#### c SETTING THE STAGE

*Salisbury* battled through the NCAA Tournament to reach its 20th National Championship appearance. Salisbury opened the tournament with an 18-10 win over Colorado College. A day later, SU fended off a late comeback from No. 8 Amherst to win, 14-10, to advance to the NCAA Quarterfinals. In the quarterfinals, Salisbury once again stopped a late rally, this time from No. 9 Washington and Lee to defeat the Generals, 12-9, and move on to the national semifinals. The next day, SU used a strong second half to defeat No. 4 CNU, 12-8, to advance to the National Championship game.

As the top seed entering the tournament, *Tufts* rolled through the first weekend of the NCAA Tournament. In the second round, the Jumbos cruised to a 27-5 win over Emmanuel College. The next day, Tufts once again rolled to a 22-7 win over No. 10 York (Pa.) to advance to the second weekend. In the quarterfinals, the Jumbos once again used a dominating effort to defeat No. 11 Lynchburg, 17-9, to advance to the semifinal game. After a tight first quarter, Tufts pulled away and never looked back in the 15-11 win over No. 3 RIT to advance to the National Championship game.

#### In the Rankings

Salisbury enters the National Championship game ranked second in the USILA Coaches Top 25 Poll and in the U.S. Lacrosse Magazine Top 20 Poll. Salisbury has been in the top-five of each of major polls all season long and entered the 2023 season as the second-ranked team in the nation.

#### **Major Awards**

After the regular season, the Sea Gulls earned three of the five CLC major awards and had 12 selections to the inaugural All-CLC teams. **Cross Ferrara** was named the CLC Player of the Year after another dominating offensive performance with a team-high 118 points with 85 goals and a career-high 33 assists. For the third straight season, Ferrara was named to the Tewaaraton Award Watch List. This season, Ferrara became SU's all-time leader in points (469) and goals (359).

**Blake Malamphy** was selected as the CLC Rookie of the Year. Malamphy earned the faceoff job during the season and never looked back going 187-of-317 from the faceoff X. Malamphy finished with a 59 faceoff win percentage and added a team-high 131 ground balls. Malamphy also earned a USA Lacrosse Division III Player of the Week after a dominating 18 faceoff wins against CNU in April.

Jim Berkman and the rest of the Sea Gulls coaching staff earned the CLC Coaching Staff of the Year. After an early season loss to Gettysburg, the Sea Gulls have won 19 straight games on the way to their 20th National Championship appearance in program history. The winningest coach in NCAA men's lacrosse history, Berkman earned his 600th career win on Feb. 18 against Scranton and earned his 600th career win at SU on April 15 in the 'War on the Shore' game against Washington College.

#### All-C2C

Ferrara, Jude Brown, Isaac Thrasher, Jack Dowd, John DeFazio, and Zach Timmons all earned first-team honors. Malamphy, Brice Bromwell, Luke Nestor, Thomas Ballard, James Gilfillan, and Braden Glushakow each were named to the second team. Ferrara earned his third straight all-conference first-team honors, while Brown, Dowd, DeFazio, and Timmons each earned their second first-team all-conference honors.

#### Kings of the Sky

The 12-time national champions are competing in their 40th NCAA Tournament in 2023, the most in Division III history. The 12 titles are the second-most in DIII, behind Hobart's 13 titles. Salisbury competed in its 28th semifinal game and will be competing in its 20th national title game.

#### **Dominating Defense**

The Sea Gull defense dominated down the stretch in the 2023 season. In SU's final 12 games, the Sea Gulls did not allow their opponents to score more than 10 goals in a game. USILA All-Americans, *Zach Timmons, Thomas Ballard* and *John DeFazio* led the defensive group that caused 453 turnovers and scooped up 905 ground balls on the season. Salisbury has only allowed 196 goals on the season. The Sea Gull defense was excellent in man-down situations, allowing only 14 goals on 65 man-down situations, which ranked 21st in the country.

#### **Rising Rookies**

The Sea Gulls relied on many freshmen to make significant contributions during the 2023 season. Along with CLC Rookie of the Year *Blake Malamphy, Jeremiah Stafford, Brady Mancha, Riley Strub*, and *Evan Huffman* have played crucial roles during the 2023 season. The five freshmen have tallied 11 goals, six assists, 37 caused turnovers and 194 ground balls.

#### **Fantastic Ferrara**

**Cross Ferrara** was named the Conference Player of the Year for the third straight season. Ferrara broke the Salisbury record for career points (469) and goals (359). Ferrara led the Sea Gulls with 118 points with 85 goals and a career-high 33 assists. Ferrara enters the championship game 15th in the country with 3.70 goals-per game. Ferrara was also selected with the 28th overall pick by the Chrome LC in the 2023 PLL College Draft and was the only non-Division I player selected.



