Bowl Game Notes

- The two teams combined to score 52 first-half points (WVU 31, Georgia 21), breaking the BCS record for combined points by two teams in a half. The previous high was 48 combined points by Southern California (38) and Oklahoma (10) in the Orange Bowl, Jan. 4, 2005. The previous NOKIA Sugar Bowl record was 44 points scored by Notre Dame (32) and Florida (12) in the 1995 Classic.
- West Virginia scored 21 first-quarter points, the second highest point output in NOKIA Sugar Bowl history for an opening quarter. Tennessee holds that bowl record with 24 in a 1971 victory over Air Force (led 24-7 after first quarter & won 34-13). The 21 points are the most in the first quarter since Ohio State led Texas A&M 21-7 in the 1999 Classic (OSU won 24-14).
- Steve Slaton's 52-yard first quarter touchdown run is the first TD rush of more than 50 yards in a NOKIA Sugar Bowl game since Tennessee's Jeff Powell scored from 60-yards out vs. Miami in the 1986 Classic.
- West Virginia got on the board first on the 52-yard Steve Slaton TD rush in the opening quarter. The team who scores first is 5-2 in BCS-era NOKIA Sugar Bowl games, with Florida (2001) being the last team to open the scoring and lose (37-20 to Miami).
- West Virginia leads at the half by a 31-21 score. The team leading the NOKIA Sugar Bowl at the half is a perfect 7-0 in the BCS era and 12-1 since 1992 (Texas led Virginia Tech 10-7 at the half in 1995 and came back to win 28-10).
- Today's appearance by Georgia is its eighth in the NOKIA Sugar Bowl, which ties the Bulldogs for third on the all-time bowl appearance list. Alabama and LSU are first with 12 appearances each, followed by the Bulldogs and Ole Miss.
- Today's appearance by West Virginia is its first ever in the NOKIA Sugar Bowl.
- Today's game is the only the second time ever one of the current BCS games (Sugar, Rose, Fiesta, Orange) was played away from home. On Jan. 1, 1942, amid concerns on the West Coast after the Dec. 7, 1941 attack on Pearl Harbor, Oregon State downed Duke, 20-16, in the Rose Bowl, played in Durham, N.C.
- The first reviewed play in NOKIA Sugar Bowl history came with 11:37 to play in the second quarter. A reception by Darius Reynaud of West Virginia was reviewed and the catch upheld, giving WVU a first down.



Georgia Game Notes

- **STARTERS:** RS-freshman FLK Kenneth Harris made his first career start, getting the nod for the injured junior Sean Bailey. Senior OG Max Jean-Gilles started his team-high 39th consecutive game while on defense, the team-high is 26 by seniors Greg Blue (ROV) and DeMario Minter (SCB). Also, junior Ray Gant got the start at NG in place of senior Gerald Anderson who missed most of bowl practice in Atlanta this past week due to a back problem. Anderson did not dress out for tonight's game. Gant has started three previous times at NG this season and tonight marked his seventh start overall of the year. Senior C Russ Tanner got the start, his ninth this year and 35th overall. Tanner had split starts with senior Ryan Schnetzer who had started the last four games. Junior Danny Verdun Wheeler got the start at SLB in place of sophomore Brandon Miller. For Verdun Wheeler, it was his 9th of the year.
- **COIN TOSS:** West Virginia won the toss and deferred. Coming in tonight, the Bulldogs are 5-0 this season when they do not win the coin toss. Boise State was the only team that won the coin toss against the Bulldogs and then took the football as the others deferred.
- **FIRST POSSESSION:** Georgia went three plays and out for four yards and had to punt on its first possession. The Bulldogs scored on the opening drive in five games this year. Tonight, West Virginia posted a TD on its opening drive, the fifth team to score early against the Bulldogs, including the fourth time for a TD, joining Florida, Auburn and Ga. Tech. Miss. State posted a field goal against Georgia.
- **EARLY DEFICITS:** West Virginia posted TDs on its first four possessions giving Georgia its largest deficit of the season at 28-0. The previous high was Florida as it jumped out to a 14-0 advantage on its first two possessions against the Bulldogs. The Gators eventually posted a 14-10 win in Jacksonville, handing Georgia its first loss in game eight after the Bulldogs began the year 7-0.
- Before tonight, the Bulldogs largest deficit in the Mark Richt era was 24 when then third-ranked Auburn built a 24-0 lead over Georgia in 2004 en route to a 24-6 win in Auburn.
- The last team to score 31 points in the first half against Georgia was Auburn in 1999 when it led 31-0 en route to a 38-21 win in Athens.
- Georgia's biggest comeback in the Mark Richt era was 16 when it trailed South Carolina 16-0 in 2004 in Columbia in the second quarter. At the start of the 4th quarter, the Gamecocks led 16-13 and Georgia would rally back for a 20-16 win.
- **TURNOVERS:** Coming in, Georgia ranked 9th nationally with a +14 Turnover Margin. Opponents had scored 30 points off 15 Bulldog turnovers. Tonight, WVA has 14 points off two Bulldog miscues. In the first half, WVA

converted the first Bulldog fumble (Danny Ware) into a TD. The second fumble was caused on a hit on QB D.J. Shockley. It led to a TD. Before tonight, Georgia last fumble came against Auburn in game nine of the year when it had two and the Tigers converted them into 14 points en route to a 31-30 Auburn victory in Athens.

