, ranking second on the team in digs (63) and blocks (16.0).

- In the Cornell Invite, Yuka Urano was named Tournament MVP, tallying 38 digs through the three games of the tournament.
- Charis Burge and Abby Nicholson were named to the All-Tournament Team, Burge notched 97 assists in 11 sets throughout the tournament while Abby Nicholson earned 17 total blocks and 25 kills while in Ithaca.
- In the Syracuse Invitational, Kiernan Stamey and Emma Williams were named to the All-Tournament Team.
- Stamey notched 37 kills and 5.3 kills per set at the home tournament, hitting .302 against FDU and .364 against Buffalo while Emma Williams tallied 22 kills (13 against FDU, 9 against Buffalo) on .310 and .318 hitting in consecutive matches.

WE'RE SET

- Freshman Setter Charis Burge has had an impressive start to her collegiate career so far for the Orange.
- In her first collegiate weekend against Cincinnati and Illinois, Burge tallied 25 assists against the Bearcats, followed by 24 assists against Illinois.
- Burge followed up the opening-weekend performance with three consecutive 20-plus assist matches in the Cornell Invite, with 22 and 25 assists respectively in sweeps over Howard and UAlbany, and 50 assists in a five-set win over the hosts, Cornell.
- In her nine career matches at the collegiate level, Burge has tallied 286 assists and 9.23 assists per set.
- The freshman ranks ninth in the ACC in both assists and assists per set, 286 and 9.23 respectively.

LOOK WHO'S BACK, BACK AGAIN

- Setter Mira Ledermueller returns to Syracuse for her senior year after a season away at UT-Arlington.
- Ledermueller began her career at Syracuse, notching 449 assists as a freshman and adding 361 assists as a sophomore.
- Ledermueller transferred to UT-Arlington for the 2025 season, where she led the Western Athletic Conference with a career-high 943 assists (9.07 per set) as a junior.
- Ledermueller was named WAC Setter of the Week five times in 2025, the most of any player in the conference.

OH CAPTAINS, MY CAPTAINS

- Sophomore Marie Laurio, graduate Abby Nicholson and sophomore Yuka Urano will serve as captains for the 2026 season.
- The trio brings a mix of experience and talent to Syracuse, spanning multiple positions and backgrounds at the collegiate level.
- Laurio enters her second season in Orange after a productive freshman season, after appearing in 23 matches and 49 sets.
- Laurio posted 55 kills, 93 digs and 11 blocks a year ago as she continues to develop into a key contributor for the Orange.
- Nicholson joins Syracuse this fall after transferring from Lafayette, where she made 37 starts as a middle blocker across three seasons.
- Nicholson appeared in 43 matches and 98 sets, finishing her career at Lafayette with 177 kills, 36 digs and 133 total blocks.
- Urano, a libero from Tokyo, Japan, joins the Orange after a standout 2025 season at Navarro College, where she was named Region XIV Libero of the Year.

MEET THEM IN THE MIDDLE

- The Orange have new faces at the Middle Blocker position with Kiera Hagler, Emma Faerber, Bo Nijenhuis and Abby Nicholson joining the fold.
- Hagler, a freshman from Calera, Ala., competed at Calera High School and Alabama Performance Volleyball Club before joining the Orange.
- Faerber, a freshman from Wiesbaden, Germany, played for VC Wiesbaden and competed in the German National Championship in each year from 2023-26.
- Nijenhuis brings experience from Rivo Rijssen, a championship-winning team in the Netherlands.
- Nicholson, a graduate from Savannah, Ga., competed for Lafayette, tallying 43 matches played, appearing in 98 sets while notching 37 starts.

LAURIO LEADS THE WAY

- Outside hitter Marie Laurio returns to Syracuse, now entering her sophomore season.
- As a freshman in 2025, Laurio recorded 55 kills and 93 digs.
- Laurio was crucial in a five-set win over Boston College last season, logging 13 digs and 10 kills in the match.
- Through the first nine matches of her sophomore campaign, Laurio has notched 40 kills and 60 digs.

DIG THIS

- Syracuse builds its libero and defensive specialist room around graduate Anna Smith, freshman Queen Howse and sophomore Yuka Urano.
- Smith, from Charleston, S.C., spent three seasons at Coastal Carolina before graduating early to continue her career.
- Howse, a freshman from Brentwood, Tenn., joins the Orange after a standout career at Brentwood High School, being named to the TSSAA First Team All-District and All-Region while adding AVCA All-Region awards as a senior.
- Urano, a sophomore from Tokyo, Japan recorded 502 digs and 142 assists in the 2025 season playing for Navarro College.