*Cross Ferrara* was announced on Feb. 10 as an addition to the Tewaaraton Award Watch List. It was the third time in his career he was named on the national watch list.

#### Jumbo Matchup

The Sea Gulls and the Jumbos have met five times in history. This is the fifth meeting in the National Championship between the two teams, with the teams splitting the previous four meetings. The two teams have met two times in the past seven years, both in the NCAA Tournament. The most recent meeting was in 2022 in the NCAA Quarterfinals. The Jumbos defeated the Sea Gulls 17-10, with Cross Ferrara scoring four goals and adding an assist. The Sea Gulls defeated the Jumbos in the 2016 National Championship, 14-13, for Salisbury's 11th National Championship.

#### **Offensive Firepower**


The eighth-ranked scoring offense in the country, the Sea Gulls have scored 398 goals during the 2023 season while scoring 17.30 goals per game. The Salisbury offense was one of the most efficient offenses in the country with 14.74 turnovers per game, which ranked second in Division III. The Sea Gull offense took advantage of man-up opportunities with 27 man-up goals and the 20th-ranked man-up goal percentage (43.5). **Cross Ferrara** finished 15th in the country with 3.70 goals-per game and **Jack Dowd** led the man-up unit with eight extra-man goals.

#### **Dishing Dimes**

The 2023 Sea Gull offense continued the tradition of moving the ball. Salisbury finished 14th in Division III with 199 assists on the season. Jude Brown led the Sea Gulls with 65 assists on the season and finished 15th in the country with 2.83 assists per game. Six Sea Gulls finished the season with double-digit assist totals with *Cross Ferrara* finishing second on the team with 33 assists. *Jack Dowd* added 21 assists and *Luke Nestor* and *Brice Bromwell* added 14 and 13 assists, respectively.

#### At the X

Led by CLC Rookie of the Year, **Blake Malamphy**, the Sea Gulls have had a steady group of faceoff specialists this season. Malamphy finished 53rd in the country with a 59.0 faceoff win percentage, while going 187-of-317 from the faceoff X. **Mackenzie Moreland** and **Ham McPartland** have each contributed at the faceoff circle with 50.3 and 50.8 faceoff win percentages, respectively.





The all-time winningest coach in NCAA men's lacrosse history, **Jim Berkman** enters his 35th season at the helm of 12-time national champion Salisbury University in 2023. Berkman has been the head of Salisbury men's lacrosse since 1989.

#### Notable Games as Head Coach

- May 29, 1994 Salisbury beats Hobart, 15-9 in College Park for the program's first NCAA Championship and caps off an undefeated season.
- May 28, 1995 Salisbury takes down Nazareth, 22-13 to repeat as national champions, the first of eight repeat championships for the Sea Gulls.
- May 29, 2005 Salisbury beats Middlebury, 11-10 to win their third consecutive national championship. The 2005 team is only the third team in NCAA Division III to three-peat as national champions.
- May 16, 2012 Berkman collects his 400th SU win in 14-4 NCAA semifinal win against Cabrini
- May 17, 2017 Berkman becomes the only coach in NCAA history with 500 wins with a 17-5 win over Cabrini in the NCAA guarterfinals.
- May 28, 2017 Salisbury wins the I2th national championship in program history with a 15-7 win over RIT in front of the largest crowd for a Division III championship in NCAA history (31,560).

#### **Coaching Career prior to Salisbury**

After graduating from St. Lawrence in 1982, Berkman spent two years at SU while he earned his master's degree. He served as the Gulls' assistant lacrosse coach during that time as SU compiled a 23-7 record. Following one season at SUNY Potsdam (1985), where Berkman coached the team to a school-record nine wins, he returned to St. Lawrence from 1985-88. As head basketball coach. Berkman directed his 1987-88 Saints to the ICAC league championship. Berkman also guided the SU women's soccer program for seven seasons (1994-2000) and posted an overall 102-28-5 (.774) record and two CAC championships.

#### **Playing Career**

An All-American midfielder at St. Lawrence University in 1982, the Watertown, N.Y., native starred on the basketball team as well as the lacrosse squad at St. Lawrence, earning MVP honors in basketball as both a junior and senior. He also was selected to play in the prestigious North-South All-Star lacrosse game in 1982. Berkman was inducted into the St. Lawrence Athletics Hall of Fame in 2001.