- **BOWL COMEBACKS:** In school history, Georgia's largest bowl comeback came in the 2000 Outback Bowl in Tampa when it trailed Purdue 25-0 in the second quarter in the Jim Donnan era. Georgia rallied back for a 28-25 in overtime. Tonight, Georgia trailed WVA by as much as 28 in the second quarter (28-0) before scoring a pair of TDs. The Mountaineers led 31-21 at the half.
- **LUMPKIN CAREER-LONG TD RUN:** In the second quarter, Georgia got on the board with a quick, four-play, 80-yard drive in 1:12 capped by a career-long 34-yard TD run by sophomore **Kregg Lumpkin** that cut the deficit to 28-7. Lumpkin's previous long rush was 21 yards twice.
- **BROWN CAREER-LONG TD RUN:** Also in the second quarter, sophomore **Thomas Brown** joined Lumpkin with a career-long TD run, this one covering 52 yards to pull Georgia to within 14 at 28-14. Brown's previous long rush was for 46 yards against LSU last year.

- WVU Coach **Rich Rodriguez** announced the 2005 team captains prior to today's game: senior free safety **Jahmile Addae**, senior boundary safety **Mike Lorello**, senior offensive tackle **Garin Justice** and senior nose tackle **Ernest Hunter**. During the season, coach Rodriguez selected game captains each week.
- **Brandon Barrett** was WVU's lone first-time starter against Georgia. Forty-two Mountaineers have made at least one career start. Lorello made his team-leading 38th career start and team-best 37th consecutive start.
- **Steve Slaton's** 52-yard rushing touchdown on WVU's game-opening drive was his 15th rushing touchdown of the season. It marks the seventh consecutive game that Slaton has scored a rushing touchdown.
- Slaton's rush was the longest rushing touchdown in WVU bowl game history. The rush also marked the longest rush in WVU bowl game history until Owen Schmitt rushed for 54 yards in the second quarter. It was also Slaton's longest career rush. His previous best was 44 yards against Virginia Tech.
- WVU's touchdown in its game-opening drive marked the fourth time this season that the Mountaineers have scored on its opening possession. WVU also scored on its opening drives against East Carolina, Cincinnati and South Florida.
- **Darius Reynaud** hauled in WVU's second score of the first quarter on a three-yard pass from **Pat White**. The touchdown was his team-leading fifth touchdown catch of the season and second consecutive contest with a receiving touchdown. The touchdown pass was White's eighth of the season.
- Addae forced Georgia's Danny Ware's fumble in the first quarter. **Dee McCann** recovered the fumble. The forced fumble was his second of the season and third of his career. The recovery was the first of the season for McCann and third of his career.
- **Steve Slaton** reached 1,000 yards for his career on his fourth carry of the game (an eight yard gain late in the first quarter).
- **Darius Reynaud's** 13-yard touchdown rush in the first quarter marked his second touchdown of the game, tying a WVU bowl record for most touchdowns in a game. It was his first rushing touchdown of the season.
- **Mike Lorello** forced D.J. Shockley's fumble in the first quarter and **Marc Magro** recovered the ball. It was Lorello's fifth forced fumble of the season and seventh of his career. The recovery was the first of Magro's career.
- WVU's 21 first quarter points marked the most points the Mountaineers have scored in a quarter since tallying 24 points in the fourth quarter in the win at Maryland. The points were the most scored by WVU in the first quarter all season.
- WVU's 21 first quarter points were the most ever scored in a game by the Mountaineers in a bowl game. It was the most points scored in any bowl quarter since WVU racked up 28 points in the second stanza of the 2000 Music City Bowl.
- Slaton's 18-yard touchdown run early in the second quarter marked his second rushing touchdown of the game. The two touchdowns ties a bowl record for most touchdowns in a bowl game.
- Slaton's multiple rushing touchdown performance marked the fourth time this season he has scored at least two rushing touchdowns: Louisville (5), Cincinnati (4) and Pitt (2).
- The rushing touchdown was Slaton's 16th of the season, tying him for fourth place on WVU's single season rushing touchdowns list tying him with Kerry Marbury (1972).
- **Owen Schmitt's** 54-yard run in the second quarter was the longest of his career. His previous long was a 44-yard gain in the Pitt win.
- **Pat McAfee's** 27-yard field goal in the second quarter was his 11th of the season.