ALL OVER THE MAP

- During the 2026 season, Syracuse Volleyball will represent nine states and three countries outside the U.S., with five international players.
- From overseas, the Orange bring in Emma Faerber and Mira Ledermueller (Germany), Aileen McAllister and Yuka Urano (Japan) and Bo Nijenhuis (Netherlands).
- Of the nine U.S. states represented, only two pairs of players share a home state, Keila Gabriel and Sophie Vienna (California) and Queen Howse and Kiernan Stamey (Tennessee).

ACADEMIC WEAPONS

- The Orange got it done in the classroom this past year, landing three players on the All-ACC Academic team.
- Syracuse was recognized with the AVCA Team Academic Award after posting a 3.158 fall GPA and 3.690 spring GPA in 2025-26.

SCOUTING LOUISVILLE

- Chloe Chicoine leads the Cardinals with 174 kills and 4.24 kills per set in the non-conference slate.
- Nayelis Cabello facilitates the Louisville offense, tallying 406 assists and 10.68 assists per set to start the year.
- Payton Peterson anchors the defense for Louisville, ranking second in the ACC with 181 digs.
- The Orange are looking to earn their first win over the Cardinals for the first time since 2019.

SCOUTING NOTRE DAME

- Syracuse has won the last two matches against Notre Dame, including a four-set win over the Irish in South Bend last season.
- Maya Evens anchors the Notre Dame defense with 4.43 digs per set while Anna Bjork leads the Irish in blocks with 36.
- The Irish are led on the attack by Sydney Helmers who has notched 105 kills and 3.62 kills per set so far this season.

PREVIOUS STOPS

2008-11	West Virginia	Assistant Coach
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Baker Ganesharatnam is entering his fifth season at the helm of the Syracuse Volleyball program and coming off the heels of a 15-win campaign in 2024, his most wins in a single season since taking over as Head Coach of the Orange. He joined Syracuse University in June 2022 after serving as the head coach at Temple where he guided the Owls to 173 wins in 11 seasons, including four 20-win campaigns from 2011-21.

In his first season on The Hill, Ganesharatnam guided the Orange to an 11-17 overall record and 7-11 in the ultra competitive ACC while Polina Shemanova was named AVCA All-America Honorable Mention and earned All-ACC First Team honors in her final campaign. Most recently, Ganesharatnam piloted the Orange to a 12-match win streak to start the 2024 season, his longest stretch of victories since joining Syracuse.

The 2020-21 American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) North Region Coach of the Year and American Athletic Conference (AAC) co-Coach of the Year guided the Owls to the 2020-21 AAC Tournament Championship Game. During that season he mentored an AVCA All-Region honorable mention selection who was the AAC Libero of the Year and an all-league selection, in addition to two all-conference and two AAC All-Tournament selections. He also led the Owls to the 2017 National Invitational Volleyball Championship (NIVC) second round, the 2016 Philadelphia Big Five title, and the 2012 Atlantic 10 Tournament.

At Temple, Ganesharatnam mentored five AVCA All-Region selections, an AAC Setter of the Year, Libero of the Year and Rookie of the Year, an Atlantic 10 Libero of the Year, one Academic All-American, 15 All-AAC honorees, two All-Atlantic 10 players and one A-10 All-Rookie selection. His 2014 and 2015 squads earned the AAC Academic Team Award. He guided the Owls to 20-win seasons in four consecutive years (2014-17) and led Temple back to the national postseason in 2017 for the first time in 15 years. The Owls finished 20-10 overall, advancing to the second round of the NIVC, and were second in The American with a 15-5 record in conference play.

In addition to Ganesharatnam's work on the court at Temple, he was actively involved in collegiate volleyball operations. He represented Temple on the AVCA All-Region All-American Committee since 2018 and as a voter for the AVCA Division I Coaches Top-25 Poll.

Prior to his arrival at Temple, Ganesharatnam spent five years at West Virginia University as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for three seasons and a graduate assistant coach for the first two.

Ganesharatnam started his coaching career as an assistant coach at Cedar Valley College in Grand Prairie, Texas in 2005. During his one season there in 2005-06, the Suns reached their co-conference championship.
